WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost a season-high tying seven straight games as they open a seven-game homestand today with a straight doubleheader vs. Oakland.
- RHPs James Shields and Lucas Giolito are the scheduled starters for the White Sox, who were postponed yesterday for the fifth time this season and first in Chicago.
- The Sox are coming off a three-game sweep at Cleveland in which they were outscored by a 24-5 margin.
- Following this four-game series and a day off on Monday, the Sox conclude the homestand with three games vs. Minnesota (6/26-28).
- The Sox went 2-5 on their last homestand vs. Cleveland (2-2) and Detroit (0-3) from 6/11-17.

ROSTER MOVES

- Prior to the first game of today's doubleheader, the White Sox returned OF Avisaíl García and INF Leury García from their injury rehab assignments at Class AAA and reinstated both from the 10-day disabled list, optioned INF José Rondón to Charlotte and designated OF Trayce Thompson for assignment.
- The White Sox 40-man roster decreases to 38

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox are a season-high 25 games under .500 ... the Sox have been outscored, 43-16, during their seven-game losing streak.
- The Sox have lost four straight home games after going 9-5 in their previous 14.
- The White Sox have lost five straight games to Oakland (all at the Coliseum) and eight of the last nine.
- James Shields owns a 2.85 ERA (13 ER/41.0 IP) over his last six home starts (all quality) ... Shields has thrown at least 6.0 IP in 11 straight starts, his longest streak since 9/9/15-5/25/16when he went 14 in a row.
- The Sox are hitting .202 (91-450) with 34 runs scored over their last 14 games (2.4 R/G).

WEDNESDAY'S RECAP

- Corey Kluber combined with two relievers on a two-hitter as Cleveland completed its second three-game home sweep of the White Sox this season with a 12-0 victory.
- Reynaldo López (4 ER/4.1 IP) suffered the loss to fall to 0-2 with a 14.14 ERA (11 ER/7.0 IP) in two starts against Cleveland in 2018 ... Bruce Rondón gave up six runs in 1.0 IP of relief.
- Omar Narváez (second-inning single) and José Abreu (ninthinning double) collected the only hits for the Sox, who were shut out for the eighth time this season.
- The Sox lost their seventh straight game in Cleveland.

LET'S PLAY TWO

- The White Sox are playing their third doubleheader of the season and first at home ... the Sox split twinbills on 4/28 at Kansas City and 6/5 at Minnesota.

BIG GAME JAMES

- James Shields has made seven quality starts in his last nine outings and has thrown at least 7.0 IP in five of his last six starts.
- Shields is allowing 1.04 home runs per 9.0 IP in 2018, down from 2.08 in 2017, and has lowered his opponents average from 253 to 232
- He reached the 40,000-pitch milestone on 5/27 at Detroit (postseason included) and 2,500.0 career IP on 6/1 vs. Cleveland Shields ranks 69th all-time with 2 144 strikeouts

LAST NIGHT ON THE FARM

- Class AAA Charlotte RHP Carson Fulmer struck out a careerhigh 11 batters over 7.0 IP vs. Columbus.
- OF Joel Booker matched his career high (fifth time) in his Class AA Birmingham debut, going 4-5 with with a double, stolen base and two runs scored.
- Booker a 22nd-round pick in 2016, is batting .310/.398/.482 (61-197) with five homers, 21 RBI, 41 runs scored and 15 steals in 54 combined games this season between Birmingham and Class A Winston-Salem.
- OFs Blake Rutherford and Micker Adolfo, the No. 7 and 10 prospects in the Sox organization per MLB Pipleline, both homered last night for Class A Winston-Salem ... OF Luis Robert, the Sox No. 3 prospect and No. 24 overal in baseball, went 1-3 with a RBI, run scored and stolen base in his Winston-Salem debut.

WHITE SOX VS. OAKLAND

- The A's lead the season series, 3-0, sweeping a three-game series from 4/16-18 at the Coliseum.
- The White Sox are batting .252/.313/.358 (31-123) with a 8.49 ERA (28 ER/29.2 IP) and have been outscored, 30-14.
- The Sox were 1-5 in 2017 (0-3 at home and 1-2 on the road) for their first losing record against Oakland since 2013.
- Oakland's three-game sweep on 6/23-25/17 was its first at Guaranteed Rate Field since 2005.
- The White Sox are 287-310 all-time, going 149-146 at home (61-64 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 138-164 on the road.

SOX-A'S CONNECTIONS

- White Sox hitting coaches Todd Steverson (2009-13) and Greg Sparks (1997-2015) both coached in the Oakland organization.
- RHP Dylan Covey was selected by Oakland in the fourth round of the 2013 draft.
- Oakland RHPs Chris Bassitt (2014) and Frankie Montas (2015), INF Marcus Semien (2013-14) and C Josh Phegley (2013-14) all played for the White Sox.

WILD WILD WEST

- The White Sox are 4-9 vs. the American League West in 2018, going 4-6 at home and 0-3 on the road.
- The Sox are 182-163 vs. the AL West since 2008, including a

CWS AT THE CWS

- White Sox draft choices INF Nick Madrigal (first round, Oregon State), LHP Konnor Pilkington (third round, Mississippi State) and RHP Davis Martin (14th round, Texas Tech) all helped their teams reach the College World Series in Omaha, Neb.
- Madrigal went 2-6 with two runs scored on Wednesday as Oregon State rallied to defeat North Carolina, 11-6, in an elimination game ... the Beavers play Mississippi State today at 2:00 CT in the double elimination round.
- Texas Tech was eliminated last night with a 9-6 loss to Florida.

BULLPEN RELIEF

- The White Sox bullpen owns a 2.69 ERA (35 ER/117.0 IP) in 37 games since 5/13, the fourth-best mark in the major leagues.
- Joakim Soria owns a 0.00 ERA (12.2 IP) over his last 13 appearances, converting all six save chances with five hits allowed, two walks and 13 strikeouts.
- Jace Fry has posted a 2.25 ERA (5 ER/20.0 IP) with 26 strikeouts and a .151 (11-73) opponents average in 20 appearances this season
- Xavier Cedeño has made seven straight scoreless appearances since joining the White Sox on 6/7.

PITO STILL FIRST AT FIRST

- José Abreu continues to lead American League first basemen in fan balloting for the MLB All-Star Game presented by Mastercard ... as of 6/19, Abreu had received 636,666 votes to widen his lead over Boston's Mitch Moreland (472,245).
- Abreu is the first White Sox player to lead at any point in the balloting process since Frank Thomas won the fan election at first base in 1996.
- He would be the sixth Sox player (11th time) to be fan-elected as a starter to the All-Star Team, joining Thomas (1994-96), Carlton Fisk (1981-82), Richie Zisk (1977), Dick Allen (1972-74) and Luis Aparicio (1970).

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

• The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,345 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, two more than the second-place New York Mets (1,343) and 44 more than Oakland (1,300), the next-closest American League team.

DOUBLE VISION

- José Abreu ranks second in the major leagues with 27 doubles, and is on pace to hit 60 this season, which would be the most in the major leagues since Colorado's Todd Helton (59) in 2000.
- Abreu, who hit a career-high 43 doubles in 2017, needed just 62 games this season to reach 25, which fied Bibb Falk (25 in 1926) for the fewest in Sox history to reach that milestone.

TRIPLE THE FUN

- The White Sox are tied for third in the major leagues this season with 21 triples ... the Sox led the AL with 37 triples last season, their most since 1999 (also 37).
- Yolmer Sánchez leads the majors with eight triples in 2018 after ranking sixth last season with eight.

SHIELDS AT A GLANCE

- Is scheduled to make his 17th appearance (16th start), 10th start at Guaranteed Rate Field and first vs. Oakland ... is looking to record just his second win in Chicago this season.
- Has worked at least 6.0 IP in each of his last 11 starts, his longest streak since 9/9/15-5/25/16 (14) ... is 1-6 with a 4.13 ERA (33 ER/72.0 IP), 1.11 WHIP and .213 opponents average during the 11-start span.
- Has allowed seven home runs in his last four starts.
- Is 1-2 with a 2.85 ERA (13 ER/41.0 IP) and 1.76 run support average (8 RS) in his last six starts at Guaranteed Rate Field ... the Sox have scored zero runs in support of Shields three times during that span.
- Ranks 69th all-time in major-league history with 2,144 strikeouts, five behind Dennis Martínez (2,149) for 68th all-time (see chart at right).
- Is 11-27 with a 5.59 ERA (203 ER/326.2 IP), 245 strikeouts, 69 home runs allowed and a 1.48 WHIP over 59 appearances (58 GS/26 QS) since being acquired by the White Sox from the Padres in a trade on 6/4/16.
- Ranks among the active MLB leaders since 2007 in games started $(2\mathsf{nd},366), \mathsf{IP}\,(2\mathsf{nd},2,\!382.0), \mathsf{pitches}\,\mathsf{thrown}\,(2\mathsf{nd},37,\!479), \mathsf{quality}\,\mathsf{starts}$ (T4th, 225), shutouts (5th, 9), opponents GIDP (5th, 194), complete games (T5th, 22), strikeouts (8th, 2,040) and wins (11th, 134).

LAST START

- Suffered the loss on 6/17 vs. Detroit after allowing three runs on six hits, including one homer, with four walks and five strikeouts in 6.0 IP.
- Surrendered a two-run home run to Nicholas Castellanos in the first inning and a RBI single to José Iglesias in the fourth ... allowed just two hits in the other four frames.
- Left the game with the White Sox trailing, 3-1, after throwing 103 pitches (61 strikes) ... the Sox were held scoreless over the final seven innings in the 3-1 defeat vs. the Tigers
- Received one run or less of support for the sixth time in his last eight outings ... Chicago lost for the fourth time in his last five starts.

WORTH THE WAIT

- Snapped his 12-start, and 13-appearance, winless streak on 6/12 vs. Cleveland ... marked his first win since Opening Day (3/29) at Kansas City ... the 12-start stretch was the longest of his career
- The winless start stretch tied with Minnesota's Kyle Gibson (active), Kansas City's Ian Kennedy (active) and Miami's José Ureña for the longest in MLB this season
- Went 0-6 with a 4.76 ERA (40 ER/75.2 IP), .233 opponents average and 2.02 run support average (17 RS) over the 12 starts during the streak.

WARMING UP WITH THE WEATHER

- Is 1-5 with a 3.95 ERA (29 ER/66.0 IP), .209 opponents average and 1.06 WHIP over his 10 starts (eight QS) since 5/1 ... has worked 7.0-plus IP four times and allowed three runs or less in eight outings.
- Ranked among the MLB May leaders in opponents SLG (5th, .252), opponents average (6th, .173), hits per 9.0 IP (6th, 5.40), opponents OPS (6th, .500), WHIP (T10th, 0.93) and opponents OBP (11th, .248).

- Has received two runs or less of support in nine of his last 10 starts (one or less six times) and three or less in 12 of last 13 (1.83 RSA; 17 RS/83.2 IP) since 4/11... the club scored 17 runs in his first two outings
- The 11-start stretch of three runs or less of support from 4/11-6/7 was his longest since 9/27/15-6/8/16 (13 consecutive starts; 1.90 RSA, 16 RS).
- Received a 5.46 run support average (71 RS/117.0 IP) over his 21 starts last season, compared to a 3.22 mark (65 RS/181.2 IP) in 2016 ... his 4.60 career RSA is the ninth-lowest among active pitchers.
- His 3.22 RSA in 2016 was the lowest in baseball and the lowest of his career.
- Owns a 4.31 RSA (156 RS/326.0 IP) as a starter since joining the White Sox (58 starts), receiving the following run support marks: zero runs (15x), one (10x), two (10x), three (7x), four (4x), five (4x) and six-plus (8x) ... has received one run or less of support in 43.1 percent (25-58) of his outings with the Sox.

NOT DIGGING THE LONG BALL

- Has surrendered 11 home runs this season, including seven in his last four starts ... allowed three homers in each outing on 6/2 vs. Milwaukee and 6/7 at Minnesota after going 14 consecutive appearances without allowing multiple homers from 9/20/17-5/27/18, the second-longest stretch of his career
- Has allowed 78 homers since 2016 and 111 since 2015 ... his 111 homers allowed since 2015 are the second-most in MLB behind Kansas City's Ian Kennedy (112).
- Allowed 27 home runs last season, his fewest since 2014 (23) ... surrendered a major-league leading 40 home runs in 2016 after leading baseball with 33 in 2015 ... became the first pitcher to lead MLB in homers allowed in consecutive seasons since Tom Browning in 1988-89.
- Has allowed 1.68 homers per 9.0 IP since 2015 (596.1 IP), the fourth-highest mark in the major leagues.

35TH AND SHIELDS

- Is 9-15 with a 4.88 ERA (111 ER/204.2 IP), 196 hits allowed (41 homers), 87 walks, 159 strikeouts, a .248 opponents average and 1.38 WHIP in his 35 starts (20 quality) at Guaranteed Rate Field with Chicago.
- Prior to joining the White Sox, was 4-1 with a 3.00 mark (24 ER/72.0 IP), 1.33 WHIP, 47 strikeouts and nine home runs allowed over 11 starts (nine quality starts) as a visitor at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- Over his 46 career outings in Chicago, has allowed three runs or less 31 times and two or less 21 times has worked at least 6.0 IP in 37 of 46 starts ... 29 of his starts have been quality.

FEELING INDECISIVE

- Is tied for ninth in the American League with six no decisions this season ... his 73 NDs since 2011 are the second-most in the major leagues behind Texas' Cole Hamels (74).
- In his six no decisions this season, Chicago has scored a total of 10 runs, including two runs twice, one run once and zero runs four times ... the White Sox are 3-3 when Shields receives a ND.

OPENING DAY HONORS

- His season debut marked his eighth career Opening Day start following four with Tampa Bay (2008-10, 12), two with Kansas City (2013-14) and one with San Diego (2015).
- Is 2-2 with a 4.98 ERA (26 ER/47.0 IP) and 30 strikeouts in the eight OD outings.
- Is tied with the Dodgers' Clayton Kershaw for the fourth-most Opening Day starts among active pitchers. ioined Edinson Vólguez as the only active pitchers to start season openers for four different teams (STATS).
