WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost eight of their last nine games as they continue a seven-game homestand today vs. Oakland.
- RHP Dylan Covey, who was selected by Oakland in the fourth round of the 2013 draft, is scheduled to start for the White Sox.
- The Sox opened the homestand yesterday by splitting a doubleheader against the A's, winning the nightcap after losing the opener.
- Following this four-game series and a day off on Monday, the Sox conclude the homestand with three games vs. Minnesota (6/26-28).
- The Sox went 0-3 on their last trip to Cleveland from 6/18-20 and 2-5 on their last homestand vs. Cleveland (2-2) and Detroit (0-3) from 6/11-17.

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- Dylan Covey is 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA (3 ER/19.0 IP) and 20 strikeouts in three starts at home this season.
- The White Sox are a season-high tying 25 games under .500.
- The Sox have lost five of their last six home games after going 9-5 in their previous 14.
- The White Sox are 2-8 in their last 10 games against Oakland.
- The Sox are hitting .210 (109-520) with 42 runs scored over their last 16 games (2.6 R/G).

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- The White Sox split a doubleheader vs. Oakland, recording a 6-4 victory in the nightcap after losing the opener, 11-2.
- In the nightcap, the Sox ended a season-high, eight-game losing streak and a six-game slide to Oakland with a 6-4 victory.
- Lucas Giolito earned the win, allowing four runs on seven hits with a season-high eight strikeouts over a career-high tying 7.0 IP ... after giving up a run on two hits and a walk in the first inning, Giolito retired 18 of the next 22 hitters before yielding consecutive hits to open the eighth.
- Xavier Cedeño (1.0) made his eighth straight scoreless appearance for his second hold, and Joakim Soria pitched a 1-2-3 ninth for his 11th save and seventh in a row to extend his streak to 14 straight appearances without allowing an earned run.
- Omar Narváez tied his career-high with three hits (third time) and drove in two runs, Adam Engel hit a two-run single, and Tim Anderson hit his 12th home run, a solo shot off Yusmeiro Petit.
- James Shields suffered the loss, allowing a season-high eight runs (two earned) on five hits over 4.2 IP, ending his streak of 11 consecutive starts of at least 6.0 IP ... Juan Minaya threw 2.0 scoreless IP in relief.

POWERFUL PROSPECT PIPELINE

- The White Sox feature eight of the Top 100 prospects according to MLB Pipeline's latest rankings, tied with Atlanta for the most in baseball.
- OF Eloy Jimenez (No. 4) is the highest rated Sox prospect, followed by RHP Michael Kopech (12), OF Luis Robert (26), RHPs Dylan Cease (43), Alec Hansen (49) and Dane Dunning (56), OF Blake Rutherford (85) and C Zack Collins (99).

ON THE FARM

- OF Joel Booker has gone 7-9 with a double and four runs scored in his first two games with Class AA Birmingham ... he was 3-4 with two runs scored last night after going 4-5 with a double, stolen base and two runs scored on Thursday.
- Booker a 22nd-round pick in 2016, is batting .318/.407/.493 (64-201) with five homers, 21 RBI, 43 runs scored and 15 steals in 55 combined games this season between Birmingham and Class A Winston-Salem.
- Class A Winston-Salem OF Blake Rutherford, the No. 7 prospect in the Sox organization per MLB Pipeline, went 3-4 with a double, home run, four RBI and three runs scored last night vs. Down East ... Rutherford is hitting .295 (67-227) with six homers and 48 RBI in 58 games with the Dash this season.
- OF Luis Robert, the Sox No. 3 prospect and No. 24 overall in baseball, has gone 3-7 (.429) with two runs scored and a stolen base in his first two games with Winston-Salem since being promoted from Class A Kannapolis.

CWS AT THE CWS

- White Sox draft choices INF Nick Madrigal (first round, Oregon State), LHP Konnor Pilkington (third round, Mississippi State) and RHP Davis Martin (14th round, Texas Tech) all helped their teams reach the College World Series in Omaha, Neb.
- Madrigal went 3-5 with a walk, two RBI, two runs scored and two stolen bases yesterday in a 12-2 victory over Mississippi State in the double elimination round ... Pilkington did not pitch.
- The Beavers and Bulldogs play again tonight at 7:00 p.m. CT in an elimination game.

WHITE SOX VS. OAKLAND

- The A's lead the season series, 4-1, including a three-game sweep at the Coliseum from 4/16-18.
- The White Sox are batting .254/.304/.352 (49-193) with a 6.99 ERA (37 ER/47.2 IP) and have been outscored, 45-22.
- The Sox were 1-5 in 2017 (0-3 at home and 1-2 on the road) for their first losing record against Oakland since 2013.
- Oakland's three-game sweep on 6/23-25/17 was its first at Guaranteed Rate Field since 2005.
- The White Sox are 288-311 all-time, going 150-147 at home (62-65 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 138-164 on the road.

SOX-A'S CONNECTIONS

- White Sox hitting coaches Todd Steverson (2009-13) and Greg Sparks (1997-2015) both coached in the Oakland organization.
- RHP Dylan Covey was selected by Oakland in the fourth round of the 2013 draft.
- Oakland RHPs Chris Bassitt (2014) and Frankie Montas (2015), INF Marcus Semien (2013-14) and C Josh Phegley (2013-14) all played for the White Sox.

WILD WILD WEST

- The White Sox are 5-10 vs. the American League West in 2018, going 4-7 at home and 0-3 on the road ... they have won five of their last nine games after losing their first six.
- The Sox are 183-164 vs. the AL West since 2008, including a 106-71 record at home.

BULLPEN RELIEF

- The White Sox bullpen owns a 2.77 ERA (38 ER/123.1 IP) in 39 games since 5/13, the fifth-best mark in the major leagues.
- Joakim Soria owns a 0.00 ERA (13.2 IP) over his last 14 appearances, converting all seven save chances with five hits allowed, two walks and 15 strikeouts.
- Jace Fry has posted a 2.25 ERA (5 ER/20.0 IP) with 26 strikeouts and a .151 (11-73) opponents average in 21 appearances this season.
- Xavier Cedeño has made eight straight scoreless appearances (6.1 IP) since joining the White Sox on 6/7.

PITO STILL FIRST AT FIRST

- José Abreu continues to lead American League first basemen in fan balloting for the MLB All-Star Game presented by Mastercard ... as of 6/19, Abreu had received 636,666 votes to widen his lead over Boston's Mitch Moreland (472,245).
- Abreu is the first White Sox player to lead at any point in the balloting process since Frank Thomas won the fan election at first base in 1996.
- He would be the sixth Sox player (11th time) to be fan-elected as a starter to the All-Star Team, joining Thomas (1994-96), Carlton Fisk (1981-82), Richie Zisk (1977), Dick Allen (1972-74) and Luis Aparicio (1970).
- Voting continues through 7/5 at 11:59 p.m. ET.

DOUBLE VISION

- José Abreu ranks second in the major leagues with 27 doubles, and is on pace to hit 58 this season, which would be the most in the major leagues since Colorado's Todd Helton (59) in 2000.
- Abreu, who hit a career-high 43 doubles in 2017, needed just 62 games this season to reach 25, which tied Bibb Falk (25 in 1926) for the fewest in Sox history to reach that milestone.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,345 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, two more than the second-place New York Mets (1,343) and 43 more than Oakland (1,300), the next-closest American League team.

TRIPLE THE FUN

- The White Sox are tied for third in the major leagues this season with 21 triples ... the Sox led the AL with 37 triples last season, their most since 1999 (also 37).
- Yolmer Sánchez leads the majors with eight triples in 2018 after ranking sixth last season with eight.

CALL TO THE HALL

- Jim Thome, who played for the White Sox from 2006-09 and serves as a special assistant to the general manager, will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame on 7/29/18.
- Thome, who ranks eighth in major-league history with 612 home runs, received 89.8 percent of the votes to become the fifth former Sox player inducted on the first ballot.
- He will join Chipper Jones, Vladimir Guerrero, Trevor Hoffman Jack Morris and Alan Trammell in the Class of 2018.

COVEY AT A GLANCE

- The 26-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his eighth start of the season, fourth at home and first career appearance vs. Oakland.
- Is 3-1 with a 2.36 ERA (9 ER/ 34.1 IP), 32 strikeouts and a .254 (34-134) opponents average over his last six starts.
- Made six relief appearances last season, posting a 7.94 ERA (10 ER/11.1 IP) with four home runs, seven walks and seven strikeouts ... opponents hit .325 (13-40) during those games.
- Was selected by the White Sox from the Athletics in the major-league portion of the Rule 5 Draft on 12/8/16 ... entered the 2017 season with zero major-league experience.
- Has gone 20-26 with a 4.06 ERA (181 ER/401.1 IP) and 288 strikeouts over 81 appearances (78 starts) over five minor-league seasons in the Athletics (2013-16) and White Sox (2017-18) organizations.
- Attended the University of San Diego from 2010-13 ... was teammates with Chicago Cubs third baseman and 2016 National League Most Valuable Player Kris Bryant.
- Was originally selected by Oakland in the fourth round of the June 2013 First-Year Player Draft.
- Bio is on page 63 of the 2018 Chicago White Sox media guide.

LAST START

- Suffered his second loss of the season on 6/18 at Cleveland after allowing five runs (four earned) on six hits and five walks with two strikeouts over 5.0 IP.
- Allowed a two-RBI double to Roberto Pérez in the second inning, an RBI single to Jason Kipnis in the third and a solo homer to Kipnis in the fifth.
- Left the game with the White Sox trailing, 5-0, after tossing 94 pitches (56 strikes) ... Chicago went on to lose, 6-2.

HOME COOKIN'

- Is set to make his eighth career start at Guaranteed Rate Field ... is 2-1 with a 3.59 ERA (19 ER/47.2 IP), .243 (43-177) opponents average, 18 walks and 45 strikeouts lifetime, compared to 1-8 with a 7.76 ERA (54 ER/62.2 IP) and .320 (81-253) opponents average, 15 homers allowed, 32 walks and 31 strikeouts over 12 career starts.
- Earned the win in his last home start on 6/13 vs. Cleveland ... allowed two runs on 10 hits with five strikeouts over a career-high tying 7.0 IP.

WHERE'S THE RUN SUPPORT?

- Received one run or less of support in three of his last four starts, after receiving 17 runs of support in his previous three.
- Has received one or no runs of support in nine of his 19 career starts ... his career run support breakdown: zero (two), one (seven), two (five), three (two) and four-plus (three).

2018 MINOR LEAGUE STARTS

- Went 3-1 with a 2.33 ERA (10 ER/38.2 IP), 36 strikeouts and a .226 (32-141) opponents average over seven starts with Class AAA Charlotte this season.
- Did not receive a decision in his last start with Charlotte on 5/15, allowing one unearned run on four hits with one walk and six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.

LOOKING BACK AT 2017

- Made his major-league debut on 4/14/17 at Minnesota ... did not receive the decision after allowing one run on five hits with three walks and one strikeout over 5.1 IP.
- Went 0-7 with a 7.71 ERA (60 ER/70.0 IP) in 12 starts with the Sox ... the last Sox pitcher to begin his MLB career winless over seven or more starts was Ramon García from 5/31/91-7/6/91 (eight straight starts) ... source: STATS LLC.
- Was on the 10-day disabled list from 5/26-8/15/17 (retroactive to 5/24) with a strained left oblique.
- Made two appearances with Class AAA Charlotte, going 0-0 with a 3.00 ERA (2 ER/6.0 IP), one walk and three strikeouts ... opponents batted .227 (5-22) with one home run.

COVEY'S COVER STORY

- Originally was selected by Milwaukee in the first round (14th overall) of the June 2010 First-Year Player Draft ... following his post-draft physical and before signing a contract, was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes.
- Following the diagnosis, elected not to sign with the Brewers and committed to play at the University of San Diego ... was teammates with Chicago Cubs third baseman and 2016 National League Most Valuable Player Kris Bryant.
- Pitched for the Toreros from 2010-13 before being drafted by Oakland in the fourth round in 2013.
- Former White Sox and current Boston Red Sox left-hander Chris Sale was selected one spot ahead of Covey with the 13th overall pick in the 2010 draft.

VS. AMERICAN LEAGUE WEST

- Is scheduled to make his fifth career appearance and third start against the American League West.
- Is 0-0 with an 8.79 ERA (14 ER/14.2 IP) and .286 (16-56) opp. average against the division lifetime.

VS. OAKLAND ATHLETICS

- Is scheduled to make his first career appearance against Oakland.
- Spent four minor-league seasons with the Oakland organization (2013-16), going 18-25 with a 4.20 ERA (172 ER/369.0 IP) and 264 strikeouts over 72 games (71 starts) ... was selected by Oakland in the fourth round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- LHP Carlos Rodón (0-2, 4.41) is scheduled to make his fourth start of the season, second at home and fourth career against Oakland.
- Suffered the loss in his last start on 6/19 at Cleveland ... allowed four runs on five hits and two walks with five strikeouts over 6.1 IP.
- Is 1-1 with a 4.67 ERA (9 ER/17.1 IP) and .232 (16-69) opponents average over three career starts against the Athletics.
- Will make his 18th career start against an American League West opponent ... is 6-3 with a 3.14 ERA (36 ER/103.1 IP) and .234 (94-392) opponents average lifetime.
