WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost nine of their last 10 games as they continue a seven-game homestand this afternoon with the finale vs. Oakland.
- LHP Carlos Rodón is scheduled to start for the White Sox, who are 2-9 in their last 11 games against the A's.
- The Sox have opened the homestand by losing two of the first three game of this series, splitting a doubleheader on Friday and suffering a 7-6 loss yesterday.
- Following today's game and a day off tomorrow, the Sox conclude the homestand with three games vs. Minnesota (6/26-28).
- The Sox went 0-3 on their last trip to Cleveland from 6/18-20 and 2-5 on their last homestand vs. Cleveland (2-2) and Detroit (0-3) from 6/11-17.

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox are a season-high tying 26 games under .500.
- The Sox have lost six of their last seven home games after going 9-5 in their previous 14.
- The White Sox bullpen owns a 7.80 ERA (13 ER/13.0 IP) over his last four games, compared to 1.75 (11 ER/56.2 IP) over the first 19 in June.
- Chicago is hitting .210 (117-556) with 48 runs scored over their last 17 games (2.8 R/G).
- Tim Anderson is 4-8 with a double, two home runs, four RBI and five runs scored over his last two games.

GONZÁLEZ ON ASSIGNMENT

- The White Sox have sent RHP Miguel González on a rehab assignment to Class AAA Charlotte ... González, who has been on the disabled list since 4/22 with right rotator cuff inflammation, is scheduled to start today for Charlotte vs. Toledo.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- Pinch-hitter Nick Martini recorded his first major-league hit, a game-winning RBI single off Juan Minaya in the eighth inning, as Oakland overcame a 5-0 deficit to defeat the White Sox, 7-6.
- The Sox scored five runs in the first inning, including a three-run home run from Tim Anderson, but the A's rallied for two runs in the second and three in the fifth to tie the game.
- Anderson, celebrating his 25th birthday, homered for the second straight game and scored two runs.
- Sox starter Dylan Covey (4 ER/4.0 IP) was removed in the fifth inning with right hip soreness ... Jace Fry threw 2.0 scoreless IP in relief to lower his ERA to 2.05.

HAWK'S FAREWELL

- Ken "Hawk" Harrelson, who is in his 33rd and final season in the White Sox television booth in 2018, will work primarily Sunday home games this season as well as select other contests.
- The celebration of his final season in the broadcast booth continues this season as special guests will join Hawk in the booth ... special guest analyst this season include:
 - Hall-of-Famer Frank Thomas on 6/17 vs. Detroit.
 - Former White Sox captain Paul Konerko on 8/19 vs. Kansas City at 1:10 p.m. on NBC Sports Chicago.
 - Fan-favorite A.J. Pierzynski on Hawk Day, 9/2 vs. Boston at 1:10 p.m. on NBC Sports Chicago.

30/30 THREAT

- SS Tim Anderson (13 HR/15 SB) is one of seven players in the major leagues this season with at least 10 home runs and 10 stolen bases.
- Anderson is on pace to record career highs with 28 homers and 32 stolen bases ... the 28 home runs would tie José Valentín for the second-highest total in Sox history by a shortstop (Valentín, 30 in 2004), and the 32 steals would be the most since Ozzie Guillén in 1989 (36).
- His 13 homers are tied with Valentín (2000 and 2003) for the third-highest total in franchise history by a shortstop before the All-Star Break.

ON THE FARM

- OF Joel Booker has gone 8-14 (.571) with two doubles, a home run and six runs scored in his first three games with Class AA Birmingham ... he hit his first homer with the Barons last night.
- Booker, a 22nd-round pick in 2016, is batting .316/.403/.500 (64-201) with six homers, 22 RBI, 45 runs scored and 15 steals in 56 combined games this season between Birmingham and Class A Winston-Salem.
- Winston-Salem OF Micker Adolfo, the No. 10 prospect in the Sox organization per MLB Pipeline, hit a three-run homer (No. 9) last night in a 5-3 victory vs. Down East ... Adolfo is hitting .278 (70-252) with nine homers and 42 RBI in 68 games with the Dash this season.

WHITE SOX VS. OAKLAND

- The A's lead the season series, 5-1, and have clinched back-to-back season series victories over the White Sox for the first time since 2009-10.
- The White Sox are batting .249/.304/.358 (57-229) with a 6.99 ERA (44 ER/56.2 IP) and have been outscored, 52-28.
- Oakland's three-game sweep on 6/23-25/17 was its first at Guaranteed Rate Field since 2005.
- The White Sox are 288-312 all-time, going 150-148 at home (62-66 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 138-164 on the road.

WILD WILD WEST

- The White Sox are 5-11 vs. the American League West in 2018, going 4-8 at home and 0-3 on the road ... they have won five of their last 10 games after losing their first six.
- The Sox are 183-165 vs. the AL West since 2008, including a 106-71 record at home.

CWS AT THE CWS

- White Sox draft choices INF Nick Madrigal (first round, Oregon State), LHP Konnor Pilkington (third round, Mississippi State) and RHP Davis Martin (14th round, Texas Tech) all helped their teams reach the College World Series in Omaha, Neb.
- Madrigal went 1-4 last night as Oregon State defeated Mississippi State, 5-2, to advance to the CWS finals ... the Beavers play Arkansas in the best-of-three finals starting tomorrow night at 6:00 p.m. CT.

BULLPEN RELIEF

- The White Sox bullpen owns a 2.88 ERA (41 ER/128.1 IP) in 40 games since 5/13, the fifth-best mark in the American League.
- Joakim Soria owns a 0.00 ERA (13.2 IP) over his last 14 appearances, converting all seven save chances with five hits allowed, two walks and 15 strikeouts.
- Jace Fry owns a 2.05 ERA (5 ER/22.0 IP) with 28 strikeouts and a .151 (12-79) opponents average in 22 games this season.
- Xavier Cedeño has made eight straight scoreless appearances (6.1 IP) since joining the White Sox on 6/7.

POWERFUL PROSPECT PIPELINE

- The White Sox farm system features eight of the Top 100 prospects in baseball according to MLB Pipeline's latest rankings, tied with Atlanta for the most in the major leagues.
- OF Eloy Jimenez (No. 4) is the highest rated Sox prospect, followed by RHP Michael Kopech (12), OF Luis Robert (26), RHPs Dylan Cease (43), Alec Hansen (49) and Dane Dunning (56), OF Blake Rutherford (85) and C Zack Collins (99).

PITO STILL FIRST AT FIRST

- José Abreu continues to lead American League first basemen in fan balloting for the MLB All-Star Game presented by Mastercard ... as of 6/19, Abreu had received 636,666 votes to widen his lead over Boston's Mitch Moreland (472,245).
- Abreu is the first White Sox player to lead at any point in the balloting process since Frank Thomas won the fan election at first base in 1996.
- He would be the sixth Sox player (11th time) to be fan-elected as a starter to the All-Star Team, joining Thomas (1994-96), Carlton Fisk (1981-82), Richie Zisk (1977), Dick Allen (1972-74) and Luis Aparicio (1970).
- Voting continues through 7/5 at 11:59 p.m. ET.

DOUBLE VISION

- José Abreu ranks second in the major leagues with 27 doubles, and is on pace to hit 58 this season, which would be the most in the major leagues since Colorado's Todd Helton (59) in 2000.
- Abreu, who hit a career-high 43 doubles in 2017, needed just 62 games this season to reach 25, which tied Bibb Falk (25 in 1926) for the fewest in Sox history to reach that milestone.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,345 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, one more than the second-place New York Mets (1,343) and 43 more than Oakland (1,300), the next-closest American League team.

ON DECK: MINNESOTA TWINS

- The White Sox continue the homestand on Tuesday with a three-game series vs. Minnesota ... RHP Reynaldo López (2-5, 3.59) is scheduled to start the series opener ... López allowed one hit over 7.0 scoreless IP in his last start against the Twins on 6/5-1 at Target Field.
- The Sox are 3-6 vs. Minnesota in 2018, going 1-3 at home and 2-3 on the road.

RODÓN AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his fourth start of the season, second at home and first against Oakland.
- Needs one strikeout for 400 in his career and 10.0 IP for 400.0.
- Started the 2018 season on the disabled list to continue his rehabilitation from left shoulder surgery ... underwent arthroscopic surgery on his left shoulder on 9/27/17.
- Began the 2017 season on the disabled list with left biceps bursitis ... went 2-5 with a 4.15 ERA (32 ER/69.1 IP) and 76 strikeouts over 12 starts before going back on the disabled list with left shoulder inflammation ... underwent arthroscopic surgery on his left shoulder on 9/27/17.
- His 394 career strikeouts are the most by a White Sox pitcher in his first 68 career games ... is averaging 9.24 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (383.2 IP) lifetime ... has struck out 10-plus seven times in his career.
- Was selected in the first round (third overall) in the June 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of North Carolina State University ... was the highest pick by the Sox since taking outfielder Harold Baines first overall in 1977.
- Entered the 2014 draft rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 1 college prospect and the No. 3 prospect overall ... was rated by MLB.com as the No. 2 overall prospect.

LAST START

- Suffered his second loss of the season on 6/19 at Cleveland after allowing four runs on five hits over 6.1 IP ... walked two and struck out five.
- Tossed 4.1 scoreless IP from the third-seventh innings after allowing all four runs in the second ... retired 11 of the last 12 batters he faced.
- Departed with the Sox trailing, 4-1, in the seventh ... threw 98 pitches (62 strikes) ... the Sox lost 6-3.

HE GONE!

- Has averaged 9.21 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (399 SO/390.0 IP) over his career, the 12th-best mark in the AL since 2015 (minimum 350.0 IP).
- Has recorded 10-plus strikeouts seven times in his career, including a career-high 11 on four occasions: 8/4/17 at Boston, 7/25/17 at the Cubs, 9/25/16 at Cleveland and 8/11/15 vs. Los Angeles-AL.

QUALITY IS KEY

- Six of his 12 starts last season were quality, including five straight from 7/30-8/21.
- Made 17 quality starts in 2016, going 9-3 with a 2.16 ERA (26 ER/108.1 IP) in those outings ... recorded 16 quality starts in 2015, the most among American League rookies and second-most among major-league rookies behind Cincinnati's Anthony DeSclafani (17).
- Recorded 10 consecutive quality starts from 8/11/15-4/13/16 ... went 6-3 with a 1.73 ERA (13 ER/67.2 IP), 61 strikeouts and a .202 (48-236) opponents average during that span.
- Is 20-8 with a 2.38 ERA (74 ER/280.1 IP) in 43 career starts when working at least 6.0 IP (39 QS).

LOCKDOWN ON LEFTIES

- Is limiting lefties to a .223 (77-345) average with five home runs in his career ... right-handers are batting .269 (306-1,139) with 44 homers.
- Charlie Blackmon, Jackie Bradley Jr., Robinson Canó, David Ortiz and Corey Seager are the only lefties to homer off Rodón.

CARLOS ON THE MEND

- Made four rehab starts during his stint on the disabled list: one with Class A Kannapolis and three with Class AAA Charlotte ... received a no decision in his only start with Kannapolis on 5/19 vs. Hickory ... allowed one run on three hits with no walks and six strikeouts over 5.0 IP ... went 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA (2 ER/12.2 IP), five walks and 22 strikeouts over three starts with Charlotte ... opponents hit .222 (10-45).

2017 REVIEW

- Began the 2017 season on the disabled list with left biceps bursitis ... went 2-5 with a 4.15 ERA (32 ER/69.1 IP) and 76 strikeouts over 12 starts before going back on the disabled list with left shoulder inflammation ... underwent arthroscopic surgery on his left shoulder on 9/27/17.
- Made five straight quality starts from 7/30-8/21-1 and pitched into the eighth inning or later in three straight starts for the first time in his career from 8/4-16
- His streak of 90 consecutive batters faced without issuing a walk ended on 8/16 at Los Angeles-NL ... matched his career high with 8.0 IP on 8/10 vs. Houston
- Struck out 10-plus batters for the seventh time in his career and third time in 2017 on 8/4 at Boston ... joined Sale (five times) and Jake Peavy (twice) as the only Sox pitchers since 2012 to record 11-plus strikeouts with zero walks in a game.
- Posted a ND on 7/30 vs. Cleveland despite allowing one run over 6.2 IP ... matched his career high with 11 strikeouts over 4.0 IP on 7/25 at the Cubs ... according to STATS, became the first pitcher since at least 1913 to work 4.0 IP or fewer in a start or relief appearance and record 11 strikeouts or more.
- Earned his first win on 7/3 at Oakland, allowing two runs on four hits over 6.1 IP ... made his season debut on 6/28 vs. the Yankees (L; 0 ER/5.0 IP; allowed three unearned runs).

VS. OAKLAND ATHLETICS

- Is scheduled to make his fourth career start against Oakland and first at Guaranteed Rate Field... is 1-1 with a 4.67 ERA (9 ER/17.1 IP) and .232 (16-69) opponents average lifetime.
- Earned the win in his last start on 7/3/17 at Oakland, allowing two runs on four hits and three walks with 10 strikeouts over 6.1 IP.

TUESDAY'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP Reynaldo López (2-5, 3.59) is scheduled to make his 16th start of the season, seventh at home and third against the Minnesota Twins.
- Is 1-1 with a 2.25 ERA (10 ER/40.0 IP) and .183 (26-142) opp. average over six home starts this season.
- Suffered the loss in his last start on 6/20 at Cleveland, allowing five runs (four earned) on six hits and four walks with six strikeouts over 4.1 IP ... the Sox lost, 12-0
- Is receiving a 3.18 run support average (31 RS/87.2 IP) this season, the ninth-lowest in baseball.
- Will make his third career start against the Twins and second at Guaranteed Rate Field ... received a no decision in his last start on 6/5 at Minnesota (7.0 scoreless IP) ... did not factor into the decision in his last start at home on 5/3 (5 R/4 ER/6.2 IP).
