### TRIBE HEADLINES

» **TREVOR BAUER** fanned a career-high 14 batters in his May 30, 2017 start vs. Oakland...with 10 strikeouts tonight, he would become just the third pitcher in franchise history to record 150 punchouts by the end of June (joining **Bob Feller** & **Sam McDowell**).  
» The Tribe bullpen worked 3.0 perfect frames on Wednesday and has posted a 2.93 ERA (22ER/67.2IP) in June...**NEIL RAMIREZ** is riding a career-long 14-game, 13.1-inning scoreless streak.  
» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (23), **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (19) and **EDWIN ENCARNACION** (19) have combined for 61 homers, the most of any three teammates in MLB this season...the Indians are 37-20 (.649) this season when hitting at least one home run.

### STRAIGHT A'S

» The Indians travel to Oakland for their first of two series this season against the Athletics...following this three-game set, the Tribe will host Oakland for three contests at Progressive Field next weekend (July 6-8).  
» The Tribe went 3-4 against the A's in 2017, taking three of four contests in Cleveland (May 29-June 1) and suffering a three-game sweep at Oakland Coliseum (July 14-16)...the Indians have managed just one win in their past eight matchups here in Oakland.  
» In the rivalry between two original members of the American League, the Indians hold an all-time record of 1,032-909-11 (.532) against the Athletics.  
» Through six series against A.L. West opponents this season, Cleveland holds an 8-12 record...the Tribe is 1-4-1 in A.L. West series play, with the lone win coming vs. Texas (April 30 - May 2).

### WEDNESDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians improved to 19-8 in series finales this season, as they avoided a three-game sweep with a 5-1 win at St. Louis.  
» Cleveland opened the scoring in the 2nd inning with back-to-back solo homers by **EDWIN ENCARNACION** (#19) and **LONNIE CHISENHALL** (#1)...**JASON KIPNIS** went 2-for-4 with an RBI-single and a run scored, while **TYLER NAQUIN** was 2-for-3 with an RBI-double.  
» **SHANE BIEBER** improved to 3-0 in his Major League career, holding the Cardinals to one run on six hits over 6.0 strong innings (1BB, 5K)...also helped his own cause at the plate, going 1-for-3 with a double in his first professional batting appearance...Bieber has now struck out 27 batters in four starts against just four walks.  
» The Tribe bullpen worked 3.0 perfect innings in relief of Bieber, receiving scoreless outings from **NEIL RAMIREZ** (1.2IP, 1K), **OLIVER PÉREZ** (0.1IP, 1K) and **CODY ALLEN** (1.0IP, 1K).

### STARTING STRONG

» **Tribe starting pitchers rank 2nd in the American League (3rd in MLB) with a 3.37 collective ERA this season...the club's 51 quality starts this season rank 2nd in MLB (Houston - 60), while they lead the Majors with 35 starts of 7.0-or-more innings.**  
» Cleveland starters have also struck out 511 batters this season (2nd-most in MLB) against just 121 walks (2nd-fewest in MLB), good for a collective 4.22 K/BB ratio that leads MLB and is on pace to challenge the franchise record (4.15 in 2017).

### HOMER HAPPY

» Tribe hitters have combined for 112 home runs this season, 3rd-most in MLB (NYY - 127, BOS - 118)...62 of those longballs have come at home (2nd in MLB to NYY - 67), compared to 50 on the road (T7th in A.L., T12th in MLB).  
» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (23HR - T2nd in A.L.), **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (19 - T9th) and **EDWIN ENCARNACION** (19 - T9th) have combined for 61 home runs, the most of any three teammates in MLB.

### DOUBLE-A ALL-STARS

» The first-place Akron RubberDucks will send five players to the Eastern League All-Star Game, which is set to take place in Trenton, New Jersey on July 11.  
» Four of the Akron All-Stars are position players: **OF ANDREW CALICA** (.296, 5HR, 33RBI), **OF CONNOR MARABELL** (.278, 8HR, 42RBI, 16SB), **SS WILLI CASTRO** (.257, 2HR, 29 RBI, 11 SB) and **3B JOE SEVER** (.293, 6HR, 45 RBI)...**RHP JAKE PAULSON** (4-3, 2.71 ERA) is the Ducks' lone pitching representative.

Bobby Bradley and Joe Sever each hit three-run homers...Bradley has hit four longballs across his past four games.

Conner Capel (1-2) drove in both of Lynchburg's runs...Zach Plesac matched a career-high with eight strikeouts.

Juan Hillman (ND) worked 8.0 strong innings (5H, 2R/ER, 1BB, 8K)...Oscar González was 2-for-5 with an RBI.  
» **MV Scrappers (Short-A): 10-2, 1st (+3.0G)** » 6/28: W, 5-2 at West Virginia » Today: 7:05 at West Virginia  
Luis Oviedo allowed one run on two hits over 6.0 innings, fanning 12 batters for a Mahoning Valley franchise record.

### BAUER BY THE BAY

» **TREVOR BAUER** is starting on extended five days' rest after making his last start on June 23 vs. Detroit...earned his seventh win of the season after holding the Tigers to one run on five hits over 6.1 innings of work (2BB, 11K).  
» Went 1-1 with an 8.22 ERA (7ER/7.2IP) in two starts against Oakland last year...in his May 30, 2017 start at Progressive Field, **Bauer struck out a career-high 14 batters in 7.0 innings of work.**  
» **Bauer currently ranks 3rd in the American League with 140 strikeouts and 1st with seven outings of double-digit strikeouts (2nd in MLB)...he ranks 4th in franchise history in strikeouts through his first 16 starts, trailing only Bob Feller (1946 - 152K), COREY KLUBER (2017 - 149) and Sam McDowell (1965 - 148).**  
» Should Bauer reach 10 strikeouts in tonight's start, he would become just the 3rd pitcher in club history to notch 150 strikeouts by the end of June, joining **Feller** (1946 - 174K through June 30) and **McDowell** (1970 - 151K).  
» In addition to his strikeout prowess, Bauer also ranks 4th in the American League with a team-low 2.44 ERA...his 2.36 ERA (14ER/53.1IP) in eight road starts is the 5th-lowest in the A.L.

### PARROT SIGHTING

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** put the Tribe ahead on Wednesday night with his 19th home run of the season...he currently ranks T2nd with **FRANCISCO LINDOR** on the team (**Ramirez** - 23) and T9th in the American League and MLB.  
» Over his past seven games, Encarnacion is batting .321 (9-28) with three homers, two doubles, 13 RBI and seven runs scored...**his 13 RBI since June 19 lead the American League in that span and trail only Colorado's Nolan Arenado (14 RBI) for tops in MLB.**  
» Encarnacion's 19 homers through 79 games are two ahead of his 2017 pace (finished with 38 HR)...he finished the first half of last season with 18 longballs.

### DIG THE LON-BALL

» **LONNIE CHISENHALL** slugged his first home run of the season on Wednesday, going back-to-back in the 2nd inning with **EDWIN ENCARNACION** (5th instance by Cleveland in 2018).  
» Chisenhall has hit safely in 10 of his last 13 starts, and he is batting .381 (16-42) since June 10 with two doubles, a triple, a homer, five RBI and seven runs scored.

### KIP THE BALL ROLLING

» **JASON KIPNIS** has hit safely in nine of his last 10 games, including multi-hit efforts in three of those contests...he is batting .371 (13-35) over that span with three homers, eight RBI and eight runs scored...this recent hot stretch has raised his batting average over 20 points, and he enters play at his highest clip since April 1.  
» Among A.L. second basemen in the month of June, Kipnis ranks 3rd in homers (4), 4th in RBI (11) and T5th in hits (20).

### THE PEN'S MIGHTIER

» The Tribe bullpen's 2.93 ERA (22ER/67.2IP) in June is the 5th-lowest in the American League (7th-lowest in MLB).  
» **NEIL RAMIREZ** enters play tonight on a career-long 14-game, 13.1-inning scoreless streak...marks the longest by a Tribe reliever this year (in games and innings) and serves as the 4th-longest active relief streak (innings) in the American League.  
» **OLIVER PÉREZ** has allowed just one run in 12 appearances for Cleveland...his 0.93 ERA (1ER/9.2IP) is 6th-lowest in MLB among pitchers with at least 10 games pitched.  
» **CODY ALLEN** has converted each of his last 11 save opportunities...Allen now has 138 career saves and sits just one shy of tying **Bob Wickman** (139) for the most in Indians franchise history.

### MISC. NOTES

» After beginning the season 5-11 in series openers, Cleveland has posted an 8-3 record over their past 11 openers...the Indians are 9-2-2 this season in series play when winning the first contest.  
» The Indians rank 3rd in the American League (5th in MLB) with 57 stolen bases, paired with just 13 times caught stealing...Tribe's 81.4% success rate is 3rd-best in MLB...Cleveland is the only A.L. team boasting three players with double-digit steals: **RAJAI DAVIS** (16), **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (13) and **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (10).

### THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

**1946:** Hall of Famer **Bob Feller** spins his fifth shutout of the season, holding the White Sox to four hits with nine strikeouts in the Tribe's 2-0 win at Comiskey Park...Feller finished the 1946 campaign with a number of franchise records, including 10 complete-game shutouts (tied by **Bob Lemon** in 1948) and 348 strikeouts, a mark that stands as the 4th-most in American League history.

**TONIGHT'S START**

» The 27-year-old right-hander is due to make his 17th start of the season in tonight's series opener against the Oakland Athletics...will mark his 149th career appearance and 140th start.  
 » Will be pitching on extended five days' rest after his last start on June 23 vs. Detroit...notched his seventh win and recorded his 11th quality start of the season, holding the Tigers to one run on five hits, with two walks and 11 strikeouts.  
 » Tonight will mark his first start of the season vs. Oakland...went 1-1 with a 8.22 ERA (7ER/7.2IP) in two starts in 2017 and owns a 1-2 mark and 4.44 ERA (13ER/26.1IP) in five career starts.  
 » Bauer has posted a 3-2 record and 2.08 ERA in five June starts so far...his **54 strikeouts this month lead the Majors, and his ERA is T5th in the American League** (T8th in MLB) among pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched this month...he is also holding opponents to a .195 batting average in June (7th in A.L.).

**VS. OAKLAND | A.L. WEST**

» Bauer is due to make his season debut vs. Oakland tonight...posted a 1-1 record and 8.22 ERA (7ER/7.2IP) in two starts against them last year.  
 » First faced the A's on on May 30, 2017 at Progressive Field, striking out a career-high 14 batters in just 7.0 innings (W, 7H, 3R/ER, 1BB)...last faced the A's on July 16, 2017 in Oakland...took the loss, allowing four runs on three hits in 0.2 innings (3BB, 2K), tied for the shortest start of his career (also, 0.2IP on June 28, 2013 at Chicago-AL).  
 » Will mark his fourth start of the season against an American League West division opponent...**Tribe has gone 2-1 in his three starts vs. the A.L. West, though Bauer has not recorded a decision, posting a 3.79 ERA (8ER/19.0IP) the three outings.**  
 » Started on April 1 at Seattle, his first appearance this season (5.0IP, 2R/ER, 3BB, 7K)...later faced Texas on April 30 at home (6.2IP, 4H, 2R/ER, 1HR, 4BB, 11K)...then squared off on May 27 vs. Houston (7.1IP, 5H, 4R/ER, 1HR, 2BB, 13K).  
 » Owns a career 14-6 record and 3.63 ERA (77ER/190.2IP) in 31 games (30 starts) vs. the A.L. West...his five career starts vs. Oakland are tied with Los Angeles-AL and Texas (five starts/appearances each) for his fewest against an opponent in this division.

**ON THE ROAD**

» Tonight marks Bauer's ninth road start of the year...is 3-4 with a 2.36 ERA (14ER/53.1IP) and enters tonight **5th in the American League in road ERA.**  
 » Bauer is holding opponents to a .202 batting average on the road, which is tied with TEX's Cole Hamels for the 8th-lowest mark in the A.L. (min. 40.0IP on the road).  
 » Bauer has also allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in each of his last 13 road starts, dating back to August 14, 2017...marks the longest such streak of his career and is 7-4 with a 2.21 ERA (21ER/85.2IP) in that span.  
 » In 2017 went 7-5 with a 4.54 ERA (37ER/73.1IP) in 15 games (14 starts) on the road...owns a career record of 23-25 with a 3.98 ERA (163ER/368.2IP) in 69 road appearances (64 starts).

**LAST TIME OUT & 2018 RECAP**

» Bauer fanned 11 batters over 6.1 innings, allowing one run on five hits (2BB) in his last start on June 23 vs. Detroit...improved to 5-3 with a 2.17 ERA (15ER/62.1IP) in nine starts against the A.L. Central this season.  
 » **Entering tonight's game, Bauer ranks among the overall American League pitching leaders in strikeouts (140, 3rd), strikeouts-per-9.0IP (11.8, 3rd), night ERA (2.28, 3rd), ERA (2.44, 4th), road ERA (2.36, 5th), innings pitched (107.0, T6th) and opponent batting average (.207, 9th).**  
 » Bauer has struck out 10-or-more batters in a career-best seven starts this season, which is the 2nd-most such starts in MLB behind Washington's Max Scherzer (10).  
 » He has thrown 100-or-more pitches in each of his 16 starts so far this season, which is the longest such streak of his career and the longest active run in MLB...**streak is also the longest streak of consecutive starts with 100-plus pitches by an Indians pitcher since 1988, the most recent year that Baseball Reference has accurate pitch count data available...**streak marks the longest such run in MLB since Tampa Bay's Chris Archer had a 24-game run from August 12, 2016 - June 16, 2017.  
 » Recorded a streak of 10-or-more strikeouts in four consecutive starts from May 27 to June 13...streak the longest such run in MLB this season...**marked just the third pitcher in Indians franchise history to record a streak of four-or-more starts with 10-or-more strikeouts, joining teammate COREY KLUBER (two streaks of five starts in 2017) and Hall-of-Famer Bob Feller (one streak of four starts from 1938-39).**

**2017 REGULAR SEASON HIGHLIGHTS & POSTSEASON RECAP**

» Had a career year in the Indians rotation last year, posting his lowest full-season ERA (4.19) while also recording career highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196), innings pitched (176.1) and strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (10.0)...also struck out six-or-more batters in 22 of his 31 starts, good for 6th in the American League...made one relief appearance, in the 8th inning of the second game of a DH on August 17 at Minnesota (0.2IP, 1H, 1K).  
 » **Struck out a career-high 14 batters in 7.0 innings on May 30 vs. Oakland, equaling the highest single-game strikeout total by a Tribe starter last season.**  
 » Dominated after the All-Star Break, going 10-2 with a 3.01 ERA (28ER/83.2IP) in his final 15 appearances (14 starts) of the season...his 10 second-half wins ranked T2nd in the A.L. and his 3.01 ERA ranked T5th among A.L. starters (min. 80.0IP).  
 » **Won a career-best nine consecutive decisions from July 21 to September 10, spanning 11 starts...**posted a 2.51 ERA (18ER/64.2IP) in that span...streak marked the longest by an Indians pitcher last season.  
 » **POSTSEASON RECAP:** Started Games 1 & 4 for Cleveland of the 2017 ALDS against New York-AL...won the first game at home with 6.2 shutout innings (2H, 1BB, 8K)...eight strikeouts in Game 2 marked his most in a postseason start...took the loss in Game 4 in NYC after allowing four runs (all unearned) over 1.2 innings (4H, 2BB/1BB, 3K).

**CAREER SNAPSHOT**

» Right-hander is in his sixth season with the Indians organization after being acquired from the Arizona Diamondbacks on December 11, 2012, along with RHP Matt Albers, RHP Bryan Shaw (from Arizona) & Drew Stubbs (from Cincinnati), in a 3-team trade...at time of trade, was ranked as Arizona's No. 1 prospect by *Baseball America* and had just earned Dbacks Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors.  
 » Made his Major League debut with Arizona on June 28, 2012, becoming the first player from the 2011 Draft Class to reach the Majors...did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings of work.  
 » In 2017, recorded his best Major League season to date in the Tribe rotation, posting career-highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196) and innings pitched (176.1), while recording his lowest full-season ERA (4.19).  
 » The 2018 season marks his eighth overall in professional baseball after being selected by Arizona in the first round of the 2011 draft out of UCLA, where he went 38-4 with a 2.36 ERA across three seasons for the Bruins...finished his college career holding a number of school records, including a Pac-10 record with 203 strikeouts in 2011.  
 » The Southern California native graduated from Hart High School in Santa Clarita, the same HS that produced Kevin Millar, James Shields, Bob Walk and Todd Zeile.
