### TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Indians sit 44-36 with an 8.0-game lead in the A.L. Central as they enter the halfway point of the season...the 2017 Tribe sat 44-37 through 81 games with a 3.0-game divisional lead...Cleveland needs just two runs this afternoon to match the pace of last year's Tribe, while the 2018 club has already hit 15 more homers than their 2017 counterparts.  
» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** is batting .310 (22-71) over his past 18 games with five homers, five doubles and 10 RBI...his 19 runs scored since June 10 are the most in MLB.  
» **ADAM PLUTKO** is set to make his first career appearance vs. Oakland this afternoon...he is 2-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3ER/13.1IP) in two prior starts this season outside of the A.L. Central division.

### STRAIGHT A'S

» The Indians are in Oakland this weekend for their first of two series this season against the Athletics...following this three-game set, the Tribe will host Oakland for three contests at Progressive Field next weekend (July 6-8).  
» The Tribe went 3-4 against the A's in 2017, taking three of four contests in Cleveland (May 29-June 1) and suffering a three-game sweep at Oakland Coliseum (July 14-16)...the Indians have managed just one win in their past nine matchups here in Oakland.  
» In the rivalry between two original members of the American League, the Indians hold an all-time record of 1,032-910-11 (.531) against the Athletics.  
» In seven series against A.L. West opponents this season, Cleveland holds an 8-13 record...the Tribe is 1-4-1 in completed series, with the lone win coming vs. Texas (April 30 - May 2).

### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians brought the go-ahead run to the plate in the top of the 9th inning but ultimately fell, 3-1, in the opener of their three-game set at Oakland.  
» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** went 2-for-4 and drove in the Tribe's lone run with an RBI-double in the top of the 8th inning, marking his 32nd multi-hit game of 2018 (T2nd-most in A.L.)...**YAN GOMES** went 1-for-1 with a pinch-hit double and scored on Lindor's hit.  
» **TREVOR BAUER** took the loss in a quality start, allowing two runs on six hits over 6.2 innings of work...walked one batter and fanned eight batters, bringing his season total to 148 (3rd in A.L.).  
» **Bauer's 148 strikeouts at the end of June are T3rd-most in franchise history with Sam McDowell (148 in 1965), trailing only Bob Feller (174 in 1946) and McDowell (151 in 1970).**

### STARTING STRONG

» Tribe starting pitchers rank 2nd in the American League (3rd in MLB) with a 3.36 collective ERA this season...the club's 52 quality starts this season rank 2nd in MLB (Houston - 61), while they lead the Majors with 35 starts of 7.0-or-more innings.  
» Cleveland starters have also struck out 519 batters this season (2nd-most in MLB) against just 122 walks (2nd-fewest in MLB), good for a collective 4.25 K/BB ratio that leads MLB and is on pace to challenge the franchise record (4.15 in 2017).

### HALFWAY HOME

» Tonight's contest will mark the Tribe's 81st of the season, bringing them to the halfway point of the 2018 campaign.  
» Through 81 games in 2017, Cleveland owned a 44-37 record and a 3.0-game lead in the A.L. Central...last year's Indians went 58-23 over their final 81 games to take the division by 17.0 games.  
» The 2018 Tribe (390 runs scored) sits just two runs shy of matching the 2017 team's output in the first 81 games (392), while they have already hit 15 more home runs (112) than last year's club (97).

### REHAB UPDATES

» **RYAN MERRITT** (left knee sprain) made his fifth rehab start for Triple-A Columbus last night, earning the win vs. Indianapolis after allowing three runs on eight hits over 6.0 innings (0BB, 3K)...Merritt, currently on the 60-day Disabled List, has gone 1-1 with a 5.57 ERA (13ER/21.0IP) on his rehab assignment.  
» **CARLOS CARRASCO** (right elbow contusion) has been on the 10-day D.L. since being struck with a line drive on June 16...he is scheduled to make his first rehab start for Akron tonight vs. Altoona.

### THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1995: Hall of Famer **Eddie Murray** records his 3,000th career hit, doing so with a 6th-inning single in Cleveland's 4-1 win over Minnesota at the Metrodome...339 of Murray's 3,255 hits came for the Indians, and he joined **Nap Lajoie** (1914) and **Tris Speaker** (1925) as the only players to reach the historic milestone in a Cleveland uniform.

# 45 ADAM PLUTKO

RHP

(4-1, 4.65 ERA)

**TODAY'S START**

» The 26-year-old right-hander is set to make his sixth career Major League start in this afternoon's series finale vs. Detroit...marks his ninth career appearance, as well as his fourth since his most recent recall on June 12.  
 » Is starting on extended five days' rest after making his last start on June 24 vs. Detroit...earned his fourth win of the season after working 6.0 effective innings (6H, 2R/ER, 0BB, 4K) in the Tribe's 12-2 victory.  
 » This afternoon marks Plutko's first career start and appearance vs. Oakland...he is 2-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3ER/13.1IP) in two career starts outside of the A.L. Central division.

**LAST TIME OUT | 2018 CLEVELAND RECAP**

» Plutko is starting on extended five days' rest after making his last start on June 24 vs. Detroit...earned his fourth win of 2018, holding the Tigers to two runs on six hits over 6.0 strong innings of work...walked no batters and struck out four, notching his third career quality start as the Tribe went on to beat Detroit, 12-2.  
 » Received his first recall of the 2018 season on May 3 to serve as the 26th man in the Tribe's doubleheader vs. Toronto...earned his first Major League victory, allowing three runs on six hits over 7.1 strong innings of work...walked none and struck out a career-high six batters as the Indians beat the Blue Jays, 13-4...marked the longest outing by a Tribe pitcher making his first career start since **Cody Anderson** worked 7.2 innings (6H, 0R, 1BB, 4K) in his Major League debut on June 21, 2015 vs. Tampa Bay.  
 » Plutko earned his second win in a May 23 start at Chicago-NL...carried a no-hit bid into the 7th inning, holding the Cubs scoreless over 6.0+ innings in the Tribe's 1-0 victory...after issuing four walks over the first 2.0 frames, Plutko retired a string of 13 consecutive batters before a pair of hits chased him in the bottom of the 7th inning.  
 » Labored through 5.0 innings vs. Chicago-AL on May 28, allowing five runs on six hits (1BB, 2K), but picked up his third consecutive win as the Tribe went on to beat the White Sox, 9-6...became the first Indians pitcher to win each of his first three career starts since **Scott Lewis** won his first four career starts from September 10-26, 2008.  
 » Plutko suffered his first career Major League loss on June 12 at Chicago-AL after allowing five runs on eight hits over 4.2 innings of work...surrendered a pair of home runs in the 1st inning and finished with three walks and five strikeouts.

**VS. OAKLAND | ON THE ROAD**

» Plutko is set to make his first career start and appearance vs. the Oakland Athletics...also marks his first-ever appearance against an opponent from the A.L. West.  
 » Six of his eight career appearances have come against the A.L. Central (2.1, 6.75 ERA)...Plutko has won both of his starts outside of the A.L. Central division, going 2-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3ER/13.1IP)...won his first career MLB start on May 3 vs. Toronto (7.1IP, 6H, 3R/ER) and took a no-hit bid into the 7th inning in his May 23 start at Chicago-NL (6.0IP, 2H, 0R).  
 » Plutko will also be making his third road start of 2018, owning a 1-1 record with a 4.22 ERA (5ER/10.2IP) in two previous starts...earned the win in the aforementioned May 23 start at Chicago-NL and took the loss on June 12 at Chicago-AL (4.2IP, 8H, 5R/ER).

**2018 MILB RECAP**

» In his last stint with Columbus, Plutko posted a 1-0 record with a 0.60 ERA (1ER/15.0IP)...threw a no-hitter at Syracuse on June 2, allowing just one baserunner on a 9th-inning walk (retired first 25 batters faced)...his eight-strikeouts performance earned him International League Pitcher of the Week honors (June 3).  
 » Through nine starts with the Clippers, Plutko owns a 5-3 record with a 1.83 ERA (12ER/59.0IP)...at the time of his most recent recall, he ranked 2nd in the International League in ERA, while he also ranked 5th in wins and 1st in WHIP (0.68).  
 » Plutko's 5-3 record at Triple-A Columbus this season includes a perfect mark of 4-0 in five starts at home...Plutko has allowed just two runs in 32.2 home innings this season (0.55 ERA), allowing just nine hits and one walk across those outings with 30 strikeouts...has posted an 1-3 record with a 3.42 ERA (10ER/26.1IP) in four road starts.  
 » Overall on the season, batters are hitting .146 (30-206) off Plutko with four home runs...left-handed hitters are batting just .120 (11-92) against him, while he has recorded 48 strikeouts in 59.0 innings (7.3 K-per-9.0IP).

**MAJOR LEAGUE CAREER**

» The Tribe right-hander is in his seventh career stint with the Indians, after receiving a recall from Columbus on June 12.  
 » Plutko received his first career Major League call-up on September 20, 2016 at age 24, following **Carlos Carrasco's** season-ending injury.  
 » Made his Major League debut on September 24, 2016 vs. the Chicago White Sox, tossing 1.2 scoreless relief innings on two hits...walked one batter and struck out two, fanning **Tim Anderson** for his first career strikeout...made another relief appearance for the Tribe on September 27 at Detroit, allowing three runs on three hits over 2.0 innings...finished the 2016 campaign with a 7.36 ERA (3ER/3.2IP) over two relief appearances.  
 » Spent three stints with the Indians in 2017, but did not make an appearance...Plutko was with the team from June 16-22, August 2-4 and September 1-3.  
 » Underwent surgical intervention on October 9 in Dallas, Texas to repair a tear in the labrum of his right hip, in an operation performed by Dr. Bill Robertson...immediately began rehab and returned to full baseball activity during the Tribe's 2018 Spring Training.

**CAREER SNAPSHOT**

» The Dallas, Texas native played his college ball at UCLA, where he spent three seasons (2011-13) with the Bruins...as a junior, he went 10-3 with a 2.25 ERA in 19 starts as he helped lead the Bruins to a College World Series championship...was named the CWS Most Outstanding Player after going 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA in two Postseason starts...finished his collegiate career with the 2nd-most wins (29), starts (52) and innings pitching (351.1IP) in school history.  
 » Was drafted by Cleveland in the 11th round (321st overall) of the 2013 Amateur Draft...made his professional debut with Lake County in the beginning of the 2014 season, entering as the 18th-best Tribe prospect by **Baseball America**...posted a record of 3-1 with a 3.93 ERA in 10 starts with the Captains, earning Midwest League Pitcher of the Week honors for the week of May 12, 2014.  
 » Earned a midseason call-up to High-A Carolina on May 29, 2014 and spent the rest of the season there, going 4-9 with a 4.08 ERA in 18 starts.  
 » Began the 2015 campaign at High-A Lynchburg, where he posted a 4-2 record with a 1.27 ERA across eight starts...earned two more Pitcher of the Week honors, earning Carolina League nods for the weeks of May 11 and May 25.  
 » Received his first Double-A assignment with a call-up on May 27 and went 9-5 with a 2.86 ERA across 19 starts for the RubberDucks...enjoyed two starts at Akron with at least 7.0 shutout innings and three-or-fewer hits allowed...finished the season 13-7 with a 2.39 ERA across both levels, earning an Organizational All-Star nod from **MILB.com**.  
 » Began the 2016 season at Double-A Akron and spent the first 2.5 months of the season there, going 3-3 with a 3.27 ERA in 13 starts before earning his first Triple-A call-up on June 18...went 6-5 over 15 starts for the Clippers with a 4.10 ERA, earning International League Pitcher of the Week honors for the week of August 21...struck out a career-high 13 batters at Syracuse on June 18...finished the Minor League season second among organizational pitchers with 161.2 innings pitched and 130 strikeouts.  
 » Spent most of the 2017 campaign with Triple-A Columbus, also serving three stints with the big-league club...posted a mark of 7-12 with a 5.90 ERA in 24 games/22 starts with the Clippers, finishing 9th in the International League and 7th in the Tribe organization with 135.2 innings pitched...over his final four starts of the season, Plutko went 2-1 with a 2.10 ERA (6ER/25.2IP).
