SINCE YOU'VE BEEN GONE: The Padres hit the road once again to take on the Oakland Athletics for a brief two-game set...the Friars played 17 of their 27 June games on the road, and by the end of the current trip (@ OAK and @ ARI), the Friars will have played 23 of their last 28 games since June 8 in grey...that's 23 of 28.

LAST TIME OUT: The Padres fell 7-5 on Sunday afternoon to the Pittsburgh Pirates, dropping the series and falling to 5-8 in rubber games this season... Tyson Ross was saddled with his sixth loss (5-6), and the Padres bullpen combined for 4.0 innings of two-hit, scoreless ball... Hunter Renfroe hit his fifth homer and had his second multi-extra-base hit game this year (April 16 vs. LAD).

MAKING MOVES: Today, the Padres placed RHP Kirby Yates on the Paternity List and recalled RHP Colten Brewer from El Paso (AAA).

HE'S QUICK, HE'S SWIFT, HE'S CLAYTON: Clayton Richard has been the best in baseball this season in retiring batters while not using many pitches, having generated 177 outs using three-or-fewer pitches...OAK's Sean Manaea is second in the majors with 165 such outs.

GAME. OVER.: Padres relievers have a 2.30 ERA (29 er, 113.1 ip) in 2018 when entering the game with a lead...only MIL (2.27) and ARI (2.26) have better numbers in such scenarios.

ATTACKING EARLY AND OFTEN: The Padres have been one of the best teams this season at hitting early in the count, batting .345 (253-for-733) in the first two pitches in their at-bats...that average is the second-best in the NL, behind the Cubs' .387 mark in the first two pitches.

A TALE OF TWO HUNTERS: In 17 games before he was shelved on the disabled list with right elbow inflammation on April 21, Hunter Renfroe was slashing .200/.284/.440 with a .200 average with RISP...since returning from the DL on May 28, he's slashed .287/356/.489 SLG with a .353 average with RISP.

TIME TO TURN THE TABLES: Since 2015, SD has been out-scored by the A's 48 to 17...the Friars have 2.83 runs per game vs. OAK (compared to the A's 8.00 rpg vs. SD).

SERIESLY: The Padres have lost five consecutive series since June 14 @ ATL (4-12), but their losing stretch began right after the club won five-straight series from May 28-June 13 (11-5).

WE HAVE A DEAL!: On Sunday, the Padres agreed to terms with LHP Ryan Weathers, their first-round selection (seventh overall) in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft...Weathers, 18, went 10-0 with a 0.09 ERA and 148 strikeouts in 76.0 innings pitched as a senior in '18, allowing just 24 hits and 10 walks while earning Gatorade National Baseball High School Player of the Year honors.

PADRES ON DECK: On Monday night for San Antonio (AA), Fernando Tatis Jr. hit his 15th homer and stole his 14th base...for Lake Elsinore (A), 2B Eguy Rosario had two homers and five RBI, and CF Edward Olivares went 3-for-4 with two triples and three RBI...for El Paso (AAA), 3B Diego Goris was 3-for-4 with a homer, three RBI and two runs scored.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#3 LHP CLAYTON RICHARD (7-7, 4.29)

READY FOR RICHARD: 34-year-old LHP **Clayton Richard** is set to make his club-leading 17th start of the season tonight against the Athletics...it will be his first start and appearance against Oakland since June 17, 2012 when he tossed 7.2-shutout IP of five-run ball.

ALL GOOD STREAKS MUST COME TO AN END: Allowed a season-high 10 hits and was tagged with his first loss since May 25 last Wednesday at TEX in SD's 5-2 loss.

• Earned the win in four consecutive starts for just the second time in his career from 6/4-22 (also: 6/22/11-4/8/12)

WORKHORSE: Richard's 107.0 IP rank 17th in the majors and fourth among all NL arms.

- Has tossed 6.0 innings in 10 consecutive starts, which is the longest streak of any left-handed pitcher this season...in 2017, Chris Sale had two different 10 start stretches of tossing 6.0-or-more while Clayton Kershaw also had 10 consecutive such starts...seven lefties (Jon Lester, Sale, Jose Quintana, Danny Duffy, Madison Bumgarner and Kershaw) had 11-or-more such consecutive start streaks during the 2016 season... Bumgarner and Kershaw did so twice.
- Over the 10 start stretch since May 8, Richard has posted a 6-3 record with a 3.25 ERA (25 ER, 69.1 IP), 0.97 WHIP and 52 strikeouts against 13 walks while limiting the opposition to a .212 average.

EFFICIENTLY EFFECTIVE: Richard leads the majors with 177 "Quick Outs", outs generated with three or fewer pitches in a plate appearance...tomorrow's starter for the A's, **Sean Manaea**, ranks second in the majors with 165.

 Additionally, Richard has had four starts this season in which he pitched at least 7.0 innings and thrown fewer than 100 pitches....that ties COL's Jon Gray and STL's Miles Mikolas for the most such starts in the NL.

IN GOOD COMPANY: His 58 wins as a Padre are now the second-most wins by a Padre lefty, ahead of **Bruce Hurt's** 55 and trailing only **Randy Jones'** 92.

MR 900.0: With 994.2 IP as a Padre, Richard is just the fourth southpaw to reach the 900.0 innings pitched plateau...he joins Randy Jones (1766.0), Bruce Hurst (911.2) and Dave Dravecky (900.1) in the 900.0 IP club.

FLIRTING WITH HISTORY: Richard took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on 6/10 at MIA, earning the win after working 7.0 innings and allowing two hits and a run (earned) with five strikeouts.

 He retired 15 straight batters in the contest, tying the longest streak in a game in his career (retired 15 straight on June 27, 2012 @ HOU).

<u>PICKOFF ARTIST</u>: Has one pickoff this season, which contributes to the Padres' MLB-leading 13 pickoffs...his eight pickoffs led all of MLB last season.

BACK ME UP: Across his first 12 outings, he received one run of support or fewer in six of his first 12 outings, including 26 total runs of support with a 3.16 run support average (runs scored while he's in the game).

- Over his last five outings, he has received at least three runs of support in four of his five outings, including 26 total runs of support with a 7.09 run support average.
- Received a season-high 11 runs of support on 6/4 vs. ATL...it was the most runs he's gotten in support since the 12 he received on 9/8/16 vs. COL.

- His 23 saves rank tied for fourth in the majors and second in the NL...converted each of his 11 save opportunities during the month
 of May, tied with BOS Craig Kimbrel for the most in MLB.
- Since trading closer Brandon Maurer on July 24, 2017, his 41 saves in that time rank second in MLB, behind only SEA Edwin Diaz (48).
- 51.6 percent of his pitches this season have been sliders...228 of his sliders have been thrown for strikes, the highest total among major league relievers this season.
