### TRIBE HEADLINES

» Cleveland has won seven straight home games, as well as 14 of their last 16...the Tribe's .675 home winning percentage (27-13) ranks 3rd-best in MLB...the Indians also rank 2nd in MLB with a .283 batting average and 241 runs scored at home.  
» **CARLOS CARRASCO** has been activated from the Disabled List and will make his 16th start of the season tonight...owns a career record of 3-1 with a 2.61 ERA (12ER/41.1IP) in six career starts (seven appearances) vs. Oakland.  
» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** continues to lead MLB with 50 extra-base hits and 75 runs scored this season...he is batting .340 (17-50) since June 20 with seven homers, four doubles, 15 RBI and an MLB-high 21 runs scored.

### RAPID REMATCH

» The Indians and Athletics are set to square off for a second straight weekend, following their three-game set at the Oakland Coliseum from June 29 - July 1...the Indians dropped the first two games of the series before notching a 15-3 win in the finale.  
» Cleveland has won six of their last seven games at Progressive Field vs. Oakland, outscoring the A's 42-16 over those contests...the Indians hold an all-time record of 1,033-911-11 (.531) against the Athletics.  
» Through seven series against A.L. West opponents this season, Cleveland holds a 9-14 record...the Tribe is 1-5-1 in A.L. West series play, with the lone win coming vs. Texas (April 30 - May 2).

### WEDNESDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians completed a three-game sweep at Kansas City with a 3-2 victory, marking their first road win on Independence Day since 1973...the win put Cleveland at a new high-water of 11 games over .500, and expanded their A.L. Central lead to a season-high 11.5 games.  
» The Tribe was held to just four hits, scoring all three of their runs in the first two innings...**MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (1-3) opened the scoring with an RBI-double in the 1st inning and came around to score on an **EDWIN ENCARNACION** sacrifice fly...**GREG ALLEN** was 1-for-3 and drove in the Tribe's third run with a 2nd-inning sac fly...**JASON KIPNIS** (1-3, double, run scored) and **ROBERTO PÉREZ** (1-3) were responsible for the Indians' other hits.  
» **TREVOR BAUER** earned his eighth win of the season, holding Kansas City to two runs on seven hits over 7.2 strong innings (1BB, 8K)...per *STATS LLC*, Bauer extended his streak to six consecutive quality starts with eight-or-more strikeouts and no homers allowed, matching **Hideo Nomo**, **Pedro Martínez** (2x), **Justin Verlander** and **R.A. Dickey** for the longest streak in the live-ball era (1920-).  
» **CODY ALLEN** worked a scoreless 9th inning to record his 140th career save, surpassing **Bob Wickman** (139) as the all-time franchise leader.

### LOAD 'EM UP

» The Indians have scored 93 runs in their past 15 games (6.2 per game), a run that has been powered by the club's success with the bases loaded.  
» Since June 20, Cleveland is hitting .769 (10-13) with the bases loaded, slugging four grand slams and recording 28 RBI...on the season, the Indians are batting an MLB-best .397 (27-68) this season with the bases loaded, driving in 83 runs (2nd to CIN - 98) and collecting 18 extra-base hits (most in MLB).  
» The Tribe has already hit eight grand slams on the year, 2nd-most in MLB (Cincinnati - 9)...marks the club's most in a season since 2006, when they hit a club-record 14...Cleveland's eight grand slams before the All-Star break match their pace from the 2006 campaign.

### STARTING STRONG

» Tribe starting pitchers rank 2nd in the American League (3rd in MLB) with a combined 3.42 ERA this season...the club's 55 quality starts this season rank 2nd in MLB (Houston - 64).  
» Indians starters have also struck out 542 batters (2nd-most in MLB) against just 127 walks (2nd-fewest in MLB), good for a collective 4.27 K/BB ratio that is 2nd-best in MLB (LAD - 4.29).  
» Cleveland has posted 17 starts this season with 10-or-more strikeouts, tied with Houston for the most in MLB.

1991: **Mike Hargrove** assumes managerial duties for the Indians, winning his first game 2-0 vs. Milwaukee...**Greg Swindell** earned the win, tossing 7.0 shutout innings on two hits with 10 strikeouts...Hargrove ranks second in franchise history with 721 wins over nine seasons at the helm, leading the Tribe to five A.L. Central titles and two World Series appearances.

# 59 CARLOS CARRASCO

RHP

(8-5, 4.24 ERA)

**TODAY'S START**

» The 31-year-old right-hander has been activated from the 10-day Disabled List to make his 16th start of the 2018 season...had been on the D.L. with a right elbow contusion since being struck with a line drive in his June 16 start vs. Minnesota.  
 » Currently sits at 992 career strikeouts, eight shy of becoming the 12th pitcher in Indians franchise history and the 17th active MLB pitcher to reach 1,000 strikeouts.  
 » Carrasco is making his first start this season against the Oakland Athletics...in seven career appearances (six starts) vs. Oakland, he owns a 3-1 record with a 2.61 ERA (12ER/41.1IP).

**LAST TIME OUT | 2018 RECAP**

» Carrasco last started on June 16 vs. Minnesota...allowed four runs on four hits over 1.1 innings before being struck by a line drive in the 2nd inning...went on the Disabled List the next day with a right elbow contusion...made one rehab start for Double-A Akron on June 30, working 4.0 shutout innings on 58 pitches (1H, 1BB, 4K).  
 » Carrasco made his 2018 debut on March 31 at Seattle, in the Tribe's second game of the season...was touched for five runs on seven hits over 5.2 innings of work (0BB, 4K), but picked up his first win of 2018 as the Indians held on to beat the Mariners, 6-5.  
 » Improved to 3-0 for the first time in his career as he tossed his 9th career complete game on April 11 vs. Detroit... held the Tigers to just one run on three hits over 9.0 innings, walking two and striking out six batters...took a no-decision at Estadio Hiram Bithorn against Minnesota on April 18 despite tossing 7.0 shutout innings (3H, 1BB, 7K).  
 » Threw his 10th career complete game and his second of 2018 on May 9 at Milwaukee, holding the Brewers to two runs on five hits in the Tribe's 6-2 win...Carrasco struck out a season-high 14 batters, one shy of his career high and the most by any Indians pitcher this season...also helped his own cause at the plate, collecting an RBI-single in the 9th inning...became the first Tribe pitcher with an RBI in his own complete game since Gaylord Perry did so on September 22, 1972 vs. New York-AL.  
 » Improved to 8-4 with a win at Chicago-AL on June 11, holding the White Sox scoreless over 7.0 innings of work with just two hits and one walk in the Tribe's 4-0 victory... Carrasco also fanned 11 batters, marking his second straight start with double-digit punchouts after doing so on June 6 vs. Milwaukee (7.0IP, 8H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 10K).

**STRIKEOUTS RISING**

» Carrasco has fanned 10-or-more batters in three starts this season, tied for 11th-most in the American League with teammate Mike Clevinger...after striking out 39 batters in his first seven starts of the season, Carrasco has punched out 57 in his last eight.  
 » Since the start of 2017, Carrasco's eight starts with 10-or-more strikeouts rank T8th in the American League over that span...Corey Kluber ranks 2nd with 19 such starts, while Trevor Bauer sits T3rd with nine.  
 » Carrasco enters play with 992 career strikeouts, eight shy of becoming the 12th pitcher in Indians history to collect 1,000 strikeouts in an Indians uniform (last achieved by Corey Kluber in 2017)...he is also poised to become the 17th active MLB pitcher with 1,000 career punchouts.  
 » Since the beginning of 2015, Carrasco has amassed 9.97 strikeouts-per-9.0IP, the 4th-highest total among American League pitchers with at least 500.0 innings pitched in that span (Chris Sale, Chris Archer, Corey Kluber ranks 3rd with 10.15 K/9.0IP).  
 » Carrasco also owns a 4.74 K/BB ratio since the 2015 season, which ranks 3rd-best in MLB over that span (min. 500.0IP) behind Chris Sale (6.16) and Corey Kluber (5.68).

**VS. OAKLAND | A.L. WEST**

» Carrasco will be making his sixth career start (seventh appearance) vs. the Oakland Athletics, as well as his first this season...owns a career record of 3-1 vs. Oakland with a 2.61 ERA (12ER/41.1IP).  
 » Went 1-1 with a 4.73 ERA (7ER/13.1IP) in two starts against the A's last season...won his start on May 29, 2017 at Progressive Field, holding Oakland to two runs on four hits over 7.0 strong innings (1BB, 7K)...took the loss on July 14 at Oakland, allowing five runs on six hits over 6.1 innings (2BB, 10K).  
 » Carrasco has made four starts against the A.L. West this season, posting a 2-2 record with a 6.95 ERA (17ER/22.0IP)...earned wins on March 31 at Seattle (5.2IP, 7H, 5R/ER, 0BB, 4K) and on May 26 vs. Houston (5.2IP, 7H, 5R/ER, 2BB, 8K).

**THE GREEN, GREEN GRASS OF HOME**

» Today will mark Carrasco's eighth start at Progressive Field this season, as well as his 79th career start (95th appearance) here.  
 » In his June 6 home start vs. Milwaukee, he earned the win after allowing one run on eight hits over 7.0 strong innings of work (1BB, 10K)...in his April 11 start here vs. Detroit, Carrasco threw the 9th complete game of his career, holding the Tigers to one run on three hits with two walks and six strikeouts...sits 4-2 with a 5.54 ERA (23ER/37.1IP) through seven starts at Progressive Field in 2018.  
 » Carrasco posted a 7-4 record in Cleveland last season with a 3.99 ERA (42ER/94.2IP), compared to an 11-2 mark with a 2.65 ERA (31ER/105.1IP) on the road...has earned a career record of 29-32 with a 4.54 ERA (243ER/482.0IP) at Progressive Field.

**2017 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS**

» Enjoyed the most prolific season of his career, finishing fourth in American League Cy Young voting as he set new career-highs in wins (18), starts (32), innings pitched (200.0) and strikeouts (226)...Carrasco finished in the A.L. Top 10 in wins (T1st), ERA (3.29, 6th), strikeouts (5th) and innings (8th)...joined Corey Kluber as the first teammates to accumulate 18 wins and 220 strikeouts each since Arizona's Randy Johnson & Curt Schilling in 2002 (6th duo all-time).  
 » Went 5-0 with a 1.48 ERA (7ER/42.2IP) and 51 strikeouts over six September starts, finishing the season on a career-best six-decision winning streak...Carrasco and Corey Kluber simultaneously became the first pitchers to post five wins, 50 strikeouts, and an ERA of 1.50-or-less in a calendar month since Sam McDowell in June 1969 (6-0, 50K, 1.05 ERA; courtesy of ELIAS).  
 » Made his Postseason debut in Game 3 of the ALDS against New York-AL after missing the 2016 playoffs with a broken metacarpal in his right hand...tossed 5.2 shutout innings on just three hits (3BB, 7K) but took a no decision in the Tribe's eventual 1-0 loss at Yankee Stadium.

**CAREER SNAPSHOT**

» Right-hander is in his 10th season with the Cleveland organization after being acquired from the Philadelphia Phillies on July 29, 2009, along with INF Jason Donald, RHP Jason Knapp & C Lou Marson, in exchange for OF Ben Francisco & LHP Cliff Lee...switched dugouts upon announcement of trade, as AAA Columbus was playing AAA Lehigh Valley.  
 » Signed 4-year contract extension with Indians thru 2018 on April 7, 2015, including club options for 2019 & 2020 and could cover up to first 3 years of free agency.  
 » Made his major league debut September 1, 2009 as the Indians starter against the Detroit Tigers at Comerica Park...took the loss after allowing six runs on nine hits (three home runs) with three walks and three strikeouts in 3.0 innings.  
 » Is in his 15th professional season since signing with Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent on Nov. 25, 2003...has appeared in parts of nine Major League seasons with Cleveland...missed the entire 2012 season after having right elbow surgery.
