TRIBE HEADLINES

- Cleveland has won eight straight home games, as well as 15 of their last 17...the Tribe's .683 home winning percentage (27-13) ranks 3rd-best in MLB...the Indians also rank 2nd in MLB with a .284 batting average and 251 runs scored at home
- FRANCISCO LINDOR is the first shortstop in MLB history with 50 extra-base hits and 75 runs scored in the first half (STATS LLC)...he and ${\bf JOSÉ\ RAMÍREZ}$ are the fifth duo in MLB history to each record 50 extra-base hits before the All-Star break (first since Boston in 2004: David Ortiz and Manny Ramírez).
- » COREY KLUBER is seeking to become the first Tribe pitcher to reach 13 wins in the first half since **Gaylord Perry** (15-3) in 1974... he is also 7-1 with a 1.60 ERA (11ER/62.0IP) at home this season

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- The Indians won their fifth straight game, dispatching Oakland 10-4 in the opener of this three-game series...the win put Cleveland at a new high-water mark of 12 games over .500.
- » The Tribe's 1-4 hitters went a combined 8-for-13, led by EDWIN ENCARNACION and JOSÉ RAMÍREZ, who each had two hits, a double and three RBI...MICHAEL BRANTLEY went 2-for-4 with an RBI-double and two runs scored...FRANCISCO LINDOR was
- 2-for-3 with three runs scored, including a 7th-inning steal of home. » CARLOS CARRASCO earned the win in his first start back from the Disabled List, allowing three runs on seven hits over 5.1 innings of work...walked no batters and struck out seven, bringing his career total to 999 strikeouts.

GONE STREAKING

- The Indians enter play today with wins in each of their last five games overall, as well as each of their last eight home games.

 » Cleveland now owns four separate winning streaks of five-or-
- more games this season, tied with Tampa Bay and Houston for the most in MLB this season...the Tribe also won five straight games from April 8-12, while they won six in a row from May 26-31 and a season-high seven straight from June 17-24.
- » The Tribe's eight-game home winning streak is the club's longest since 11 in a row from August 24 September 14, 2017, as part of their American League-record 22-game win streak...this current run marks the longest active home win streak in MLB and is T2ndlongest by any team this season (NYY: 11 games, April 21 - May 9).

HOME IS WHERE THE WIN IS

- Cleveland has gone 28-13 at Progressive Field this season, good for a .683 winning percentage that ranks 3rd in MLB behind New York-AL (.717) and Boston (.700)...since the 2017 All-Star Break, Cleveland's 56-21 (.728) home record is the best in MLB.

 » The Indians have won 15 of their last 17 home games, including
- each of their last eight...Cleveland is outscoring opponents 64-13 across this current home win streak.
- » Cleveland is batting .284 at home this season, 2nd-best in MLB (Boston .286)...despite playing just 41 home games (T5th-fewest in MLB), the Tribe also ranks 2nd with 251 runs scored, 4th with 62 home runs and 4th with 158 extra-base hits at home...the Indians are scoring 6.12 runs per home game, the highest rate in MLB.

» EDWIN ENCARNACION drove in three runs last night, bringing his season total to a club-high 61 RBI (T3rd in American League). » Encarnacion, **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (59 RBI) and **FRANCISCO LIN-**DOR (55 RBI) have combined for 175 RBI this season, tied for the most of any trio in MLB with Boston (Betts/Benintendi/Bogaerts) and Cincinnati (Suárez/Gennett/Duvall).

RAPID REMATCH

- » The Indians and Athletics are squaring off for a second straight weekend, following their three-game set at the Oakland Coliseum from June 29 - July 1...the Indians dropped the first two games of
- that series before notching a 15-3 win in the finale.

 » Cleveland has won seven of its last eight games at Progressive
- Field vs. Oakland, outscoring the A's 52-20 over those contests. » The Indians are currently 10-14 against A.L. West opponents this season...the Tribe is 1-5-1 in completed series, with the lone win thus far coming vs. Texas (April 30 - May 2).

- KLUBER DAY

 » COREY KLUBER is set to make his first start against Oakland this season in his 19th start of the 2018 campaign
- » Kluber went 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3ER/13.1IP) in two starts vs. Oakland last year, including a win at Progressive Field on June 1, 2017 in his return from the Disabled List (6.0IP, 2H, 0R, 1BB, 10K). » He has worked a quality start in each of his six outings against the A.L. West division this season, posting a 3-1 record with a 2.45 FRA (12FR/44 0IP)
- » Kluber owns a 7-1 record with a 1.60 ERA (11ER/62.0IP) in nine starts at Progressive Field this season, marking the 2nd-lowest home ERA in the A.L. (TB's Blake Snell - 0.87).
- » He also enters play today with 12 wins, 2nd-most in the American League (NYY's **Luis Severino** has 13)...with a win today, Kluber would become the first Indians pitcher to record 13 wins before the All-Star Break since 1974, when Gaylord Perry went 15-3 in the first half.
- » Kluber continues to lead Major League Baseball with just 0.98 walks per 9.0 innings (13BB/119.1IP), and he ranks among American League leaders in WHIP (0.87 - 2nd), daytime ERA (1.93 -3rd), ERA (2.64 - 7th), opponent batting average (.208 - 8th) and strikeouts (120 - 9th).

- FRANKIE'S ON FIRE

 » FRANCISCO LINDOR continued his torrid run at the plate last night, notching his 36th multi-hit effort of 2018 (T1st in A.L.).
- » Lindor leads MLB with 78 runs scored, the most by a Tribe batter through 86 team games since Kenny Lofton and Roberto Alomai also had 78 at this juncture of the 1999 season
- » He has scored at least one run in 12 of his last 14 games, batting .358 (19-53) in that stretch with seven homers, four doubles, 15 RBI and 24 runs scored...since June 20, Lindor leads MLB in runs
- scored, while he ranks T2nd in home runs and T5th in RBI.

 » Lindor has also recorded 50 extra-base hits this season with JOSÉ RAMÍREZ for the Major League lead...per STATS LLC, Lindor is the first shortstop in MLB history to have at least 50 extra-base hits and 75 runs scored before the All-Star break.
- » He also enters play today among A.L. leaders in total bases (201 - 2nd), doubles (27 - T3rd), hits (105 - 5th), home runs (23 - 5th), slugging percentage (.574 - 5th), OPS (.952 - 6th) and home batting average (.333 - 8th).

JOSÉ CAN YOU SWING

- » JOSÉ RAMÍREZ powered the Tribe offense last night, recording his team-high 16th game with multiple RBI (T6th in A.L.)...his two run double in the 3rd inning marked his 19th go-ahead RBI of the season, which is T2nd in MLB with SEA's **Mitch Haniger**, PHI's **Rhys Hoskins** and DET's **Nicholas Castellanos** (COL's **Nolan** Arenado leads MLB with 20 go-ahead RBI).

 » The double also marked Ramírez's 50th extra-base hit of the
- season, moving him into a tie with **FRANCISCO LINDOR** for the Major League lead...<u>with nine games left before the All-Star break</u>, Lindor and Ramírez are the first pair in Indians history and the fifth pair in MLB history to each record 50-or-more first-half extra-base hits...they join the 2003 Rockies (Todd Helton & Preston Wilson), the 2003 Cardinals (Albert Pujols & Jim Edmonds), the 2003 Blue Jays (Vernon Wells & Carlos Delgado) and the 2004 Red Sox (David Ortiz & Manny Ramírez).
- » Ramírez remains the team leader with 24 home runs (T2nd in A.L.) and 18 stolen bases (3rd in A.L.)...he is one of just three players in MLB to lead his team in both homers and steals, with LAA's Mike Trout (24HR, 13 SB) and MIN's Eddie Rosario (18HR, 6SB).

- SMOOTH AND STEADY
 » MICHAEL BRANTLEY has owned a batting average above .300 for every day since April 17, and he currently sits 9th in the American League with a .308 season average.

 » He has hit safely in 59 of his 75 games this season (78.7%), the
- 2nd-highest percentage among qualified MLB hitters, behind only Houston's **José Altuve** (81.1%).
- » Brantley has been particularly effective at Progressive Field, where he is batting .355 (54-152) with six homers, 15 doubles and 34 RBI...he enters play today ranked T3rd in the A.L. in doubles, T4th in RBI and 5th in batting average at home.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1923: Despite hitting no home runs, the Indians establish a franchise record for runs scored in a 27-3 victory over Boston at League Park...seven different players had multi-hit games as part of the Tribe's 24-hit attack, led by Rube Lutzke, who was 4-for-5 with two doubles and six RBI...Riggs Stephenson went 3-for-5 with three doubles and five RBI...the Indians scored in all eight innings in which they batted, including a 13-run 6th inning.

- TODAY'S START VS. OAKLAND

 » Kluber is scheduled to make his 19th start today in the middle tilt of this three-game series vs. Oakland...will mark his 187th appearance and 182nd career start.

 » Will be pitching on regular four days' rest after his last start on July 3 at Kansas City..
- notched his 12th win of the season, holding the Royals to three runs on seven hits (one home run) over 6.0 innings, with three walks and five strikeouts.
- » Kluber has recorded quality starts in 16 of his 18 outings this season...entering play today, his 16 quality starts are tied with Washington's Max Scherzer and Houston's Justin Verlander for tops in MLB.
- » Today will mark Kluber's first start of the season vs. the Athletics...last faced the A's on July 15, 2017 in Oakland (7.1IP, 5H, 3R/ER, 2HR, 0BB, 12K)...in 2017 went 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3ER/13.1IP), with 22 strikeouts in two starts vs. the Athletics.
- » Will pitch at Progressive Field for the 10th time today...entering this afternoon's game, his 1.60 home ERA ranks 2nd in the A.L. (3rd in MLB) and his seven home wins are T2nd-most in the A.L. (T3rd-most in MLB).

 » Kluber has notched a career-best 12 wins so far in the first half of the season...with a
- victory today, he would become the first Indians pitcher with 13 wins in the first half of the season since Gaylord Perry won 15 games in the first half of the 1974 campaign.

VS. OAKLAND | A.L. WEST

- » Kluber is due to make his season debut vs. Oakland this afternoon...did not apear in the Tribe's series in Oakland last weekend...in 2017, went 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA BER/13.1IP) in two starts against the Athletics.
- » Last faced the As on July 15, 2017 in Oakland...did not factor into the decision despite recording a qualty start and fanning 12 batters (7.1IP, 5H, 3R/ER, 2HR, 0BB)...also started vs. Oakland on June 1 at Progressive Field, in his first game after returning from the Disabled List...earned the win, scattering two hits over 6.0 shutout innings, with one walk and 10 strikeouts
- walk and 10 strikeouts.

 » Kluber has won each of his last two decisions vs. the Athletics, a span of three starts that dates back to July 31, 2016...has posted a 1.33 ERA (3ER/20.1IP) in that span... owns a career 2-4 record and 2.66 ERA (13ER/44.0IP) vs. Oakland.

 » His 2.66 career ERA against the Athletics is his second-lowest vs. any A.L. West opponent, behind his career 1.93 ERA against Seattle.
- » Is due to make his seventh start of the season against an A.L. West opponent...has posted a 3-1 record and 2.45 ERA (12ER/44.0IP) in his six prior starts...last faced a member of the A.L. West in his start on May 25 vs. Houston...tossed 6.1 shutout innings,
- allowing seven hits and striking out seven batters.

 » Kluber has recorded quality starts in each of his six outings against the A.L. West this season and has tossed 7.0-or-more innings in five of the six starts, including an Opening Day complete game on March 29 at Seattle.

- AT PROGRESSIVE FIELD

 » This afternoon marks Kluber's 10th home start of the season...is 7-1 with a 1.60
- » This atternoon marks Ruber's Toth home start of the season...Is 7-1 with a 1.60 ERA (11ER/62.0IP) in his home outings and enters today's game T2nd in the American League and T3rd in MLB in wins at home, as well as 2nd in the A.L. in home ERA.

 » Won his last home start on June 20 vs. Chicago-AL, allowing one hit and one walk in 7.0 shutout innings, with seven strikeouts...has recorded a quality start in eight of his nine home starts, which is tied for the 2nd-most such outings in the A.L. this year.

LAST TIME OUT & 2018 RECAP

- » Kluber enters play today among the American League pitching leaders in walks-per-9.0IP (0.98, 1st), home ERA (1.60, 2nd), opponent on-base percentage (.232, 2nd), wins (12, 2nd), day ERA (1.93, 4th), innings pitched (119.1, 4th), ERA (2.64, 7th), opponent batting average (.208, 8th) and strikeouts (120, 9th).
- » He will be pitching on regular four days' rest after earning the win in his last start on Jt 2 at Kansas City (6.0IP, 7H, 3R/ER, 1BB, 5K).
- » Kluber has recorded quality starts in 16 of his 18 outings this season, and his quality start total is tied with two other pitchers for the most such outings in both the A.L. and MLB. » Had his career-long walkless innings streak snapped at 46.1 innings on June 15 vs. Minnesota, after issuing a free pass in the 4th inning...streak marked the longest such run by a Tribe pitcher since **Paul Byrd's** stretch of 48.0 innings from April 26-June 6, 2007...also had his quality start streak snapped at 14, the longest streak of quality starts to begin a season by a Tribe starting pitcher since Hall-of-Famer **Stan Coveleski** began the 1918 campaign with a string of 16 consecutive quality starts.
- » From August 3, 2017 June 15, 2018, Kluber recorded a string of 26 starts that marked the longest streak in American League history and tied with Philadelphia's **Chris** Short (also 26G from 1967-68) for the 2nd-longest such streak in the Baseball-Reference
- Play Index era (1908-), behind Chicago-NL's **Jake Arrieta** (29G from 2015-16).

 » Tossed his 16th career complete game in his first start of the year on March 29 at Seattle...marked the first Opening Day complete-game by a Cleveland pitcher since **Jake Westbrook** on April 4, 2005 at Chicago-AL (1-0 loss), and the first such complete game in MLB since Clayton Kershaw threw a complete-game shutout on April 1, 2013 vs. San Francisco...struck out eight batters, the 2nd-most by a Tribe starter on Opening Day over the last 14 seasons (2005-18), behind **Justin Masterson** (10K on April 5, 2012 vs. Toronto)...Kluber threw just 91 pitches in the game, marking the second-lowest complete-game pitch count of his career...needed just 85 pitches to shut out the Mariners on July 30, 2014 (9.0IP, 3H, 8K) in Cleveland.

2017 HIGHLIGHTS & CAREER SNAPSHOT

- » Won his second career American League Cy Young Award in 2017, becoming the first pitcher in club history to win the award multiple times, and the 19th multiple winner in MLB since 1956.
- » Became the first Indians pitcher since Mike Garcia in 1949 to lead MLB in ERA (2.25), and ranked near the top of the A.L. leaderboard in virtually every other pitching category (see chart), including wins (18, T1st), pitcher bWAR (8.2), strikeouts (265, 2nd) and opponent batting average (.193, 141-732).

 » Won the A.L. Pitcher of the Month award three times, June (4-0, 1.26ERA), August
- (5-1, 1.96 ERA) and September (5-0, 0.84 ERA), becoming the first triple winner since Houston's Dallas Keuchel in 2015.
- » Kluber is in his ninth season with the Cleveland organization after being acquired from the San Diego Padres on July 31, 2010 in a three-team trade that sent RHP Jake Westbrook (from Cleveland) & LHP Nicholas Greenwood (from San Diego) to the St. Louis Cardinals and moved OF Ryan Ludwick from St. Louis to San Diego.
- » Signed a five-year contract extension with the Indians through 2019 on April 5, 2015.. the deal includes club options for 2020 & 2021.
- » Made his MLB debut on September 1, 2011 in relief against the Oakland Athletics... made three relief appearances as a September call-up with Cleveland in 2011...has five career relief appearances, last on April 20, 2013 at Houston.

 » Kluber was originally selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 2007 June draft out of
- Stetson (FL) University, where he played three seasons...the Birmingham, Alabama native attended Coppell (TX) High School, located in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex.
