- TRIBE HEADLINES

 » SHANE BIEBER is due to make his third career home start today, owning a 2-0 record and 0.71 ERA (1ER/12.2IP) in his two prior starts...he is holding opposing hitters to a .207 batting average with runners in scoring position.
- » EDWIN ENCARNACION has driven in a run in each of his last seven home games...his 62 RBI on the season are T2nd in the American League, while his 38 home RBI rank 3rd in the A.L.
- » The Tribe is 21-8 overall in series finales this season, including a 4-3 overall mark (3-0 at home) in rubber games...Indians starting pitchers have posted a 2.34 ERA (51ER/196.1IP) in series finales, with wins in each of their last 11 decisions.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- » The Indians saw their five-game winning streak come to an end yesterday afternoon, falling by a 6-3 final score in 11 innings.
- » Cleveland got on the board early, scoring one run apiece in the first two innings...Tribe's 65 1st-inning runs are T2nd in MLB, with Arizona (Colorado - 73)
- » FRANCISCO LINDOR (2-for-5) and MICHAEL BRANTLEY (2for-5) led the Tribe offense and each recorded a multi-hit game, their 37th and 27th of the season, respectively...Lindor's multi-hit game total is tied for the MLB lead, and the duo are T3rd in the American League with 56 hits apiece at home.
- » COREY KLUBER did not factor into the decision vesterday despite recording his MLB-leading 17th quality start of the season... Kluber scattered five hits over 7.0 shutout innings (2BB, 3K) and lowered his home ERA to 1.43 (11ER/69.0IP), which is the 2ndlowest mark in the American League and MLB.

RAPID REMATCH

- » The Indians and Athletics are squaring off for a second straight weekend, following their three-game set at the Oakland Coliseum from June 29 - July 1...the Indians dropped the first two games of that series before notching a 15-3 win in the finale...this afternoon marks the conclusion of the season series between the two clubs.
- » Cleveland has won seven of its last nine games at Progressive Field vs. Oakland, outscoring the A's 55-26 over those contests.
- » The Indians are currently 10-15 against A.L. West opponents this season and the Tribe is 1-5-1 in completed series, with the lone win thus far coming vs. Texas (April 30 - May 2).

LET'S START AGAIN

- » COREY KLUBER's start yesterday marked the Indians' 56th quality start of the season, the 2nd-most such starts in MLB., Tribe's 26 quality starts at home are the 3rd-most in the Majors
- (Houston 32, Philadelphia 27).

 » Cleveland starting pitchers have posted a 3.39 ERA (207ER/549.1IP) this year, the 2nd-best ERA in both the American League and MLB...Tribe starters have also done well at home, recording a 3.26 ERA (95ER/262.1IP) that is 3rd-best in the A.L. (4th-best in MLB).

- » FRANCISCO LINDOR continued his recent hot stretch, finishing yesterday's game 2-for-5 with an RBI and a run scored...he is batting .375 (15-40) over his last 10 games, with 16 runs scored, three doubles, four homers and 12 RBI in that span.
- » Lindor's 37 multi-hit games are tied with Seatlle's **Jean Segura** and Boston's **J.D. Martinez** for the A.L. lead...his 37 multi-hit games through 87 team games are the most by an Indians hitter since **Kenny Lofton** had 38 through 87 games in 1996.
- » Lindor also leads MLB with 79 runs scored (the next closest hitters have 69), which is tied with **Kenny Lofton** (79 in 1999) for the 4th-most runs by an Indians batter through 87 team games in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-).
- » Lindor has 50 extra-base hits and is tied with JOSÉ RAMÍREZ and two others for the MLB lead...with eight games left before the All-Star break, Lindor and Ramírez are the first pair in Indians history and the fifth pair in MLB history with 50-or-more first-half XBH... they joined the 2003 Rockies (Todd Helton & Preston Wilson), the 2003 Cardinals (Albert Pujols & Jim Edmonds), the 2003 Blue Jays (Vernon Wells & Carlos Delgado) and the 2004 Red Sox (David Ortiz & Manny Ramírez).

- SUNDAYS ARE FOR SHANE

 » Rookie right-hander SHANE BIEBER is due to take the mound in this afternoon's finale...will mark his sixth career start, as well as his first career outing against Oakland.
- » Bieber will pitch today on regular four days' rest after notching his fourth win in his last start on July 3 at Kansas City...scattered nine hits over 6.0 innings but held the Royals to four runs (1HR, 1BB, 2K) as the Tribe won 6-4.
- » Makes his third home start today, winning both of his prior outngs and allowing just one run combined across the starts (0.71 ERA)...last pitched at Progressive Field on June 22, when he fanned a career-best nine batters and tossed 7.0 shutout innings (4H, 1BB).
- Though opponents are batting .303 (37-122) against him overall, Bieber is holding opposing hitters to a .207 (6-29) mark with runners in scoring position and a .167 (2-12) batting average with RISP and two outs
- » Bieber is just the third Tribe pitcher in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-) with four wins in his first five career starts, joining John Farrell (1987) and Scott Lewis (2008-09)...should he win today, he will become the only Indians pitcher in the Play Index era with five wins in his first six career starts.
- » Additionally, Bieber's four wins this season are tied with ADAM PLUTKO and Los Angeles-AL's Shohei Ohtani for the 5th-most by an American League rookie pitcher.

HOME IS WHERE THE WIN IS

- » Cleveland has gone 28-14 at Progressive Field this season, good for a .667 winning percentage that ranks 3rd in MLB behind New York-AL (.717) and Boston (.700)...Tribe's 14 home losses are also the 3rd-fewest in MLB...since the 2017 All-Star Break, Cleveland's 56-22 (.718) home record is the best in MLB.
- » The Indians have won 15 of their last 18 home games, including eight of their last nine, despite having their home win streak snapped at eight games yesterday...Cleveland is outscoring opponents 67-19 across their last nine home games
- » Cleveland is batting .282 at home this season, 2nd-best in MLB (Boston .286)...despite playing just 42 home games (T6th-fewest in MLB), the Tribe also ranks 2nd with 254 runs scored, 4th with 62 home runs and 4th with 160 extra-base hits at home...the Indians are scoring 6.03 runs per home game, the highest rate in MLB.

- THEY HAVE THE GREEN LIGHT

 » GREG ALLEN and JOSÉ RAMÍREZ each stole a base in yesterday's game, marking the Tribe's MLB-leading 19th game with two-or-more steals.
- » The Indians have 68 stolen bases overall on the year, which is tied with Boston for the 2nd-most in the American League and 3rdmost in MLB (Chicago-AL - 70, Milwaukee - 69)...Tribe's 38 steals at home also lead MLB.

FINISH STRONG

- » The Indians have gone 21-8 in series finales this season, including a mark of 12-2 in home finales.
- » Tribe starters own a 19-2 record with a 2.34 ERA (51ER/196.1IP) in series finales, with wins in each of their last 11 decisions
- » Today's starting pitcher SHANE BIEBER will make his second series finale start this afternoon, after his outings on June 17 vs. Minnesota and June 27 at St. Louis...Bieber is 2-0 with a 1.54 ERA (2ER/11.2IP) in those outings
- » Additionally, Cleveland is a perfect 3-0 at home (4-3 overall) in rubber games this season.

» JOSÉ RAMÍREZ leads the team with 24 home runs (4th in A.L.) and 19 stolen bases (3rd in A.L.)...should Ramírez steal his 20th base of the season within the Tribe's eight games remaining before the All-Star break, he would become the second player in Indians franchise history with at least 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in the first half of the season, joining Grady Sizemore, who had 23
