The Astros clubhouse will be open from 3:10-4 p.m...manager AJ Hinch will be available in the Astros dugout at approximately 4 p.m.

THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY - JULY 10

2003 - CF Craig Biggio hits his 500th career double in an 11-2 win over the Reds at Minute Maid Park...the Astros run away early with a nine-run 1st inning, an inning that featured two singles by **2B Geoff Blum**...Blum leads the way with a 3x6 night, with two RBI.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The defending World Series Champion Houston Astros, who have won six of their last seven games, are in the midst of their longest homestand of the season, an 11-game, 11-day stand, which will take them thru the All-Star Break...speaking of All-Stars, **RHP Justin Verlander** (9-4), who was named to his seventh All-Star Team on Sunday, will start for the Astros tonight opposite the Athletics.

#ALLSTROSGAME: MLB announced the rosters for the 2018 All-Star Game on Sunday, naming five Astros to the All-Star Game in **2B Jose Altuve**, **3B Alex Bregman**, **RHP Gerrit Cole**, **OF George Springer** and **RHP Justin Verlander**...this marks the third time that the Astros have had five or more All-Stars on one squad...they had a club-record six All-Stars in 2017 and five in 1994...Houston's five All-Stars in 2018 are tied for tops among all AL clubs (CLE and BOS).

10 STARS: Including the Astros five All-Stars this season, there are 10 players on the Astros roster with All-Star Game appearances...the 2018 five are joined by **RHP Chris Devenski** (2017), **RHP Will Harris** (2016), **LHP Dallas Keuchel** (2015, 2017), **C Brian McCann** (2006-11, 2013) and **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (2017).

UP THE CHARTS: **RHP Justin Verlander** has amassed 2,570 strikeouts in his career, which ranks 28th in Major League Baseball history...he entered the season ranking 42nd in strikeouts and has moved up 14 spots over the first three months of the season.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros were shut out for the sixth time on the season last night, dropping the series opener to the A's by a score of 2-0...**RHP Gerrit Cole** (0ER/6IP) did his part for Houston, shutting out the A's on three hits in 6.0 innings...the Astros offense produced just five hits, including a 2x4 game by **CF George Springer**.

DOUBLE DIGITS: Including last night's performance by **RHP Gerrit Cole**, Astros starting pitchers have recorded 19 double-digit strikeout games this season...in franchise history, Astros starting pitchers have posted 19-or-more double digit strikeout games in just two other seasons: 1969 (24g) and 1987 (20g).

COLE TRAIN: **RHP Gerrit Cole** has amassed 169 strikeouts in 2018, which is an Astros franchise record for strikeouts prior to the All-Star Game...the previous record was held by **RHP Mike Scott**, who posted 167 strikeouts in 22 starts prior to the 1986 All-Star Game.

STREAKS SNAPPED: With their 2-0 loss last night, the Astros had their six-game winning streak snapped, their six-game home winning streak snapped and their eight-game winning streak against the A's snapped...they also had their streak of games with a homer snapped at 15 games, which tied as their third-longest streak in franchise history.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE: The Astros have recalled **OF Jake Marisnick** from Triple A Fresno today...he will take the roster spot of **RHP Gerrit Cole**, who was placed on the bereavement list today.

HIT MACHINE: **2B Jose Altuve** leads the Majors in hits (123) and ranks second in batting average (.337)...his 123 hits tie as the second-highest total posted by an Astro prior to the All-Star Game, trailing only his 2014 total (130) and tied with **Bob Watson**, who had 123 hits in the first half of the 1973 season.

CLUTCH CITY: **1B Yuli Gurriel** and **3B Alex Bregman** rank first and second in the AL in batting average with runners in scoring position, with Gurriel checking in with a .427 (32x75) average and Bregman a .373 (28x75) mark.

LUMBERJACKINI: **DH Evan Gattis** leads the Astros with 62 RBI on the season after totaling just eight RBI thru his first 32 games...since then (May 12), he has tallied 54 RBI, which leads the Majors in that span and leads the AL by seven RBI over **J.D. Martinez** (47 RBI).

HOUSTON TRAFFIC: **3B Alex Bregman**, the AL Player of the Month for June, had his 12-game hitting streak snapped on Sunday, has reached base safely in 16 consecutive games...dating back to May 15, Bregman has reached base safely in 47 of his last 48 games.

AT THE BACK END: The Astros have converted 10 straight 9th-inning save opportunities dating back to May 31...it's been a combination of **RHP Héctor Rondón** (7 saves) and **RHP Ken Giles** (3) in the 9th for the Astros since that date, with the two combining to toss 10.2 scoreless innings in those opportunities.

ALL-STAR WORTHY: **RHP Collin McHugh** has been one of the best relievers in the Majors this season, as he's posted a 4-0 record and a 0.86 ERA (4ER/42IP) with 55 strikeouts...among AL relievers, he ranks first in WHIP (0.74) and second in ERA and in opponent OPS (.449).

GAME OF THRONES NIGHT: Tonight marks **Game of Thrones Night** at the ballpark, during which fans are encouraged to come out and enjoy the game dressed as their favorite Game of Thrones character and have their photo taken on the **Iron Throne** of the Seven Kingdoms, the real throne used on the set at HBO...the Game of Thrones Night special ticket package includes a **Charlie Morton** Ruler of the Realm Bobblehead.

THIS IS HOME: Yesterday at its public Board meeting, the Harris County - Houston Sports Authority Board of Directors voted to approve an extension of the Astros lease at Minute Maid Park through 2050...the home for the Astros since 2000, the original lease agreement was set to expire in March of 2030...the details of the lease extension include a rent increase in the amount of \$1 million beginning this year for the remainder of the original lease (through 2030) and an additional \$1 million increase for the 20-year extension (through 2050)...the majority of these funds will be directed towards maintenance and capital repairs at MMP.

LAST START - 7/5 VS. CWS: did not factor into the decision in Houston's 4-3 walkoff win over the White Sox...allowed just 2 runs on 4 hits, striking out 10 with no walks.

- was his 4th double-digit strikeout game of the season, and the 46th of his career, which ranks T-21st in MLB history with **Walter Johnson** and **Dwight Gooden**.
- also marked his 16th quality start of the season, which ranks T-2nd in the AL with **Max Scherzer**, behind only **Corey Kluber** (17).

STILL SHINING: the 35-year-old and **2018 AL May Pitcher of the Month** was named to his 7th-career **All-Star** Team on Sunday...marks his first All-Star nomination since 2013...was an All-Star in 2007 and in every season from 2009-13.

- has been arguably the top pitcher in the game this season, as he leads the Majors in WHIP (0.84) and opponent OBP (.231)...among AL pitchers, ranks 2nd in innings pitched (125.2), 2nd in opponent OPS (.546), 2nd in strikeout to walk ratio (6.42), 3rd in ERA (2.15), 3rd in walks per 9.0 innings (1.72), 3rd in opponent batting average (.182), T-4th in strikeouts (154) and 6th in strikeouts per 9.0 innings (11.03).

DOMINANT START: is in the midst of the best first-half of his career...his 154 strikeouts, 2.15 ERA, .182 opponent batting average and .546 opponent OPS are all career-best marks in a single season prior to the All-Star Break.

- his 2.15 ERA is the 4th-lowest in franchise history for a single season prior to the All-Star Break (min. 100IP), behind only **Roger Clemens** (1.48 in 2005), **Mike Cuellar** (1.78 in 1966) and **J.R. Richard** (1.96 in 1980).

QUEST FOR 200: is just 3 wins shy of 200 for his Major League career...will become the 112th pitcher in MLB history to reach the 200-win plateau...has earned all of his wins as an American Leaguer, which will make him the 40th pitcher to win 200 games as a member of the American League.

- notched his 197th career victory in his 400th career start on June 14...only 15 pitchers in MLB history (10 Hall of Famers) recorded more wins within their first 400 games: **Pete Alexander** (230), **Juan Marichal** (222), **Walter Johnson** (217), **Tom Seaver** (209), **Mike Mussina** (206), **Roger Clemens** (204), **Jim Palmer** (202), **Whitey Ford** (202), **Greg Maddux** (201), **Bob Feller** (200), **CC Sabathia** (199), **Andy Pettitte** (199), **Randy Johnson** (199), **Carl Hubbell** (199) and **Roy Halladay** (198).

CHASING NOLAN: per the Elias Sports Bureau, ranks 28th in Major League history in strikeouts (2,570)...entered the season 42nd on that list, and so far has passed **Luis Tiant** (2,416), **Jamie Moyer** (2,441), **Andy Pettitte** (2,448), **Sam McDowell** (2,453), **Jim Kaat** (2,461), **Mark Langston** (2,464), **Tim Keefe** (2,475), **Jack Morris** (2,478), **Don Drysdale** (2,486), **Christy Mathewson** (2,507), **Bartolo Colon** (2,508), **A.J. Burnett** (2,513), **Javier Vazquez** (2,536) and **Jerry Koosman** (2,556).

- is within 11 strikeouts of 27th-place **Bob Feller** (2,581).

VS. OAK: has been dominant against the A's over the last few seasons...in his last 8 starts against the club since the 2011 season, has gone 7-1 with a 2.28 ERA (13ER/51.1IP) and 45 strikeouts.

- squared off against the A's in the postseason 5 times as a member of the Tigers, going 4-0 with a 1.24 ERA (5ER/36.1IP) and 49 strikeouts in 5 starts from 2006-13.

WITH THE 'STROS: in 24 regular season starts since getting traded to Houston last season, has gone 14-4 with an MLB-best 1.92 ERA (34ER/159.2IP) and 197 strikeouts.

- went 1x4 to extend his hitting streak to 6 games last night...has homered in 2 of his last 5 games.
- was named to his 6th-career **All-Star** team as the top vote-getter in Major League Baseball (4,849,630)...is the first player in franchise history to lead MLB in All-Star fan votes...will make his 4th consecutive start at 2B for the AL, joining **Craig Biggio** (1995-98) as the only players in club history to get 4 fan-elected starts.
- has hit safely in 17 straight starts at Minute Maid Park, the 2nd-longest streak of his career behind a career-long 18-game streak set in 2015...has hit .410 (25x61) with 5 doubles, 4 HR, 8 RBI, 5 steals and a 1.209 OPS (.520 OBP/.689 SLG) during this run.
- has 20 walks in his last 25 games, posting a .463 OBP in that span.
- leads MLB in hits (123) and ranks 2nd in batting average...ranks 3rd in the AL in OBP (.403), T-7th in batting w/ RISP (.351, 27x77) and T-8th in runs (61)...leads MLB in road batting (.365, 69x189).
- his 123 hits are tied for the 2nd-most prior to the All-Star Break of a season in club history with **Bob Watson's** 1973 season...trails only his record-setting 2014 season (130 hits).
- over his last 42 games overall, has hit .377 (60x159) with 11 doubles, 1 triple, 7 HR, 22 RBI, 9 SB and 16 multi-hit games (2g with a career-high 4 hits).
