### THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY - JULY 12

**2016 - 2B Jose Altuve** and **RHP Will Harris** represent the Astros in the All-Star Game, as the American League downs the National League by a score of 4-2 at Petco Park in San Diego...for Altuve, it marked his second All-Star start and fourth overall appearance... Harris, who was making his All-Star debut, pitched out of a huge jam in the 8th inning, striking out **PH Aledmys Diaz** with the bases loaded to preserve the 4-2 lead.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The defending World Series Champion Houston Astros, who have won seven of their last nine games, are in the midst of their longest homestand of the season, an 11-game, 11-day stand, which will take them thru the All-Star Break...**RHP Charlie Morton** (11-2), who made a strong case for an All-Star appearance this season, will make his final start of the first half today opposite the Athletics.

**GOING FOR 12:** **RHP Charlie Morton** is one of six American League pitchers with 11 wins on the season and is the first Astro to post 11 wins prior to the All-Star Game since **LHP Dallas Keuchel** in 2015 (11-4)...with a win today, it would mark the seventh time in franchise history for a pitcher to post 12 wins in the first half and the first time since **RHP Roy Oswalt** in 2005 (12-7).

**BANANA SPLIT:** The Astros need a win today to secure a split of this four-game series...the Astros have won or split 11 of their last 12 series, dating back to May 31, including eight series victories.

**THRU 95 GAMES:** The Astros are 29 games over .500 and are off to their second-best, 95-game start in franchise history, trailing only their 63-32 start in 2017.

**#ALLSTROSGAME:** The Astros will be represented by five players at the 2018 All-Star Game in **2B Jose Altuve**, **3B Alex Bregman**, **RHP Gerrit Cole**, **OF George Springer** and **RHP Justin Verlander**...this marks the third time that the Astros have had five or more All-Stars on one squad...they had a club-record six All-Stars in 2017 and five in 1994...Houston's five All-Stars in 2018 are tied for tops among all AL clubs (CLE and BOS).

**10 STARS:** Including the Astros five All-Stars this season, there are 10 players on the Astros roster with All-Star Game appearances...the 2018 five are joined by **RHP Chris Devenski** (2017), **RHP Will Harris** (2016), **LHP Dallas Keuchel** (2015, 2017), **C Brian McCann** (2006-11, 2013) and **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (2017).

**BREGMAN IN THE DERBY:** Last night, **3B Alex Bregman** was named one of eight participants in the 2018 T-Mobile Home Run Derby, which will be held on Monday at Nationals Park in Washington, DC, and broadcast live by ESPN and MLB.com beginning at 7 p.m. CT... Bregman, who has 19 home runs this season, is the fifth different Astros player to take part in a Derby, joining **Glenn Davis** (1989), Hall of Famer **Jeff Bagwell** (1994, 1996-97, 1999), **Moises Alou** (1998) and **Lance Berkman** (2002, 2004, 2006, 2008).

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Astros dropped last night's game to the A's by a score of 8-3...offensive highlights included a two-hit game by **SS Alex Bregman**, a two-RBI game by **3B Yuli Gurriel** and the first home run of the season for **1B Tyler White**.

**CIONEL'S DEBUT:** **LHP Cionel Pérez** made his MLB debut last night, tossing 1.2 innings...at 22 years, 81 days old, he became the youngest Cuban-born pitcher to make his Major League debut since **Jose Fernandez** debuted for the Marlins on April 7, 2013 (20.250).

**YESTERDAY'S ROSTER MOVE:** Prior to last night's game, the Astros recalled **LHP Cionel Pérez** from Double A Corpus Christi...he took the roster spot of **RHP Ken Giles**, who was optioned to Triple A Fresno.

**SECOND IN THIS ERA:** The Astros lead the Majors in run differential at +182, which is the second-best run differential thru the first 95 games of a season in the Expansion Era (since 1961)...only the 1998 Yankees (+186) posted a better run differential in their first 95 games than the 2018 Astros have.

**POWER SURGE: IF Alex Bregman** recorded his first career multi-homer game on Tuesday, giving him 19 home runs this year, which ties his single-season career high, set in 2017...he has 11 home runs in his last 25 games and six homers in his last 10 home games.

**HOUSTON TRAFFIC: IF Alex Bregman**, the AL Player of the Month for June, had his 12-game hitting streak snapped on Sunday, but has reached base safely in 18 consecutive games...dating back to May 15, Bregman has reached base safely in 49 of his last 50 games.

**HIT MACHINE: 2B Jose Altuve** has hit safely in 19 consecutive starts at Minute Maid Park, which is the longest streak of his career and the longest streak by an Astro in Minute Maid Park history (**Joey Votto** had a 23-game streak as a visitor)...the last Astro to hit safely in 19 consecutive home starts was **Derek Bell**, who hit safely in 20 consecutive starts at the 'Dome in 1998.

**CLUTCH CITY: 1B Yuli Gurriel** and **3B Alex Bregman** rank first and second in the AL in batting average with runners in scoring position, with Gurriel checking in at .429 (33x77) and Bregman at .368 (28x76).

**LUMBERJACKIN!:** **DH Evan Gattis** leads the Astros with 62 RBI on the season after totaling just eight RBI thru his first 32 games...since then (May 12), he has tallied 54 RBI, which leads the AL in that span by five RBI over **J.D. Martinez** (49 RBI).

**TUCKER TIME:** On Saturday, the Astros called up top prospect **OF Kyle Tucker**, who has started each of the last five games (4x18, 2B, BB, RBI) in left field... according to MLB.com, Tucker currently ranks as the No. 8 prospect in baseball.

**ALL-STAR WORTHY:** **RHP Collin McHugh** has been one of the best relievers in the Majors this season, as he's posted a 5-0 record and a 1.02 ERA (5ER/44IP) with 57 strikeouts...among AL relievers, he ranks first in WHIP (0.73) and second in ERA.

**PACK 'EM IN:** The Astros have sold out Minute Maid Park eight times this season, including all three games during which they distributed Replica World Series Championship Rings...this marks their most sellouts in a single season since 2008 (15 sellouts).

**BIRTHDAY WISHES:** The Astros would like to wish **LHP Tony Sipp** a happy 35th birthday today...Sipp shares his birthday with pro wrestler **Brock Lesnar** and the late-comedian **Charlie Murphy**.

**LAST START - 7/7 VS. CWS:** notched his 11th victory despite giving up 5 runs on 5 hits in 5.2 innings...struck out 8 and walked 2...was dominant early...retired the first 9 batters he faced and had given up just 1 run over his first 5.0 frames.

- became the 4th American League pitcher to reach 11 wins on the year...is just the 4th Astros pitcher to win 11 games prior to the All-Star Game dating back to the 2000 season, joining **LHP Dallas Keuchel** (11-4 in 2015), **RHP Roy Oswalt** (12-7 in 2005) and **RHP Wade Miller** (11-3 in 2001).

**CHARLES IN CHARGE:** 34-year-old with a turbo-charged fastball is in the midst of the best season of his career...has set a career highs in wins and strikeouts prior to the All-Star Break of a single season, while his ERA is his best prior to the break.

- is in the 2nd year of a 2-year contract he signed with the Astros as a free agent.
- has been one of the best pitchers in the AL since signing with the Astros...has gone 25-9 with a 3.29 ERA (93ER/254.2IP) and 304 strikeouts in 43 starts with the Astros from 2017-18.
- since the start of the 2017 season, ranks 5th in the AL in groundball rate (51.8%), T-5th in in wins (25), 7th in opponent batting average (.216), 4th in strikeouts per 9.0 innings (10.74), 10th in ERA (3.29) and 11th in WHIP (1.16).

**ALL-STAR TRAJECTORY:** this season, ranks among the top 10 AL pitchers in winning percentage (2nd, .846), strikeouts per 9.0 innings (3rd, 11.75), wins (T-4th), strikeouts (7th) and ERA (8th).

- is the first Astros pitcher with 11 wins through the All-Star Break since **Dallas Keuchel** in 2015.
- has 6 double-digit strikeout games this season (10 in his career)...ranks T-5th in the Majors in double-digit strikeout games...prior to joining the Astros, had just 1 double-digit strikeout game in his career (6/25/14).

**BRINGING THE HEAT:** formerly a low 90's sinkerballer, has developed into one of the hardest-throwing starting pitchers in the game...has posted an average fastball velocity of 95.9 miles per hour this year, which ranks 4th among MLB starters behind **Luis Severino** (97.8), **Mike Foltynewicz** (96.6) and teammate **Gerrit Cole** (96.4).

**LIGHTS OUT VS. LEFTIES:** his breakout with the Astros has been sparked by a newfound dominance over left-handed hitters...has held lefties to a .196 opponent batting average (37x189) in 2018...in 2017 he held them to a .175 batting average (44x252) and a .561 OPS.

- over the last 2 seasons, his combined .184 (81x441) opponent batting average vs. left-handed hitters ranks 2nd among AL starters, trailing only **Blake Snell** (.149).
- prior to joining the Astros in 2017, had allowed left-handed hitters to bat .307 (493x1607) with an .859 OPS against him in his career.

**UNCLE CHARLIE:** his curveball has been a huge weapon...has given up just 16 hits on his curveball this season (.119, 16x134).

- has recorded a whiff on 49.1% of all swings against his curveball, which leads all MLB starters.

**HAPPY AT HOME:** in 29 starts at Minute Maid Park as an Astro (regular and-postseason combined), has gone 19-4 with a 2.91 ERA (57ER/176IP) and 209 strikeouts.

**WINNER WINNER:** recently had a career-long 10-game winning streak that ended on June 3...in 14 starts during his streak, posted a 2.20 ERA (21ER/86IP) with 101 strikeouts and a .195 opponent batting average

- went 1x4 with a steal last night...riding a season-high tying 8-game hitting streak.
- has hit safely in 19 straight starts at Minute Maid Park, which is a career-long streak and the longest by an Astros player in Minute Maid Park history (**Joey Votto** had a 23-game streak as a visitor)...the last Astro to hit safely in 19 consecutive home starts was **Derek Bell**, who hit safely in 20 consecutive starts at the Astrodome in 1998...Altuve has hit .386 (27x70) with 5 doubles, 4 HR, 8 RBI, 6 steals and a 1.117 OPS (.488 OBP/.629 SLG) during this run.
- was named to his 6th-career **All-Star** team as the top vote-getter in Major League Baseball (4,849,630)...is the first player in franchise history to lead MLB in All-Star fan votes...will make his 4th consecutive start at 2B for the AL, joining **Craig Biggio** (1995-98) as the only players in club history to get 4 fan-elected starts.
- leads MLB in hits (125) and ranks 2nd in batting average...ranks 3rd in the AL in OBP (.399), 9th in batting w/ RISP (.346, 27x78) and T-10th in runs (62)...leads MLB in road batting (.365, 69x189).
- his 125 hits are the 2nd-most prior to the All-Star Break of a season in club history, behind only his record-setting 2014 season (130 hits).
- over his last 44 games overall, has hit .369 (62x168) with 11 doubles, 1 triple, 7 HR, 22 RBI, 10 SB and 16 multi-hit games (2g with a career-high 4 hits).

- the **2018 All-Star** will participate in the **2018 T-Mobile Home Run Derby**...will become the 5th player in Astros history to participate in the Home Run Derby, joining **Lance Berkman** (2002, 2004, 2006, 2008), **Jeff Bagwell** (1994, 1996-97, 1999), **Moises Alou** (1998) and **Glenn Davis** (1989).
- posted the first multi-HR game of his career on Tues...has hit 11 home runs over his last 25 games...has 6 homers in his last 10 home games...leads the Astros with 19 home runs, which ties his single-season career-high mark set last year.
- has 4 walkoff plate appearances (single, double, HR, E2), tied for the most in MLB with **Wilmer Flores** of the Mets.
