TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants and Athletics play the first game of the Bay Bridge Series, which will feature three games in San Francisco and three games in Oakland following the All-Star Break...the Giants are 4-3 on this homestand (2-2 vs. STL; 2-1 vs. CHC), while the A's are 5-2 on their current road trip (2-1 at CLE; 3-1 at HOU).

THE BRIDGE: The A's and Giants will compete for The Bridge, a new trophy awarded to the winner of the Bay Bridge Series...The Bridge will be awarded to the team that wins more games in the regular-season Bay Bridge Series...if the series finishes tied, the winner of the final game shall win The Bridge.

SIX STRAIGHT: According to Stats, LLC, this is the first time the Giants will play six-straight against the same opponent in a single season since they played six in a row against Atlanta between July 3-6, 1969 (July 4 and 6 were doubleheaders).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: The Giants are 3-4 in interleague games this season (1-1 vs. SEA; 2-1 at LAA; 0-2 at HOU) while the A's have gone 7-2, the third-best record in the Majors behind Boston's 7-1 record and Pittsburgh's 10-2 mark.

BELT VS. THE AL: IF Brandon Belt has hit well against AL pitchers this season, ranking first in several offensive categories in interleague play.

ON THE SHORES OF McCOVEY COVE: The Giants are 30-17 (.638) here at home this season, the third-best home record in the NL behind Philadelphia (30-16, .652) and Chicago (28-15, .651)...the Giants have won eight of their last 12 home games and 18 of their last 25.

THE GIANTS VS. RIGHTIES: The Giants are facing RHP Edwin Jackson tonight...they have performed better against right-handed pitchers this season with the fourth-highest difference in batting average vs. right-handed pitchers and left-handed pitchers.

This Date in Giants History: July 13, 2014

LHP Madison Bumgarner and **C Buster Posey** both hit grand slams, accounting for all their team's runs, as the Giants defeated the Diamondbacks, 8 - 4...it was the first time that both members of a battery hit slams in the same game, and for Bumgarner, it was his second of the year, making him only the second pitcher in history to do so...Tony Cloninger hit two in the same game in 1966.

#40 LHP Madison Bumgarner
6-4, 243, 28 years old (August 1, 1989)
2-3 Record, 3.09 ERA

- The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the hill today for his eighth start of the season...the Giants are 3-4 in his outings this year.
- Last pitched Sunday versus the Cardinals and picked up his second win of the year after tossing 5.1 innings and allowing four runs on seven hits in the Giants' 13-8 win.
- For the season, opponents are 1-for-33 (.030) with two walks in at-bats ending with his curveball (*Baseball Info Solutions*).
- Opponents are hitting .324 (11-for-34) off him with runners in scoring position...had entered the year with a .221 career against against with RISP.
- Is holding left-handed batters to a .133 average against (4-for-30).
- Is 3-2 with a 5.18 ERA (19er, 33.0ip) in five starts (one quality outing) against the A's...last faced them in 2016, allowing four runs on seven hits in 6.1 innings...his 5.18 ERA against Oakland is his highest in his career against any team he's faced at least five times.
- Was reinstated from the 60-day DL June 5...made just two rehab starts.
- Missed the Giants' first 60 games with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand.
- Had never been on the disabled list in his first eight Major League seasons but has now twice been placed on the DL the last two years, missing a total of 135 games.
- SF is 59-76 (.437) with Bumgarner on the DL.
- Missed three months last year (mid-April, May, June, mid-July) - 85 days, 75 games) with a left shoulder AC sprain...sustained the injury during a dirt bike accident on the team's off day in Denver, CO on April 20.
- Has 32 double-digit strikeout games, the second-most in Giants franchise history behind [Tim Lincecum](#) (36).

HITTING NOTES: Is 1-for-16 with one RBI this year...his last hit was a home run against St. Louis' Luke Weaver last Sept. 3...batted .206 with three homers and five RBI last season...has hit 17 homers in his 10-year career, the most of any active player and the most in Giants franchise history...is the first pitcher to total at least three homers in four consecutive seasons since Earl Wilson achieved the feat in five-straight seasons between 1964 and 1968.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP JEFF SAMARDZIJA

2018: 1-5, 6.42 ERA / Career: 69-92, 4.17 ERA

NOTES: 33-year-old right-hander will make his 10th start of the season...is 1-5 with a 6.42 ERA in nine starts this year, with the Giants going 2-7 in his outings...returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the 10-day disabled list July 7...missed 35 games with right shoulder tightness...also started the season on the disabled list and missed San Francisco's first 18 games with a right pectoral strain...made four rehab starts with triple-A Sacramento, going 0-2 with a 5.29 ERA (10er, 17.0ip)...was charged with his fifth loss of the year despite allowing three runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings of a 3-2 Giants defeat to the Cardinals at AT&T Park...has gone 2-2 with a 7.92 ERA (22er, 25.0ip) in four career starts against the Oakland A's, a team he pitched with for half a season in 2014...was traded from the Cubs to the A's in a six-player deal on July 4, 2014...went 5-6 with a 3.14 ERA in 16 starts with Oakland.
