**THE GIANTS:** With last night's victory, the Giants improved to 50-46 this season... last season the Giants didn't win their 50th game until Aug. 18...San Francisco has won 15 of their last 23 contests.

**SIX STRAIGHT:** Following the All-Star break, the Giants and Athletics will play three more games in Oakland...according to *Stats, LLC*, this is the first time the Giants will play six-straight against the same opponent in a single season since they played six in a row against Atlanta between July 3-6, 1969 (July 4 and 6 were doubleheaders).

**THE BRIDGE:** The A's and Giants will compete for The Bridge, a new trophy awarded to the winner of the Bay Bridge Series...The Bridge will be awarded to the team that wins more games in the regular-season Bay Bridge Series...if the series finishes tied, the winner of the final game shall win The Bridge.

**HOME SERIES WINS:** The Giants have gone 10-0-2 (win-lost-split) in their last 12 home series...they haven't lost a home set since dropping two of three to Arizona from April 8-10.

**ON THE MOUND: RHP Jeff Samardzija** will take the hill for the Giants...he's struggled against Oakland over his career, posting a 2-2 record with a 7.92 ERA (22er, 25.0ip) with a .320 opponents average in four starts...he'll oppose LHP Brett Anderson, who hasn't faced the Giants since 2015...he's 2-0 with a 2.89 ERA (6er, 18.2ip) over his last three starts against SF.

**TOUGH COMPETITION:** The Giants are currently in the stretch of playing 25 of 27 games against teams with a record above .500 (July 5-Aug. 7)...SF is 5-3 over the first eight such contests...the only team the Giants will face during this stretch without a record above .500 is San Diego (July 30-31).

**POWER OUTAGE:** Since July 1, the Giants have hit just five home runs, which is the fewest in the Majors during that span.

**VS. LEFTIES:** The Giants have posted a 19-19 record against left-handed starters this season, but have dropped 11 of their last 17 such games...since June 19, San Francisco is hitting just .201 off left-handers.

**SUCCESS VS. OAKLAND: C Buster Posey** has recorded a multi-hit game in 10 of his last 15 games against the Athletics, batting .429 (27-for-63) during the stretch...**OF Hunter Pence** is a career .348 (24-for-69) hitter with 11 extra-base hits in 17 games against Oakland.

**THREE IS BETTER THAN TWO:** The Giants have been held to two runs or fewer in 35 of their 96 games this season, going 7-28 (.200) in those games...when the Giants score three-or-more runs they are 43-18 (.705).

**ON THE SHORES OF McCOVEY COVE:** The Giants are 31-17 (.646) here at home this season, the third-best home record in the NL behind Philadelphia (30-16, .652) and Chicago (28-15, .651)...the Giants have won nine of their last 13 home games and 19 of their last 26.

**RISP MANAGEMENT:** Over their last six games, the Giants are hitting .327 (18-for-55) with runners in scoring position.

**STRETCH DRIVE:** The Giants Community Fund and **Willie McCovey** will hold the 10th annual Junior Giants Stretch Drive this weekend: Friday, July 13 - Sunday, July 15...the Stretch Drive is an organization-wide campaign dedicated to raising funds for the Junior Giants Program.

#### This Date in Giants History: July 14, 2005

Defeating their historical arch rivals, the Giants became the first team to win 10,000 games as a franchise by edging the Dodgers in Los Angeles, 4 - 3...the Giants, who started as the New York Gothams in 1883, had posted a 10,000-8,511 record during the club's 123 seasons in the National League.

• 33-year-old right-hander will make his 10th start of the season...is 1-5 with a 6.42 ERA in nine starts this year, with the Giants going 2-7 in his outings.

• Returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the 10-day disabled list this past Saturday...missed 35 games with right shoulder tightness...also started the season on the disabled list and missed San Francisco's first 18 games with a right pectoral strain.

• Made four rehab starts with triple-A Sacramento, going 0-2 with a 5.29 ERA (10er, 17.0ip).

• Prior to this season he had never been on the disabled list and now this year he's missed a total of 53 games due to injury.

• Was charged with his fifth loss of the year despite allowing three runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings of a 3-2 Giants defeat to the Cardinals at AT&T Park.

• Will attempt to snap a personal five-game losing streak...won his first start of the year, but since then has gone 0-5 with a 7.32 ERA (29er, 35.2ip) in his last eight outings...his career-high losing streak is six games, done three times.

• Has gone 2-2 with a 7.92 ERA (22er, 25.0ip) in four career starts against the Oakland A's, a team he pitched with for half a season in 2014...was traded from the Cubs to the A's in a six-player deal on July 4, 2014...went 5-6 with a 3.14 ERA in 16 starts with Oakland.

• Has received a total of just 18 runs of support this season in his nine outings (3.98 RSA)...however, has pitched 5.0-or-fewer innings in seven of nine games.

• 18 of his 29 earned runs allowed have come with two outs...opponents are batting .339 (19-for-56) with six extra base hits off him with two outs and are 11-for-26 (.423) with RISP and two outs.

- Finished second in the NL Final Vote for the All-Star Game, losing out to Milwaukee's Jesus Aguilar.
- Ranks 11th in the NL with an OPS of .882...leads all first basemen with nine defensive runs saved.
- Is batting .228/.327/.428 with seven homers with two strikes...he's never finished a season at .200 batting average or even .375 slugging with two strikes...the .428 slugging ranks seventh in the NL (*Baseball Info Solutions*).
