**THE GIANTS:** Will play the final game of this 10-game homestand that will also conclude the first half of the season...the Giants are 5-4 on this home set, going 2-2 vs. St. Louis, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL and 1-1 against Oakland.

**AT THE BREAK:** Last season, the Giants were 34-56 (.378) at the break, their worst mark at the unofficial halfway point since reaching the break in 2008 at 40-55... this year, the Giants enter their final game before the break at 50-47 (.515) after not getting their 50th win until late-August last season.

**TODAY'S STARTER:** LHP Andrew Suárez enters today's outing having allowed two runs or fewer in six straight outings while posting a 2.00 ERA (8er, 36.0ip) in those games...his 3.75 ERA is the sixth-lowest among NL rookie pitchers...beginning June 1, Suárez has fashioned a 2.28 ERA (12er, 47.1ip), which ranks as the seventh-lowest figure in the Majors (min. 35ip).

**HOME SERIES WINS:** The Giants need a win today to keep their streak of consecutive home series wins alive... SF has gone 10-0-2 (win-lost-split) in their last 12 home series...they haven't lost a home set since dropping two of three to Arizona from April 8-10.

**SEEING DOUBLE:** OF Steven Duggar is 8-for-25 (.320) with six runs scored, five doubles and four RBI in his first five Major League games...Duggar is the first Giant in the live-ball era (since 1920) to have five or more doubles in his first five games (*Stats, LLC*).

**ON THE MOUND:** Giants pitchers have not allowed a hit with a runner in scoring position since Monday...during this stretch, opponents are 0-for-their-last-30 since an Albert Almora Jr. single in the 3rd inning of Monday's game against the Cubs.

**ON THE SHORES OF McCOVEY COVE:** The Giants are 31-18 (.633) here at home this season, the third-best home record in the NL behind Philadelphia (30-16, .652) and Chicago (28-15, .651)...the Giants have won nine of their last 14 home games.

**THE BRIDGE:** The A's and Giants will compete for The Bridge, a new trophy awarded to the winner of the Bay Bridge Series...The Bridge will be awarded to the team that wins more games in the regular-season Bay Bridge Series...if the series finishes tied, the winner of the final game shall win The Bridge.

**POWER OUTAGE:** Since July 1, the Giants have hit just five home runs, which is the fewest in the Majors during that span...SF is 15-24 when they do not homer, 35-23 when they hit at least one homer and 18-6 when they hit at least two in a game.

**WITH RISP:** The Giants are hitting .249 with runners in scoring position this season (8th in NL) and .198 with RISP and two outs (last in NL).

**THREE IS BETTER THAN TWO:** The Giants have been held to two runs or fewer in 35 of their 97 games this season, going 7-28 (.200) in those games...when the Giants score three-or-more runs they are 43-19 (.694).

#### This Date in Giants History: July 15, 1997

The Giants scored 13 runs in the 7th inning to coast to a 16-2 win over the Padres... SF sent 19 men to the plate in the 7th and faced 80 pitches in the 52-minute inning...they scored seven runs before **J.T. Snow** grounded out for the first out...five Giants scored two runs each, including starting pitcher **Kirk Rueter** (6-4).

• Received a no decision in the Giants' 2-1, 11-inning victory over the Cubs on Monday...allowed one run on three hits with five strikeouts and a career-high four walks over 6.0 innings.

• Has allowed two runs or fewer in each of his last six outings, posting a 2.00 ERA (8er, 36.0ip).

• Has struck out 77 batters while issuing just 19 walks in his first 15 career Major League starts.

• Snapped his streak at 14-straight starts of allowing two walks or fewer...that's the longest such streak by a Giants starting pitcher to begin his big league career since Hi Bell also did it in 14-straight starts from June 18, 1932 to July 4, 1933.

• His 3.75 ERA is the second lowest by a Giants left-handed pitcher prior to the All-Star break since 1958 (Phil Nastu, 3.71 ERA in 1979) (min. 75.0ip).

• Opponents have 20 hits in 66 at-bats (.303) off him with runners in scoring position...is holding opponents to a .120 average (3-for-25) with RISP and two outs.

• Has received three or fewer runs of support in 11 of his 15 starts.

• Is 1-0 with a 1.44 ERA (4er, 25.0ip) and a .216 opponents average over his last four starts at AT&T Park.

• Lefties are hitting .177 (14-for-79) off him and are just 5-for-their-last-38 (.132).

• Was selected in the second round of the 2015 MLB Draft by San Francisco (No. 61 overall).
