THE GIANTS: Kick off the second half of the season with a five-game, two-city road trip against the Oakland A's (this weekend) and Seattle Mariners (Tuesday-Wednesday)...the Giants enter tonight's game having lost eight of their last 13 games.

AT THE BREAK: Last season, the Giants were 34-56 (.378) at the break, their worst mark at the unofficial halfway point since reaching the break in 2008 at 40-55...this year, the Giants are 50-48 (.510) after not getting their 50th win until late-August last season.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: RHP Dereck Rodríguez (4-1, 2.89) will make his eighth start of the season and his first since July 6 vs. St. Louis...Rodríguez has allowed three runs or fewer in six of his seven starts and has posted a 1.35 ERA (3er, 20.0ip) in his past three starting assignments...he has never faced an American League opponent.

ON THE ROAD: The Giants are 19-29 (.396) on the road this season, the second-lowest road winning percentage in the NL, ahead of only Miami (18-29, .383)...SF has won just four road series all year (at LAA, at ATL, at WSH, at ARI).

AT THE COLISEUM: The Giants are 23-34 (.404) all-time here at the Oakland Coliseum...despite winning four of the last six contests in this facility, SF has lost 14 of their last 20 in Oakland beginning with the 2010 season...the Giants' 6-14 (.300) record against the A's here in Oakland is their lowest road winning pct. vs. any single opponent since 2010.

GIANTS IN INTERLEAGUE: The Giants are 4-6 in Interleague this season despite outscoring their American League opponents by a 44-40 count...as the designated hitter, the Giants are hitting .211 (4-for-19) with three extra base hits and five RBI.

IN THE 'PEN: The Giants' bullpen has been dominant in recent games, with some of the best National League numbers over the last couple of months.

ON THE MEND: IF Evan Longoria, out since June 14 with a broken left hand, will begin his triple-A rehab assignment tonight for Sacramento in El Paso.

THE BRIDGE: The A's and Giants will compete for The Bridge, a new trophy awarded to the winner of the Bay Bridge Series...The Bridge will be awarded to the team that wins more games in the regular-season Bay Bridge Series...if the series finishes tied, the winner of the final game shall win The Bridge.

POWER OUTAGE: Since July 1, the Giants have hit just six home runs (one from Hernandez, one from Hanson, two from Sandoval & two from d'Arnaud), which is the fewest in the Majors during that span...SF is 15-24 when they do not homer, 35-24 when they hit at least one homer and 18-6 when they hit at least two in a game.

JUST SCORE 4: The Giants are 39-11 (.780) this season when scoring four or more runs.

At San Francisco, **Willie Mays** scored from first base on a **Jim Ray Hart** single...it was the only run of the game as the Giants defeated Houston, 1-0.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#57 RHP Dereck Rodriguez
6-1, 215, 26 years old (June 5, 1992)
4-1 Record, 2.89 ERA

- 26-year-old right-hander is slated to make his eighth Major League start (10th appearance) today...the Giants have won each of his last five starts and are 6-1 overall when he takes the hill as a starter.
- Is 3-1 with a 3.12 ERA (14er, 40.1ip) in seven starts compared to a 1-0 record with a 1.42 ERA (1er, 6.1ip) in two relief outings.
- Is making his first start since July 6 vs. St. Louis (W, 6.2ip, 5h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 1so)...his last appearance was on July 11 vs. CHC in long-relief...he earned the win as he pitched 3.0 shutout innings allowing just two base runners (both walks) with three strike outs.
- Has allowed three runs or fewer in six of his seven starts this year...has fashioned a 1.35 ERA (3er, 20.0ip) in his past three starting assignments.
- Is 2-0 with a 2.55 ERA (7er, 24.2ip) in his four starts AT&T Park, compared to a 1-1 record with a 3.79 ERA (8er, 19.0ip) in his four outings on the road.
- Among rookie pitchers with at least five starts, his 2.89 ERA is the third-best in the Majors behind Tampa Bay's Ryne Stanek (2.08) and Milwaukee's Freddy Peralta (2.65).
- Opponents are just 3-for-their-last-17 (.176) off him with runners in scoring position.
- Became the first Giants pitcher to earn his first win in his first Major League start since **Ryan Sadowski** did it on June 28, 2009 at MIL...prior to Rodriguez, the last Giants pitcher to win his first MLB start was **Joe Martinez** on Aug. 5, 2009 at HOU.
- Made his Major League debut on May 29 at COL when he replaced **RHP Jeff Samardzija**, who left the game after 1.0 inning with a tight right shoulder...pitched 3.1 innings, allowing four runs (one earned) on five hits...was removed from the game after being hit in the shin by a 108-mph comebacker...was diagnosed with a shin contusion.
- Struck out 53 batters in 50.1 innings of work...his 53 strikeouts led the Rivercats and ranked tied for ninth in the PCL at the time of his call up.
- Prior to being called up by San Francisco May 28 he posted a 4-1 record with a 3.40 ERA (19er, 50.1ip), 53 strikeouts and 11 walks allowed in nine starts for triple-A Sacramento this season.
- Signed a minor league contract with the Giants on November 15, 2017...was invited to Major League camp as a non-roster invitee.
- Is the son of former Major League catcher and Hall of Famer, Ivan Rodriguez...his dad has traveled to watch him pitch against the Nationals in Washington, the Marlins in Miami and against the Cardinals in San Francisco.
- Was drafted in the sixth round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins...spent his first three professional seasons as an outfielder before converting into a pitcher in 2014.

NOTES: The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the hill tomorrow for his ninth start of the season...the Giants are 4-4 in his outings this year, winning four of his last five starts...faces Oakland again for the second time in a week...earned the win last Friday night at AT&T Park in the Giants' 7-1 victory...tossed 6.0 innings and allowed a run on three hits with five strikeouts...for the season, opponents are 2-for-39 (.051) with two walks in at-bats ending with his curveball (*Baseball Info Solutions*)...is 4-2 with a 4.62 ERA (20er, 39.0ip) in six starts against the A's...has pitched four times here at Oakland, going 2-2 with a 6.23 ERA (18er, 26.0ip).
