THE GIANTS: Last night, the Giants tied the season series with the Athletics 2-2 with a 5-1 victory...following this series in Oakland, San Francisco will travel to Seattle for a two game set against the Mariners (Tuesday-Wednesday).

ROSTER MOVES: IF Ryder Jones was optioned to triple-A Sacramento following last night's game...IF Brandon Belt was reinstated from the paternity list prior to tonight's game...yesterday Belt and his wife, Haylee, welcomed their second son, August "Augie" Kyle Belt.

AT THE COLISEUM: Despite winning five of their last seven contests in this facility, the Giants are just 24-34 (.414) all-time here at the Oakland Coliseum...the Giants have scored 60 runs in their seven wins in Oakland since 2010 (8.6 runs per game) but just 23 runs in their 14 losses (1.6 runs per game).

TONIGHT'S STARTER: LHP Madison Bumgarner has posted a 3-1 record with a 1.95 ERA (7er, 32.1ip) and a .193 opponents average over his last five starts...he faced Oakland last Friday and earned the win, as he threw 6.0 innings, allowing one run on three hits and three walks...Bumgarner has struggled in four career starts at the Coliseum, posting a 6.23 ERA (18er, 26.0ip).

NOTABLE MATCHUPS: A few Giants have had some success of tonight's opposing starter Trevor Cahill...OF Andrew McCutchen is 6-for-12 (.500) with three doubles and a home run, IF Pablo Sandoval is hitting .346 (9-for-26) with a double and a triple, IF Brandon Belt is 8-for-25 (.320) with a triple and a homer and C Buster Posey is hitting .320 (8-for-25) with two doubles, a home run and five walks.

ON THE ROAD: SF is 20-29 (.408) on the road this season, tied with the Padres for the second-lowest road winning percentage in the NL, ahead of only Miami (18-29, .383)...SF has won just four road series all year (at LAA, at ATL, at WSH, at ARI).

**GIANTS IN INTERLEAGUE**: The Giants are 5-6 in Interleague this season despite outscoring their American League opponents by a 49-41 count...as the designated hitter, the Giants are hitting .174 (4-for-23) with three extra base hits and five RBI.

IN THE 'PEN: The Giants' bullpen has been dominant GIANTS, PITCHING BREAKDOWN BY in recent games, with some of the best National League numbers over the last couple of months.

ON THE MEND: IF Evan Longoria, who has missed the Giants last 30 games with a broken left hand, began his rehab assignment with triple-A Sacramento last night...he went 2-for-3 with a run, double and RBI and played 5.0 defensive

innings...he's scheduled to play 7.0 innings tonight with Sacramento.

POWER OUTAGE: Last night, the Giants recorded their first multi-homer game since June 30 at Arizona (three homers)...since July 1, the Giants have hit just eight home runs, which is the fewest in the Majors during that span...SF is 15-24 when they do not homer, 36-24 when they hit at least one homer and 19-6 when they hit at least two in a game.

# #40 LHP Madison Bumgarner 6-4, 243, 28 years old (August 1, 1989) 3-3 Record, 2.90 ERA

- The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the hill today for his ninth start of the season...the Giants are 4-4 in his outings this year, winning four of his last five starts.
- Faces Oakland again for the second time in a week... earned the win last Friday night at AT&T Park in the Giants' 7-1 victory...tossed 6.0 innings and allowed a run on three hits with five strikeouts.
- For the season, opponents are 2-for-39 (.051) with two walks in at-bats ending with his curveball (*Baseball Info Solutions*).
- Is holding left-handed batters to a .125 average against (4-for-32) with just one extra base hit allowed (double).
- Is 4-2 with a 4.62 ERA (20er, 39.0ip) in six starts against the A's...has pitched four times here at Oakland, going 2-2 with a 6.23 ERA (18er, 26.0ip).
- Was reinstated from the 60-day DL June 5...made just two rehab starts.
- Missed the Giants' first 60 games with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand.
- Had never been on the disabled list in his first eight Major League seasons but has now twice been placed on the DL the last two years, missing a total of 135 games.
- •SF is 59-76 (.437) with Bumgarner on the DL.
- Missed three months last year (mid-April, May, June, mid-July) - 85 days, 75 games) with a left shoulder AC sprain...sustained the injury during a dirt bike accident on the team's off day in Denver, CO on April 20.
- Has 32 double-digit strikeout games, the secondmost in Giants franchise history behind **Tim Lincecum** (36).

**HITTING NOTES:** Is 1-for-18 with one RBI this year...his last hit was a home run against St. Louis' Luke Weaver last Sept. 3...batted .206 with three homers and five RBI last season...has hit 17 homers in his 10-year career, the most of any active player and the most in Giants franchise history...is the first pitcher to total at least three homers in four consecutive seasons since Earl Wilson achieved the feat in five-straight seasons between 1964 and 1968.

### TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP JOHNNY CUETO

#### 2018: 3-1, 2.36 ERA / Career: 125-84, 3.31 ERA

**NOTES:** The two-time All-Star (2014 & 2016) is slated to make his third start since coming off the disabled list on July 5 and his eighth start overall this season...did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 11 vs. Chicago-NL...threw 5.0 innings, allowing three runs on six hits in seven strikeouts in the Giants 5-4 victory over the Cubs...has faced Oakland just once in his career...threw 7.0-scoreless innings, allowing seven hits and two walks with four strikeouts in the Reds' 3-0 victory over the Athletics on June 23, 2010...has posted a 16-7 record with a 2.68 ERA (62er, 208.1ip) in 33 career starts in Interleague play...is 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1er, 12.0ip) in two Interleague starts this season.
