TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and A's play the final game of this three-game series... the winner of today's game will receive The Bridge, a new trophy awarded to the winner of the Bay Bridge Series...The Bridge is awarded to the team that wins more games in the regular-season Bay Bridge Series...if the series finishes tied, the winner of the final game shall win The Bridge.

THE GIANTS: Enter play today having lost nine of their last 16 games...SF is currently in fourth place in the NL West, 4.0 games behind the first-place Dodgers.

FROM ELIAS: LHP Madison Bumgarner failed to complete 5.0 innings in his start last night for the first time since April 11, 2015...the 89 straight starts of 5.0-or-more innings pitched was the longest active streak in the Majors and the best by a Giants pitcher since the mound was moved in 1893.

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Johnny Cueto will make his eighth start today...he's 3-1 with a 2.36 ERA in seven outings...however, since coming off the disabled list on July 5, he's 0-1 with a 7.20 ERA (8er, 10.0ip) in two starts...Cueto has faced Oakland just once in his career on June 23, 2010 (W, 7.0ip, 7h, 0r, 0er, 2bb, 4so).

AT THE COLISEUM: The Giants are 24-35 (.407) all-time here at the Oakland Coliseum...they'll be seeking their first series win here since Sept. 25-27, 2015... the Giants have scored 60 runs in their seven wins in Oakland since 2010 (8.6 runs per game) but just 26 runs in their 15 losses (1.7 runs per game).

ON DECK: Following today's game the Giants will travel to the Pacific Northwest where they'll face the Seattle Mariners for a quick two-game series that starts Tuesday...the Giants are 14-17 (.452) all-time against the Mariners...the Giants, who have lost nine of their last 12 in Seattle, have not played at Safeco since 2015.

ON THE ROAD: SF is 20-30 (.400) on the road this season, the lowest road winning percentage in the NL...the Giants have won just four road series all year (at LAA, at ATL, at WSH, at ARI).

ON THE MEND: IF Evan Longoria, who has missed the Giants last 31 games with a broken left hand, began a rehab assignment with triple-A Sacramento on Friday and has gone 2-for-7 in two games...he went 0-for-4 last night.

IN THE 'PEN: The Giants' bullpen has been dominant in recent games, with some of the best National League numbers over the last couple of months.

MUCH BETTER THAN LAST YEAR: Through 100 games last season, the Giants were 38-62 (.380) and in fifth place in the NL West, 30.5 games behind the first-place Dodgers.

#47 RHP Johnny Cueto 5-11, 229, 32 years old (February 15, 1986) 3-1 Record, 2.36 ERA

- The two-time All-Star (2014 & 2016) is slated to make his third start since coming off the disabled list on July 5 and his eighth start overall this season.
- The Giants have won five of his seven starts.
- Since coming off the DL he's made two starts, going 0-1 with a 7.20 ERA (8er, 10.0ip), allowing four homers and a .364 opponents batting average against.
- Did not factor into the decision in his last start on July 11 vs. Chicago-NL...threw 5.0 innings, allowing three runs on six hits with seven strikeouts in the Giants' 5-4 victory.
- Was placed on the DL May 1 with right elbow inflammation...saw Dr. James Andrews on May 7 and was diagnosed with an elbow sprain...missed 61 games.
- Prior to landing on the DL, Cueto had allowed just three runs in 32.0 innings of work (0.84 ERA), covering his five starts.
- In three starts on the road this season, he's tossed 20.0-scoreless innings and allowed just five hits (.079 opponents average).
- Opponents are hitting just .207 (6-for-29) off him with runners in scoring position.
- Also missed nine games from April 10-17 with a left ankle sprain, an injury he suffered while working out in the Giants' gym...missed just one start.
- Has faced Oakland just once in his career...threw 7.0-scoreless innings, allowing seven hits and two walks with four strikeouts in the Reds' 3-0 victory over the Athletics on June 23, 2010.
- Has posted a 16-7 record with a 2.68 ERA (62er, 208.1ip) in 33 career starts in Interleague play...is 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1er, 12.0ip) in two Interleague starts this season.


