WINS AND LOSSES: Texas lost to the A's last night, 15-3, and club has a 1-3 record on this 2nd 'half' opening 7-day, 7-game homestand against CLE (1-2) and OAK (0-1)...team has dropped 5 of 6, 8 of 10, and 11 of 13...at 4-13 (.235), Texas has the lowest win pct. in MLB this month...TEX has more losses this month (4-13) than in entire month of June (14-11)...the 4 wins this month have come against DET (2), BAL (1), and CLE (1), and 2 of the 4 wins have been SHO... team still has a 15-15 record beginning 6/16.

• At 42-59 (.416), Rangers rank 12th in A.L. in winning pct... the 42 wins are the fewest for Texas after 101 games since 2014 (40-61) and 2nd fewest in last 16 seasons (beg. 2004).
• Texas has been under the .500 mark since a season best 1-1 on 3/30...team has matched season high at 17 games under .500 (3rd time, also 6/15 and Saturday)...this was just 4th season in TEX history to be 17+ under as early as 6/15 (last 2007, club-record 6/3)...club lost a season high 7 straight games from 6/7-15 and directly followed that with a 2018 best 7 consecutive wins from 6/16-23.

SERIES STUFF: Rangers are 0-4-1 in last 5 series after having won a season-best 5 consecutive series from 6/15-7/1... team is still 6-3-1 in last 10 series in Arlington, only losses in that span to the Astros (0-4 from 6/7-10; 0-2 from 7/3-4) and Indians (1-2 from 7/20-22)...the Rangers have gone 18-14 in the 2nd game of series in 2018, but have lost 5 in a row.

IN THE STANDINGS: Texas is 23.5 GB of division-leading HOU, gaining ground on just 2 total days in July (once on an off day)...club was season high 24.0 GB following loss on Saturday, the 2nd-earliest date ever for Rangers to have a 24-game deficit (6/4 in 2001) and just the 10th season overall in club history to have a deficit so large...only other season with a 24+ game deficit in last 16 seasons (beg. 2004) was 2014...club has lost 7.0 games in the standings over the last 20 days...current deficit is T3rd-largest in the majors...club has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 105 days and in either 4th or 5th place for 115 of 116 days (T2nd following win on 3/30).

AT HOME: Texas is 20-31 (.392) in Arlington this season, 3rd-lowest home win pct. in A.L. and T4th-lowest in MLB... team has gone 1-6 in 7 home games in July, a span which was preceded by a 6-1 stretch in Arlington from 6/16-6/30... team is 7-7 in last 14 at home, this after a 5-G losing skid from 6/7-15, and are 13-14 in last 27 G after opening year at 5-15...overall 20-31 record is 2nd-slowest 51-G start at home in TEX history (19-32 in 2014).

THE SWINGIN' A'S: The Rangers are 5-5 vs. OAK in '18, only A.L. West opponent with a .500-or-better record against...TEX has won 3 of 4 and 4 of last 7 vs. A's, and have a 3-3 mark in Arlington...Rangers have gone 23-21 vs. OAK beginning 6/14/16...Texas was 8-11 against Oakland in 2017, and Rangers have lost season series vs. A's in 4 of last 6 seasons...Rangers went 7-3 vs. the A's at home last season, and have won 14 of last 22 meetings in Arlington... Texas leads all-time series 366-357, and holds leads of 194-169 in Arlington and 106-102 at Globe Life Park...this is the 3rd straight series between the clubs to be played at Globe Life Park, as each of final 2 meetings will be at the Coliseum (8/20-22 and 9/7-9).

THE SPACE BETWEEN: The Rangers allowed 15+ runs in the games preceding and following Sunday's shutout, the first time in club history for pitching staff to bookend a shutout in that fashion...it is just the 3rd time in team history to allow a pair of 15+ run games in a span of 3 contests, the others being back-to-back instances on 5/16-17/93 and 9/17&19/08.

SCORING CHANGE: Official scorer Greg Porzucek made a scoring change from last night's game, as Jonathan Lucroy's PA in the 8th has been changed from a FC to an E4 (error on Rowned Odor)...no other stats were impacted from the change, which will be reflected in tomorrow's official stats.

DESHIELDS OPTIONED. MANN RECALLED: The Rangers announced earlier today that the club has optioned OF Delino DeShields to Round Rock and recalled LHP Brandon Mann from Round Rock...Mann has posted no record and a 1.50 ERA (1 ER/6.0 IP) over 4 relief appearances spanning 2 stints with Texas this season (also 5/13-23 and 6/15-16) in his 1st MLB action.

KINER-FALEFA TABBED FOR AWARD: The MLB Players Alumni Association today announced that Isiah Kiner-Falefa is the Texas Rangers 2018 Heart and Hustle Award winner... the award honors active players who demonstrate a passion for the game of baseball and best embody the values, spirit and traditions of the game...it is the only award in MLB that is voted on by former players.

GETTING THEIR WORK IN: Last night, Carlos Tocci (0.2 IP) and Ryan Rua (1.0 IP) recorded the final 5 outs without allowing a run in the Rangers' loss...it marked the 1st time in Rangers history for multiple position players to pitch in a single game...there have now been 16 instances of a position player appearing on the mound for Texas, with 14 different players serving as pitchers (list on page 142 of media guide).
• Over the first 40 years in Rangers history from 1972-2011, there were a total of 4 instances/3 players to pitch for the club, including Jose Canseco's infamous 5/29/93 outing at Fenway and Scott Sheldon's one-batter faced appearance while playing all 9 positions on 9/6/00 at CWS...since the start of 2012, however, the Rangers have now used a position player to pitch at least once in 7 consecutive seasons.

RUA'S RARE COMBO: Ryan Rua, who made his ML pitching debut last night, also recorded outfield assists in both LF and RF prior to his game finished on the mound...according to Elias Sports Bureau, since 1961 (expansion era), the only other players to both pitch and post an OF assist in the same game were TOR's Rick Leach on 8/15/84 at CLE (G1) and MIL's Joe Inglett on 7/27/10 vs. CIN...Jonathan Lucroy was Inglett's catcher for his outing in 2010.

MILESTONE FOR ELVIS: Elvis Andrus recorded career hit no. 1500 with his 2-run HR in the 3rd inning last night...he became just the 5th player in club history to reach the 1500 mark, joining Michael Young (2230), Ivan Rodriguez (1747), Rafael Palmeiro (1692), and Juan Gonzalez (1595).

ODOR OF LATE: Rowned Odor had a double and scored one of the Rangers' 2 runs last night...Odor is now batting .356/.426/.576/1.002 (21-59) with 3 HR, 4 2B, and 8 RBI in July to raise his season average from .229 to .259...in his last 48 G over a 2-month span beginning 5/24, Odor is batting .298/.371/.468/.839 (51-171), posting the 4th-highest OPS among ML second baseman (min. 167 PA) in that span behind only Jose Altuve (.930), Javier Baez (.896), and Scooter Gennett (.840).

TIGHTEN UP: Texas pitching has allowed its 2 highest run totals (16 on Fri. vs. CLE, 15 last night) all season, as well as 3 of its 4 highest hit totals in '18, in the 4 games since the All-Star break...Rangers' A.L.-high 40 runs and 61 hits allowed in the 2nd 'half' are surpassed only by the Cubs (41 R/62 H), and the North Siders have played 2 more games than Texas.

SHORTS: Shin-Soo Choo has reached safely via H/BB/HBP in 54 of his last 55 G and ranks 4th in A.L. with a .402 OBP... Adrián Beltré is one HR shy of matching fellow 3B Chipper Jones on the all-time list (see chart in left column)...Jones is set to be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame on Sunday in Cooperstown, NY...the only primarily 3rd basemen with more HR than Beltré are Mike Schmidt (548), Eddie Mathews (512), and Jones (468)...Mike Minor is 4-2, 3.54 in 10 GS in Arlington this season, 2 more home wins than any other TEX pitcher (5 Rangers have 2 home wins)...of the Rangers' 65 G after the break in '18, 55 of them (84.6%) are scheduled to take place in either Texas or California.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#36 Mike Minor, LHP
(6-6, 4.89)

TONIGHT: The 30-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 19th start of the season in tonight's 2nd game of this series vs. Oakland...will be making his 1st start in the 2nd 'half', as he took the loss in the Rangers' pre-break finale on 7/15 at BAL, season-low 2.2 IP...the 7/15 outing (6 R-5 ER in 2.2 IP) spiked his season ERA from 4.56 to 4.89, although he is still 2-2, 3.60 (16 ER/40.0 IP) in his last 7 starts to drop season figure from 5.76...his 6 wins lead the team and his 79 SO rank 2nd on staff (114-Hamels)...with 99.1 IP this season, has already surpassed innings total from 2017 (77.2) when he worked as a reliever for Kansas City...has permitted 5 HR in last 7 starts (1.13 HR/9), this after 11 HR in 1st 11 starts (1.67 HR/9)...is in his 1st season as a starting pitcher since 2014 (w/ ATL), also his 1st season with the Rangers after signing a 3-year contract on 12/6/17...did not make ML appearance in 2015-16 following surgery for a torn labrum in his left shoulder on 5/13/15...was 38-36, 4.10 in 111 games/110 starts for ATL from 2010-14...from the 2012 All-Star break through 2014 season, ranked 11th in N.L. with a 3.52 ERA (min. 70 starts)...was selected by the Braves as the 7th overall selection in the 2009 June draft out of Vanderbilt University.

JUNE JAM: Last month, made quality starts in all 4 outings, going 2-0, 2.08 (6 ER/26.0 IP) in 4 G/GS with a .170/.213/.261/.474 opp. slash line...among MLB pitchers w/ 25.0+ IP in June, Minor's opp. OPS (.474) and WHIP (0.77) figures were 2nd to only BOS' Chris Sale (.422/0.76)...Minor's 0.77 WHIP was lowest in a single month by a TEX pitcher (min. 90 BF) since Yu Darvish (0.74) in Sept. 2012...ranked among A.L. June leaders (min. 25.0 IP) in opp. BA (4th) and ERA (8th).

LAST START: Took loss in pre-break finale on 7/15 at BAL (2.2 IP, 4 H, 6 R-5 ER, 2 BB, 1 SO, 1 HR, 68 pitches/44 strikes) in a 6-5 Texas defeat...was shortest outing of the season and matched most runs allowed...was staked to a 4-0 lead before ever taking the mound, but could not escape a 3rd inning in which he threw 43 pitches.

VS. OAKLAND: Will be making his 8th start of the season against an A.L. West opponent, although the other 7 have all come against HOU (4) and SEA (3)...is 1-1, 3.72 (4 ER/9.2 IP) in 4 G/1 GS in his career against the A's, including 3 relief outings with KC in 2017 (2.2 IP, 2 R-ER)...lone start vs. A's came on 8/17/14 in ATL, a 4-3 Braves win (W, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R-ER)...no current A's played in that game in which Minor pitched opposite Jon Lester.

AT GLOBE LIFE PARK: Is 4-2 with a 3.54 ERA (24 ER/61.0 IP) in 10 starts in Arlington this season...2 more home wins than any other TEX pitcher (5 Rangers have 2 home wins)...has quality starts in his last 4 home outings (6/27 vs. SD, 6/16 vs. COL, 6/9 vs. HOU, 7/4 vs. HOU), and Rangers have won 3 of last 5 times he has started at Globe Life Park...opponents are batting .227/.280/.444/.725 over 10 starts at Globe Life Park compared to .301/.347/.545/.892 in 8 road starts...has allowed 10 of 16 HR at this facility.

2018: Texas is 8-10 in his 18 starts...had 6 hit batters over 1st 8 starts, none in last 10 starts...has allowed 4 HR in last 6 starts, this after permitting at least one HR in 7 straight starts from 5/3-6/9...has still given up 14 HR in his last 13 GS after only allowing just 2 HR in his first 5 GS...batters leading off innings have hit .290 (27-93) with 7 BB and 3 HBP...bottom 3 spots in the lineup are a combined 19-for-109 (.174) w/ .550 OPS...opponents batting .196 (22-112) with 2 outs in an inning...opposing batters w/ RISP are 19-for-84 (.226), including 8-for-30 (.267) in last 7 starts...opponents by plate appearance vs. Minor: 1st PA (.233, 35-150), 2nd PA (.273, 39-143), 3rd PA (.286, 24-84), 4th PA (0-4)...Chirinos has caught 10 starts (3-3, 4.86), Centeno 3 starts (2-0, 5.29), Pérez 2 starts (0-2, 6.00), Trevino caught start on 6/16 (0-0, 2.57), and Kiner-Falefa (1-1, 4.66) has caught 2 starts (6/27, 7/15)...win on 4/7 vs. TOR was 1st victory as a starter since 8/28/14 w/ ATL...has allowed 2 HR to LH batters in '18 (Moustakas-5/25 vs. KC, Reddick-7/4 vs. HOU), 1st HRs by LH batter since he was with ATL on 7/1/14 vs. NYM (Daniel Murphy in the 5th inning at Turner Field)...took a perfect game into the 7th on 6/27 vs. SD, as game score of 80 (Bill James formula) matched the highest of his career (also w/ ATL on 5/25/13 at NYM)...was 2nd-deepest perfect game effort by a Ranger in '18, as Bartolo Colon retired 1st 21 Astros on 4/15 at HOU...posted QS in 5 straight starts from 6/9-7/4, longest QS streak since 6 in a row w/ ATL from 8/12-9/8/14...has been the starter in 2 of Rangers' 5 shutout defeats in '18, last on 7/9 at BOS.

2017: In his lone season with KC, led staff in relief wins (6), was 2nd in appearances (65) and saves (6) and placed 3rd in holds (17) and games finished (13)...career low 2.55 ERA was 2nd lowest among all KC pitchers...tied for 7th among A.L. relievers in wins and was T11th in strikeouts (88), 2nd most ever for a Royals lefty (Tim Collins, 93 in 2012)...issued just 0.58 home runs per 9.0 innings, 2nd-lowest among A.L. pitchers (min. 70.0 IP), bettered by Rangers' Alex Claudio (0.54 HR/9.0 IP)...held opposition to .204 batting average, including .163 vs. LHB, 7th-lowest mark in A.L. (minimum 90 batters faced)...had a 1.017 WHIP, 10th-lowest in ML (min. 70.0 IP).

WINS BEFORE ALL-STAR BREAK: Minor leads the Rangers with 6 victories...it marked just the 4th season in club history to not have a pitcher with 7+ wins at the All-Star break: also 1973, 2007, and 2017, when Yu Darvish topped the staff with 6 victories.
