 Split a two-game series against the Houston Astros prior to yesterday's off day ... have now gone seven consecutive series without a series loss (last series loss: June 26-28 at San Francisco, 1-2) ... that is their second-longest streak in franchise history without losing a series (longest: nine, April 30-May 28, 2017) ... prior to the split with Houston, had won six consecutive series against teams at .500 or above, their longest series winning streak since 2014 and the first time in franchise history that they won six consecutive series against teams at or above .500.

 Won Wednesday on a Charlie Blackmon walk-off home run, his first career walk-off home run and his second career walk-off RBI (also: RBI single, Sept. 1, 2014 vs. San Francisco) ... held Houston to one hit, the third time in franchise history that the Rockies have one-hit their opponent at Coors Field (last: July 9 vs. Chicago-AL).

Yesterday, the Rockies announced that they acquired right-handed reliever Seunghwan Oh from the Toronto Blue Jays in exchange for Minor League infielder Chad Spanberger, Minor League outfielder Forrest Wall and a player to be named later. Oh, 36, went 4-3 with two saves, a 2.68 ERA (47.0 IP, 14 ER) 10 walks and 55 strikeouts in 48 relief appearances with Toronto this season.

- TIN? IT The Rockies are 20-9 since June 19, a .690 winning percentage that is the best in the NL and the third-best in MLB (Oakland's .781 winning percentage is best) ... have won 16 of their last 21 games since June 28.

Carlos González made his Major League debut with Oakland on May 30, 2008 and played 85 games with them prior to his November 10 trade to Colorado (along with Greg Smith and Huston Street) in exchange for Matt Holliday.

Brett Anderson was acquired by Colorado from Oakland on Dec. 10, 2013 in exchange for Chris Jensen and Drew Pomeranz ... made eight starts for the Rockies in 2013, going 1-3 with a 2.91 ERA (43.1 IP, 14) prior to becoming a free agent on Nov.

1. Jonathan Lucroy was acquired by the Rockies from the Texas Rangers on July 30 of last season for a player to be named later (Pedro Gonzalez) ... he batted .310 (44-for-142) in 46 games for Colorado prior to signing with Oakland as a free agent on March 12 of this year.

Matt Chapman (class of 2011) was teammates with Nolan Arenado (class of 2009) at El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

Colorado leads the Majors in runs scored in the first inning (82) and also leads MLB in runs allowed in the first frame (88). Have hit a Major League-leading 30 home runs in the first inning, while their 25 home runs allowed are the second-most in MLB ... Nolan Arenado's 11 first-inning home runs and 28 RBI lead MLB.

- Ranks seventh in the National League with 4.2 WAR, fourth among NL pitchers (Baseball Reference) ... tied for 10th in innings pitched and ninth with a 3.28 ERA (120.2 IP, 44 ER).
- Pitched collegiately at the University of Evansville in Southern Indiana ... drafted by Colorado in the first round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft (eighth overall).
- · A member of the Opening Day roster for the second consecutive season after making his debut in 2017 ... earned his first win and recorded his first hit in his Major League debut in the Rockies Home Opener on April 7, 2017 vs. the Los Angeles Dodgers.

LAST TIME OUT

Received no decision for his third consecutive start his last time out on July $2\,\mathrm{I}$ in Arizona, a 6-5 Rockies win ... pitched five innings while allowing four runs on five hits with three walks and three strikeouts ... it was his third consecutive start going 5.1 innings or fewer, his longest streak without going 6.0 or more this season.

- Has 12 quality starts, which ranks tied for fifth in the National League (also Tyler Anderson) ... made 13 quality starts in 2017, which ranked second among Major League rookies.
- His 25 quality starts rank fifth in franchise history within a pitcher's first 50 Major League career starts with Colorado.

- Will be making his third Interleague start of the season, the seventh of his career, and his first against Oakland.

- His 3.38 career ERA at Coors Field (136.0 IP, 51 ER) is the second-lowest in franchise history (min. 100 IP), the lowest by a starting pitcher ... II-10 in 27 games, 24 starts at home.
- Is 5-2 with a 2.76 ERA (49.0 IP, I 5 ER) in Denver this year ... five home wins tied for the third-most in NL.
- His 3.42 ERA in Denver last year was the 11th-lowest home mark in Colorado history among all pitchers \dots lowest mark at Coors Field since Jorge De La Rosa had an ERA of 2.76 in 2013 and 3.08 in 2014 \dots second-lowest ERA by a Rockies rookie (Denny Stark, 3.21, 2002).

- Has made 12 starts on the road this season, going 3-4 with a 3.64 ERA (71.2 IP, 29 ER), 23 walks and 54 strikeouts \dots he is 8-7 with a 4.09 ERA (140.2 IP, 64 ER) in 26 road games, 24 starts, over his career.
- Over his past nine road starts since April 30, has gone 3-2 with a 2.97 ERA (57.2 IP, 19 ER) with seven quality starts.

- Career 3.74 ERA (276.2 IP, 115 ER) ranks seventh all-time among Rockies pitchers with 200.0 or more innings, second among starting pitchers (first: . Ubaldo Jimenez, 3.66)
- Is 19-17 with a 3.76 ERA (270.1 IP, 113 ER) in 48 career starts with the Rockies going 28-20 in those games ... has no decisions with a 2.70 ERA (3.1 IP, I ER) in two road relief outings ... has a 3.00 ERA (3.0 IP, I ER) in three relief appearances at home.

ROOKIE CARD

- Last season tied for the Major League lead among rookies with 11 wins (also: German Márquez) ... ranked third in innings (156.0), fifth in ERA (4.10, min. 15 starts) and seventh in strikeouts (107).
- His 4.10 ERA was the fourth-lowest by a rookie in franchise history, the lowest since Jhoulys Chacin set the franchise record for rookies in 2010 (3.28).
