THE LATEST:

- Yesterday afternoon, the Blue Jays plated five runs in the 9th inning as they came back to beat the White Sox, 7-4...Was their 27th come-from-behind victory of the season...Won a game when trailing after eight innings for just the 2nd time this year, also coming back for a 5-4 win in 10 innings on June 7 vs. BAL...Have now claimed two of their last three series after going 0-3-5 over their previous eight sets.
- The Jays are now 9-13 in July and have won 18 of their last 36 games, as well as 22 of their last 43...Have moved to 4.0 games back of the Rays but remain a season-most 24.5 games behind the division-leading Red Sox...Have not been further back since 2009, finishing 28.0 GB of NYY.

BEST STREAK BY A ROOKIE...EVER!:

- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. extended his career-best hitting streak to 11 games yesterday with a 1st-inning single...The streak is the longest by a Blue Jay this season...He then added two more singles to **extend his multi-hit streak to 11 games, extending the longest such streak in franchise history (Fernandez - 9G in 1986)**...Was his 4th career three-hit effort, the 3rd of his last eight games...Was also his 3rd consecutive 2-RBI game.
- The 24 year old **became the 7th player since 1900 to record a multi-hit streak of at least 11 games** (last: Tony Perez - 11G in 1973) **and the 1st rookie to do so...His streak is tied for the longest all-time by an AL batter, joining Shoeless Joe Jackson (1912) and Sam Rice (1925).**
- Gurriel Jr. has hits in each of his last 17 starts, tied for the 3rd longest streak in the Majors this season (Brantley - 19, Ramos - 18)...Is batting .432 (32-for-74) with 4-2B, 5-HR and 15-RBI over that span...**Is now hitting .322 for the season, the best among all MLB rookies with at least 100 plate appearances (2nd: Juan Soto - .310)**...Now has 46 hits over the course of his first 38 career games, 2nd most in team history, trailing only Aaron Hill who had 48 in 2005...**Has hit .423 (30-for-71) over the course of July for the highest AVG in the AL this month.**

- Teoscar Hernandez tied yesterday's game, 3-3, with a home run to lead off the 9th inning...Each of his last six homers have either tied the game or given the Jays the lead...Now has 10 such HR (T-10th in the AL)...Has hit 10 of his 16 HR on the road, including each of his last four.

LEFT COAST LIFESTYLE:

- This afternoon marks the 4th game of Toronto's longest road trip of the season, playing 10 games in a 10-day span...After this three-game series in Oakland, will complete the trip with four dates in Seattle (62-43).
- The Jays are 2-1 on the current road trip...Have gone 4-7 in their last 11 road games and are 8-17 since May 29...Have an overall road record of 21-28...The .429 win% ranks 9th among AL clubs...Have been out-scored, 258-225, and out-hit, 457-401, during away contests...Have averaged 4.59 runs/game on the road (7th highest in the AL) while allowing 5.27 R/G (12th in the AL)...Have averaged 1.37 HR/road game, 3rd best in the AL.

BLUE JAYS vs. THE ATHLETICS:

All-Time: 195-221...All-Time, On The Road: 99-109...2018: 0-4

- The Blue Jays were swept by the A's in a four-game series the last time they met, back at Rogers Centre in May...Were out-scored, 27-12 in that set...Have gone 4-9 in Oakland since the start of 2014 (1-2 last year) while going 12-5 at home.
- Kendrys Morales leads all current Blue Jays with 22 career home runs and 61 RBI vs. Oakland...Has gone 23-for-83 (.277) with 3-2B, 4-HR and 11-RBI in 22 games against them since 2015 (.806 OPS).
- Yangervis Solarte went 7-for-18 (.389) in the 4G series earlier against the A's earlier this year, including a pair of doubles, a home run and four RBI...Has hits in each of his last five games against them, dating back to 2015 (8-for-22, .364 AVG).
- Justin Smoak has gone 20-for-74 (.270) vs. OAK over the last four seasons, with 2-2B, 6-HR, 14-RBI and 14BB/19K across 22 games (.541 SLG, .927 OPS).

DIAZ HITS NUMERO DIEZ:

- Aledmys Diaz got the Jays on the board yesterday with a solo shot in the 5th inning...Marked his 10th home run of the season, 7th most among AL shortstops...Was his 3rd HR this year vs. CWS...Eight of his home runs have been solo homers.
- Diaz also doubled in the 9th...Has hit .281 (41-for-146) with 9-2B, 4-HR and 15-RBI over 43G since his DL stint (.216 AVG prior).

DRURY DRIVES IN A PAIR:

- Brandon Drury drove in two runs with a 9th-inning double, giving Toronto a 5-3 lead yesterday...Marked his 1st XBH and RBI as a Blue Jay...Has gone 2-for-8 with three runs scored in three games so far for Toronto.

MAILE'S NEW MARKS:

- Luke Maile doubled, walked and drove in a run yesterday...The double was his 8th this season, giving him a new career high (7 in 2016)...Has also set personal bests this year in games (50), runs (20), hits (89), walks (19) and RBI (24).

A QUALITY KID:

- Ryan Borucki threw 6.0 innings of two-run ball yesterday...Has thrown five quality starts in his first six MLB games...Is yet to allow a home run over 35.0 innings of work, the 4th longest active homerless streak among all MLB starters...Recorded five strikeouts while issuing a lone walk...Has 28 strikeouts so far, tied for 3rd most all-time by a Blue Jay through their first six MLB games, while his 2.83 ERA is 3rd best (Chacin - 2.54, Guzman - 2.62).

WEARING OUT WELCOME MATS:

- The Jays recorded eight home runs over their three games in Chicago, tied for their most in a 3G set this year (8HR vs. WAS)...Have recorded 31 HR since July 3, tied for 3rd most in the AL over that span (LAA-32, OAK-32)...In that time, have hit 17 HR in just nine road games for an average of 1.89 HR/G, the highest in the Majors (2nd: PIT - 1.88).

TRADING POST:

- Prior to tonight's contest, the Blue Jays acquired RHP Ken Giles, RHP David Paulino and minor-league RHP Hector Perez from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP Roberto Osuna.

TONIGHT'S START:

- ✦ Making his 18th start of the season...Was reinstated today from the today after being placed on the 10-day DL retroactive to 7/10 with a left glute strain...He also exited his rehab start with Triple-A Buffalo on 7/24 due to a right middle finger blister and was listed as day-to-day...In his last MLB start, on 7/3 vs NYM, he lasted only a third of an inning (1H, 1BB, 1K, 1HR) before exiting the game with left hip soreness.

2018 HIGHLIGHTS:

- ✦ His .52 ground ball to fly ball ratio (73:141) is the lowest in the Majors (T-2nd: Verlander - .63, Odorizzi - .63).
- ✦ Has thrown his changeup to record 43.1% (106/246) of his strikeouts since the start of last season, the 2nd highest rate among all starting pitchers (Hendricks - 54.9%).
- ✦ His .229 opponents' average since 2015 ranks 5th in the AL (Verlander -.213, Kluber -.215, Sale -.215, Severino -.227).
- ✦ Has allowed 50 XBH, T-9th most in the Majors.
- ✦ Broke a streak of 4 consecutive quality starts on 6/27 at HOU where he tied a season low of 1 strikeout over 5.0IP (3ER, 7H).
- ✦ Gave up just 1 hit through 5.2 innings on 6/16 vs. WAS and allowed a season-best 3 hits over 6.2 scoreless frames (2BB, 4K)...Threw a season-high 109 pitches (76 strikes)...Was his longest scoreless start since 9/5/17 at BOS (7.0 IP)...Won consecutive starts for the first time this year.
- ✦ Earned his 1st win at home on 6/10 vs. BAL while recording a season-high 9 strikeouts.
- ✦ Lost 5 consecutive decisions from 4/26 to 5/29, matching the longest skid of his career (4th time, last: 6/1-8/5/17).
- ✦ On 5/18 vs. OAK, recorded his first start without a walk since 9/11/17 vs. BAL (5.0 IP).
- ✦ Became the 20th pitcher in franchise history to record 500 SO when he fanned Matt Duffy to end the 1st inning on 5/6 vs TB.
- ✦ Recorded his 1,000th career strikeout when he fanned Mitch Moreland to begin the 2nd inning on 4/26 vs BOS...Is one of 53 active pitchers to reach this milestone.
- ✦ Allowed 3HR on 4/20 at NYY, his most allowed since 4/9/17 at TB (3HR)...Marked his 2nd career win when allowing at least 3HR.
- ✦ Went 7.0 innings in his first outing (3/31 vs. NYY), allowing 3 runs on 4 hits for Toronto's first quality start of 2018.

VS. THE ATHLETICS:

- ✦ Lost his other outing against the A's this season, despite a quality start (6.2 IP, 3ER, 0BB, 6K)...Has only made 1 start at Oakland Coliseum where he took the loss after allowing 7H and 4ER over 5.2IP (1BB, 8K)...Is winless in his 4 career starts against the Athletics while (0-3) while holding a 5.91 ERA
