THE LATEST:

- Last night, the Blue Jays lost the opener of their three-game series with the Athletics by a score of 10-1...Was their largest margin of defeat since a 12-2 loss to the Mets on May 15...Are now 20-16 in series openers, having dropped two of their last three.
- The Jays are now 9-14 in July but have won 18 of their last 37 games, as well as 22 of their last 44...Are now 4.5 games back of the Rays and have dropped to a new season mark of 25.5 games behind the division-leading Red Sox...Have not been further back since the end of the 2009 campaign, finishing 28.0 games back of the Yankees.

JUMPING ON IT:

- Aledmys Diaz was responsible for the Jays' only run last night, hitting a solo home run in the 9th inning...Was his 9th solo HR and his 7th road HR...Has homered in back-to-back games for the 4th time this season (last: May 3(Game 2)-4 at CLE), doing so in 76 games...Had not homered in consecutive games in any of his 190 career contests prior to joining the Blue Jays.
- Diaz notched his 11th home run on the first pitch of the at-bat, his 4th such HR this year...Has had 59 of his 266 plate appearances last only one pitch...The 22.2% clip is the highest among all qualified batters (MLB avg: 10.7%).

THIS AND THAT:

- Last night marked the 7th time this season that Toronto pitchers have allowed 10 runs or more (T-9th most in the AL), but have done so twice in the last five games (also July 25 vs. MIN 12R)...Recorded three strikeouts to match a season-low for the 3rd time (also April 29 at NYY and June 8 vs. BAL).
- Blue Jay batters have now scored one-or-less runs 18 times (T-8th most in the AL)...Doubled twice last night and have doubled in 14 consecutive games (30-2B), one shy of their longest such stretch this year (15G from April 22- May 6).

LEADING MAN:

Curtis Granderson walked to start last night's game and then doubled in his next at-bat...Upped his OBP to .337, his best since 2015 (.364)... Among AL leadoff batters this season, leads in pitches/PA (4.39) while ranking 5th in SLG (.456), 6th in OPS (.804) and 7th in OBP (.348).

LEFT COAST LIFESTYLE:

- This afternoon marks the 5th game of Toronto's longest road trip of the season, playing 10 games in a 10-day span...After this three-game series in Oakland, will complete the trip with four dates in Seattle (63-43).
- ◆The Jays are 2-2 on the current road trip...Have gone 4-8 in their last 12 road games and are 8-18 since May 29...Have an overall road record of 21-29...The .420 win% ranks 10th among AL clubs...Have been outscored, 268-226, and out-hit, 469-406, during away contests...Have averaged 4.52 runs/game on the road (7th highest in the AL) while allowing 5.36 R/G (13th in the AL)...Have averaged 1.36 HR/road game, 4th best in the AL.

BLUE JAYS vs. THE ATHLETICS:

- The Blue Jays were swept by the A's in a four-game series the last time they met, back at Rogers Centre in May...Have gone 4-10 in Oakland since the start of 2014 while going 12-5 at home...Have been out-scored, 37-13, while losing all five games vs. the Athletics this year, their longest streak against them since Aug. 29, 2007-May 27, 2008 (5G)...Last had a longer skid vs. OAK from Aug. 18, 1998-Aug. 15, 1999 (7G).
- Kendrys Morales leads all current Blue Jays with 22 career home runs and 61 RBI vs. Oakland...Has gone 23-for-86 (.267) with 3-2B, 4-HR and 11-RBI in 23 games against them since 2015 (.786 OPS).
- Yangervis Solarte went 7-for-18 (.389) in the 4G series earlier against the A's earlier this year, including a pair of doubles, a home run and four RBI...Has hits in each of his last six games against them, dating back to 2015 (9-for-26, .346 AVG).
- Justin Smoak has gone 20-for-74 (.270) vs. OAK over the last four seasons, with 2-2B, 6-HR, 14-RBI and 14BB/19K across 22 games (.541 SLG, .927 OPS).

A KEEN EYE:

- Russell Martin started at third base last night for the 5th time this season... Walked in his first at-bat and doubled in the 5th inning...Has had four of his last five hits go for extras (2-2B, 2-HR)...Has gone 12-for-46 (.261) with 2-2B, 2-HR, 4-RBI and 7-BB over his last 14 games (.793 OPS).
- ◆Martin's walk was his 45th this season (70G), five shy of last year's total (91G)...Has chased just 10.0% of pitches outside of the strike zone, the best rate among all MLB batters.

LATE TEE TIMES:

♦ With last night's late blast, the Blue Jays have now hit 16 home runs in the 9th inning and extras, 3rd most in the AL (NYY-18, OAK-18)...Have now plated 42 runs in the 9th inning, 4th most in the AL (OAK leads with 53)...Toronto's 57 runs scored in the 9th or later are tied for 3rd in the AL (OAK-69, TB-59, TEX-57).

NOT SO WILD ABOUT THE WEST:

◆The Jays are now 8-16 against AL West clubs this season...The .333 win% ranks 12th among AL teams and is tied for their 2nd lowest in a season all-time (.333 in 2002, .319 in 1977).

WEARING OUT WELCOME MATS:

◆The Blue Jays have recorded nine home runs over the first four games of this road trip...Have recorded 32 HR since July 3, tied with three teams for 2nd most in the Majors over that span (OAK-34)...In that time, have hit 18 HR in 10 road games for an average of 1.80 HR/G, the highest in the AL (2nd: CLE - 1.78).

TRADING POST:

- Earler today, the Blue Jays acquired RHP Jacob Waguespack from the Phillies in exchange for LHP Aaron Loup...Waguespack is 24 and went 1-1 with a 3.99 ERA for AA Reading this year (7GS), and 3-5 with a 5.06 ERA for AAA Lehigh Valley (14G, 8GS).
- The Jays also traded RHP John Axford to the Dogders in exhange for RHP Corey Copping...The 24 year old is 3-0 with a 2.53 ERA for AA Tulsa (30G) and 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA for AAA Oklahoma City (5G).

TONIGHT'S START:

Making his 14th start of the season...Coming off a no decision on 7/25 vs. MIN, allowing 3 runs on 6 hits over 5.0 innings (3BB, 4K)... Making his 2nd start against the Athletics this season and his 1st at Oakland Coliseum.

2018 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Is 1-0 with a 2.82 ERA (14 ER/44.2 IP) at home and 1-3 with an 7.92 ERA on the road.
- Ranks 5th in the AL in first-pitch strike percentage at 67.4% (Severino 70.7, Hardy 69.3, Sale 68.4, Tanaka 68.1).
- Set career-highs with 8 strikeouts and 7.2 innings pitched vs BAL on 7/20...Threw 103 pitches, including a career-best 71 strikes while allowing 4 runs on 7 hits.
- Made a start on 2 days rest for the 1st time at BOS on 7/14 where he allowed 1 run on 4 hits across 3.1 innings (1BB/2K).
- Allowed a season-high 6ER on 7/11 at ATL...Marked his shortest outing as a starter (1.2 innings) and his only start without recording a strikeout.
- After allowing 2 runs (1 earned) vs. NYY on 7/6, held a 1.95 ERA (6 ER/27.2 IP) over his first five home starts as a Blue Jay - the best all-time (2nd: Price - 1.98, 3rd: Candiotti - 2.16).
- Placed on the paternity list on 6/19 and reinstated on 6/22...Sam and his wife, Alaina, welcomed their first child, Livia, on June 19.
- Went 3.1 IP on 6/11 at TB, the shortest of his 18 career starts in the Majors...The only other time he failed to go at least 5 IP as a starter was 7/6/17 vs. OAK (4.2 IP, with SEA)...His 7 hits allowed tied a season high (also 5/30 at BOS) and his 5 runs were his most since 7/18/17 at HOU (5, with SEA).
- Threw 7.0 scoreless innings on 6/6 vs NYY (3H, 3BB, 4K)...The 7.0 IP were a career high (6.1 on 7/1/17 at LAA), as were his 104 pitches (102 on 6/9/17 vs. TOR)...Had thrown 12.1 scoreless innings across his first 2 starts at home.
- On 5/25 at PHI, threw his 1st quality start as a Blue Jay...Hit his 1st extra-base hit a double in the 2nd inning...Marked the 1st extra-base hit by a Blue Jays pitcher since 5/18/17 at ATL, when Marcus Stroman homered...Became the 9th Blue Jays pitcher all-time to record an extra-base hit.
- Made his 1st start for the Blue Jays on 5/19 vs. OAK where he threw 5.1 scoreless innings.
