### THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY - AUG. 17

**2008** - The Astros retire the number 7, worn by **Craig Biggio** from 1989-2007, in a pregame ceremony.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The defending World Series Champion Houston Astros begin a crucial nine-game AL West road trip tonight with the first of three against the A's at Oakland Coliseum...2018 All-Star **RHP Charlie Morton** (12-3) will take the hill for the Astros opposite **RHP Edwin Jackson** (4-2) and the Athletics.

**THE RACE IS ON!** The AL West race is in full swing as the Astros enter tonight with a 2.0-game lead in the division over the A's...the two club's will match up six times to close out the regular season: this three-game series in Oakland, and a three-game series in Houston later this month from Aug. 27-29.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Astros embark on this 10-day, nine-game road trip as the top road team in the Majors Leagues, as their 41-18 (.695) road record is the best in baseball...the Astros are making a run at the best single-season road winning percentage in Major League history, as their current record ranks fourth all-time behind only the 1939 Yankees (54-20, .730), 2001 Mariners (59-22, .728) and 1933 Senators (53-23, .697).

**DOWN BY THE BAY:** The Astros have gone undefeated in six games at Oakland Coliseum this season, as they swept consecutive three-game series at the venue from May 7-9 and June 12-14...this six-game winning streak at Oakland Coliseum is the Astros second-longest in franchise history, behind a 10-game streak they posted at the venue from July 20, 2016-June 22, 2017.

**GOING BACK TO CALI:** The Astros have been at their best in the state of California this season, as they have gone 14-3 (.824) in 17 games in The Golden State...this includes games against the A's (6-0), Angels (4-2), Dodgers (2-1) and Giants (2-0).

**WEDNESDAY'S WIN:** The Astros emphatically ended their five-game losing skid, and nine-game losing streak at Minute Maid Park with a 12-1 thumping of the Rockies...**DH Evan Gattis** (3x4, 2HR, 2RBI) and **1B Tyler White** (2x4, 2HR, 4RBI) both had multi-homer games...**RHP Gerrit Cole** (1ER/6IP) struck out 12 batters in what was his MLB-leading seventh game of the season with at least 11 strikeouts...**SS Carlos Correa** (1x3, 3RBI) hit a bases-clearing double, his first extra-base hit since coming off the Disabled List.

**DROPPING THE HAMMER:** In Wednesday's win, the Astros set a single-game season high for home runs (5) and tied a season-high for extra-base hits (9, also Aug. 4 at LAD)...also tied their season-high for runs scored at home (also July 7 vs. CWS).

**COLE TRAIN:** **RHP Gerrit Cole's** 12 strikeouts on Wednesday put him into a tie with **LHP Chris Sale** for the most strikeouts in the American League (219)...Cole's 219 strikeouts have already tied him for the 10th-most in a single season in club history with **RHP Darryl Kile** (1996)...the last Astros pitcher with more strikeouts was **RHP Nolan Ryan**, who struck out 228 batters in 1988.

**TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE:** The Astros have activated **OF George Springer** (left thumb sprain) from the 10-day DL...**OF Derek Fisher** was optioned to Triple A Fresno following Wednesday's game vs. COL.

**MORE GOOD NEWS:** **C Brian McCann**, who underwent arthroscopic surgery on his right knee on July 3, began an injury rehab assignment with Triple A Fresno last night and went 1x4 with a walk and a run scored in a start at DH...McCann joined **RHP Chris Devenski** (left hamstring tightness) who is also serving an injury rehab assignment at Fresno...Devenski has made one scoreless appearance thus far on his assignment.

**INJURY REPORT:** The Astros extensive injury report got considerably lighter with today's activation of **OF George Springer** (left thumb sprain) and last week's activation of **SS Carlos Correa** (lower back soreness)...Houston's injury report still includes **OF Jake Marisnick** (left groin discomfort) and four former All-Stars in **2B Jose Altuve** (right knee soreness), **RHP Chris Devenski** (left hamstring tightness), **C Brian McCann** (right knee discomfort) and **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (right elbow discomfort).

**STEPPING UP:** Since **2B Jose Altuve** was placed on the DL on July 29, the Astros have gone 7-8 in 15 games...since that date, **IF Marwin Gonzalez** has hit .302 (16x53) with two doubles and four home runs, while **IF Tyler White** has hit .333 (15x45) with two doubles, a triple, four home runs, 12 RBI and a 1.156 OPS.

**FIVE GUYS:** The Astros have only used five starting pitchers this season, the fewest in the Majors, and two less than their closest counterparts, the Rockies (7) and Indians (7)...the Astros rotation has posted the best ERA (3.06) and WHIP (1.09) and the most strikeouts (860) in the Majors this season.

**FEEL THE BREEZE:** Astros starters have posted 25 double-digit strikeout games this season, a new club record (previously 24 in 1969)...also ties the second-most double-digit strikeout games by a team in AL history (last, 2017 Indians)...the Astros are seven shy of the AL record of 32, set by the 1973 Angels.

**MEDIA WALL OF HONOR:** The Astros have opened up a call for nominations for the 2018 inductee to the Houston Baseball Media Wall of Honor...nominations can be made by season-credentialed media only and are due today...following the nomination process, a formal ballot will be distributed to the media.

**RBI WORLD SERIES:** The Astros RBI softball team won the 2018 RBI World Series softball championship yesterday in Minnesota, defeating the Rays RBI Tampa team, 9-1...it marked the first-ever softball championship for the Astros RBI team in what was their 45th tournament appearance...was Houston's second-overall championship (2010 - Seniors Baseball).

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY:** The Astros would like to wish a belated Happy Birthday to **C Martín Maldonado**, who celebrated his 32nd birthday yesterday on the Astros offday.

**LAST START - 8/11 VS. SEA:** got just his 3rd loss of the season in Houston's 3-2 loss against the Mariners...gave up 3 runs on 7 hits in 6.0 innings pitched...struck out 4 with 1 walk.

• still leads the American League in winning percentage, (12-3, .800).  
**CHARLES IN CHARGE:** 34-year-old with a turbo-charged fastball is in the midst of the best season of his career...was named to his 1st career **All-Star Team** this year in what is his 11th season in the Majors.

• has set a single-season career-high for strikeouts...is 2 wins shy of tying his single-season career-high for wins (14, set in 2017).

**CY MORTON:** T-2nd in the Major Leagues in winning percentage (.800)... among AL pitchers, ranks 6th in strikeouts per 9.0 innings (11.21), T-7th in wins, 7th in strikeouts and 7th in ERA.

• has 6 double-digit strikeout games this season (10 in his career)...prior to joining the Astros, had just 1 double-digit strikeout game in his career (6/25/14).

**VS. OAK:** will be making is 4th-career start against Oakland and 2nd of the season...in his career is 1-1 with a 4.96 ERA (9ER/16.1IP), with 25 strikeouts and 5 walks.

**HAPPY IN HOUSTON:** is in the 2nd year of a 2-year contract signed with the Astros, and has been one of the best pitchers in the AL since signing with the club.

• has gone 26-10 with a 3.26 ERA (112ER/284IP) and 334 strikeouts in 48 starts with the Astros since the beginning of the 2017 season...in that span, ranks 6th in the AL in groundball rate (51.1%), T-6th in wins (26), 7th in opponent batting average (.219), 7th in strikeouts per 9.0 innings (10.58) and 11th in ERA (3.26).

**CHUCK IN THE ASG:** the **2018 AL All-Star** pitched 2.0 innings in the 2018 All-Star Game...allowed 2 runs on 2 hits across the 7th-8th innings...walked 1 with 2 strikeouts.

• set career bests prior to the ASG of a season in the following categories: wins (11), strikeouts (146), ERA (2.96).  
 • became the 4th Astros pitcher to win 11+ games prior to the All-Star Game of a season dating back to 2000, joining **Dallas Keuchel** (11-4 in 2015), **Roy Oswalt** (12-7 in 2005) and **Wade Miller** (11-3 in 2001).

**BRINGING THE HEAT:** formerly a low 90's sinkerballer, has developed into one of the hardest-throwing starting pitchers in the game...has posted an average fastball velocity of 95.9 miles per hour this year, which ranks 4th among MLB starters behind **Luis Severino** (97.7), **Mike Foltynewicz** (96.5) and teammate **Gerrit Cole** (96.5).

**LIGHTS OUT VS. LEFTIES:** his breakout with the Astros has been sparked by a newfound dominance over left-handed hitters...has held lefties to a .211 opponent batting average (48x227) in 2018...in 2017 he held them to a .175 batting average (44x252) and a .561 OPS.

• has struck out 37.5% of all left-handed hitters he has faced, the 4th-best mark among MLB starters behind **Gerrit Cole** (41.4%), **Chris Sale** (40.0%) and **Justin Verlander** (38.3%).  
 • over the last 2 seasons, his combined .192 (92x479) opponent batting average vs. left-handed hitters ranks 5th among MLB starters.  
 • prior to joining the Astros in 2017, had allowed left-handed hitters to bat .307 (493x1607) with an .859 OPS against him in his career.

**UNCLE CHARLIE:** his curveball has been a huge weapon...has given up just 22 hits on his curveball this season (.132, 22x167).

• has recorded a whiff on 48.0% of all swings against his curveball, the 2nd-highest mark in the Majors behind **Blake Snell** (49.7%).
