**DOUBLE BAGEL:** The Rangers have been shut out in consecutive games to open this trip, 1st time to be blanked in 2 straight since 8/13-14/16 vs. DET...last road instance was 9/9-10/15 at SEA...Texas had not been shut out in 2 straight to begin a series since 9/18-19/92 at TOR against the eventual World Series champs.

• The Rangers' 5 hits in this series match fewest in any 2-G span for TEX since the start of 1993...other 2 instances were 9/9-10/15 at SEA and 4/18-19/07 at CWS, with the 1st game of the '07 span being a Mark Buehrle no-hitter.

START ME UP: Oakland starters Mike Fiers and Brett Anderson have both posted 7.0 SHO IP while allowing one hit in their starts against the Rangers this week...including Sunday's effort by LAA's Jaime Barria, starting pitchers have a 0.47 ERA (1 ER/19.0 IP) vs. TEX over the last 3 G.

FACEBOOK GAME: The video broadcast of today's game will be featured exclusively on Facebook Watch, with the game produced by the MLB Network...former Rangers outfielder Gary Matthews, Jr. will be part of the broadcast team with play-by-play announcer Rich Waltz, co-analyst Dallas Braden, and social media reporter Guy Haberman...only 3 MLB clubs have more FB appearances in 2018 than the Rangers' 3 such games: MIL, PHI, SEA (4 each).

• Rangers are 2-0 in Facebooks games this season, wins on 5/16 at SEA (5-1) and 8/8 vs. SEA (11-7).

HERE COMES THE SUN: Texas is scheduled to play day tilts for 3 of the final 4 games on this road trip...the Rangers are 15-21 in day games this season, winning 4 of 7...club is 7-12 in road day contests, just 4-11 in last 15...entering today, the only MLB clubs with fewer day games than the Rangers (36) are BOS and LAD (35 each).

· Adrián Beltré leads the Rangers with a .370 (27-73) average in day games this season...Joey Gallo's team-best 8 HR in day tilts are 3 more than next-closest Ranger (5-Nomar Marzara)...Gallo in 5 day games in August: .389 (7-18), 2 HR, 22B, 5RBI, 4BB.

LECLERC OF LATE: Jose Leclerc has posted 10.0 SHO IP over his last 10 appearances, and he owns a 0.83 ERA (2 ER/21.2 IP) in his last 22 outings...in his last 8 G beg. 7/30, opponents have gone 2-for-26 with one BB and 15 SO, as he has whiffed 15 of 27 (55.6%) BF in that span while converting

all 5 save chances and finishing 6 TEX wins.
• Leclerc's is T2nd in A.L. with 5 August saves (8-E. Diaz).

CAN'T FIGHT THE YOUTH: The Rangers have 98 HR by players in their age 25-or-younger season (age as of 6/30) in 2018...the MLB-leading figure is also the 2nd-highest total in Rangers history, trailing only 104 HR in 2017...last year's 104 HR by age-25-or-younger season players for the Rangers ranked T2nd in MLB to the Cubs' 149.

SHORTS: The Rangers' season-best 10-G errorless streak ended last night with Jurickson Profar's throwing error in the 2nd inning...Joe Palumbo is scheduled to make his Double-A debut tonight with Frisco at San Antonio (7:05 p.m. CT)... the Rangers' rotation has 104 starts of 5.0+ innings, 4th-most in MLB to HOU (114), CLE (112), and ARI (107)...scoreless drought for the offense entering today is 19 innings...Ronald Guzmán has 2 of the 3 BB for TEX batters in this series... after having hits w/ RISP in 1st 17 G in Aug., TEX is 0-for-11 w/ RISP in this series

### SHIN-SOO CHOO had the Rangers' lone extra-base hit last night, his 28th double of the year...over his last 12 games, Choo is batting .405 (17-42) w/ 6 BB and 2 HBP to raise his season BA from .270 to .283, reaching safely in all 12 G...11

### WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers lost to the A's last night, 6-0, and team has a 0-2 record to open this 6-game, 7-day road trip to the Bay Area against OAK (0-1) and SF (3 G) with an off day on Thursday...team went 4-2 on homestand that preceded this trip...Texas has lost 2 straight, 3 of 4, 6 of 10, and 9 of last 16 G...team is 10-9 in last 19 G. and club's 14-10 (.583) record since 7/27 is T7th-best in MLB and T4th-best in A.L. to CLE (.750, 18-6), BOS (.739, 17-6), and OAK (.682, 15-7)...have lost 21 of 37 and 23 of last 40 G, the longer span beginning 7/6...team is 29-28 beginning 6/16 • The Rangers are 10-9 (.526) in August, T7th-best record in the A.L...the 10 August wins have surpassed last month's

- total, as 8-17 (.320) record in July marked lowest win pct. in A.L. and 2nd-lowest in MLB (SD: 5-20, .200)...at 15-16 (.484) since the AS break, TEX owns 7th-best record in the A.L., as just 6 of the 15 teams in the league have a record above .500 in the 2nd 'half'
- At 56-72 (.438), Rangers are 11th in the A.L. in winning percentage...the 56 wins are fewest for Texas after 128 G since 2014 (49-79) and 2nd-fewest for club since start of 2008.
- Texas has been under the .500 mark since a season best 1-1 on 3/30...club currently sits 16-under and high point since the break is 14-under...team has gone 0-6 in last 6 chances to reach 13-under...team was season-high 20 G under .500 at 42-62 on 7/26...TEX won season-high 7 straight from 6/16-23, preceded by longest losing skid at 7 G, 6/7-15.

SERIES STUFF: After ensuring a loss in this series, Rangers are now 4-2-2 in last 8 series after having gone 0-5-1 in previous 6 series...Texas needs a win today to avoid going winless in a series for a 7th time...the current 6: 4/9-11 vs. LAA (3), 6/7-10 vs. HOU (4), 6/12-13 at LAD (2), 7/3-4 vs. HOU (2), 7/9-11 at BOS (3), and 7/23-26 vs. OAK (4).

**IN THE STANDINGS:** Rangers have been between 21.0 and 23.0 games back in the A.L. West for 21 of the last 25 days, including 20 straight from 7/28-8/16...Rangers had been 20.0 GB for 4 straight days before last night's loss, currently 21.0 GB of OAK/HOU in the A.L. West...there are 6 MLB teams with larger division deficits than Texas, including BAL's MLB-high 50.5-game deficit in the A.L. East...season high deficit of 25.0 G on 7/26...club has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 134 days and in either 4th or 5th place

ON THE ROAD: Texas is 27-34 (.443) away from Arlington this season, 8th-best winning percentage in A.L...club has dropped 3 straight and 6 of 7, going 5-6 in last 11, 6-8 in last

### **TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER**

### #36 Mike Minor, LHP (9-6, 4.61)

TONIGHT: The 30-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 23rd start of the season in tonight's series finale against the A's...was originally slated to start on Friday against the Angels in Arlington, but was scratched due to back stiffness...has gone 3-0 with a 3.42 ERA (9 ER/23.2 IP) in last 4 outings, winning season-high 3 straight...last worked and earned the win in the Rangers' 12-7 victory on 8/10 at NYY...since beginning of June, is 5-2, 3.53 (25 ER/63.2 IP) in 11 G/GS to lower season ERA from 5.76 to 4.61...during that span, ranks among A.L. leaders (min. 11 GS) in WHIP (2nd, 0.99), opp. OPS (7th, .642), and opp. average (7th, 2.14)...has issued multiple walks just once in last 6 starts, and his 1.98 BB/9 rate ranks 9th in the A.L. (min. 22 GS)...with 123.0 IP this season, has already surpassed innings total from 2017 (77.2) when he worked as a reliever for Kansas City...has produced his highest inning total since 145.1 IP with the Braves in 2014...is in his 1st season as a starting pitcher since 2014 (w/ ATL), also his 1st season with the Rangers after signing a 3-year contract on 12/6/17... did not make ML appearance in 2015-16 following surgery for a torn labrum in his left shoulder on 5/13/15...was 38-36, 4.10 in 111 games/110 starts for ATL from 2010-14...from the 2012 All-Star break through 2014 season, ranked 11th in N.L with a 3.52 ERA (min. 70 starts)...was selected by the Braves as the 7th overall selection in the 2009 June draft out of Vanderbilt University...has a team-high 9 wins and Rangers are 11-11 in Minor's 22 starts.

MAJOR MINOR: Has won 3 consecutive starts for the 1st time since winning 5 in a row from 9/16/12-4/10/13 with Atlanta...matches his longest win streak of 2018 (including NDs), as he also had a 3-G streak spanning 5 starts from 4/7-5/3...win tonight would match Yovani Gallardo (4 straight from 7/22-8/8) for longest win streak by a Rangers pitcher this season.

LAST START: Earned the win in the Rangers' 12-7 victory on Friday at NYY (5.2 IP, 6 H, 4 R-ER, 1 BB, 2 SO, 1 HR, 84 pitches/55 strikes)...retired 1st 7 batters faced and allowed just one baserunner to reach scoring position prior to the 6th... was one out from recording QS, as he exited leading 9-4 following Luke Voit's 2-run single with 2 outs in the 6th...the win was highlighted by a 3-homer game from Ronald Guzmán, who became the 1st Rangers rookie to ever pull the trick.

VS. OAKLAND: Has gone 1-1 with a 3.68 ERA (6 ER/14.2 IP) in 5 G/2 GS career vs. the A's...took ND in Rangers' 13-10 loss in 10 innings on 7/24 vs. OAK (5.0 IP, 2 R-ER), a game Texas led by 8 runs at one point...prior to that outing, had not started against A's since 8/17/14 w/ ATL (7.0 IP, 2 R-ER), a 4-3 Braves win at Turner Field...is 0-1, 10.80 (2 ER/1.2 IP) in 2 G/0 GS career at Oakland Coliseum, both outings in relief last season w/ KC.

ON THE ROAD: Is 4-4 with a 6.48 ERA (36 ER/50.0 IP) in 10 G/GS away from Arlington this season, but has won 2 straight at 2-0, 4.63 (6 ER/11.2 IP) with 2 BB/10 SO and .227/.255/.409/.664 opponent slash line...last 2 wins came against HOU and NYY...overall road ERA is over 3 runs higher than his home figure (3.33) opp. are batting .285/.327/.515/.842 on the road compared to .220/.269/.429/.698 in Arlington...HR total on the road (8) is lower than GLPIA (12).

2018: Texas is 11-11 in his 22 starts...has permitted 4-or-fewer hits in 6 of last 9 starts...has 2-or-fewer walks in 20 of 22 outings, 2nd-most such starts on staff (Colon-23)...has surrendered 1.46 HR/9, 9th-highest rate in the A.L. (min. 100 IP)...has allowed just one HR in last 2 GS after 7 HR over 5 GS/25.0 IP in July... has still given up 18 HR in his last 17 GS after only allowing just 2 HR in his first 5 GS...had 6 hit batters over 1st 8 starts, none in last 14 starts...batters leading off innings have hit .256 (30-117) with 7 BB and 3 HBP...bottom 3 spots in the lineup are a combined 24-for-132 (.182) w/ .581 OPS...opponents batting .200 (28-140) with 2 outs in an inning...opposing batters w/ RISP are 22-for-96 (.229)...opponents by plate appearance vs. Minor: 1st PA (.215, 40-186), 2nd PA (.258, 46-178), 3rd PA (.300, 30-100), 4th PA (0-4)...Chirinos has caught 11 starts (4-3, 4.68), Kiner-Falefa (3-1, 3.95) has caught 5 starts, Centeno 3 starts (2-0, 5.29), Pérez 2 starts (0-2, 6.00), and Trevino caught start on 6/16 (0-0, 2.57)...win on 4/7 vs. TOR was 1st victory as a starter since 8/28/14 w/ ATL...has allowed 3 HR to LH batters in '18 (Moustakas-5/25 vs. KC, Reddick-7/4 vs. HOU, Gardner-8/10 at NYY), 1st HRs by LH batter since he was with ATL on 7/1/14 vs. NYM (Daniel Murphy in the 5th inning at Turner Field)...took a perfect game into the 7th on 6/27 vs. SD, as game score of 80 (Bill James formula) matched the highest of his career (also w/ ATL on 5/25/13 at NYM)...was 2nd-deepest perfect game effort by a Ranger in '18, as Bartolo Colon retired 1st 21 Astros on 4/15 at HOU...posted QS in 5 straight starts from 6/9-7/4, longest QS streak since 6 in a row w/ ATL from 8/12-9/8/14...had a team-leading 6 wins at the All-Star break, marking just the 4th season in club history to not have a pitcher with 7+ wins at the All-Star break: also 1973, 2007, and 2017, when Yu Darvish topped the staff with 6 victories.

JUNE JAM: In June, made quality starts in all 4 outings, going 2-0, 2.08 (6 ER/26.0 IP) in 4 G/GS w/ .170/.213/.261/.474 opp. slash line...among MLB pitchers w/ 25.0+ IP in June, Minor's opp. OPS (.474) and WHIP (0.77) figures were 2nd to only BOS' Chris Sale (.422/0.76)...Minor's 0.77 WHIP was lowest in a single month by a TEX pitcher (min. 90 BF) since Yu Darvish (0.74) in Sept. 2012... ranked among A.L. June leaders (min. 25.0 IP) in opp. BA (4th) and ERA (8th).
