THE TWINS: The Twins returned from their short two-game roadtrip in Chicago with a split with the White Sox, winning the first of the two...tonight they will begin a four-game series with Oakland from Thursday-Sunday.

TWINS DROP GAME 2 WITH SOX: The Twins lost to the White Sox yesterday afternoon at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 7-3...Kyle Gibson (7-10) was the starter and loser, allowing seven runs (4 earned) on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded seven hits, three coming from Logan Forsythe...Jorge Polanco hit his third home run of the season, a two-run shot in the first inning.

TWINS AND A'S: The Twins went 3-3 against the A's last season...they went 2-1 at Target Field May 2-4 and 1-2 at the Coliseum July 28-30...they have gone 5-3 in their last eight vs. Oakland, out-scoring the A's 51-31 in that span.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .315 (94-for-298) with 41 walks and a .398 on-base percentage in 83 career games against the A's.

☞ Twins pitching coach Garvin Alston served as Oakland's bullpen coach in 2017...he also served as a coach in the A's system from 2005-15, holding various titles.

MINNESOTA'S GREATEST HITS: Joe Mauer enters today with 2,084 career hits, third most in club history (since 1961), behind Hall of Famers Kirby Puckett and Rod Carew...he needs one to tie Carew for second:

LOGAN LOVIN' 'SOTA: Logan Forsythe is hitting .377 (26-for-69) with four doubles, nine RBI, six walks and a .434 on-base percentage in 19 games since being traded to Minnesota from Los Angeles-NL on July 31 (for Brian Dozier)...in that span, he has reached safely in 15 of 19 games...among AL players this month, he ranks second in batting average (.377), trailing only J.D. Martinez (.384)...additionally, he ranks tied for fifth in hits (26).

FEELING MINNESOTA: The Twins have gone 38-26 at home this season, compared to 22-40 on the road...they have gone 19-6 at Target Field since June 24, including wins in eight of their last 10...since that date, they are tied with Oakland for third most home wins in baseball, trailing Boston (21-6) and Tampa Bay (20-8).

2019: The Twins announced their preliminary regular season schedule for the 2019 season, the 59th campaign in Twins Territory...Minnesota will open the season at home against Cleveland on March 28 in their 10th season at Target Field...the Twins will play 20 Interleague games...the home Interleague schedule includes series' against Milwaukee (May 27-28), New York (July 16-17), Atlanta (August 5-7), and Washington (September 10-12)...in addition, the Twins will make Interleague roadtrips to Philadelphia (April 5-7), New York (April 9-10), Miami (July 30-August 1) and Milwaukee (August 13-14)...the 2019 schedule features three home games in the month of March, 12 in April, 13 in May, 12 in June, 12 in July, 16 in August and 13 in September...additionally, during the months of April, May (prior to Memorial Day) and September, the Twins have moved weekday (Monday-Thursday) night games to a 6:40 pm start.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1977, Dave Goltz one-hits the Red Sox to give the Twins a 7-0 win, Jim Rice was the only Red Sox player to record a hit...in 2001, in a 6-2 loss to the Blue Jays, Torii Hunter throws out consecutive runners Darrin Fletcher and Homer Bush, both trying to stretch singles...in 2009, Michael Cuddyer hits two home runs in the same inning, becoming the first member of the Twins and the 53rd major league player to do so as the Twins defeat Kansas City, 10-3...Carl Pohlad was born on this day in 1915...the late owner passed away on January 5, 2009.

TWINS ON A STICK: The Twins today announced player appearance schedule for tomorrow at the Minnesota State Fair...the Minnesota Twins Experience booth at the Great Minnesota Get Together will be located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar of the Como Avenue entrance...tomorrow from 11:30-12:30, Miguel Sanó, Mitch Garver and Eddie Rosario will compete in a famous butter craving contest with our friends at the Moo Booth.

WELCOME TO THE BIGS: Stewart made his major league debut on August 11 at Detroit, the 172nd player to make his major league debut this year and the third of four Twins to make his big league debut this year (Fernando Romero 5/2 vs. TOR, Tyler Kinley 4/7 vs. SEA, Stephen Gonsalves 8/20).

LAST START: Stewart made his second major league start against Detroit on August 18... did not factor into the decision after allowing three runs on three hits and four walks with two strikeouts in just 2.2 innings...allowed the first run of the game by hitting Mikie Mahtook with a pitch with the bases loaded...removed from the game after a two-RBI double by Ronny Rodriguez...his shortest professional start since May 24 with Double-A Chattanooga when he lasted 1.1 innings vs. Montgomery, allowing six runs on six hits.

COMING IN HOT: After his first two starts for Rochester, in which he went 0-0, 8.18 ERA (11.0 IP, 10 ER) with 17 hits allowed, he went 0-3, 2.37 ERA (30.1 IP, 8 ER), with nine walks and 19 strikeouts in five starts leading up to his contract selection.

AGAINST OAKLAND: Stewart is making his first career start vs. Oakland...has faced Oakland affiliates four times in his career, all with Single-A Cedar Rapids against Beloit in 2014... in his four starts, is 0-2 with a 4.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 7 ER) with five walks and 13 strikeouts... last start vs. Beloit was August 13, 2014, didn't factor into the decision after allowing one run on three hits with four strikeouts over 4.0 innings.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Stewart has split the season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Rochester...in 14 starts with the Lookouts, is 3-4 with a 4.76 ERA (68.0 IP, 36 ER) with 21 walks and 71 strikeouts...promoted to Rochester on June 24, is 0-3 with a 3.98 ERA (40.2 IP, 18 ER) with 12 walks and 30 strikeouts in seven games (5 starts).

ANOTHER FRESH FACE: By making his debut on August 11, Stewart is now the 11th different starting pitcher the Twins have used this year...he is one of 31 different pitchers to make an appearance this year (including outfielder Ryan LaMarre, infielder Williams Asutdillo and catcher Mitch Garver), tied for second most in the AL with Oakland.

FIRST AMONG MANY: Stewart was the fourth overall pick in the 2013 First-Year Player Draft and is now one of seven former first round draft picks to make an appearance with the Twins this year (Jose Berrios, Byron Buxton, Jason Castro, Joe Mauer, Kyle Gibson, Jake Odorizzi)...one of 24 first round picks from the 2013 draft to appear in the majors.

Odorizzi will make his 27th start of the season and first against Oakland tomorrow...is 1-2 with a 3.34 ERA (29.2 IP, 11 ER) against the A's in five career starts...his last start against Oakland came on July 17, 2017, earned the win after 7.0 innings and one run on one hit, one home run, two walks and five strikeouts...has made four starts this season against the AL West, going 1-1 with a 4.74 ERA (19.0 IP, 10 ER), eight walks and 17 strikeouts.
