THE TWINS: The Twins returned from their short two-game roadtrip in Chicago (1-1) to begin a four-game homestand against the A's, winning game one last night...tonight they will play the second of four with the Athletics through the weekend...after Sunday afternoon's series finale, the Twins will begin their penultimate roadtrip of 2018 with three at Cleveland August 28-30, three at Texas August 31-September 2 and three at Houston September 3-5.

AN A+ WIN: The Twins beat the A's last night by a score of 6-4 at Target Field...Kohl Stewart was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched...Trevor Hildenberger successfully converted his fourth straight save opportunity...the offense recorded ninth hits, exactly one from eight of nine players in the starting lineup...Max Kepler hit his 18th home run, one short of his career-high (19 in 2017).

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have recalled catcher/infielder Williams Astudillo from Triple-A Rochester...Astudillo, who played in seven games earlier this season for the Twins, was recently hitting .255 (27-for-106) with five doubles, four home runs and 12 RBI since being optioned from Minnesota to Rochester in late-July...to make room on the 25-man roster, the Twins have placed catcher Bobby Wilson on the 10-day disabled list with a right ankle sprain, an injury he suffered in the field during last night's game vs. Oakland.

TWINS AND A'S: The Twins and A's are playing the second of seven scheduled games this season...they will play a three-game series in Oakland September 21-23...the Twins have gone 6-3 in their last nine vs. Oakland, out-scoring the A's 57-35 in that span.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .316 (95-for-301) with 42 walks and a .399 on-base percentage in 84 career games against the A's...he has reached safely in 17 consecutive games vs. the Athletics, dating back to May 5, 2015, posting a .456 OBP in that span.

MINNESOTA'S GREATEST HITS: Joe Mauer enters today with 2,085 career hits, third most in club history (since 1961), behind Hall of Famers Kirby Puckett and Rod Carew...he needs one to pass Carew and move into sole possession of second:

NOTE: 14 active players have reached 1,000 runs scored...last to do so was José Bautista in mid-August.

MORE ON MAUER: Since July 6, Joe Mauer is hitting .303 (47-for-155) with six doubles, three home runs, 18 RBI, 14 walks, 21 runs scored and at .359 on-base percentage in 39 games...since that date, he ranks 13th in the AL in batting average...additionally, he is hitting .424 (28-for-66) with a .512 on-base percentage with runners in scoring position on the season, best in baseball, ahead of Yuli Gurriel (.406).

LOGAN LOVIN' 'SOTA: Logan Forsythe is hitting .370 (27-for-73) with four doubles, nine RBI, six walks and a .425 on-base percentage in 20 games since being traded to Minnesota from Los Angeles-NL on July 31 (for Brian Dozier)...in that span, he has reached safely in 16 of 20 games...among AL players this month, he ranks third in batting average, trailing Mallek Smith (.389) and J.D. Martinez (.382)...additionally, he ranks tied for sixth in hits (27).

FEELING MINNESOTA: The Twins have gone 39-26 at home this season, compared to 22-40 on the road...they have gone 20-6 at Target Field since June 24, including wins in nine of their last 11...since that date, they have the third most home wins in baseball, trailing Boston (22-6) and Tampa Bay (21-8).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1981, in his first major league game, Kent Hrbek hit a 12th inning home run, giving the Twins a 3-2 victory over the Yankees...he became the fifth player in club history to homer in his first major league game (12 now)...Hrbek finished his career with 293 home runs, second most in Twins history, trailing only Harmon Killebrew (475).

PLAYER'S WEEKEND: The second ever Players Weekend is taking place this weekend...the joint effort between MLB and the MLB Players Association will include: new uniforms and nicknames on the back of new uniforms, a "Thank You" patch for players to recognize someone who was important in their development, and customized gear.

TWINS ON A STICK: The Minnesota State Fair is taking place through Labor Day...the Minnesota Twins Experience booth at the Great Minnesota Get Together is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar of the Como Avenue entrance...earlier today, Miguel Sanó, Trevor Hildenberger and Eddie Rosario competed in a famous butter carving contest...tomorrow from 10:30am-11:15am, Jorge Polanco and Ehire Adrianza will compete in a classic Minnesota axe throwing competition through Timberworks Lumberjack Shows.

PLAYERS WEEKEND: Jake decided to go with "Odo" on the back of his jersey this weekend for the second straight season.

LAST START: Odorizzi did not factor in the decision in his last start vs. Detroit...went 5.0 innings and allowed four runs on four hits, while walking one and striking out seven...the four runs allowed were the most of any start this month and has given up four hits in each of his last four starts...has failed to go 6.0 innings in any start this month.

AGAINST OAKLAND: Will be making his sixth career start against the A's...is 1-2 with a 3.34 ERA (29.2 IP, 11 ER) across his previous five starts...July 17, 2017 was his last start against Oakland, he earned the win after allowing just one hit and run (home run) while walking two and striking out five...three of his five starts have been quality starts, with one going 8.0 innings and now allowing a run on five hits...this will be Odo's fifth start against the AL West this season, with a record of 1-1 with a 4.74 ERA (19.0 IP, 10 ER).

ON THE FIRST PITCH: Through his 26 starts this season, Odorizzi has allowed a .478 (22-for-46) average on the first pitch against a batter...on the 0-0 count, five of the 21 hits have been home runs and seven have been doubles...his .478 average is the highest of any full season in his career.

- On the contrary, when Odorizzi gets two strikes on a batter he is holding hitters to a .184 (57-for-309) average.

QUALITY NOT QUANTITY: Over his 26 starts this season, Odorizzi has averaged just over 5.0 innings/start...of starters with at least 26 starts, his 130.2 innings ranks as the fewest in MLB...his 19.1 pitches/inning ranks highest in MLB...he averages 4.38 pitches/batter faced which is most in MLB...though his starts have been on the short side, his 66 earned runs allowed ranks 14th fewest in the American League among qualified pitchers who have started at least 25 games.

- He has now started the season with 26 consecutive starts without recording an out in the 7th inning, the longest stretch in MLB history.

HOME AND ROAD: Has gone 4-3, 5.12 ERA (63.1 IP, 36 ER) in 13 home starts this season, compared to 1-4, 4.01 ERA (67.1 IP, 30 ER) in 13 road starts...at home Odo has walked 21 batters and 32 on the road...among starters on the Twins Odorizzi has received the second most runs of support at home (39)...in contrast, he has only received 25 runs of support in the same amount of starts on the road, which is fewest of any starter with at least 13 road starts in baseball.

STILL NEED HELP: In Odorizzi's 26 starts in 2018, the Twins offense has supplied 64 total runs, good for a run support average of 4.41 runs per game...the 64 runs of support rank fewest in baseball among starters with at least 26 starts and his 4.41 RSA ranks ninth lowest in baseball and fifth lowest in the American League.

FLY AWAY: In 2017 Odorizzi ranked fourth among all major league pitchers in Fly Ball Percentage (min. 140.0 IP) with a rate of 47.3%...he trailed Ariel Miranda of Seattle (52.2%), Marco Estrada of Toronto (50.3%), and Ian Kennedy of Kansas City (47.7%)...since 2014 Odorizzi has ranked in the top-10 in fly ball percentage every season: 2014 (2nd, 48.7%), 2015 (10th, 40.6%), and 2016 (9th, 44.4%)...in 2018, Odorizzi has allowed 161 fly balls, eighth most in baseball and seventh most in the AL.

A BRIGHT START: Odorizzi pitched in his first career Opening Day start and first career start for the Twins...he went 6.0 innings and allowed just two hits, while not allowing a run and striking out seven...only five other times in his career has he notched seven or more strikeouts while not allowing a run in 6.0-plus innings, the first since April 8, 2015 vs. Baltimore...he became the eighth different pitcher to start Opening Day for the Twins in the last 12 seasons.

- 2017 marked his fourth straight year of at least 28 starts.
- On May 29, 2016 vs. New York-AL, retired his first 16 batters-faced, tied for third-longest perfect game bid in Rays history.
- Established career-highs in 2016 for starts (33) and innings pitched (187.2).
- In 2016 allowed 2 ER or fewer in 13 of his no-decisions, a mark reached by only one other pitcher since 1913.
- Earned his first major league win in his season debut on April 4, 2014 vs. Texas.
