THE TWINS: The Twins began their short four-game homestand with a win and a loss to the A's...tonight they will play the third of four with the Athletics through tomorrow...after Sunday afternoon's series finale, the Twins will begin their penultimate roadtrip of 2018 with three at Cleveland August 28-30, three at Texas August 31-September 2 and three at Houston September 3-5.

NICKNAMES UNKIND: The Twins lost to the A's last night at Target Field by a score of 7-1...Jake Odorizzi was the starter and loser, allowing two runs (1 earned) on five hits in 7.0 innings pitched...he snapped his streak (to begin a season) of not recording an out in the seventh inning at 26 games...the offense recorded five hits, two from both Eddie Rosario and Robbie Grossman...they put just three men in scoring position, going 0-for-3 in such instances.

TWINS AND A'S: The Twins and A's are playing the third of seven scheduled games this season...they will play a three-game series in Oakland September 21-23...the Twins have gone 6-4 in their last 10 vs. Oakland, out-scoring the A's 58-42 in that span.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .315 (96-for-305) with 42 walks and a .397 on-base percentage in 85 career games against the A's...he has reached safely in 18 consecutive games vs. the Athletics, dating back to May 5, 2015, posting a .444 OBP in that span.

☞ Robbie Grossman has reached base safely in 11 straight against the A's...hitting .364 (12-for-33) during the streak with 11 walks in those games.

MINNESOTA'S GREATEST HITS: Joe Mauer recorded his 2,086th career hit last night, passing Rod Carew and moving into sole possession of second place on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

WORTH NOTING: During Harmon Killebrew's 22-year career with Washington/Minnesota and Kansas City, he amassed exactly 2,086 hits.

NOTE: 14 active players have reached 1,000 runs scored...last to do so was José Bautista in mid-August.

ROSIE THE HIT-MAN: Eddie Rosario had two more hits last night, giving him 149 on the season, eight shy of his career-high of 157, done in 2017...he ranks tied for third in the AL in hits with Francisco Lindor and Whit Merrifield, trailing J.D. Martinez (158) and Jean Segura (153)...his 45 multi-hit games are tied for third most in the AL with Segura, trailing Martinez (51) and Lindor (49).

☞ No Twin has reached 200 hits since Paul Molitor recorded 225 in 1996...the most recent Twin to reach at least 190 in a season was Joe Mauer in 2009...Rosario is on pace for 188.

FEELING MINNESOTA: The Twins have gone 39-27 at home this season, compared to 22-40 on the road...the Twins won 41 games at home last season...they have gone 20-7 at Target Field since June 24, including wins in nine of their last 12...since that date, they have the third most home wins in baseball, trailing Boston (22-6) and Tampa Bay (22-8).

INSIDE 45: The Twins have gone 26-19 in their last 45 games, dating back to July 5...in that span they have out-scored opponents 224-215...since that date their 26 wins are third most in the AL and tied for fourth most in baseball (Boston - 31, Oakland - 29, St. Louis - 28, Colorado - 26).

THOME, MINNESOTA'S HOMIE: The Twins are honoring Hall of Famer Jim Thome in a special pre-game ceremony today...the slugger played nearly two full seasons for the Twins from 2010-11, hitting .266 (128-for-482) with 28 doubles, 37 home runs and 99 RBI in 179 games...while with the Twins, in 2010, Thome hit career homers 573 and 574, passing Harmon Killebrew and moving into sole possession of 10th on baseball's all-time home runs list (now sits 8th with 612)...additionally, he hit his 600th home run with the Twins on August 15 at Comerica Park.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1962, Jack Kralick threw the first no-hitter in Twins history, as he beat the A's by a score of 1-0 on Lenny Green's sacrifice fly, scoring Bill Fischer...George Alusik with one out in the ninth inning broke up the potential perfect game drawing a walk...in 1987, Paul Molitor's 39-game hitting streak came to an end as he waited on-deck watching pinch hitter Rick Manning single home the winning run in a 1-0, 10-inning Brewer victory over the Indians...Molitor went 0-for-4 in the game as the 39-game streak remains the seventh longest streak in major league history.

PLAYER'S WEEKEND: The second ever Player's Weekend is taking place...the joint effort between MLB and the MLB Players Association will include: new uniforms and nicknames on the back of new uniforms, a "Thank You" patch for players to recognize someone who was important in their development, and customized gear.

TWINS ON A STICK: The Minnesota State Fair is taking place through Labor Day...the Minnesota Twins Experience booth at the Great Minnesota Get Together is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar of the Como Avenue entrance...earlier today, Jorge Polanco and Ehire Adrianza competed in a classic Minnesota axe throwing competition through Timberworks Lumberjack Shows.

PLAYERS WEEKEND: Gonsalves' Players Weekend name is Stove, given the nickname from friends...it originates from the movie Bridesmaids, during the airplane scene, when Kristen Wiig's character misreads the Flight Attendant's name tag "Steve" and calls him Stove.

WELCOME TO THE BIGS: Gonsalves made his Major League debut on August 20, making him the seventh Twin this season to make his big league debut...Kohl Stewart 8/11 at DET, Willians Astudillo 6/30 at CHC, Zack Littell 6/5 vs. CWS, Jake Cave 5/19 vs. MIL, Fernando Romero 5/2 vs. TOR, and Tyler Kinley 4/7 vs. SEA.

LAST START: Gonsalves suffered the loss in his big league debut on August 20 vs. Detroit after allowing four runs on six hits and two walks with three strikeouts in 1.1 innings...first pitch of the game was delayed by rain for 33 minutes...his shortest professional outing since he lasted 0.2 innings on May 29 with Triple-A Rochester vs. Durham.

MINING THE MINORS: Since 2013, Gonsalves has made 108 starts and 113 appeared across six different levels in the Twins minor league system...he owns a career 53-20 record with a 2.46 ERA (599.0 IP, 164 ER)...among International League pitchers this season he ranks seventh best in ERA 2.96, fifth in wins, and sixth in WHIP (1.20)...Gonsalves is currently ranked as the No. 5 prospect in the Twins minor league system by MiLB.com.

WHAT HAS HE DONE SO FAR?: Gonsalves began the season in Double-A Chattanooga where he went 3-0 across four starts with a 1.77 ERA (20.1 IP, 4 ER), two home runs allowed, 10 walks and 25 strikeouts...was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the week for the week of April 22-28...promoted to Triple-A Rochester and made his first start for the Red Wings on May 1... had three winning months in Rochester, going 4-1 in May, 2-0 in July and 2-0 in August...in July, he went 2-0 with a 0.88 ERA (30.2 IP, 3 ER) across five starts.

KEEP 'EM COMIN': Gonsalves is now the 12th different starting pitcher the Twins have used this year...he is one of 31 different pitchers to make an appearance this year (including outfielder Ryan LaMarre, infielder Willians Astudillo and catcher Mitch Garver), tied for fourth most in the AL with Toronto.

2017 RECAP:

- Spent first career spring training with Twins and reassigned to minor league camp March 13; reported to Double-A Chattanooga.
- Began season on 7-day disabled list with left rotator cuff strain.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Month for June, going 4-1, 2.32 ERA (31.00 IP, 8 ER) in five starts for the Lookouts.
- Ranked third on Chattanooga staff in wins (8), innings pitched (87.1), and strikeouts, despite pitching just three months.
- Promoted to Triple-A Rochester August 7.
- Made five appearances (four starts) for Red Wings in August where he finished the season.
- Named left-handed starting pitcher on the Twins Organizational All-Star team by MiLB.com.
- Ranked fourth best prospect and best changeup in Twins system by Baseball America, entering 2018...ranked 78th best prospect in baseball by MiLB.com.
