**THE TWINS:** The Twins began their short four-game homestand with a win and consecutive losses to the A's...today they will play the series finale...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow before beginning their penultimate roadtrip of 2018 with three at Cleveland August 28-30, three at Texas August 31-September 2 and three at Houston September 3-5.

**NOT SO ATHLETIC:** The Twins lost to the A's last night by a score of 6-2...Stephen Gonsalves was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded eight hits, two from both Joe Mauer and Tyler Austin, who hit his 12th home run of the season, his fourth as a Twin.

**TWINS AND A'S:** The Twins and A's are playing the fourth of seven scheduled games this season...they will play a three-game series in Oakland September 21-23...the Twins have gone 6-5 in their last 11 vs. Oakland, out-scoring the A's 60-44 in that span.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .316 (98-for-310) with 42 walks and a .397 on-base percentage in 86 career games against the A's...he has reached safely in 19 consecutive games vs. the Athletics, dating back to May 5, 2015, posting a .442 OBP in that span.

**MAUER RUNS THE 1K:** Joe Mauer needs one run scored to become the third Twin to reach 1,000 runs, below are the club's all-time leaders (since 1961):

**NOTE:** 14 active players have reached 1,000 runs scored...last to do so was José Bautista in mid-August.

**ROSIE THE HIT-MAN:** Eddie Rosario has 149 on the season, eight shy of his career-high of 157, done in 2017...he ranks tied for fourth in the AL in hits with Francisco Lindor, trailing J.D. Martinez (160), Jean Segura (155) and Whit Merrifield (151)...his 45 multi-hit games are fourth most in the AL, trailing Martinez (52), Lindor (49) and Segura (46).

☞ No Twin has reached 200 hits since Paul Molitor recorded 225 in 1996...the most recent Twin to reach at least 190 in a season was Joe Mauer in 2009...Rosario is on pace for 187.

**MAUER, MONEY:** Since July 6, Joe Mauer is hitting .305 (50-for-164) with six doubles, three home runs, 18 RBI, 14 walks, 21 runs scored and at .358 on-base percentage in 40 games...since that date, he ranks 11th in the AL in batting average...additionally, he is hitting .424 (28-for-66) with a .512 on-base percentage with runners in scoring position on the season, best in baseball, ahead of Yuli Gurriel (.413).

**FEELING MINNESOTA:** The Twins have gone 39-28 at home this season, compared to 22-40 on the road...the Twins won 41 games at home last season...they have gone 20-8 at Target Field since June 24, including wins in nine of their last 13...since that date, they are tied for third most home wins in baseball with Chicago-NL, trailing Tampa Bay (23-8) and Boston (22-6)...the Twins are looking to avoid losing three straight at home since June 21-23 (also 3).

**LOGIE BEARS DOWN:** Logan Forsythe is hitting .354 (28-for-79) with four doubles, nine RBI, eight walks and a .420 on-base percentage in 22 games since being traded to Minnesota from Los Angeles-NL on July 31 (for Brian Dozier)...in that span, he has reached safely in 18 of 22 games...among AL players this month, he ranks fourth in batting average, trailing J.D. Martinez (.400), Malle Smith (.389) and Mitch Haniger (.358)...additionally, he ranks tied for fifth in hits (28).

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2015, Vadim Balan of the GCL Twins becomes the first Moldovan to appear in the minor leagues...he strikes out four of five batters he faces to close out his team's 6-2 loss to the GCL Rays...Balan was released by the organization this last March.

**TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLY HONORS:** The Twins have named Single-A Cedar Rapids outfielder Trevor Larnach and Single-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Jhoan Duran as Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week...in six games for theernels, Larnach hit .391 (9-for-23) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, three walks and six runs scored...the California native was drafted by the Twins 20th overall in this past June's draft...Duran made two starts for the kernels, going 1-0, 0.66 ERA (13.2 IP, 1 ER) with three walks and 19 strikeouts...Duran, who earned this award earlier in the month, was acquired at the trade deadline from Arizona in exchange for infielder Eduardo Escobar.

**PLAYER'S WEEKEND:** The second Player's Weekend is taking place...the joint effort between MLB and the MLB Players Association will include: new uniforms and nicknames on the back of new uniforms, a "Thank You" patch for players to recognize someone who was important in their development, and customized gear.

**TWINS ON A STICK:** The Minnesota State Fair is taking place through Labor Day...the Minnesota Twins Experience booth at the Great Minnesota Get Together is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar of the Como Avenue entrance...earlier this weekend, Miguel Sanó, Trevor Hildenberger and Eddie Rosario competed in a butter carving competition, and Jorge Polanco and Ehire Adrianza competed in a classic Minnesota ax throwing competition.

**LA MAKINA:** Berríos' Player's Weekend nickname this year is "La Makina," which is Spanish for "The Machine," which has been his nickname since he was in the minors...last year his name on the back of his Player's Weekend uniform was "Orlandito," which means "Little Orlando"...Berríos' father's name is Orlando.

**LAST START:** Berríos did not factor into the decision on August 21 at Chicago-AL after allowing one run on four hits and two walks with four strikeouts over 5.0 innings...only run came on a Nicky Delmonico solo home run in the second...game was delayed for 52 minutes in the second inning due to rain...one earned run is the fewest he's allowed since July 24 at Toronto...three starts without a quality start or a decision are his longest stretches of the season.

**YES WAY JOSÉ!:** Starting pitcher José Berríos was named to the AL All-Star team, the first of his career...Berríos came in for the fifth inning and faced four batters, allowing one walk on 13 pitches, five of which were strikes...it marked the second consecutive season that the Twins have sent a starting pitcher to the All-Star Game (Ervin Santana)...below is a list of Twins starting pitchers to make the ASG:

**AGAINST THE OAKLAND:** Berríos is making his first career start vs. Oakland...has faced AL West opponents 11 times in his career, going 5-6 with a 5.34 ERA (57.1 IP, 34 ER) with 21 walks and 60 strikeouts...in 2018, is 1-3 with a 4.44 ERA (24.1 IP, 12 ER) with four walks and 29 strikeouts...his last start vs. an AL West team was June 24 vs. Texas, earned the win after shutting out the Rangers over 7.0 innings on two hits and two walks while striking out a career-high 12 batters...Oakland is the only AL team he has yet to appear against.

**TALE OF TWO SEASONS:** Has gone 3-3, 4.69 ERA (55.2 IP, 29 ER) with 26 walks and 52 strikeouts in his last 10 starts, dating back to his start at the Cubs June 29...prior to that start he went 8-5, 3.15 ERA (103.0 IP, 36 ER) with 20 walks and 109 strikeouts in 16 starts.

**CAREER YEAR:** After his last start vs. Chicago-AL, Berríos set a career high for starts in a season with 26, his previous career high being 25 in 2016...the righty has also set career highs in innings pitched (158.2) and strikeouts (161)...he is on pace to set career bests in ERA, WHIP (1.13), strikeouts per nine innings (9.13), walks per nine innings (2.61) and opponent batting average (.224).

**MORE FROM THE LEADERBOARD:** Berríos is leading the Twins starters with at least five starts in wins (11), strikeouts (161), WHIP (1.13), opponent batting average (.224), has allowed the fewest walks (46), tied for the lead in innings pitched (158.2) and is second in ERA (3.69) and quality starts (14)...among AL starters, is tied for 11th in IP, 13th in strikeouts, and 14th in OBP (.291)...one of only four pitchers in AL with two complete games (SEA James Paxton, CLE Carlos Carrasco, CLE Corey Kluber).

**DAY 'N' NIGHT:** Berríos has made 14 starts in night games this year and is among the best in baseball, going 8-2 with a 2.73 ERA (89.0 IP, 27 ER) with 19 walks and 93 strikeouts...his ERA is sixth best in the AL while his 0.94 WHIP in night games is third best in the AL and sixth in baseball and his 4.89 strikeout-to-walk ratio is fourth in the AL and eighth in baseball...in day games, Berríos is 3-6 with a 4.91 ERA (69.2 IP, 38 ER) with 27 walks and 68 strikeouts...however, both of his complete games this year have come in day games.

**NO PLACE LIKE HOME:** Since the beginning of 2017, Berríos is 17-3 with a 2.82 ERA (156.1 IP, 49 ER) in 25 games (24 starts) in home games...his 2.82 ERA at home is eighth best in the AL since the beginning of last season...his 0.95 WHIP at home is fifth best in the AL over that stretch...Berríos is 8-2 with a 3.13 ERA (89.0 IP, 31 ER) in 14 home starts in 2018...is fifth in the AL in strikeouts at home with 100...all six of his 10+ strikeout games in his career have come at Target Field...on the road, Berríos is 8-13 with a 4.80 ERA (148.0 IP, 79 ER) in 27 starts since the beginning of 2017.
