**TODAY'S MEDIA AVAILABILITY**  
The Astros clubhouse will be open from 3:10-4 p.m...manager **AJ Hinch** will be available in the Astros dugout at approximately 4 p.m.

**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY - AUG. 28**  
**2000** - With a 2nd-inning double **C Tony Eusebio** sets a then team-record, 24-game hitting streak that began on July 9...**CF Willy Taveras** owns the current mark with a 30-game streak, set in 2006.  
**1974** - **Cliff Johnson** hits a pinch-hit solo home run in the 10th-inning that lifts the Astros to a 3-2 win over the Mets at Shea Stadium...it is Johnson's 5th pinch-hit homer of the season, which is the franchise record.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The defending World Series Champion Houston Astros, winners of six straight games, will continue this 10-day, 10-game homestand tonight with the middle game of three against the Athletics... **RHP Charlie Morton** will get the start tonight for the Astros as they try to win the series against **RHP Edwin Jackson** and the A's.

**31 GAMES UP THRU 131:** At 81-50, the Astros have tied their best 131-game record in club history, also reached by the 1998 Astros...to keep pace with the 1998 club, the Astros need to win tonight...a win tonight would also push the Astros to 32-games above .500, which would be a new season high.

**STREAKERS:** The Astros current six-game winning streak is their fourth this season of six-or-more games... they've posted a 12-game streak (June 6-18) and now three six-game streaks, most recently from July 3-8.

**IRRESISTIBLE FORCE PARADOX:** With a win tonight or tomorrow, the streaking Astros would hand the streaking A's just their second series loss in their last 21 series, dating back to June 15...the A's are 17-1-2 in their last 20 series.

**THE RACE IS ON!** This series is a big one, as the Astros and Athletics are locked in a tight division race, which is currently tilted in the Astros favor by 2.5 games, the Astros largest lead since Aug. 12...the lead can be attributed to the Astros 11-6 record against the A's in 2018 in a season series that will conclude this week.

**TWO-HUNDO CLUB:** **RHP Gerrit Cole** (234K) and **RHP Justin Verlander** (229K) rank first and second in the AL in strikeouts...tonight's starter, **RHP Charlie Morton**, ranks sixth in the AL in strikeouts and is just 18 away from reaching 200 on the year...should he get 200, it would put the 2018 Astros in a rare group.

**SKIPPERING:** Astros manager **AJ Hinch** has posted a 352-265 managerial record in his three-plus years at the helm...he ranks fifth in Astros history in managerial wins and is just three wins shy of tying **Harry Walker** (355-353) for fourth on the all-time list.

**LAST NIGHT'S BIG WIN:** The Astros won their sixth straight game last night, downing the A's by a score of 11-4... Houston did their damage in two innings, scoring five runs in the 3rd inning and six runs in the 8th...**RHP Gerrit Cole** was the beneficiary, picking up his 12th win of the season...**3B Alex Bregman** had a big night, going 4x5 with his 25th homer of the season and four RBI, tying his career high in both hits and RBI...**1B Tyler White** went 2x4 with four RBI and hit his ninth home run in his 37th Major League game this season.

**THE BAND'S BACK TOGETHER:** **CF George Springer** returned to the starting lineup last night, going 1x3 with two walks, two runs scored and an RBI...with Springer back in the lineup, it meant the Astros started the trio of Springer, **2B Jose Altuve** and **SS Carlos Correa** for the first time together since June 25, a span of 50 games without all three in the same starting lineup... the Astros went 28-22 in those contests.

**HE'S BACK:** The Astros have won all six games since **2B Jose Altuve's** return from the DL last Tuesday, while the offense has hit .341 (74x217) with 44 runs scored (7.3 runs/game)...**Altuve** missed 21 total games (his first-ever DL stint), with Houston going 8-13...**Altuve** has hit .375 (9x24) with two doubles, one homer, four RBI, one steal and a .464 OBP since his return.

**SHARK WEEK:** **IF Tyler White** has been the Astros best offensive performer since the All-Star Break, as he has hit .342 (27x79) with 13 extra-base hits (4 doubles, 2 triples, 7 homers), 20 RBI and a 1.104 OPS in 22 games.

**MR. AUGUST:** **LF Marwin Gonzalez** has four home runs in his last eight games, and eight home runs in 22 games in August...he ranks tied for third in the AL in homers this month, fourth in OPS (1.108) and fifth in batting average (.349, 30x86).

**TWO-BAG BREGMAN:** **3B Alex Bregman** has hit 41 doubles and 25 home runs this season, both single-season career-highs...he has hit 36 of those doubles as a third baseman, a new single-season franchise record for that position, previously held by **Sean Berry** (35 in 1996)...**Bregman's** 41 doubles are the most doubles in the American League this year.

**PIÑA POWER:** **IF Yuli Gurriel** has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games, batting .313 (15x48) with four doubles, one triple, two homers, eight RBI and a .928 OPS.

**PACKED HOUSE:** Last night's crowd of 43,171 marked the Astros 12th sellout of the season and fourth sellout of a game in which they gave away Replica World Championship Rings...this is the most sellouts at Minute Maid Park in a single season since 2008, when they had 15 sellouts.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY:** The Astros would like to wish **Will Harris** a happy 34th birthday...he shares his birthday with comedian **Jack Black** and musician **Shania Twain**.

**LAST START - 8/22 AT SEA:** got his 13th win of the season in Seattle despite allowing 6 runs on 7 hits in 5.0 innings...walked 1 batter and had 7 strikeouts in the Astros 10-7 victory over the Mariners.

**CHARLES IN CHARGE:** 34-year-old with a turbo-charged fastball is in the midst of the best season of his career...was named to his 1st career **All-Star Team** this year in what is his 11th season in the Majors.

- has already set a single-season career high in strikeouts and has posted the best WHIP (1.17) and ERA for a single season in his career...is also just 1 win shy of tying his career-high for wins (14, set in 2017).

**WHERE HE RANKS:** has been one of the best starters in the AL this season, as he ranks 1st among AL pitchers in winning percentage (13-3, .813), 6th in strikeouts per 9.0 innings (11.12), 7th in ERA, 6th in strikeouts and T-8th in wins.

**VS. OAK:** is facing the Athletics for the 3rd time this season and for the 5th time in his career...is 0-0 with a 2.89 ERA (3ER/9.1IP) in his 2 starts vs. the club this season.

**HAPPY IN HOUSTON:** is in the 2nd year of a 2-year contract signed with the Astros, and has been one of the best pitchers in the AL since signing with the club.

- has gone 27-10 with a 3.34 ERA (109ER/294IP) and 345 strikeouts in 50 starts with the Astros since the beginning of the 2017 season...in that span, ranks 6th in the AL in groundball rate (51%), 7th in in wins (27), 8th in opponent batting average (.221), 8th in strikeouts per 9.0 innings (10.56) and 13th in ERA (3.34).

**BRINGING THE HEAT:** formerly a low 90's sinkerballer, has developed into one of the hardest-throwing starting pitchers in the game...has posted an average fastball velocity of 95.8 miles per hour this year, which ranks 4th among MLB starters behind **Luis Severino** (97.6), teammate **Gerrit Cole** (96.6) and **Mike Foltynewicz** (96.6).

**LIGHTS OUT VS. LEFTIES:** his breakout with the Astros has been sparked by a newfound dominance over left-handed hitters...has held lefties to a .214 opponent batting average (52x243) in 2018...in 2017 he held them to a .175 batting average (44x252) and a .561 OPS.

- has struck out 36.9% of all left-handed hitters he has faced, the 3rd-best mark among MLB starters behind **Gerrit Cole** (41.4%) and **Justin Verlander** (38.4%).

- over the last 2 seasons, his combined .194 (96x495) opponent batting average vs. left-handed hitters ranks 5th among MLB starters.

- prior to joining the Astros in 2017, had allowed left-handed hitters to bat .307 (493x1607) with an .859 OPS against him in his career.

**CHUCK IN THE ASG:** pitched 2.0 innings in the 2018 All-Star Game...allowed 2 runs on 2 hits across the 7th-8th innings...walked 1 with 2 strikeouts.

- earned his 1st All-Star selection after setting career bests prior to the ASG of a single season in the following categories: wins (11), strikeouts (146), ERA (2.96).

- became the 4th Astros pitcher to win 11+ games prior to the All-Star Game of a season dating back to 2000, joining **Dallas Keuchel** (11-4 in 2015), **Roy Oswalt** (12-7 in 2005) and **Wade Miller** (11-3 in 2001).
