**TODAY'S MEDIA AVAILABILITY**  
The Astros clubhouse will be open from 10:10-11 a.m...manager **AJ Hinch** will be available in the Astros dugout at approximately 11 a.m.

**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY - AUG. 29**  
**1961** - 494 acres of land on the south end of Houston are bought by R.E. "Bob" Smith and Judge Roy Hofheinz...180 acres are sold to Harris County as the site where the new domed stadium will be built.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The defending World Series Champion Houston Astros, winners of six of their last seven, will continue this 10-day, 10-game homestand today with the rubber game of this three-game series with the Athletics...**LHP Dallas Keuchel** will try to pitch the Astros to a series victory today, opposite **RHP Trevor Cahill** and the A's.

**THRU 132:** At 81-51, the Astros have posted their second-best 132-game record in club history, trailing the 1998 Astros by one victory (82-50)...they are also two games ahead of last year's pace (79-53), set by the eventual World Series Champions.

**STREAKERS:** The Astros had their six-game winning streak snapped last night in a one-run loss to the Athletics...they have posted four winning streaks of six-or-more games this season, including a 12-game run from June 6-18.

**IRRESISTIBLE FORCE PARADOX:** With a win today, the streaking Astros would hand the streaking A's just their second series loss in their last 21 series, dating back to June 15...the A's are 17-1-2 in their last 20 series.

**THE RACE IS ON!** This series is a big one, as the Astros and Athletics are locked in a tight division race, which is currently tilted in the Astros favor by 1.5 games...the lead can be attributed to the Astros 11-7 record against the A's in 2018 in a season series that will conclude today.

**VINTAGE KEUCHEL:** LHP Dallas Keuchel has found his form over his last 13 starts, posting a 7-2 record with a 2.61 ERA (24ER/82.2IP) and 10 quality starts...he'll get a chance to redeem one of those losses in that timeframe today, as the pitching matchup is a rematch of his start on Aug. 18 at OAK, which ended as a 7-1 A's victory.

**SKIPPING:** Astros manager **AJ Hinch** has posted a 352-266 managerial record in his three-plus years at the helm...he ranks fifth in Astros history in managerial wins and is just three wins shy of tying **Harry Walker** (355-353) for fourth on the all-time list.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Astros had their six-game winning streak snapped last night in a 4-3 loss to the visiting A's...the bullpen, which was eventually handed the loss, tossed an effective 4.1 innings, allowing just the one run, which proved to be the difference...**3B Alex Bregman** went 2x4 with a two-run double, while **1B Tyler White** went 1x4 with an RBI.

**TWO-HUNDO CLUB:** RHP Gerrit Cole (234K) and RHP Justin Verlander (229K) rank first and second in the AL in strikeouts, while last night's starter, RHP Charlie Morton, ranks sixth with 185...should Morton reach 200 strikeouts this season, the Astros would become just the fourth team in MLB history to have three pitchers reach 200 strikeouts in the same season.

**TODAY'S PREGAME CEREMONY:** Prior to today's game, the Astros will honor **RHP Justin Verlander** for his 200th career win in a pregame ceremony on the field (approx. 12:45 p.m.)...Verlander picked up win number 200 on the club's last road trip on Aug. 19 at OAK, becoming the 114th pitcher in MLB history to reach 200 career wins...he also joined a select group of 19 other pitchers to reach 200 wins within 412 career games, a group that includes 13 Hall of Fame pitchers.

**HE'S BACK:** The Astros have won six of seven games since **2B Jose Altuve's** return from the DL on Aug. 21, while the offense has hit .321 (80x249) with 47 runs scored (6.7 runs/game)...Altuve missed 21 total games (his first-ever DL stint), with Houston going 8-13...Altuve has hit .321 (9x28) with two doubles, one homer, four RBI, one steal and a .406 OBP since his return.

**THE BAND'S BACK TOGETHER:** CF **George Springer** returned to the starting lineup on Monday and has gone 2x6 with a double, an RBI and three walks in his two games...with Springer back in the lineup, it meant the Astros started the trio of Springer, **2B Jose Altuve** and **SS Carlos Correa** for the first time together since June 25, a span of 50 games without all three in the same starting lineup...the Astros went 28-22 in those contests.

**TWO-BAG BREGMAN:** **3B Alex Bregman** has hit 42 doubles and 25 home runs this season, both single-season career-highs...he has hit 37 of those doubles as a third baseman, a new single-season franchise record for that position, previously held by **Sean Berry** (35 in 1996)...Bregman's 42 doubles are the most doubles in the American League this year.

**THE KID:** **3B Alex Bregman** has recorded a hit in nine-straight games and has reached base safely in 25 straight games, the longest active streak in the Majors...Bregman has also reached base safely in 25 straight games against the A's, dating back to June 27, 2017, and has reached base in a single-season franchise record 45 consecutive road games.

**SHARK WEEK:** IF **Tyler White** has been the Astros best offensive performer since the All-Star Break, as he has hit .337 (28x83) with 13 extra-base hits (4 doubles, 2 triples, 7 homers), 21 RBI and a 1.076 OPS in 23 games.

**MR. AUGUST:** LF **Marwin Gonzalez** has four home runs in his last nine games, and eight home runs in 23 games in August...he ranks fourth in the AL this month in OPS (1.061), tied for fourth in homers and ninth in batting average (.333, 30x90).

**PACKED HOUSE:** Monday's crowd of 43,171 marked the Astros 12th sellout of the season and fourth sellout of a game in which they gave away Replica World Championship Rings...this is the most sellouts at Minute Maid Park in a single season since 2008, when they had 15 sellouts.

**LAST START - 8/24 AT LAA:** got his 10th win of the season in Anaheim... allowed just 2 runs on 5 hits over 7.0 innings...walked 2 batters and had 6 strikeouts in his 17th quality start of the season in the Astros 9-3 victory over the Angels.

**DK60:** two-time All-Star (2017, 2015) is set to make his 28th start of the season today in what is his 7th season in the Majors...has made every turn in the rotation this season and his 28 starts will be his most in a season since making a career-high 33 starts in 2015.

• ranks 5th in the AL in innings pitched and 13th in ERA (4th among lefties).

**HITTING HIS STRIDE:** over his last 13 starts since June 16, has gone 7-2 with a 2.61 ERA (24ER/82.2IP) and 10 quality starts.

• among all AL pitchers during this recent run, ranks 4th in ERA, T-3rd in innings pitched and T-5th in wins.

**YOU'RE GROUNDED:** ranks 2nd in the Majors in groundball rate (54.3%) and groundball to flyball ratio (2.64)...trails Clayton Richard in both categories (57.6%, 2.96).

• is one of the best groundball artists in recent memory...since 1987, the year groundballs were first tracked, is 1 of 4 pitchers to post a career groundball rate of at least 58.9% (min. 1000IP)...his 60% mark trails only **Brandon Webb** (64.13%), **Derek Lowe** (62.3%) and **Bill Swift** (61.7%).

**SOFT SERVE:** among all AL pitchers, ranks 2nd in in soft contact percentage (23.2%), trailing only **Chris Sale** (28.7%).

• since his breakout 2014 season, no starting pitcher in the Majors has induced soft contact at a higher rate...has posted a 23.6% soft contact rate since 2014, the top mark among MLB starters in that span directly ahead of **Tyler Anderson** of the Rockies (22.4%).

**BACK TO HIS OLD TRICKS:** the 3-time Rawlings Gold Glove Award winner (2014-16) has not made an error in his 27 starts and 33 total chances this season...ranks T-4th among AL pitchers in assists (21) and T-6th in total chances (33).

**VS. OAK:** will be facing the Athletics for the 4th time this season today and 22nd time in his career...is 6-6 with a 2.99 ERA (45ER/135.1IP), with 87 strikeouts and 39 walks in 21 career starts.

**JET SETTER:** while he has been better at Minute Maid Park than on the road in his career with a 3.06 ERA at the venue, this season, he has been one of the AL's top pitchers on the road...in 15 road starts, has gone 7-5 with a 3.27 ERA (34ER/93.2IP), which ranks 9th in the AL in road ERA.

**UP THE CHARTS:** currently ranks 13th in franchise history in innings pitched and is 3rd among lefties, trailing **Wandy Rodriguez** (1306.2) and **Bob Knepper** (1738.0).

• recorded his 900th career strikeout on 8/7 at SF...became the 12th pitcher in Astros history to record 900 strikeouts...currently ranks 12th in strikeouts in franchise history, immediately trailing **Bob Knepper** (946) on that list.
