Wade LeBlanc is 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA (7 ER, 23.1 IP) over his last 4 road starts (7/27-c)...during this stretch he has limited opponents to a .175 (14x80) average, while walking 8 and striking out 21.

**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners continue their penultimate road trip of the season - a 10-day, 9-game, 3-city trip - with the 1st of 4 games at the Oakland Athletics...the Mariners opened the road trip taking 2 of 3 games vs. the Arizona Diamondbacks at Chase Field and fell 0-2 in a brief 2-game series vs. the San Diego Padres...following this series, will return to Safeco Field on Monday for a 10-day, 8-game homestand against Baltimore (3 G), New York-AL (3 G) and San Diego (2 G)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **570 KVI, 770 KTTH** and the Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...Mariners have won 9 of their last 18 and 11 of their last 22 games...are 19-28 (7/4-current) since winning a season-high 8 straight games (6/25-7/3)...the Mariners have won 34 of their last 69 games, 41 of their last 78, 45 of their last 84 and 52 of their last 94...Seattle is 60-48 in its last 108 games, 65-51 over its last 116 games...Seattle is 23-24 during the day and 51-35 at night...Seattle is 38-28 at Safeco Field, 36-31 on the road.

- **Close Games** - the Mariners are 48-21 (.696) this season in games decided by 1 or 2 runs, the highest winning percentage in the Majors...the Mariners are 32-18 (.640) in 1-run games (most 1-run wins in MLB) and 16-3 (.842) in games decided by exactly 2 runs (best 2-run winning percentage in MLB).
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 53-17 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 21-42 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 2 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (63-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining Oakland (65-0).
- **1,000 RBI** - Nelson Cruz (295) is 5 doubles away from 300 in his career...Cruz (995) is also 5 RBI away from 1,000 in his career...he will become the 12th active Major League player with at least 1,000 RBI.
- **Milestone Tracker** - Kyle Seager (390) trails Harold Reynolds (391) by 1 for 7th-most walks in club history...also Seager (532) trails Raúl Ibañez (540) by 8 for 8th-most runs scored in club history.
- **Extra! Extra!** - the Mariners are 13-1 (.929) in extra innings this season, the most wins and best winning percentage in the Majors...the Mariners 13 extra-inning wins are a club record (previous: 12-4 in 1984)...the last ML team with at least 13 extra-inning wins in a single season was the 2017 Boston Red Sox (15-3).

**ROAD WARRIOR**...Jean Segura is batting .336 (86x256) with 47 runs, 16 doubles, 2 triples, 3 home runs, 28 RBI, 3 HBP, 17 walks and 13 stolen bases in 61 games on the road this season...he leads the American League with 86 hits on the road, while also ranking 2nd in average (.336), T3rd in runs scored (47), T4th in stolen bases (13) and 10th in on-base percentage (.383)...Segura's .336 road batting average is currently the 13th-highest in franchise history (Ichiro Suzuki, .405 in 2004) and highest since Ichiro's .337 average in 2007.

**STEAL AWAY**...Jean Segura recorded his 20th stolen base of the season yesterday afternoon vs. the Padres...his 20 stolen bases currently rank T8th in the American League this season (teammate Dee Gordon leads the league with 29 SB)...Segura has recorded 20+ stolen bases in 6 consecutive seasons (44 in 2013, 20 in 2014, 25 in 2015, 33 in 2016, 22 in 2017), which is currently the T2nd-longest streak in the Major Leagues...he trails only Elvis Andrus-TEX (9, 2009-2017, 4 SB in 2018), while also being tied with Starling Marte-PIT (6, 2013-18), José Altuve-HOU (6, 2012-17, 15 SB in 2018) and Jarrod Dyson (6, 2012-17, 16 SB in 2018)...Gordon (5, 2014-18), Billy Hamilton-CIN (5, 2014-18) and Jacoby Ellsbury-NYY (5, 2013-17, 0 SB in 2018) each have active streaks of 5 seasons...with 1 more stolen base, Gordon will extend his streak of seasons with 30+ steals to 5 consecutive seasons...only Altuve (6, 2012-17, 4 SB in 2018) has a longer active streak while Hamilton (4, 2014-17, 29 SB in 2018) is also 1 stolen base away from his 5th consecutive season with 30+ stolen bases.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING**...Mitch Haniger currently has a season-high 10-game hitting streak (8/18-current), batting .333 (14x42) with 9 runs scored, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 5 RBI, 1 HBP and 6 walks...his active 10-game hitting streak is currently T2nd-longest in the Major Leagues (along with Alex Bregman-HOU), trailing only an 11-game hitting streak by Milwaukee's Lorenzo Cain...Haniger's 10-game hitting streak is also the 2nd-longest in his career, trailing only a 13-game hitting streak, April 6-19, 2017.

**PLAYER OF THE MONTH**...Mitch Haniger has hit safely in 22 of 26 games in August, including 11 multi-hit games...over that span, he is batting .349 (38x109) with 18 runs, 12 doubles, 4 home runs, 14 RBI, 1 HBP, 9 walks, a .400 on-base percentage and a .569 slugging percentage (.969 OPS)...among American League leaders in the month of August, Haniger ranks 4th in average, trailing only J.D. Martinez-BOS (.398/37x93), Mallex Smith-TB (.389/28x72) and Yan Gomes-CLE (.350/21x60)...leads the AL during August in hits (38) and doubles (12) and is T3rd in extra-base hits (16), 4th in total bases (62) and T10th in on-base percentage (.400).

**THE DÍAZ REPORT**...in 64 games this season, Edwin Díaz is 50-for-54 (92.6%) in save opportunities with a 1.97 ERA (14 ER, 64.0 IP) with 108 strikeouts and 15 walks...here are some notes on Díaz's standout season:

- Leads the Major Leagues with 50 saves...Craig Kimbrel-BOS is 2nd with 37.
- Is the 14th pitcher (done 17x) in ML history to record at least 50 saves in a season.
- Ranks 2nd among Major League relievers with 108 strikeouts...Josh Hader-MIL is 1st with 113.
- Leads the Major Leagues with 25 one-run saves...Blake Treinen-OAK is 2nd with 16.
- Has struck out 44.8% (108 K, 241 BF) of batters faced this season, the 5th-best single-season strike-out rate by a reliever in Major League history.
- Has struck out his 1st batter faced 30 times this season, most in the Majors (Adam Ottavino-COL, 29).
- His 50 saves are a franchise record, passing Fernando Rodney (48, 2014).
- His 108 strikeouts are 2nd-most as a reliever in club history...trails only Bill Caudill (111, 1982).
- The Mariners are 59-0 when he enters with a lead, including 28-0 when he enters with a 1-run lead.

**MAKING THEMSELVES AT HOME**...since 2015, the Mariners are 23-11 (.676) in 34 games vs. the Athletics at the Oakland Coliseum...Seattle's .676 winning percentage at the Oakland Coliseum since 2015 is tied for the best road winning percentage by any team against a divisional opponent (also: Boston at Toronto, 25-12/.676), ranking ahead of Houston at Seattle (24-13/.649), Chicago-NL at Milwaukee (23-13/.639) and New York-NL at Philadelphia (23-13/.639)...during that stretch, Seattle is averaging 5.0 runs/game (171 R, 34 G) while posting

**AS YOU KNOW**...Jean Segura went 2-for-3 with 1 run scored and 1 stolen base yesterday afternoon vs. the Padres at PETCO Park, including recording his 1,000th career hit with a single in the first inning off Joey Lucchesi...AND AS YOU MAY KNOW...Segura recorded his 1,000th career hit in his 879th game, while also becoming the 20th player to accomplish this feat in a Mariners uniform...BUT DID YOU KNOW?...among the 20 players that recorded their 1,000th career hit in a Mariners uniform, Segura's 879 games to reach this milestone was the 3rd-fewest?...only Ichiro Suzuki (696 G) and Ken Griffey Jr. (874 G) reached 1,000 career hits faster than Segura...he also ranks ahead of Edgar Martinez (905 G) and Alvin Davis (958 G).

**ABOUT LEBLANC...**

- 34-year-old left-hander is making his 27th appearance and 22nd start of the season, his 203rd career appearance, 101st career start and 5th start (7th appearance) vs. Oakland tonight.
- Signed with Seattle on March 25, 2018 after being released by New York-AL at his request.
- Previously played with Seattle in 2016...acquired on June 22, 2016 from Toronto in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations...was traded to Pittsburgh on Sept. 13, 2016 in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations.
- Selected by San Diego in the 2nd round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Native of Lake Charles, LA...attended Alfred M. Barbe High School.
- Made his Major League debut with the Padres on Sept. 3, 2008 at Los Angeles-NL (L, 4.0,8,5,5,3,1,HR-2).
- Pitched for the University of Alabama, 2004-06...was 24-9 with a 2.81 ERA (100 ER, 320.1 IP) and 334 strikeouts in 46 career G/45 GS...holds Alabama's all-time record for strikeouts with 334...National Freshman of the Year (*Baseball America*) and SEC Freshman of the Year in 2004 after going 8-4 with a 2.08 ERA (26 ER, 112.2 IP) with 98 strikeouts in 16 G/15 GS while posting 8 complete games, including 2 shutouts.
- Went 2-5 with a 4.23 ERA (21 ER, 44.2 IP) in 8 starts with the Seibu Lions in the Japan Pacific League in 2015.
- Is 9-10 with a 5.34 ERA (96 ER, 161.2 IP) in 39 career games/27 starts in August.

**LAST OUTING...** did not factor into the decision in his 8th quality start of the season, a 4-3 10-inning Mariners win at Arizona on Aug. 25...allowed just 1 run (a solo home run) on 4 hits and 2 walks while striking out 6 batters in 6.0 innings pitched.

**FOR STARTERS...** since moving into the Mariners rotation on May 3, is 7-3 with a 3.83 ERA (49 ER, 115.0 IP) with 92 strikeouts and 26 walks in 21 starts...the Mariners are 14-7 in those starts...among American League leaders during that span, ranks 7th in WHIP (1.14/26 BB, 105 H, 115.0 IP), 9th in BB/9.0 IP (2.03/26 BB, 115.0 IP), 12th in K/BB (3.54/92 K, 26 BB) and 14th in ERA.

**START IT UP...** in 29 career starts with the Mariners, is 10-3 with a 4.00 ERA (71 ER, 159.2 IP) with 126 strikeouts and 35 walks...the Mariners are 21-8 in his 29 starts with the club...made 8 starts with Seattle in 2016, going 3-0 with a 4.43 ERA (22 ER, 44.2 IP) with 34 strikeouts and 9 walks.

**HE'S A WINNER...**made 21 career starts with the Mariners before suffering a loss (6/24/16-7/8/18)...only 1 American League pitcher in the live-ball era had a longer such streak to begin a tenure with a single club (Whitey Ford-NYY, 22, 7/6/50-6/12/53)...among all pitchers in the live-ball era, LeBlanc's streak trailed only Ford and Kirk Rueter-MON (22, 7/7/93-6/15/94)(STATS).

**MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME...**signed to a contract extension through the 2019 season with annual club options through 2022 on July 3.

**THAT'S NEAT!**...turned in one of the best starts of his career June 16 vs. Boston, allowing 2 hits and striking out 9 across 7.2 scoreless innings...faced just 1 over the minimum, thanks to a 1st-inning double play...retired 22 straight batters after allowing a leadoff single in the 1st inning, ending with a 2-out single in the 8th...his 7.2 innings and 9 strikeouts were both his most since 2011 with San Diego.

**A MAY TO REMEMBER...**in 6 starts in the month of May, went 1-0 with a 1.72 ERA (6 ER, 31.1 IP) with 23 strikeouts and 6 walks...among American League leaders for the month of May, ranked 4th in ERA and 9th in WHIP (0.99/6 BB, 25 H, 31.1 IP)...the Mariners went 5-1 in those 6 starts.

**WELCOME (BACK) TO SEATTLE...**signed with Seattle on March 25 after being released by New York-AL at his request...became the 43rd player in club history to have spent at least two different stints with the Mariners...Mike Blowers (1992-95, 1997, 1999), Raúl Ibañez (1996-2000, 2004-2008, 2013), Norm Charlton (1993, 1995-97, 2001) and Jeff Nelson (1992-95, 2001-03, 2005) are the only players who spent three separate stints with the Mariners.

**2017 SEASON...**went 5-2 with 1 save and 4 holds in 50 relief appearances with a 4.50 ERA (34 ER, 68.0 IP), 54 strikeouts and 17 walks with Pittsburgh...held right-handed batters to a .217 (38x175) batting average against with a .270 OBP and a .389 slugging percentage (.658 OPS against).

**CAREER...**10-year MLB veteran with 7 clubs (San Diego, Miami, Houston, Los Angeles-AL, New York-AL, Pittsburgh & Seattle)...overall, is 37-38-3 with a 4.31 ERA (338 ER, 705.1 IP) in 202 career appearances/100 starts...in 100 career starts, is 29-34 with a 4.40 ERA (266 ER, 544.0 IP) with 386 strikeouts and 173 walks...in 102 career relief appearances, is 8-4-3 with a 4.02 ERA (72 ER, 161.1 IP) with 125 strikeouts and 43 walks...appeared in 11 games (8 starts) with the Mariners in 2016, going 3-0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (25 ER, 50.0 IP).
