WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers lost to the Angels in last game on Thursday, 9-3, and finished with a 3-5 record on its 8-game, 9-day homestand vs. LAD (0-2), MIN (2-1), and LAA (1-2)...have still won 3 of 5 since snapping a 5-G losing streak that was T2nd-longest by TEX in 2018...team has dropped 7 of 10, 9 of 14, 10 of 16, 13 of 22, and 16 of last 28 G...TEX is 15-16 in last 31 G, and club's 19-17 (.528) record since 7/27 remains 7th-best in A.L., 3rd-best among A.L. West clubs (OAK: .622, 23-14; HOU: .556, 20-16)...have lost 28 of 49 and 30 of last 52 G, the longer span beginning 7/6... team is 34-35 beg. 6/16...at 20-23 (.465) since the AS break, TEX is tied for 8th-best record in the A.L.

• At 61-79 (.436), Rangers are 11th in the A.L. in winning percentage...the 61 wins are fewest for Texas after 140 G since 2014 (53-87) and T6th-fewest at this point in Rangers history.

• Texas has been under the .500 mark since a season best 1-1 on 3/30...club's high point since the break is 14-under (6 times, last on 8/24)...team was season-high 20 G under .500 at 42-62 on 7/26...TEX won season-high 7 straight from 6/16-23, preceded by longest losing skid at 7 G, 6/7-15.

SERIES STUFF: Texas has gone 1-4-0 over its last 5 series, with the lone series win over that stretch coming vs. MIN (2-1), 8/31-9/2...club had gone 4-1-2 in 7 series from 7/27-8/19...team has dropped 3 straight road series and has gone 0-3-1 since its sweep at Houston, 7/27-29...the Rangers are 17-28 in series openers, but 9-12 on the road.

IN THE STANDINGS: Texas was eliminated from A.L. West contention with Tuesday night's loss in game no. 138, earliest point to be out of division race since 2014 (game no. 135)... current 26.0-game is season high...team was between 20.0 and 23.0 GB for 30 straight days from 7/28-8/26...Rangers have lost 5.0 games in the standings in the past 12 days... current 26.0-G deficit is 4th-largest division margin in MLB to BAL (-55.5), TOR (33.5), and KC (-33.5)...club has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 150 days and in either 4th or 5th place for 160 of 161 days this season (T2nd following win on 3/30).

ON THE ROAD: Texas is 29-36 (.446) away from Arlington this season, 9th-best winning percentage in A.L...club has dropped 8 of 11 road contests since the end a 4-G road win streak, 7/27-30...team is 7-8 in last 15, 8-10 in last 18, and 15-16 beginning 6/18...the club enters tonight with an MLB-low 65 road games, and is tied with the Los Angeles Dodgers and Miami Marlins for most road games remaining.

• Texas is batting .187/.283/.279/.561 over last 8 road games and season OPS of .675 on the road is more than 100 points lower than the club's home figure (.790)...the pitching staff's 4.19 road ERA is more than 100 points lower than its home ERA (5.61).

VS. OAKLAND: Tonight is the 1st of 3 G at the Coliseum this weekend, the final meetings between the Rangers and Athletics in 2018... the Rangers are 6-10 vs. OAK in '18, dropping 6 of 7 G with the A's...club snapped a 6-G losing streak vs. the A's with a win on 8/22 during the club's last road trip... Rangers have now lost season series vs. A's in 5 of 7 seasons from 2012-18...TEX is 5-8 in last 13 G vs. A's and has gone 24-26 vs. OAK beginning 6/14/16... Texas has gone 3-4 at the Coliseum this season, but lost 2 of 3 during last trip to the Bay Area, 8/20-22...team is 3-3 in last 6 at this park after going 0-9 at this historic facility from 4/18/17-4/2/18...just 4-12 at this park since the start of 2017... Texas leads all-time series 367-362 while A's have 190-173 edge at the Coliseum.

• This series will conclude a stretch of 9 consecutive road games in the Bay Area from 8/20-9/9...club was 2-4 on its 6-game, 7 day trip at OAK (1-2) and SF (1-2) from 8/20-26.

RISP MANAGEMENT: The Rangers were 4-for-26 with RISP during the 3-game series with the Angels this week, but the club's .286 avg w/RISP since the break is 4th in the A.L.

BELTRÉ ON THE ALL-TIME LISTS: Adrián Beltré has homered in 3 of last 5 games, hitting safely in all 5 games during that stretch at .350 (7-20)...with his home run on Wednesday night vs. LAA, Beltré has recorded his 19th career 10-homer season, most among active players (Hank Aaron leads with 23 such seasons)...Beltré's 19 seasons of 10 home runs are the most ever by a third baseman...he now has 472 career home runs, one shy of matching Carlos Delgado for 32nd on the all-time list.

• Beltré enters tonight with 3149 career hits, just 3 hits shy of matching Paul Waner for 16th all-time (George Brett ranks 15th with 3154)...his 1138 career extra-base hits are tied with Ty Cobb for 14th most in baseball history...Beltré also has 5269 total bases, 2 shy of matching Ken Griffey Jr for 14th all-time.

• Beltré is batting .308/.338/.492/.830 with 10 HR and 45 RBI in 62 G at the Oakland Coliseum since 2010...his 14 career home runs at this facility are tied for 3rd-most among active opponents (16-Nelson Cruz; 15-Mitch Moreland; 14- Beltré/ Mike Trout).

NOMAR MAZARA has multiple hits in 2 straight and 3 of the last 4 G, and is batting .421/.476/1.053/1.529 (8-19) over his 1st 5 G in September...7 of Mazara's last 9 hits have gone for extra base hits (3 2B, 4 HR), 2nd-most in MLB since 8/31 (8-Alex Bregman/Trevor Story)...his 10 RBI in that span are tied for most in the majors with Bregman, Story, and OAK's Stephen Piscotty.

• Each of Mazara's last 3 RBI have come with 2 outs to raise his season 2-out RBI total to 33, tied with Jurickson Profar for most on the club...Mazara is batting a team-best .309 (17-55) with RISP and 2 outs.

YOVANI GALLARDO ended a 3-start winless drought with a win in his last outing on Sat. vs. MIN, and has gone 8-3 with a 4.85 ERA (35 ER/65.0 IP) in his last 12 starts dating back to 6/23...his 8 wins since 6/23 are tied for most in MLB during that span with CLE's Carlos Carrasco, MIL's Jhoulys Chacin, TB's Blake Snell, PIT's Jameson Taillon, and NYM's Zack Wheeler...Gallardo's 9.14 run support average over that same span is highest in the majors, nearly 2 runs higher than the next closest pitcher (CLE's Carlos Carrasco at 7.75).

POST-BREAK OFFENSE: This weekend's series will feature the clubs with the top 2 OPS figures in the A.L. since the break with OAK in 1st at .801 and Texas 2nd at .790...the Rangers totaled 8 runs in the 3-G series with the Angels this week, 2nd-fewest runs scored in a 3-G series since the All-Star break (4 runs at OAK, 8/20-22)...the club has still scored a MLB-best 247 runs since the break, 11 more than the next closest club (BOS/STL are next with 236)...the Rangers are averaging 5.74 runs per game in the 2nd "half", highest in the majors...the team also ranks among the A.L. post-break leaders in HR (3rd, 64), walks (3rd, 156), average (4th, .260).

SPOKANE IN POSTSEASON: The Spokane Indians lost Game 2 in their best-of 3 semifinal series on Thursday night, 8-3...the series will be decided today at 3:00 CT in Spokane with RHP Chi Chi Gonzalez starting for the Indians...the series winner advancing to the best-of-5 Northwest League Championship Series against Eugene.

SHORTS: Rougned Odor has scored a ML-high 41 runs since the All-Star break...C.D. Pelham and Jeffrey Springs are 2 of only 8 draft selections in the 30th round-or-later from 2014-18 to reach MLB, and the only teammates among that group...Pelham was the 31st pitcher used by the Rangers this season, T6th in the A.L...Adrian Sampson is the only player on the active roster who has yet to appear in a game with the club...Shin-Soo Choo has reached base safely in 10 straight road games, 3rd-longest streak by a Texas batter this season (29-Choo; 11-Chirinos)...the Rangers have a 9-9 record in games following an off day.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#49 Yovani Gallardo, RHP
(8-3, 5.97)

TONIGHT: The 32-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 17 appearance/14th start of the season tonight as the Rangers open a 3-game weekend set in Oakland...has 8 wins in 12 G/GS since 6/23, tied for most in MLB during that span w/CLE's Carlos Carrasco, MIL's Jhoulys Chacin, TB's Blake Snell, PIT's Jameson Taillon, and NYM's Zack Wheeler...will be working on extended 5-days' rest after earning the win in the Rangers' 7-4 victory over the Twins on Saturday in Arlington...has gone 5-2 with a 4.07 ERA (19 ER/42.0 IP) over his last 8 starts since 7/22 to drop season ERA from 8.60 to 5.97...opponents are batting .288/.359/.508/.867 over last 6 starts...his 8.15 run support average would easily be highest in MLB if he qualified...overall, is 8-3 with a 5.14 ERA (40 ER/70.0 IP) in 13 G/GS with the Rangers in 2018...had contract purchased from Triple-A Round Rock prior to start on 6/17, where he went 2-1 with a 3.81 ERA (21 ER/49.2 IP) in 10 starts after signing with Texas as a minor league free agent on 4/13...signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on 12/21/17 and was released near the end of spring training on 3/26...signed with Cincinnati on 3/31 and was added to the Reds bullpen...allowed 8 R-ER over 2.1 IP with 6 of the 8 runs coming on 4/6 at PIT...was designated for assignment by Cincinnati on 4/10 and refused a minor league assignment on 4/12 to become a free agent...signed a minor league deal with Texas the following day...was the Rangers Opening Day starter in 2015, posting the lowest ERA of his career and starting Game 1 of the 2015 ALDS vs. Toronto...Rangers are 10-3 in his 13 starts.

LAST START: Earned the win in the Rangers' 7-4 victory over the Twins on Saturday in Arlington (5.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R-ER, 1 BB, 1 SO, 1 HR, 84 pitches/50 strikes)...faced a 2-0 deficit after a wild pitch in the 1st inning scored a run and Jake Cave hit a solo homer in the 2nd inning...Texas would score 4 runs off Berrios in the bottom of the 2nd...was 5th time to earn the win in an outing of less than 6.0 IP.

VS. ATHLETICS: Has gone 2-5 with a 4.47 ERA (29 ER/58.1 IP) over 11 G/10 GS in his career vs. the Athletics...has not faced the A's in 2018, but was 2-0, 3.33 (9 ER/24.1 IP) in 5 G/4 GS last season with the Mariners...is 1-2 with a 3.58 ERA (11 ER/27.2 IP) in 5 career starts at the Coliseum.

ON THE ROAD: Is 3-2, 5.54 (16 ER/26.0 IP) in 5 starts away from Arlington this season...has made just one road start since 7/28 (took the loss on 8/26 across the Bay at SF)...opponents have an .877 OPS on the road compared to .800 at GLPIA...last road win was 7/27 at HOU.

2018: Robinson Chirinos (3-0, 4.70 in 4 G) and Isiah Kiner-Falefa (5-3, 5.36 in 9 G) have caught his 13 starts w/ TEX...owns reverse splits, with RHB slashing .321/.387/.536/.923 and LHB at .237/.327/.417/.744...opponents batting .265/.339/.451/.790 in his 13 starts w/ TEX...opposition by PA in game in his 13 starts: 1st PA (.274, 27-108), 2nd PA (.250, 27-108), 3rd PA (.280, 14-50)...opposition batting .305 (18-59) with RISP, including 2-for-10 in last 4 starts...signed by Milwaukee to major league contract as a free agent on 12/21/17...in spring training with Brewers, went 0-1, 4.73 (7 ER/13.1 IP) in 8 G/1 GS w/ 8 BB/12 SO...released by MIL on 3/28 and signed by CIN to one-year major league contract on 3/31...made 3 relief appearances with Reds (2.1 IP, 8 R-ER) before he was designated for assignment on 4/10...rejected outright assignment to Louisville (AAA) on 4/12, signed minors deal with Rangers on 4/13, and reported to Round Rock (AAA)...in win on 7/22 vs. CLE, became 4th starter in TEX history (since pitches 1st tracked in 1988) to post 6.0+ SHO IP on 75-or-fewer pitches...posted back-to-back scoreless qualifying starts on 7/22 vs. CLE and 7/27 at HOU for the 1st time since 8/22-27/15 w/ TEX.

BACK IN TEXAS: The Fort Worth native had his contract purchased from Round Rock (AAA) prior to start on 6/17...he went 2-1 with a 3.81 ERA (21 ER/49.2 IP) in 10 starts for the Express after signing with Texas as a minor league free agent on 4/13...prior to joining the Texas organization, Gallardo had early season stints with Milwaukee and Cincinnati...the Fort Worth resident was a member of the rotation for the Rangers' 2015 division-winner in his lone season with the club...was the Rangers Opening Day starter in 2015, posting the lowest ERA of his career and starting Game 1 of the 2015 ALDS vs. Toronto.

ROUND ROCK: Was 2-1 with a 3.81 ERA (21 ER/49.2 IP) in 10 starts with Triple-A Round Rock...went 2-0 with a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP) over his last 3 starts with the Express...held opponents to a .239/.271/.328/.600 slash line over that stretch...opposition batted .263/.317/.344/.661 overall...had a 57% ground ball rate and induced 6 double play ground balls...surrendered just one HR in 49.2 IP...permitted 3 ER-or-less in all 10 outings.

CAREER: Since 1st stint with Texas in 2015, has spent seasons with Baltimore (2016) and Seattle (2017)...was a mainstay in the Brewers starting rotation from 2009-14...was a 2nd round selection by the Brewers in the 2004 1st Year Player Draft out of Trimble Tech High School in Fort Worth, TX...has the 2nd-most strikeouts (1568) among players born in Mexico, and also ranks among the all-time Mexican leaders in wins (3rd, 121), starts (3rd, 302), and innings (4th, 1794.2).
