WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers dropped the opener of this series in Oakland on Friday night, 8-4, and are 0-1 on this 9-game, 10-day road trip to OAK (0-1), LAA (3 G), and SD (3 G)...club finished with a 3-5 record on its 8-game, 9-day homestand vs. LAD (0-2), MIN (2-1), and LAA (1-2) prior to this trip...have gone 3-3 in last 6 G since snapping a 5-G losing streak that was T2nd-longest by TEX in 2018...team has dropped 8 of 11, 10 of 15, 11 of 17, 14 of 23, and 17 of last 29 G...TEX is 15-17 in last 32 G, and club's 19-18 (.514) record since 7/27 remains 7th-best in A.L., 3rd-best among A.L. West clubs (OAK: .632, 24-14; HOU: .568, 21-16)...have lost 29 of 50 and 31 of last 53 G, the longer span beginning 7/6...team is 34-36 beg. 6/16...at 20-24 (.455) since the AS break, TEX is tied for 9th-best record in the A.L.

• At 61-80 (.433), Rangers are 11th in the A.L. in winning percentage...the 61 wins are fewest for Texas after 141 G since 2014 (53-88) and 6th-fewest at this point in Rangers history.
 • Texas has been under the .500 mark since a season best 1-1 on 3/30...club's high point since the break is 14-under (6 times, last on 8/24)...team was season-high 20 G under .500 at 42-62 on 7/26 and needs a victory tonight to avoid matching that mark...TEX won season-high 7 straight from 6/16-23, preceded by longest losing skid at 7 G, 6/7-15.

SERIES STUFF: Texas has gone 1-4-0 over its last 5 series, with the lone series win over that stretch coming vs. MIN (2-1), 8/31-9/2...club had gone 4-1-2 in 7 series from 7/27-8/19...team has dropped 3 straight road series and has gone 0-3-1 since its sweep at Houston, 7/27-29.

IN THE STANDINGS: Texas was eliminated from A.L. West contention with Tuesday night's loss in game no. 138, earliest point to be out of division race since 2014 (game no. 135)...current deficit of 27.0 games back is season high...team was between 20.0 and 23.0 GB for 30 straight days from 7/28-8/26...Rangers have lost 6.0 games in the standings in the past 13 days...current 27.0-G deficit is 4th-largest division margin in MLB to BAL (-55.5), KC (-33.5), and TOR (32.5)...club has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 151 days and in either 4th or 5th place for 161 of 162 days this season (T2nd following win on 3/30).

ON THE ROAD: Texas is 29-37 (.439) away from Arlington this season, 9th-best winning percentage in A.L...club has dropped 9 of 12 road contests since the end a 4-G road win streak, 7/27-30...team is 7-9 in last 16, 8-11 in last 19, and 15-17 beginning 6/18...the club enters today with an MLB-low 66 road games, and is tied with the Los Angeles Dodgers and Miami Marlins for most road games remaining...the club will play 15 of final 21 G away from Arlington.

• Texas is batting .193/.289/.294/.583 over last 9 road games and season OPS of .676 on the road is more than 100 points lower than the club's home figure (.790)...the pitching staff's 4.24 road ERA is more than 100 points lower than its home ERA (5.61).

VS. OAKLAND: The Rangers are 6-11 vs. OAK in '18, dropping 7 of 8 G with the A's...Texas snapped a 6-G losing streak vs. the A's with a win on 8/22 during the club's last road trip...Rangers have now lost season series vs. A's in 5 of 7 seasons from 2012-18...TEX is 5-9 in last 14 G vs. A's and has gone 24-27 vs. OAK beginning 6/14/16...Texas has gone 3-5 at the Coliseum this season, but has dropped 3 of last 4 games here in Oakland...team is 3-4 in last 7 at this park after going 0-9 at this historic facility from 4/18/17-4/2/18...just 4-13 at this park since the start of 2017...Texas leads all-time series 367-363 while A's have 191-173 edge at the Coliseum.

CALIFORNIA LOVE: The Rangers are in the midst of a stretch that will see the club play 18 straight road contests in California from 8/20-9/26...team does not play a game outside of Texas or California until its final series of the year, 9/27-30 at SEA...today will also be the club's 8th consecutive road game in the Bay Area, and Texas is 2-5 in that stretch.

BELTRÉ PASSES COBB: Adrian Beltré recorded career extra-base hit no. 1139 with his 7th inning double last night...with the double, Beltré passed Hall of Famer Ty Cobb to move into 14th place in baseball history...the hit also gave Beltré 5271 career total bases, matching Ken Griffey Jr for 14th all-time on that list...the double also drew Beltré within 2 hits of Paul Waner (3152) for 16th all-time (George Brett ranks 15th with 3154)...Beltré has hit safely in each of the 1st 6 G in September at .364/.440/.818/1.258 (8-22) with a 2B, 3 HR, and 4 RBI.

JOEY GALLO has joined Juan Gonzalez (1992-93) as the only players in Rangers history with multiple seasons of 35+ HR prior to their 25th birthday...according to baseball-reference.com, Gallo is one of just 5 active players with multiple seasons of 35+ HR prior to their age-25 season (age as of 6/30), joining Albert Pujols (3x, 2001-04), Manny Machado (2x, 2015-16), Mike Trout (2x, 2014-15), and Giancarlo Stanton (2x, 2012 and 2014).

• Gallo now ranks 4th in the A.L. with 35 homers and his 13 long balls since the All-Star break are 2nd-most in the A.L. behind only OAK's Khris Davis (19).

• Gallo's 6 home runs vs. the A's this season are tied for the 5th-highest single-season total ever by a Texas batter vs. OAK and most since Beltré also hit 6 in 2016.

SHIN-SOO reached base twice last night via walk to raise his season total to 85, 3rd in the A.L....Choo's 85 walks are already the highest figure by a Texas batter since Ian Kinsler had 89 walks in 2011...his .383 OBP is currently the 3rd-highest figure by a Texas batter over the last 10 seasons (2009-18) behind only Josh Hamilton in 2010 (.411) and Adrian Beltré in 2014 (.388).

• Choo has reached safely in 16 of 38 career plate appearances vs. Edwin Jackson, going 12-for-33 with 3 2B, HR, 4 RBI, and 5 BB...Choo currently sits at 21 home runs, one shy of a career high, and his last home run came here at the Oakland Coliseum on 8/22 off Jackson.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: With 5 walks last night, Texas now has 502 walks this season, 2nd-most in the A.L. (NYY-529)...Texas batters' average of 4.00 pitches per plate appearance would be the highest figure by the club since the stat was 1st tracked in 1988 (current high is 3.96 in 2017).

HERE COMES THE SUN: The Rangers will conclude this series with day games in each of the final 2 contests...Texas enters this afternoon's contest with just 40 day games this season, T3rd-fewest in the majors (38-LAD, 39-LAA, 40-BOS/TEX)...including tonight, the club has 6 day games remaining on the schedule...the Rangers have gone 17-23 in afternoon tilts in 2018, but has won 6 of 11 in the 2nd 'half.

SPokane ADVANCES TO NWL CHAMPIONSHIP: The Spokane Indians held on for a 5-4 win over Everett yesterday to capture the best-of-3 semifinal series and earn a spot in the Northwest League Championship Series...RHP Chi Chi Gonzalez (5.0 IP, 0 R) started for the Indians and earned the victory...3B Sherten Apostel, who was acquired from PIT on 8/17, was 3-for-3 with a walk, double, and 2 RBI...CF J.P. Martinez hit a solo home run in the first inning...Game 1 of the best-of-5 NWL Championship Series is slated for 7:05 CT on Sunday in Eugene...the entire series will be played in Eugene as Spokane's Avista Field is unavailable due to a county fair...Spokane will play as the home team for the 1st 2 games.

SHORTS: Choo's 1st inning steal last night was the club's 3rd in its last 22 G since 8/12, 3rd-fewest in MLB over that stretch (1-MIN; 2-TOR)...Adrian Sampson was the 32nd pitcher used by the Rangers this season (including Carlos Tocci and Ryan Rua)...Texas batters have been plunked 77 times this season, 2nd-most in the A.L., and already the 2nd-highest total in team history (club-record 81 in 2017)...Texas starters have 3 quality starts since 8/20: 2- Mike Minor; 1- Yohander Méndez.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#65 Yohander Méndez, LHP
(1-1, 5.59)

TODAY: The 23-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 4th appearance of the season today in the 2nd of 3 games against the Athletics...will be 13th ML appearance overall...will be working on extended 5 days' rest after earning his 1st major league win in the Rangers' 18-4 victory on Sunday vs. MIN...was recalled from Round Rock (AAA) ahead of start on Sunday for his 3rd stint w/ TEX in 2018 (also 5/3-12 and 6/15-18)...each of 1st 10 ML outings from 2016-18 were in relief prior to his 1st ML start on 6/15 vs. COL...has combined to go 2-4, 4.31 (34 ER/71.0 IP) in 13 G/GS with Down East (Hi-A), Frisco (AA), and Round Rock (AAA) since being optioned to minors on 6/19...posted no record and a 2.92 ERA (4 ER/12.1 IP) over 6 games/2 starts for the Rangers this spring before he was optioned to Round Rock on 3/18...a September call-up for Texas in both 2016 and 2017, Méndez has gone 1-2 with a 6.84 ERA (19 ER/25.0 IP) in 12 G/2 GS in his ML career...entered this season rated as the Rangers' no. 5 overall prospect by *Baseball America*, this after being ranked no. 2 prior to 2017...climbed through the top three levels of the Texas farm system to make his major league debut in 2016...over his 7 minor league seasons, Méndez has produced a 3.29 ERA and 1.165 WHIP over 552.2 innings, averaging 8.4 strikeouts per 9 innings and 1.0 HR per 9...the 6-foot-5 Venezuela native originally signed with the Rangers on 7/2/11.

LAST START: Earned his 1st major league win in the Rangers' 18-4 victory on Sunday vs. MIN (6.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 2 SO, 79 pitches/49 strikes)...remains the only quality start by a Rangers pitcher other than Mike Minor since 8/20...marked 7th scoreless outing of 6.0+ IP by a Texas starter this season, 3rd since the start of July (Minor on 8/22 at OAK and Gallardo on 7/22 vs. CLE)...Rangers scored season-best 18 runs and set club record with 13 extra-base hits.

VS. OAKLAND: Has no record, 3.86 ERA (3 ER/7.0 IP) in 3 career games vs. Oakland, all in relief...outing in season finale on 10/1/17 in Arlington (4.2 IP, 2 R-ER) matched Austin Bibens-Dirkx for longest relief outing by a Texas pitcher in '17...has one career appearance at the Coliseum, striking out lone BF (Matt Olson) in Rangers' 4-1 loss on 9/22/17.

TEXAS IN 2018: Has gone 1-1, 5.59 in 3 G/2 GS for the Rangers this season spanning 3 stints with the club (5/3-12, 6/15-18, 9/2-current)...was scratched from scheduled start for TEX on 6/20 at KC and optioned to minors on 6/19...made 1st ML start on 6/15 vs. COL, taking loss in Rangers' 9-5 defeat (L, 3.0 IP, 7 H, 6 R-ER, 2 BB, 1 SO, 1 HR, 72 pitches/40 strikes)...allowed all 6 runs in the 2nd inning, throwing 42 pitches in the frame...picked up 1st big league win on Sunday vs. MIN (6.0 SHO IP)...lone relief appearance in 2018 was on 5/12 at HOU (0.2 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 0 SO)...finished Rangers' 6-1 loss that night in Houston...it was his 1st ML appearance outside of September/October.

MINORS IN 2018: Overall in minors this season w/ club's top 3 affiliates: 2-10, 4.71 (64 ER/122.1 IP) in 23 G/GS...after he was optioned to the minors on 6/19, combined to go 2-4, 4.31 (34 ER/71.0 IP) in 13 G/GS with Down East (Hi-A), Frisco (AA), and Round Rock (AAA)...made 5 starts w/ Down East, 6 w/ Frisco, and 2 w/ Round Rock...last minors start was 8/28 vs. Memphis (ND, 2.0 IP, 1 H, 1 BB, 2 SO, 43 pitches/26 strikes), a start in which Méndez exited after being struck by a batted ball...recovered fully in time to make start on Sunday vs. MIN.

ROUND ROCK: Méndez went 0-7 with a 5.25 ERA (34 ER/58.1 IP) in 12 G/GS with Round Rock (AAA) this season...had a 1.526 WHIP, 7.7 SO/9, and just a 2.08 SO/BB ratio...opponents batted .286 (65-227) with 24 BB and 50 SO in the Pacific Coast League...Express did not score more than 2 runs of support for Méndez in any of his 12 Triple-A starts (one or zero runs in 10 of 12 starts), as he has registered a 1.85 run support average (12 RS/58.1 IP) in the PCL in 2018.

CAN'T FIGHT THE YOUTH: Is one of 2 Texas starters age 23-or-younger this season (also Ariel Jurado)...only other time in the last 6 seasons (2013-18) that club used 2 starters age 23-or-younger at time of 1st ML start was in 2014 (Nick Martinez/Martin Perez)...since start of 2005, only left-handed Texas starters to be younger than Méndez (23.149 for 1st start on 6/15 vs. COL) are Martin Perez (21.087 for 1st start on 6/30/12 vs. OAK), Derek Holland (22.225 on 5/22/09 at HOU), and Matt Harrison (22.296 on 7/8/08 vs. LAA).

AS RELIEVER: Has pitched almost exclusively as a starter throughout his minor league career, but each of 1st 10 MLB outings were in relief (0-1, 7.31)...longest career relief outing came in the 2017 season finale on 10/1/17 vs. OAK (4.2 IP, 5 H, 2 R-ER, 2 BB, 1 SO, 1 HR, 67 pitches/39 strikes), when he pitched in relief of Cole Hamels (3.0 IP)...his 1st career decision was a loss on 9/15/17 at LAA, when he issued a walk to his only BF (Kole Calhoun) before Ricardo Rodriguez allowed Calhoun to score in a 7-6 Texas defeat.

2017: Went 0-1, 5.11 (7 ER/12.1 IP) in 7 relief outings for the Rangers after he was recalled from Frisco (AA) on 9/4...allowed runs in 4 of 7 outings for Texas...2nd straight year as a September call-up...finished season with 2 longest outings of his brief ML career to that point: 4.2 IP in season finale on 10/1 vs. OAK, and 3.2 IP on 9/26 vs. HOU...1st ML loss, 9/15 at LAA (BB to only BF), 1st Ranger to take loss when walking only BF since Juan Alvarez on 7/28/02 vs. OAK.
