WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers lost to the Athletics on Saturday, 8-6, and are 0-2 on this 9-game, 10-day road trip to OAK (0-2), LAA (3 G), and SD (3 G)...have gone 3-4 in last 7 G since snapping a 5-G losing streak that was T2nd-longest by TEX in 2018...team has dropped 9 of 12, 11 of 16, 12 of 18, 15 of 24, and 18 of last 30 G...TEX is 15-18 in last 33 G, and club's 19-19 (.500) record since 7/27 remains T7th-best in A.L., 3rd-best among A.L. West clubs (OAK: .641, 25-14; HOU: .579, 22-16)...have lost 30 of 51 and 32 of last 54 G, the longer span beginning 7/6...team is 34-37 beg. 6/16...at 20-25 (.444) since the AS break, TEX is tied for 10th-best record in the A.L.

- At 61-81 (.430), Rangers are 11th in the A.L. in winning percentage...the 61 wins are fewest for Texas after 142 G since 2014 (53-89) and 6th-fewest at this point in Rangers history.

- With yesterday's loss, the Rangers cannot finish with a winning record in 2018...this will be the team's 2nd straight season with a .500-or-below record, but just 3rd such record in the last 10 seasons (2009-18).

- Texas has been under the .500 mark since a season best 1-1 on 3/30...club's high point since the break is 14-under (6 times, last on 8/24)...team has matched its season high at 20 G under .500 (also 42-62 on 7/26)...has not been 21-under since finishing with a 67-95 record in 2014...TEX won season-high 7 straight from 6/16-23, preceded by longest losing skid at 7 G, 6/7-15.

SERIES STUFF: Texas has gone 1-5-0 over its last 6 series, with the lone series win over that stretch coming vs. MIN (2-1), 8/31-9/2...club had gone 4-1-2 in 7 series from 7/27-8/19...team has dropped 4 straight road series and has gone 0-4-1 since its sweep at Houston, 7/27-29...Texas has gone 17-26 in series finales, including a 7-14 mark on the road.

IN THE STANDINGS: Texas was eliminated from A.L. West contention with Tuesday night's loss in game no. 138, earliest point to be out of division race since 2014 (game no. 135)...current deficit of 28.0 games back is season high...team was between 20.0 and 23.0 GB for 30 straight days from 7/28-8/26...Rangers have lost 7.0 games in the standings in the past 14 days...current 28.0-G deficit is 4th-largest division margin in MLB to BAL (-55.5), KC (-33.5), and TOR (32.5)...club has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 152 days and in either 4th or 5th place for 162 of 163 days this season (T2nd following win on 3/30).

ON THE ROAD: Texas is 29-38 (.433) away from Arlington this season, 9th-best winning percentage in A.L...club has dropped 10 of 13 road contests since the end a 4-G road win streak, 7/27-30...team is 7-10 in last 17, 8-12 in last 20, and 15-18 beginning 6/18...the club enters today with an MLB-low 67 road games, and is tied with the Los Angeles Dodgers and Miami Marlins for most road games remaining...the club will play 14 of final 20 G away from Arlington.

- Texas is batting .199/.287/.322/.609 over last 10 road games and season OPS of .678 on the road is more than 100 points lower than the club's home figure (.790)...the pitching staff's 4.31 road ERA is more than 100 points lower than its home ERA (5.61).

VS. OAKLAND: The Rangers are 6-12 vs. OAK in '18, dropping 8 of 9 G with the A's...this is the most loss vs. the A's in a single season since going 4-15 in 2003...Texas snapped a 6-G losing streak vs. the A's with a win on 8/22 during the club's last road trip, but has dropped the 1st 2 G of this series...Rangers have now lost season series vs. A's in 5 of 7 seasons from 2012-18...TEX is 5-10 in last 15 G vs. A's and has gone 24-28 vs. OAK beginning 6/14/16...Texas has gone 3-6 at the Coliseum this season, but has dropped 4 of last 5 games here in Oakland...team is 3-5 in last 8 at this park after going 0-9 at this historic facility from 4/18/17-4/2/18...just 4-14 at this park since the start of 2017...Texas leads all-time series 367-364 while A's have 192-173 edge at the Coliseum.

ALL ABOUT ADRIÁN: Adrián Beltré hit a pair of home runs yesterday for his 1st multi-homer game of 2018 and 33rd of his career...the 33 multi-home run games are 3rd-most among active players behind Albert Pujols (58) and Miguel Cabrera (39)...Beltré has now hit safely in each of his 1st 7 games in September at .385/.448/1.000/1.448 (10-26)...his 5 HR this month are tied for most in the majors with HOU's Alex Bregman, STL's Marcell Ozuna, and COL's Trevor Story...Beltré's performance on Saturday moved him up several of baseball's all-time lists:

- The 2 home runs yesterday raised Beltré's career total to 474 and moved him into 32nd place on the all-time list ahead of Carlos Delgado (473)...Stan Musial and Willie Stargell are tied for 30th place with 475 homers.

- Beltré has tied Paul Waner for 16th place on the all-time hit list with 3152 career hits...George Brett is 15th on the list with 3154.

- With 3 RBI on Saturday, Beltré raised his career total to 1696, moving into 24th place on the all-time RBI (since 1920) ahead of Cal Ripken, Jr. (1695)...he is now 4 RBI shy of matchign Jim Thome (1699) for 3rd all-time.

- His 5279 career total bases are 14th-most in baseball history (Frank Robinson is 13th w/5373)...on Saturday, Beltré recorded 8 total bases to break a tie with Ken Griffey Jr (5271).

NOMAR MAZARA is batting .333/.391/.738/1.129 (14-42) with 5 2B, 4 HR, and 13 RBI over his last 11 games...his 13 RBI since 8/26 are tied for 5th-most in MLB over that span...each of his last 5 RBI have come with 2 outs, and his 35 2-out RBI overall are T7th in the A.L.

OPEN SESAME: The Rangers are slated to use "an opening pitcher" this afternoon for the 2nd time in 2018...in the 1st instance on Monday vs. LAA, Jeffrey Springs tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in a 3-1 loss to the Halos.

YOU ARE MY SUNSHINE: Texas has gone 17-24 in afternoon tilts in 2018, posting a 6-6 record since the All-Star break...club's 41 day games are T2nd-fewest in A.L.

- Adrián Beltré is batting .360/.448/.573/1.021 (32-89) with 4 HR and 16 RBI in 28 day games this season...Beltré owns the highest day average in MLB.

HALOS NEXT: The Rangers move down the Pacific Coast and start a series in Anaheim on Monday night...Texas is 5-8 vs. the Angels, going 5-4 since an 0-4 start...TEX and LAA are playing 4 series in final 6 1/2 weeks, as 13 of Rangers' final 40 games (32.5%) are against the Halos...the teams will play a Mon./Tues./Wed. series in 3 of the 4 weeks in September...Texas also returns to Anaheim during the final road trip of the season, 9/24-26.

MINOR LEAGUE PLAYOFFS: The Spokane Indians open the best-of-5 Northwest League Championship series tonight at 7:05 in Eugene (CHC)...RHP Scott Engler will start Game 1 for the Indians...the entire series will be played in Eugene as Spokane's Avista Field is unavailable due to a county fair...Spokane will play as the home team for Games 1 and 2.

SHORTS: Yohander Mendez was the 1st Texas starter with an outing of 4.0-or-fewer IP and zero-or-one hits since Alexi Ogando on 6/10/12 at SF (3.0 IP, 0 R)...Adrián Beltré is batting .371 (13-35) with 2 HR and 6 RBI in his career vs. Trevor Cahill, 4th-highest BA among active players (min. 20 PA)...Shin-Soo Choo has reached safely in 11 of 20 career plate appearances vs. Cahill (6 H, 5 BB)...Rougned Odor is batting .330/.407/.530/.937 (38-115) in day games, 8th-highest average in MLB...Shin-Soo Choo has 3 BB in his last 2 G and ranks 3rd in the A.L. with 86 BB...Texas has an 8-15 record on Sunday...bullpen's current 76.5 (39 of 51) save percentage is now best in the A.L. and would be the 7th-best figure in Texas history...the Rangers have 68 HR since the All-Star break, 3rd-most in the A.L. (NYY/OAK-71).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP Jeffrey Springs (0-0, 2.29) Opp. slash: .243/.325/.392/.717; LHB: .333 (8-24); RHB: .200 (10-50)

- Slated to make second career major league start in today's series finale at OAK...made first career start in Monday's series opener against the Angels (2.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R-ER, 0 BB, 3 SO, 0 HR, 32 pitches/23 strikes)...each of his 1st 10 ML outings came in relief: 0-0, 2.55 (5 ER/17.2 IP), 9 BB, 18 SO, 1.415 WHIP...longest relief outing was 8/14 vs. ARI (2.2 IP)...career high for pitches was 8/20 at OAK (51 pitches).
- Has pitched primarily in relief during his pro career, but has 26 starts in minors, 9 w/ High Desert in 2016 and 17 w/ Down East in 2017...in those 26 starts: 1-10, 5.08 (73 ER/129.1 IP)...last start was w/ Down East on 7/23/17 at Myrtle Beach (ND, 5.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R-ER).
- With TEX, has 7.0 SHO IP last 4 G to drop season ERA from 3.55 to 2.29...has allowed runs in 3 of last 7 G (4 R-ER/12.2 IP) to raise season ERA from 1.29, opponents 14-for-51 (.275) in that span w/ 6 BB and 15 SO...allowed hits in each of 1st 9 career MLB outings before hitless outing on 9/1 vs. MIN.
- Had contract purchased from Round Rock (AAA) and made ML debut 7/31 at ARI...allowed runs in one of 1st 4 G/7.0 IP...career-high 2.2 IP on 8/14 vs. ARI.
- Combined to go 4-4, 4.13 ERA (26 ER/56.2 IP) w/ 2 saves over 33 G with Round Rock and Frisco...posted a career best in SO/9 (15.6)...promoted to Round Rock on 6/16 and compiled a 1.72 ERA (3 ER/15.2 IP) with 24 SO in last 11 G with the Express.
- In 4 minor league seasons, has whiffed nearly one-third (32.2%) of all batters faced...led all Texas minor leaguers in strikeouts (146) in 2017 and was a non-roster invite to major league spring camp this season.

#57 Ariel Jurado, RHP
(2-4, 6.00)

TODAY: Pronounced air-REE-el hurr-RAH-doe...is slated to appear in relief during today's series finale...will be making second consecutive relief appearance...each of his 1st 7 ML outings were starts...last appeared in relief in Monday's series opener with the Angels (4.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R-ER)...opponents are batting .299/.353/.478/.831, including .369/.406/.462/.867 in his last 3 starts...has 8 BB/7 SO over 23.1 IP in his last 5 outings...has gone 2-3, 6.53 (22 ER/30.1 IP) in 6 starts since being recalled for his 2nd big league stint on 7/28...was on Rangers' active roster for one day during his 1st stint with the club for his ML debut on 5/19 at CWS...he was optioned back to Frisco the following day...has spent the bulk of the season at Double-A Frisco, going 5-3 with a 3.28 ERA (37 ER/101.2 IP) in 16 G/GS for the RoughRiders while posting a 1.220 WHIP figure, 5.1 SO/9, 1.5 BB/9, and 1.1 HR/9...is in his 5th professional season after being signed by Texas as a non-drafted free agent out of Panama in 2012...has consistently induced ground balls throughout his minor league career, with a 1.94 GO/AO rate entering 2018...remained one of the top Texas prospects entering 2018, as he ended last season ranked as the organization's no. 9 prospect according to MLB.com...was named the organization's Nolan Ryan Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2015 following a breakout campaign with Single-A Hickory...only 6 natives of Panama have ever played for the Rangers, most recently Paolo Espino (2017)...Rangers are 3-4 in his 7 starts.

LAST APPEARANCE: Made first career ML relief appearance on Monday in Rangers' 3-1 defeat in the series opener against the Angels (4.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R-ER, 1 BB, 1 SO, 0 HR, 54 pitches/34 strikes)...entered the contest in the 3rd inning after LHP Jeffrey Springs tossed the first 2 frames...faced the minimum over first 3 innings pitched despite allowing a leadoff single to Mike Trout in the 4th...first scoreless outing of his career...has allowed just 1 HR in last 18.1 IP after giving up 4 HR in start on 8/9 at NYY.

VS. THE ATHLETICS: Suffered the loss in Rangers' 6-0 defeat on 8/21 at Oakland (5.2 IP, 10 H, 4 R-ER, 1 BB, 1 SO, 0 HR, 84 pitches/59 strikes)...exited the game trailing 4-0 in the 6th...Matt Moore recorded final out in the inning, stranding Nick Martini on 1st...just 2 of 10 hits allowed were extra-base hits...will be making second start of the season against the A's and at the O.co...is 1-3 with a 6.33 ERA (15 ER/21.1 IP) in 4 road starts...has allowed at least 6 H and 4 R in 3 of 4 starts.

2018: Opposition is batting .299/.353/.478/.831 through 8 G/7 GS, including .439 (18-41) w/ RISP...15 of 47 hits allowed have been XBH (8 2B, 3B, 6 HR)...has averaged 1.38 HR/9 in majors after a 0.7 HR/9 rate over 568.1 IP at the minor league level...his 52.4 ground ball percentage is best among any TEX starting pitcher in 2018 (Fister-51.3%).

FIRST WIN: Earned his first career win in Rangers' 7-3 victory on 7/28 at HOU (6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R-ER)...retired first 9 batters faced before George Springer hit a solo home run to lead off the 4th...became the youngest Ranger ever to win a road start within his 1st 2 ML games (22.179)...1st pitcher in Rangers history to win a start within his 1st 2 ML appearances when the opposing starter was a former Cy Young Award winner...just one other Ranger has won a start against the defending WS champs within his 1st 2 ML games: Brian Sikorski on 8/16/00 vs. NYY...Jurado was the 1st Ranger to do it on the road.

CAN'T FIGHT THE YOUTH: At 22 years, 109 days old for his ML debut, Jurado became the youngest Ranger to make a start for Texas since Martin Pérez (22.108) on 7/21/13 vs. BAL...Jurado was the youngest Ranger to start in his ML debut since Tommy Hunter (22.029) on 8/1/08 vs. TOR...also became just the 7th native of Panama to ever appear for Texas, joining Paolo Espino (2017) as the only Panamanians with the club since Bruce Chen in 2007...he became the Rangers' 1st international signing to start for the club in his major league debut since Omar Beltre on 6/30/10 at LAA.

AT FRISCO: Has spent the balance of the season at Double-A Frisco, going 5-3 with a 3.28 ERA (37 ER/101.2 IP) in 16 G/GS for the RoughRiders while posting a 1.220 WHIP figure, 5.1 SO/9, 1.5 BB/9, and 1.1 HR/9...had quality starts in each of his last 5 outings at Double-A, going 3-0, 2.10 (8 ER/34.1 IP) with 4 BB/24 SO...last start came on 7/23 vs. Midland (W, 7.0 IP, 7 H, 1 R-ER, 1 BB, 5 SO, 0 HR, 98 pitches/65 strikes)...at the time of his most recent promotion on 7/28, ranked among Texas League leaders in BB/9 (1st, 1.50), baserunners/9 (2nd, 11.24), ERA (3rd, 3.28), WHIP (3rd, 1.220), opp. BA (3rd, .272).

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER — LHP MIKE MINOR (11-7, 4.31 ERA in 25 games/starts)

The 30-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 26th start of the season in Monday night's series opener in Anaheim...has gone 2-1, 2.12 (4 ER/17.0 IP) last 3 starts to drop season ERA from 4.61 to 4.31, lowest since the end of April...opponent slash last 3 starts is .111/.200/.296/.496 w/ .091 BA...is 5-2, 2.88 (13 ER/40.2 IP) in 7 starts since the AS break to drop from 4.89, and has opponent slash of .170/.219/.348/.566...his 2.88 ERA since the break ranks 13th in A.L. among pitchers with 7+ starts...his 1.100 WHIP would rank 8th in A.L. if he qualified, and would be the 8th-lowest single-season figure in Rangers history (min. 25 GS)...only Rangers w/ lower figures are Nolan Ryan (1989, 1990, 1991), Fergie Jenkins (1974, 1978), Bert Blyleven (1977), and Yu Darvish (2013)...will pitch on extra 5 days' rest after earning win in Rangers' 4-2 victory on Tues. vs. LAA (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R-ER, 1 BB, 7 SO, 1 HR, 91 pitches/59 strikes)...threw 25 pitches in the 1st inning and 21 in the 2nd...came back out for the 6th inning and permitted a solo HR to Shohei Ohtani before his exit...will be facing Angels for a 2nd straight start after no starts vs. Halos in clubs' 1st 3 series in '18...is 1-0, 4.76 (6 ER/11.1 IP) in 4 G/2 GS vs. LAA in his career, only other start before last week coming w/ ATL on 6/15/14 at Turner Field (ND, 5.0 IP, 11 H, 3 R-ER)...only career outing at the Big A was in relief on 6/16/17 w/ KC (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, hold)...has gone 5-4, 5.79 (36 ER/56.0 IP) in 11 G/GS on the road in 2018, but has won 3 straight, going 3-0, 3.06 (6 ER/17.2 IP) in away starts since the break w/ 0.79 WHIP...1st Ranger to win 3 straight road starts (zero ND) since Andrew Cashner from 8/30-9/20/17...leads Texas staff with 11 wins and 25 GS...Minor is in his 1st season with the Rangers after signing a 3-year contract on 12/6/17...did not make ML appearance in 2015-16 following surgery for a torn labrum in his left shoulder on 5/13/15...Rangers are 13-12 in Minor's 25 starts.

JURADO'S CAREER MLB DAY-BY-DAY
