RHP Andrew Cashner (4-14, 4.89) vs. RHP Liam Hendriks (0-1, 6.32)

BROTHERS GOTTA HUG: On Tuesday night against the A's, INF Corban Joseph pinch-hit for brother C Caleb Joseph in the bottom of the eighth inning...According to STATS, LLC., Tuesday night marked the first time that a brother pinch-hit for his brother since September 16, 2009 when Adrian Gonzalez pinch-hit for Edgar Gonzalez for the San Diego Padres against the Arizona Diamondbacks...According to Baseball-Reference.com, Tuesday night's Joseph-for-Joseph swap marked the 72nd time in Major League history that a brother pinchhit for his brother... According to STATS, LLC., on June 19, C Caleb Joseph and INF Corban Joseph became the first set of brothers as teammates since Melvin Upton, Jr. and Justin Upton appeared on the roster together for the 2015 San Diego Padres...Cal Ripken, Jr. and Billy Ripken are the only other set of brothers as teammates in Orioles history (since 1954)...Brothers Dick Brown and Larry Brown also played for the Orioles, but did not appear on the O's roster at the same time.

FRESH FACES: With his first appearance, OF DJ Stewart will became the 14th Oriole to make his Major League debut this season...The 14 debuts will match the most in a season in Orioles history (since 1954)...According to STATS, LLC., the mark for most Orioles to debut in a season was set in 1955 (the club's second year in Baltimore) with 14.

PLAYERS CLUB: With his first appearance, OF DJ Stewart will became the 55th player to appear in a game for the Orioles this season.. The 55 players used will mark the most in Orioles history (since 1954), surpassing the 54 players used during the 1955 season...The Orioles have also used 28 pitchers this season, marking the most in O's history (2007, 2009, 2011, and 2016 teams each used 27 pitchers).

MINOR LEAGUE PLAYERS OF THE MONTH: Class A-Advanced Frederick LHP Alex Wells was named the Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month for August...Wells went 3-1 with a 1.97 ERA (7 ER/32.0 IP) in five August starts...He struck out 29 batters, while issuing only four walks, and held opponents to a .188 (22-for-117) batting average...It was Wells' second career Orioles Pitcher of the Month award, also taking home the honors in July 2017...Short-Season A Aberdeen INF Adam Hall was named the Orioles Minor League Player of the Month for August...Hall hit .390 (32-for-82) with four doubles, two triples, a home run, 20 runs scored, 12 RBI, nine walks, and 15 stolen bases in 23 August games...He recorded a career-high 19-game hitting streak during the month (August 4-28), and hit safely in 20-of-23 games overall...Hall was also named Player of the Month for August for the New York-Penn League by Minor League Baseball...Hall led the league in average (.390), on-base percentage (.462), OPS (.987), and stolen bases (15)...He was second in runs scored (20) and third in slugging (.524)...Hall, 19, was selected in the second round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of A.B. Lucas Secondary School in London, Ontario, Canada...Hall will receive an award from Minor League Baseball in recognition of the honor.

EASTERN LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE YEAR: Double-A Bowie LHP Keegan Akin has been named the 2018 Eastern League Pitcher of the Year...Akin is the first Bowie pitcher to win the award since 2008, when RHP Brad Bergesen earned the honor...Akin pitched to a record of 14-7 with 142 strikeouts and a 3.27 ERA (50 ER/137.2 IP) in 25 starts with Bowie this season...He gave up three earned runs or less in 20 of his 25 starts...Akin led the Eastern League in wins (14), strikeouts (142), batting average against (.225), and led all starting pitchers in strikeouts per nine innings (9.28)...He was named to the 2018 Eastern League All-Star Team and was the winner of the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week Award for August 13-19...Akin was a member of the Western Division roster for the 2018 Eastern League All-Star Game in Trenton and struck out two over 1.0 scoreless inning...Akin is rated by MLB.com as the 12th-best prospect in the O's organization, and was selected by the Orioles in the second round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Western Michigan University.

CALIFORNIA LEAGUE HONORS: Despite being traded on July 18, INF Rylan Bannon was named the California League's Most Valuable Player and Rookie of the Year for his efforts with Class A-Advanced Rancho Cucamonga...At the time of the trade, Bannon led the league in home runs (20) and walks (59)...He was tied for second in RBI (61) and was a two-time Player of the Week before being named a mid-season All-Star...Bannon finished the season with Double-A Bowie.

LEADING MAN-CINI: Trey Mancini hit a lead-off home run in the eighth inning on Sept. 1, his 21st homer of the season...He is hitting .325 (50-for-154) when leading off an inning... In 47 games since the All-Star break, he is hitting .276 (51-for-185) with nine home runs and 25 RBI.

BREAKING NEWS: The Orioles rank among league leaders in several major offensive categories since the All-Star break, including ranking first in the AL and second in the majors in batting average at .265 (428-for-1617)...They have recorded 428 hits in 47 games since the All-Star break, ranking second in the AL and eighth in the majors...The O's have hit 62 home runs since the break to rank tied for sixth in the AL and tied for 11th in the majors...The O's .423 slugging percentage ranks seventh in the AL since the break.

QUALITY OVER QUANTITY: RHP Alex Cobb tossed the Orioles 59th Quality Start of the season on Tuesday...The O's 59 Quality Starts this season rank eighth in the AL and 18th in the majors...Cobb leads the club with 15 Quality Starts...O's starters have received 327 runs of support this season, which ranks second-fewest in the majors... Overall, O's pitchers have received 556 runs of support this season, which ranks third-fewest in the majors and ranks second-fewest in the AL.

CEDRIC THE ENTERTAINER: Since making his Major League debut on August 10, OF Cedric Mullins is batting .250 (24-for-96) and 10 of his 24 hits are extra-base hits...Since his debut, Mullins' .250 batting average ranks tied for 10th among AL rookies and ranks tied for 14th in the majors among rookies...His seven doubles since August 10 are tied for fourth in the majors among rookies.

VS. OAKLAND: The Orioles and Athletics play the fifth game of six matchups between the two clubs this season...The A's lead the season series, 4-0...The Orioles visited Oakland, May 4-6...The Orioles won the 2017 season series, 4-3...Baltimore trails Oakland (since 1968) in the all-time series, 265-267, with the Orioles going 130-131 at home and 135-136 in Oakland...From 1954-67, the Orioles owned a 161-116 record against the Philadelphia/Kansas City Athletics.

TRADE WINDS: On July 31, the Orioles acquired RHP Evan Phillips, INF Jean Carlos Encarnación, C Brett Cumberland, LHP Bruce Zimmermann, and International Signing Bonus Slot Money from the Atlanta Braves in exchange for RHP Kevin Gausman and RHP Darren O'Day...Also on July 31, the Orioles acquired INF Jonathan Villar, RHP Luis Ortiz, and INF Jean Carmona from the Milwaukee Brewers in exchange for INF Jonathan Schoop...On July 29, the Orioles traded RHP Brad Brach to the Atlanta Braves in exchange for International Signing Bonus Slot Money...On July 24, the Orioles acquired RHP Dillon Tate, LHP Josh Rogers, and RHP Cody Carroll from the New York Yankees in exchange for LHP Zach Britton...On July 18, the Orioles acquired OF Yusniel Díaz, INF Rylan Bannon, INF Breyvic Valera, RHP Dean Kremer, and RHP Zach Pop from the Los Angeles Dodgers in exchange for INF Manny Machado.

THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY: On this date in 1964, Orioles LHP Frank Bertaina tossed a one-hitter to defeat the Kansas City Athletics, 1-0, at Memorial Stadium...LHP Bob Meyer of the A's also threw a one-hitter in the game...C Johnny Orsino's double to lead off the eighth inning was the O's only hit, and pinch-runner Bob Savarine scored on Jackie Brandt's sacrifice fly for the game's only run... A's catcher Doc Edwards doubled in the fifth inning for the only hit off Bertaina.

DISABLED LIST: Four O's are currently on the disabled list...RHP Gabriel Ynoa (right shoulder inflammation, retroactive to 3/26), RHP Pedro Araujo (right elbow strain, since 6/11), LHP Richard Bleier (left shoulder latissimus strain, retroactive to 6/14), and OF/DH Mark Trumbo (right knee inflammation, since 8/20) are on the 60-day DL

THE SKIPPER: A three-time Manager of the Year (1994, 2004, 2014), Buck Showalter is in his ninth season as Orioles manager...He has managed the Yankees (313-268-1, 1992-95), Diamondbacks (250-236, 1998-2000), Rangers (319-329, 2003-06), and Orioles (663-672, Aug. 2010-current)...Showalter's 1,545 career wins rank 24th all-time and are third among active managers behind Bruce Bochy, Mike Scioscia, and Terry Francona...His 663 wins as O's manager are second-most in club history behind only Earl Weaver (1,480)

QUICK HITS: Cashner will be making his 28th start of 2018...Spent the entire 2017 season with Texas, posting a record of 11-11 with a 3.40 ERA (63 ER/166.2 IP) in 28 starts...His 11 wins marked a career-high, and his 3.40 ERA was the ninth-lowest in the American League...Tossed 18 Quality Starts, which tied for 11th-most in the AL...Signed by the Orioles as a free agent on February 15, 2018.

LAST START: Cashner suffered the loss on September 5 at Seattle after allowing three runs on seven hits with two walks and no strikeouts across 4.2 innings of work...All three runs allowed came on a trio of solo home runs, tying a season-high in home runs allowed (also in his 2018 debut on March 31 vs. Minnesota)or...Was his first start this season in which he did not strike out a batter, and just the third such start of his career (last: September 12, 2016 at Atlanta)...Threw 100 pitches, 58 strikes.

CAREER VS. OAKLAND: Cashner will be making his fifth career start against the Athletics, and his second against them this season...He has gone 0-1 with a 4.57 ERA (11 ER/21.2 IP) with two Quality Starts in his previous four career games against them...Faced Oakland on May 4 and did not factor into the decision of the Orioles 6-4 loss; allowed four runs (three earned) on six hits, two home runs, with three walks and five strikeouts in 4.2 innings.

VS. AL WEST: Cashner will be making his second-straight start against an AL West opponent, and his sixth against the division this season...Has gone 0-2 with a 7.83 ERA (20 ER/23.0 IP) in his five starts against AL West opponents this season; the Orioles are 0-5 in these games... In 31 career appearances (26 starts), he owns a record of 5-12 with a 4.59 ERA (78 ER/153.0 IP)...In his 26 starts against AL West opponents, he has gone 5-12 with a 4.73 ERA (77 ER/146.2 IP) with 14 Quality Starts.

RUNS WANTED: Cashner has received three-or-fewer runs of support in 24 of his 27 starts this season...His 3.16 run support average is the second-lowest in all of baseball... Among pitchers who have thrown at least 140.0 innings, Cashner's 53 total runs of support are the fewest in the majors...He has made 31 career starts in which he did not receive any run support...He has gone 38-11 in 68 career starts when receiving three-ormore runs of support, opposed to being 3-58 in 95 career starts in which he received two-or-fewer runs of support....Since the start of 2013, Cashner's 3.78 run support average is the lowest among all active starting pitchers (min. 600.0 IP).

ATTACKING EARLY: Cashner has allowed an opponent batting average of .267 (120-for-450) on pitches 1-75...When he hits the 76-90 pitch range, opponents are hitting .355 (27-for-76) and they are hitting .323 (20-for-62) when he hits the 91-105 pitch range...Opponents are hitting .286 (2-for-7) on pitches 106 and above...Similar to the pitch count, opponents are hitting .266 (59-for-222) the first time through the order, .269 (57-for-212) the second time through, and .340 (52-for-153) the third time though the lineup.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Cashner has surrendered a career-high 24 home runs on the season, including at least one in 16 of his 27 starts...His 24 home runs allowed rank tied for the 12th-most in the AL and tied for the 16th-most in the majors...His 1.43 HR/9 average this season is the highest of his career; his career average is 0.95 HR/9.

WALK THE LINE: Cashner has issued a pitching staff-high 64 walks, which ranks eighthmost in the AL...He has issued multiple walks in 22 of his 27 starts and at least three walks in 14 starts...He has walked a season-high four batters twice, June 25 vs. Seattle and May 26 at Tampa Bay...He has a 3.81 BB/9 average, which would be the fourth-highest of his career...His career average sits at 3.30 BB/9.

AT HOME: Cashner has made 13 starts at home this season, going 2-6 with a 4.50 ERA (39 ER/78.0 IP)...He has won two of his last three starts at home...He earned his first career win at Oriole Park on 7/27 vs. Tampa Bay...He went 5-5 with a 2.72 ERA (25 ER/82.2 IP) in 14 starts at Globe Life Park for Texas in 2017, which was the fifth-lowest home ERA in the AL...Cashner has gone 29-36 and posted a 3.09 ERA (181 ER/527.2 IP) in 124 career home games (79 starts).


