THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-3 through seven games on their 10-game trip, going 1-3 vs. Kansas City and 3-0 vs. Detroit...tonight they will continue the trip with the final road series of the season...following this weekend's series in Oakland, the Twins will travel home for an off-day Monday, then three against Detroit and four against Chicago-AL (doubleheader next Friday) to complete the 2018 season.

EVEN STEPHEN, TWINS SWEEP TIGERS: The Twins beat the Tigers on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 8-2, earning their sixth sweep this season...Gabriel Moya was the Opener with a scoreless first inning and Stephen Gonsalves relieved with 6.0 scoreless innings...Gonsalves allowed one run, one walk and struck out four, earning his first major league victory...the offense recorded 11 hits, three from both Robbie Grossman and Ehire Adrianza...the final four batters in the lineup recorded all seven RBI, three coming from Willians Astudillo.

ROGER THAT: Taylor Rogers enters tonight with a scoreless inning streak of 22.0 (since July 30)...it's the longest streak by a Twins pitcher since Joe Nathan's streak of 22.2 in 2009...it's the second longest active streak in baseball, trailing Chris Sale (32.0 IP)...the Twins record is 36.0 straight, held by J.C. Romero, from June 26-September 11, 2004...below are the all-time streaks in club history (since 1961):

TWINS AND A'S: The Twins and A's are playing the fifth of seven scheduled games this season...the Twins lost the four-game series at Target Field August 23-26, winning the first game.

- ☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .314 (99-for-315) with 42 walks and a .394 on-base percentage in 87 career games against the A's...he has reached safely in 20 consecutive games vs. the Athletics, dating back to May 5, 2015, posting a .427 OBP in that span.
- ☞ Twins pitching coach Garvin Alston served as Oakland's bullpen coach in 2017...he also served as a coach in the A's system from 2005-15, holding various titles.
- ☞ Gregorio Petit was signed by Oakland as a minor league free agent in July of 2001...he played parts of two seasons with the A's from 2008-09, playing 25 games, hitting .278 (15-for-54) with three doubles and one RBI.

CALI HAS BEEN A BEAR: The Twins have gone just 4-16 in Oakland since the start of 2012...16 losses are tied with New York-AL for the most in an opposing city since then (outside the AL Central)...the Twins last series win in Oakland came in a two-game sweep May 18-19, 2011...the Twins last visit here came July 28-30, 2017, winning game one then getting walked-off in games two and three on home runs by Rajai Davis and Yonder Alonso.

ALL ABOUT ADRIANZA: Ehire Adrianza has started 12 of the Twins last 15 games at third base...he has driven in 11 runs this month in 14 games played, the most on the club for September and tied for 11th most in the AL...additionally, he is hitting .417 (5-for-12) with three walks and a .533 on-base percentage in six career games vs. Oakland.

CAN'T SPELL ASTUDILLO WITHOUT STUD: Willians Astudillo is hitting .317 (20-for-63) with one double, one triple, three home runs, 14 RBI, one walk and just two strikeouts in 21 games for the Twins this season...in his last nine games, he is hitting .375 (12-for-32) with 10 RBI and a .988 OPS...he was signed as a free agent with a spring training invite last November...he has seen playing time for the Twins at catcher (86.1 innings), third base (17.0 innings), second base (9.0 innings), leftfield (2.2 innings), centerfield (1.0 inning) and pitcher (1.0 inning).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2010, the Twins defeated Cleveland by a score of 6-4 and clinched their sixth division title in nine years as Ron Gardenhire earned his 800th managerial win...in 1997, Brad Radke pitched 10 innings to beat the Brewers 2-1 and earned his 20th win...he is one of 13 pitchers in club history to win 20 games and the last Twins starter to pitch 10 innings in a game.

LAST START: Berríos did not factor into the decision in his last start vs. Kansas City on Sept. 14...allowed two runs on five hits and three walks with nine strikeouts over 6.0 innings...second straight quality start after a stretch of four starts without one...nine strikeouts were his most since July 24 vs. Toronto when he struck out nine...allowed a run in the first inning, only his sixth first-inning run allowed this year, tied for fourth fewest in the AL.

YES WAY JOSÉ! Starting pitcher José Berríos was named to the AL All-Star team, the first of his career...Berríos came in for the fifth inning and faced four batters, allowing one walk on 13 pitches, five of which were strikes...it marked the second consecutive season that the Twins have sent a starting pitcher to the All-Star Game (Ervin Santana)...below is a list of Twins starting pitchers to make the ASG:

AGAINST THE OAKLAND: Berríos is making his second career start and second of the year against Oakland...faced the A's on August 26, suffered the loss after allowing three runs on eight hits with four strikeouts over 5.0 innings...in six starts against the AL West this year, is 1-5 with a 5.40 ERA (33.1 IP, 20 ER) with seven walks and 39 strikeouts...in his career against the division is 5-8 with a 5.70 ERA (66.1 IP, 42 ER), second highest ERA against any division (NL Central: 6.04).

ROUGH ROAD: Is 3-7, 4.53 ERA (79.2 IP, 41 ER) in 14 road starts this season and has not earned a win away from Target Field since July 24 at Toronto, pitching 7.0 shutout innings...he is just 1-6 in his last 11 road starts...comparatively, he has gone 8-4, 3.15 ERA (100.0 IP, 35 ER) in 16 starts at Target Field in 2018.

AILING AUGUST: In the month of August, Berríos was 1-1 with a 4.74 ERA (24.2 IP, 13 ER) with 13 walks and 23 strikeouts over five starts...his ERA was the highest of any month for more than a run while he walked more opponents in the month than any other month (in June walked 11 in six starts) while he also had his fewest number of strikeouts...opponents hit .289 with an on-base percentage of .378 and slugging percentage of .443, all highs of any month this year...in September, he's 0-1, 4.50 ERA (16.0 IP, 8 ER) with a .190 opponent average.

TALE OF TWO SEASONS: Has gone 3-6, 4.70 ERA (76.2 IP, 40 ER) with 34 walks and 76 strikeouts in his last 14 starts, dating back to his start at the Cubs June 29...prior to that start he went 8-5, 3.15 ERA (103.0 IP, 36 ER) with 20 walks and 109 strikeouts in 16 starts...before his start on September 8 vs. KC, had a five start stretch in which he went 0-2 with a 6.65 ERA (21.2 IP, 16 ER) with 13 walks and 23 strikeouts...allowed opponents to hit .299 with a .971 OPS while he owned a WHIP of 1.80 over that stretch...didn't last longer than 5.0 innings in any start.

DAY 'N' NIGHT: Berríos has made 17 starts in night games this year and is among the best in baseball, going 8-4 with a 3.00 ERA (105.0 IP, 35 ER) with 27 walks and 113 strikeouts...his ERA is eighth best in the AL while his 0.97 WHIP in night games is fourth best in the AL and eighth in baseball and his 4.19 strikeout-to-walk ratio is 10th in the AL...in day games, Berríos is 3-7 with a 4.94 ERA (74.2 IP, 41 ER) with 27 walks and 72 strikeouts...however, both of his complete games this year have come in day games.

WIZARD OF WHIFF: With his outing on June 7 vs. Chicago-AL, Berríos has now thrown the four most recent 10+ K, 0 run games in Twins history (April 12 vs. Chicago-AL, August 30, 2017 vs. Chicago-AL, May 18, 2017 vs. Colorado)...the last to do it before Berríos was Ervin Santana on August 30, 2015 vs. Houston...now with four games of 10+ strikeouts and 0 walks, he follows Johan Santana (8) and Bert Blyleven (6) for most such performances in Twins history...Berríos is 19th in the American League in strikeout-to-walk ratio at 3.43 and is 11th in the AL with 9.13 strikeouts per nine innings...four 10+ strikeout starts in 2018 and six in his career.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - CHASE DE JONG (SEASON: 0-1, 3.68 ERA + CAREER: 0-4, 5.80 ERA)

De Jong made his second start of the season on September 15 vs. Kansas City, suffered the loss after allowing five runs (3 earned) on eight hits with four strikeouts over 3.1 innings...making his third career appearance and second career start against Oakland...in two career appearances, is 0-0 with a 3.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 4 ER) with five walks and six strikeouts...only start against Oakland was May 16, 2017, allowed four runs on seven hits and three walks with four strikeouts over 6.0 innings but did not factor into the decision.

- Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts.
- Made MLB debut April 27, 2016 vs. Cleveland.
- Named Twins second best prospect entering 2016, as well as best curveball, best changeup, and best control in Twins system by *Baseball America*.
- Named 20th best prospect in baseball by MLB.com entering 2016.
- Started for the World Team in the SiriusXM Futures Games in consecutive seasons, 2014 at Target Field and 2015 at Great American Ball Park in Cincinnati.
- Led all of minor league baseball in strikeouts (175) in 2015.
- Named Southern Pitcher of the Week May 18, 2015, making one start vs. Birmingham, pitching 9.0 shutout innings, allowing two hits and eight strikeouts.
- Named Midseason All-Star in each of the last three minor league seasons: 2015 with Chattanooga, 2014 with Ft. Myers and 2013 with Cedar Rapids.
- Appeared in first career spring training in 2015 with the Twins; reassigned March 15.
