THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-4 through eight games on their 10-game trip, going 1-3 vs. Kansas City, 3-0 vs. Detroit and 0-1 vs. Oakland...tonight they will continue the trip with the second of three in the Bay Area...following this weekend's series in Oakland, the Twins will travel home for an off-day Monday, then three against Detroit and four against Chicago-AL (doubleheader next Friday) to complete the 2018 season.

COLISEUM OF HORRORS: The Twins lost to the A's last night by a score of 7-6 in 10 innings, suffering their 14th walk-off defeat this season...José Berrios was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on four hits in 5.2 innings pitched...Matt Magill suffered the loss, allowing a Khris Davis home run in the 10th inning...the offense recorded nine hits, two from both Jake Cave and Ehire Adrianza...Robbie Grossman hit his fifth home run.

ROGER THAT: Taylor Rogers enters tonight with a scoreless inning streak of 23.1 (since July 30)...it's the longest active streak in baseball...the Twins record is 36.0 straight, held by J.C. Romero, from June 26-September 11, 2004...below are the all-time streaks in club history (since 1961):

TWINS AND A'S: The Twins and A's are playing the sixth of seven scheduled games this season...the Twins are 1-4 this season, entering tonight with four straight losses against Oakland.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .310 (99-for-319) with 43 walks and a .392 on-base percentage in 88 career games against the A's...he has reached safely in 21 consecutive games vs. the Athletics, dating back to May 5, 2015, posting a .414 OBP in that span.

CALIFORNIA IS A BEAR: The Twins have gone just 4-17 in Oakland since the start of 2012...17 losses are the most in an opposing city since then (outside the AL Central)...the Twins last series win in Oakland came in a two-game sweep May 18-19, 2011...the Twins have now been walked-off in three straight games in Oakland, all on home runs by Rajai Davis (7/29/17), Yonder Alonso (7/30/17) and Khris Davis (last night).

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Twins are hitting .307 (81-for-264) with 18 doubles, eight home runs, 41 runs scored (5.9 runs-per-game) and 20 walks in their last seven games...they have double-digit hit totals in five of those and no fewer than nine hits in any of those.

ALL ABOUT ADRIANZA: Ehire Adrianza has started 13 of the Twins last 16 games at third base...he has driven in 12 runs this month in 15 games played, the most on the club for September and tied for 13th most in the AL...additionally, he is hitting .438 (7-for-16) with two doubles, three walks and a .526 on-base percentage in seven career games vs. Oakland.

WHAT YOU TALKIN' 'BOUT WILLIAMS?: Willians Astudillo is hitting .313 (21-for-67) with one double, one triple, three home runs, 14 RBI, one walk and just two strikeouts in 23 games for the Twins this season...in his last 10 games, he is hitting .361 (13-for-36) with 10 RBI and a .934 OPS...he has seen playing time for the Twins at catcher (95.1 innings), third base (17.0 innings), second base (9.0 innings), leftfield (2.2 innings), centerfield (1.0 inning) and pitcher (1.0 inning).

THE REMAINS: The Twins have nine games remaining on the 2018 schedule...two road games and seven home games...six night games and three day games...they play Oakland twice, Detroit three times and Chicago-AL four times, including a doubleheader with the White Sox next Friday (makeup game from weather postponements in mid-April)...the Twins will begin their 2019 schedule with the Indians at Target Field on March 28.

LAST START: De Jong's last start was against Kansas City on September 15, suffered the loss after allowing five runs (three earned) on eight hits with four strikeouts over 3.1 innings...left the game with a runner on second, but Gabriel Moya allowed the run to score on an Alex Gordon double...eight hits are his second most allowed in a game and the most since he allowed nine hits at Cleveland on April 30, 2017...five runs are the most De Jong has allowed since May 11, 2017 when he gave up six runs.

AGAINST OAKLAND: Making his third career appearance and second career start against Oakland...in two career appearances, is 0-0 with a 3.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 4 ER) with five walks and six strikeouts...only start against Oakland was May 16, 2017, allowed four runs on seven hits and three walks with four strikeouts over 6.0 innings but did not factor into the decision...in four appearance against AL West teams, is 0-1 with a 4.32 ERA (16.2 IP, 8 ER) with six walks and nine strikeouts.

DOWN ON THE FARM: De Jong has spent most the season with Double-A Tacoma in the Mariners system, ia 5-6 with a 3.95 ERA (130.0 IP, 57 ER) with 40 walks and 98 strikeouts ...after being acquired by Minnesota on July 30, was assigned to Triple-A Rochester, has made two appearances with the Red Wings and is 0-1 with a 5.79 ERA (9.1 IP, 6 ER) with six walks and nine strikeouts...most recent outing came in relief against Toledo on August 8, allowed one run on three hits and three walks with five strikeouts in 5.2 innings.

ANOTHER FRESH FACE: De Jong is the 13th different starting pitcher the Twins have used this year (not including openers)...he is one of 34 different pitchers to make an appearance this year (including outfielder Ryan LaMarre, infielder Willians Asutdillo, catcher Mitch Garver and catcher Chris Gimenez), tied for third most in the AL with Los Oakland and tied for fourth most in baseball...is the 53rd different Twins player this season, breaking last season's total of 52.

HOW DID I GET HERE?: De Jong was traded to Minnesota along with catcher Ryan Jeffers from Seattle in exchange for LHP Zach Duke on July 30, 2018...this is De Jong's fourth different organization (Seattle 2017-18, Los Angeles-NL 2015-17, Toronto 2012-15).

- Traded from Los-Angeles to Seattle in exchange for RHP Aneury Zabala and SS Drew Jackson
- Was a non-roster invite to spring training and was reassigned to minor league camp March 9
- Spent most of the season with Triple-A Tacoma, was 3-6, 6.00 ERA (84.0 IP, 56 ER) with 27 walks and 61 strikeouts in 15 starts
- Made MLB debut April 5 at Houston, suffered the loss after allowing a three-run walk-off home run to George Springer.
- Made first career start April 30 at Cleveland, suffered the loss after allowing six runs on nine hits and two walks with a strikeout over 2.2 innings.
