THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-5 through nine games on their 10-game trip, going 1-3 vs. Kansas City, 3-0 vs. Detroit and 0-2 vs. Oakland...today they will complete the trip with the three-game series finale at Oakland...following today's game, the Twins will travel home for an off-day tomorrow, then three against Detroit and four against Chicago-AL (doubleheader next Friday) to complete the 2018 season.

ANOTHER WALK-OFF...SERIOUSLY.....: The Twins lost to the Athletics last night by a score of 3-2 in walk-off fashion...Chase De Jong was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits on 4.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded seven hits, three from Willians Astudillo.

TWINS AND A'S: The Twins and A's are playing the seventh of seven scheduled games this season...the Twins are 1-5 this season, entering today with five straight losses against Oakland.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .311 (100-for-322) with 43 walks and a .390 on-base percentage in 89 career games against the A's...he has reached safely in 22 consecutive games vs. the Athletics, dating back to May 5, 2015, posting a .407 OBP in that span.

CALIFORNIA IS A BEAR: The Twins have gone just 4-18 in Oakland since the start of 2012...18 losses are the most in an opposing city since then (outside the AL Central)...the Twins last series win in Oakland came in a two-game sweep May 18-19, 2011.

THE REMAINS: The Twins have eight games remaining on the 2018 schedule...one road game and seven home games...five night games and three day games...they play Oakland once, Detroit three times and Chicago-AL four times, including a doubleheader with the White Sox next Friday (makeup game from weather postponements in mid-April)...the Twins will begin their 2019 schedule with the Indians at Target Field on March 28.

PLACE YOUR BETS: Twins rookies are finishing the season with the Twins Triple Crown on this roadtrip...results to this point:

☞ **TWINTUCKY DERBY (raced in Kansas City at Kauffman Stadium):** Jake Cave, and horse Willians, was the winner...second place was Stephen Gonsalves...Willians Astudillo (horse Willito) was disqualified for "not galloping"...Matt Magill (horse Gidgit) and Kohl Stewart (horse Gronkowski) tied for last place...Alan Busenitz and horse Peaches, had trouble with the track and took a tumble. Peaches lost some stuffing but cleared to race again.

☞ **THE TWINSNESS (raced in Detroit at Comerica Park):** Kohl Stewart, and horse Gronkowski, went from worst to first, this after extensive video review...John Curtiss (horse Tejano Caballo) was originally the winner but after officials went under the hood and accepted the unconventional "Gronk Gallop", Curtiss claimed second place, and Jake Cave placed third...Johnny Field was disqualified for what the officials deemed "really aggressive galloping"...pretty much running full bore....

☞ **TWINSMONT STAKES:** Will take place today at The Granddaddy of Them All, Oakland's Coliseum...odds on favorite are Jake Cave, horse Willians and Kohl Stewart, horse Gronkowski...Willians Astudillo has yet to figure out what galloping is but if he does could be a dark horse...Astudillo recently exclaimed that all his horses have been "fed, watered and rested"...long shots to complete today's Twins Triple Crown are Alan Busenitz and Matt Magill...the Communications Dept's money is on Elvis Martinez and his horse Paco

☞ **FUN FACTS ON THE TWINSMONT STAKES:** There are exactly 151 years between the Twinsmont Stakes and the Belmont Stakes (began in 1867)...race type in the actual Belmont Stakes is Thoroughbred; the Twinsmont is mostly rookie baseball players...distance in the Belmont is 1.5 miles, compared to Twinsmont going roughly 150 feet...Belmont surface: dirt, Twinsmont: Kentucky Bluegrass...Belmont track: left-handed, Twinsmont: go straight and don't fall down...Belmont qualifications: 3 year-old thoroughbreds, Twinsmont: lack of service time...Belmont Purse: \$1.5 million, Twinsmont: pride, don't get humiliated.

LAST START: Gibson earned his eighth win of the year after allowing five runs on 11 hits with six strikeouts over 6.2 innings...win snapped a four-game losing, which tied a season long...11 hits are tied for the second most in his career and of the season, last coming June 27 at Chicago-AL...first start without a walk since July 12 vs. Tampa Bay...his six strikeouts are his most since striking out six against Cleveland on July 31.

900 IP MARK: On September 3, he surpassed the 900 career innings pitched mark, which ranks third most on the Twins and most among players on the active roster...here's how he stacks up against his teammates with the most innings pitched:

AGAINST THE ATHLETICS: Gibson is making his fourth career start against Oakland, is 1-2 with a 5.40 ERA (15.0 IP, 9 ER) with 10 walks and seven strikeouts all-time...last start against Oakland was May 4, 2017, suffered the loss after allowing four runs on eight hits and three walks with three strikeouts over 4.0 innings...only career win over the A's was May 6, 2015, shut out Oakland over 6.0 innings on four hits and two walks with a strikeout...against the AL West this year, is 0-2 with a 3.77 ERA (28.2 IP, 12 ER) with 12 walks and 23 strikeouts.

SWING AND A MISS: Thus far in 2018, Gibson has recorded 169 strikeouts through 30 starts and owns a strikeout rate of 21.9 percent and a swing-and-miss rate of 26.5 percent, 11th best in the AL...his career strikeout rate is 17.2 percent while his career swing-and-miss rate is 23.1 percent.

THAT'S KYLE WITH A K: Gibson has improved his strikeouts-per-9.0 innings rate nearly every year in his career, setting a career-high in 2017 with 6.89 K/9...through 30 starts in 2018, Gibson is striking out 8.30 batters-per-9.0 innings.

KILLING TWO BIRDS WITH ONE STONE: Gibson induced 26 double plays in 2017, ranking third in the AL...his 1.48 GIDP/9 ranked fourth in baseball among pitchers who threw more than 150 innings in 2017...since 2014, Gibson has induced the most GIDP in the majors with 117 and is second in GIDP/9 with 1.22 (Martin Perez - 1.58...has induced 21 double plays in 2018, most on the team and third most in the AL and owns a 1.03 GIDP/9 rate, good for third in the AL...now has induced at least 20 GIDPs in each of his last five seasons.

RISP-Y BUSINESS: Gibson has held opponents to a .205 average (30-for-146) with runners in scoring position, third best in the AL and 11th best in baseball...of those 30 hits, seven have gone for extra bases (two home runs, five doubles) and has struck out 36 batters...over his career, his opponents are hitting .261 (212-for-813) with RISP.

NEED SOME RUNS: Gibson has been given 77 runs of support this year but only has a run support average of 3.78, fourth lowest in the AL...in 13 of his 30 starts, he has been supported with one or fewer runs and has been given more than three runs nine times...has been given two runs or fewer in eight of his last 11 starts...in five starts against the AL West, he has a run support average of 4.08.

ROAD WOES: In Gibson's first 11 road starts this year, he was 3-3 with a 2.94 ERA (70.1 IP, 23 ER) with an opponent average of .198 and 70 strikeouts on the road, all ranking among the best in baseball...since August 6, however, Gibson is 2-4 with a 5.30 ERA (35.2 IP, 21 ER) with 13 walks and 27 strikeouts in six road starts.

- Given 2015 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA.
- His 2.85 ERA pre-ASG in 2015 was the fourth-lowest for a Twins starter since 1992 with a minimum of 80.0 IP (Liriano - 1.83 in 2006, Santana - 2.75 in 2007, Radke - 2.77 in 1998).
- In 2014, his first full season in the majors, became one of three pitchers in Twins history to win each of their first three games while posting a sub-1.00 ERA.
- Earned the win in his MLB debut 6/29/13 vs. KC allowing three runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings.
- Named the Twins Minor League Player of the Week for May 12, 2013 after tossing a CG SHO.
- Named an Arizona Fall League Rising star in 2012 and the AFL Player of the Week, 10/23/12.
- Selected to the 2011 Futures Game where he tossed 1.1 inning, allowing two hits.
- Named to the 2010 Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star Team.
- Named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week, May 3, 2010.
- Selected in the first round (22nd overall) by the Twins in the 2009 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Missouri as a senior...major was communications.
- Originally selected by Philadelphia in the 36th round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft out of Greenfield Central High School in Greenfield, IN.
- Named to the All-Big 12 honorable mention team in 2007 and 2008 and All-Big 12 First-Team in 2009 as the Tigers' Friday night starter.
