OAKLAND NOTES

- The A's improved to 36-15 in their last 51 games against the Red Sox in Oakland.
- A's starting pitchers have thrown 6.0 innings each of the last five games and have a 0.30 ERA in that span (1 ER in 30.0 IP)... have a .115 opposing batting average (11-for-96) in that span.
- **Khris Davis** has five home runs in the first seven games of the season. He joins Mark McGwire (5 in 1992) and Reggie Jackson (5 in 1974) as the only A's with at least five home runs in the first seven games of the season.
- **Fernando Rodney** made his 900th career appearance, tying Arthur Rhodes for 25th on the all-time list.
- The A's have hit 12 home runs in their first seven games, trailing only the 1994 A's (15) for most in Oakland A's history.
- **Ramón Laureano** recorded his first assist of the season, throwing out Xander Bogaerts at home in the second inning... he had 9 outfield assists in 47 games last season.
- **Ramón Laureano** hit his first home run of the season, snapping a 24-game drought dating back to September 7, 2018.
- **Jurickson Profar** snapped an 0-for-15 streak with a single in the fourth inning.

- The Red Sox have been outscored 41-24 in their first five games of the season.
- **David Price** appeared in his 300th career game and snapped his streak of six consecutive starts with 7.0 innings pitched against Oakland...he allowed three home runs in six innings after allowing four in his previous 68.0 innings pitched.
- After allowing one run in their previous 14.0 innings pitched, Red Sox relievers allowed three runs in two innings on Monday night.
- **Rafael Devers** (0-for-3, BB) snapped a streak of hitting safely in each of the first four games.
