OAKLAND NOTES

- The A's have hit 13 home runs in their first eight games of the season. That is three behind the 1957 A's who hit 16 in the first eight games.
- **Mike Fiers** threw his second straight start of six scoreless innings this season...he also improved to 3-0 with a 1.09 ERA (3 ER in 24.2 IP) in four career starts against Boston.
- The A's have shutout the Red Sox in back-to-back games for the second time over the last 88 years. The other time was August 30-31, 1996.
- Oakland has scored 19 of their 31 runs this season via the long ball.
- A's starting pitchers have thrown exactly six innings in each of the last six games...they have a 0.25 ERA (1 ER in 36.0 IP) and a .134 opponent batting average (16-for-119) over the last six games.
- **Matt Chapman** extended his hitting streak to six games and is batting .400 (8-for-20) in that span with one double, two home runs, and three RBI.
- **Marcus Semien** (0-for-4) snapped his seven-game hitting streak...he was 10-for-26 during the streak.
- **Ramón Laureano** recorded his second outfield assist, throwing out Xander Bogaerts at third base... he now has 11 assists in 56 games dating back to last season, the most in MLB.

BOSTON NOTES

- **J.D. Martinez** (1-for-4) has hit safely in each of the Red Sox first six games this season and is batting .360 (9-for-25) in that span...he is 8-for-18 against Fiers in his career.
- **Chris Sale** has allowed four home runs in 9.0 innings this season after allowing just 11 home runs all of 2018.
- Red Sox starting pitchers have allowed 12 home runs in 27.0 innings pitched this season.
- **Chris Sale** snapped his streak of six consecutive starts with eight or more strikeouts against the A's dating back to September 11, 2014...he had just one strikeout in seven innings.
- The Red Sox have now lost four straight games...Their longest losing streak was three games (three times) during 2018.
- The Red Sox have been shut out in back-to-back games... Boston was shut out seven times last season and never in consecutive games.
