## **OAKLAND NOTES**

- Marco Estrada's 5 1/3 innings pitched snapped a sixgame streak of A's starting pitchers throwing exactly six innings... A's starters still have a 0.65 ERA (3 ER in 41.1 IP) over the last seven games.
- 21 of the A's 34 total runs this season have been scored via home run.
- Nick Hundley earned his first RBI as an Athletic after a line drive single in the second inning...he had 31 RBI last season with San Francisco.
- Swihart's home run snapped the A's 25-inning scoreless streak, which was tied for the longest scoreless innings streak by an A's team since May 31-June 2, 2006.
- Matt Chapman has reached base safely in all nine games this season after being hit by a pitch in the first inning.
- Marcus Semien recorded his first stolen base of the season and just the A's second in 2019... Semien led the A's with 14 stolen bases last season.
- Ramón Laureano's home run in the fourth inning was the first home run Eovaldi has allowed in seven career starts against the A's (38.0 IP).

## **BOSTON NOTES**

- J.D. Martinez (1-for-3) has hit safely in each of the Red Sox first seven games this season and is batting .357 (10-for-28) in that span.
- Nathan Eovaldi walked four batters, snapping a streak of 1 or 0 walks in each of his last four starts against Oakland dating back to May 30, 2015.
- Blake Swihart (3-for-4) snapped the Red Sox 22-inning scoreless streak with a solo home run in the fifth inning...he had three home runs in 82 games with Boston last season.
- Mitch Moreland (1-for-4, 2B, 2 RBI) is now batting .285 (47-for-165) with 36 RBI in his career at the Coliseum.
- Jackie Bradley Jr. (1-for-4) is now batting .185 (5-for-27) to start the season.
