<ul> <li>Oakland is 11-4 in the last 15 games against Houston (since Aug. 15, 2019), including 8-1 at the Oakland Coliseum.</li> <li>Oakland leads Houston by 5.5 games in the AL West, the largest lead they've had this season (5.0 games on Aug. 9).</li> <li>Frankie Montas allowed just two runs in his 5.0 innings of workover his three previous starts he was 0-2 with a 16.76 ERA (18 er, 9.2 ip)began the season 2-1 with a 1.57 ERA (4 er, 23.0 ip) in his first four starts of the year.</li> <li>Khris Davis hit his second home run of the season (also: Aug. 3 at Seattle)had not started a game since Aug. 26 at Texascollected two extra-base hits after entering the game with three all season (two doubles, one home run).</li> <li>Jake Diekman tossed a scoreless sixth inninghas not allowed a run in 15 games this season spanning 15.0 inningsdating back to last season, has a career-high 18.2-inning scoreless streak since Sept. 16, 2019.</li> <li>Oakland is playing their second of five double-headers today the last time Oakland played five doubleheaders in a season was in 1986the first DH this year was on Aug. 29 at Houston and the A's were swept (2-4, 3-6).</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Houston has lost a season-high six games in a row (had 5-game losing streak Aug. 5-9)the last time the club lost six in a row was a seven-game streak June 16-22, 2019.</li> <li>Zack Greinke was dealt just his second loss since joining Houstonin 19 prior starts, he was 11-1 with a 3.00 ERA (38 er, 114.0 ip)his last loss came on Sept. 3, 2019 at Milwaukeebetween losses he was 7-0 with a 2.51 ERA (20 er, 71.2 ip) with 69 strikeoutsallowed four earned runs in 6.0 innings of work, the first time he's allowed four earned runs or more since Sept. 20, 2019 vs. Los Angeles-ALvs. OAK, entered the day 9-2 with a 2.74 ERA (32 er, 105.0 ip) in 20 games including 16 starts against the A's.</li> <li>Michael Brantley recorded a season-high tying three hits, his third three-hit game of the season (last: Sept. 3 vs. Texas).</li> <li>George Springer extended his hitting streak to seven games during the streak, he's hitting .357 (10-for-28) with eight runs, one double, one triple, two home runs and three RBI.</li> <li>Carlos Correa had his five-game hitting streak snappedduring the streak he had three multi-hit gamesduring the streak, he hit .400 (8-for-20) with three runs, two doubles, one home run and two RBI.</li> </ul>
