OAKLAND ATHLETICS (57-46) VS. LOS ANGELES ANGELS (51-50)

THURSDAY, JULY 29, 2021 — ANGEL STADIUM — 6:38 PDT

ABOUT THE A'S: Snapped their four-game losing streak yesterday with a 10-4 win at San Diego...the losing streak was the A's second longest this year to the season-opening six-game losing streak...are 2-7-2 over the last 11 series...are 5-6 (.455) since the All-Star Break and 13-19 (.406) over the last 32 games...however, are 57-46 (.553) for the season, which is the fifth best record in the American League...are in second place in the AL West for the 34th consecutive day and trail first place Houston by a season-high six games for the second consecutive day...are in second place in the AL Wild Card, 3½ games behind Tampa Bay and two games ahead of the third place team, Seattle...have spent 58 days alone in first place in the West, three days tied for first, 35 days in second, one day tied for second, three days in third, two days in fourth, three days tied for fourth and 10 days in fifth.

AGAINST THE WEST: The A's are in a stretch from July 19 to Aug. 8 where they are scheduled to play 13 of 17 games against American League West teams... are 3-3 against the West during the stretch...are now 22-23 (.489) against AL West competition overall compared to 35-23 (.603) against all other teams... have never made the playoffs with a losing record against the West.

A's IN JULY: The A's are 9-12 (.429) in the month of July with three games remaining...that snaps a streak of streak of 10 consecutive months with a winning record (min. 10 games) dating back to May of 2019...need to win each of the next three games to avoid their first losing month since April of 2019 when they went 11-15...the A's .429 winning percentage in July is fifth lowest in the American League but their 3.34 ERA (70 er in 188.2 ip) is the lowest in the AL and third lowest in the majors...have the second lowest opponents OPS (.646) in the AL...have the second fewest runs scored (84) and the third lowest batting average (.230) and OPS (.689) in the AL...have outscored the opposition 84-77.

PITCHING: The A's have allowed at least four runs in each of the last five games (24 er in 41.2 ip, 5.18 ERA) but have a 3.28 ERA (172 er in 471.2 ip) over the last 53 games dating back to May 26, which is second lowest in the majors over that span (Brewers, 2.81)...have the third lowest opponents OPS (.659)...overall, rank fifth in the American League in ERA (3.76), opponents on-base percentage (.303), slugging percentage (.388) and OPS (.691)...have issued the fewest walks (276), rank second in fewest pitches per inning (15.9) and third in shutouts (8) and fewest home runs (111).

STARTING PITCHING: The A's have used the same five starting pitchers over the last 70 games dating back to May 7...over the last 17 years, the only time the A's have used the same five starting pitchers over a span of at least 70 games was April 25-Aug. 9, 2013 when they did it over a 92-game stretch (Colon, Griffin, Milone, Parker, Straily)...have employed just seven starting pitchers overall, which is second fewest in the majors to the Red Sox (6)... have four pitchers with 20 or more starts for the first time since 2013 when they had five...starters are 39-35 with a 3.71 ERA (244 er in 591.1 ip) for the season...rank third in the American League in ERA and wins and fifth in opponents OPS (.692)...lead the majors in innings pitched (591.1) and are tied for second in complete games (3).

BULLPEN: The A's bullpen allowed four runs yesterday after yielding one earned run or fewer in each of the previous 15 games...now has a 2.12 ERA (11 er in 46.2 ip) and .207 (35-for-169) opponents batting average over the last 16 games but is 2-2 with four saves and four blown saves...has converted 25-of-40 (62.5%) save opportunities for the season...has 11 losses, which is the fewest in the majors...ranks fifth in the AL in ERA (3.84) and opponents OPS (.688)...has the highest slugging percentage against first batters faced (.475), the second highest batting average (.272) and fourth highest on-base percentage (.333).

OFFENSE: The A's had 11 hits in both games at San Diego and are now batting .259 (53-for-205) in six games on the road trip after hitting .212 over the previous 20 games...are hitting .234 overall, which is fifth lowest in the American League...rank eighth in batting with RISP (.260)...lead the AL in hit by pitches (57), rank second in sacrifice flies (34), third in fewest grounded into double plays (59), fourth in stolen base percentage (79.6%) and sacrifice hits (14) and tied for fifth in walks (343)...A's pinch hitters lead the AL in hits (23), RBI (16), sacrifice flies (3) and plate appearances (102), are tied for the lead in home runs (3), rank second in extra base hits (6) and tied for second in doubles (3).

DEFENSIVE DOINGS: The A's have a six-game errorless streak and have made just three errors over the last 15 games...have 44 for the season, which is second fewest in the American League (Astros, 41)...are tied for the fourth fewest double plays (75)...A's pitchers have five pickoffs, which is tied for fourth most...A's outfielders have nine assists, which is tied for second fewest to the Angels (8).

ONE-RUN GAMES AND OTHER CLOSE CALLS: The A's have lost each of their last four one-run games, 11 of the last 14 and are 15-18 (.455) overall...lead the American League in one-run games (33) and losses...are 22-26 (.458) in games decided by two runs or fewer compared to 35-20 (.636) in games decided by three runs or more...are 4-3 in extra innings and the seven extra inning games are tied for third fewest in the AL...are 12-7 in games decided in the last at bat...have eight walk-off wins, which is tied with the Mariners for the most in the AL...now have 91 walk-off wins in the Bob Melvin era, which are the most in the majors over that span.

HOME AND AWAY: The A's are 2-4 on this 10-game road trip to Seattle (1-3), San Diego (1-1) and Los Angeles-AL (four games)...are now 8-13 on the road dating back to June 19 after starting the year 19-9 in away games...this is the second of three 10-game road trips this year and it is part of a stretch from July 6 to Aug. 19 where the A's are scheduled to play 26 of 36 games on the road...are 8-9 over the first 16 games of that stretch (5-7 on the road, 3-2 at home)...are 27-22 (.551) on the road compared to 30-24 (.556) at home... went 3-2 on the last homestand against Cleveland (1-2) and Los Angeles-AL (2-0)...return home following the game Sunday for a five-game homestand against San Diego (two games) and Texas (three games).

HOME AND AWAY SPLITS: The A's are batting .248 (421-for-1700) and are averaging 4.73 runs per game on the road (232 runs in 49 games) compared to .221 with an average of 4.13 runs per game at home...have the thir best road batting average and OPS (.740) in the American League...have the second lowest home batting average and third lowest OPS (.695)...have a 3.77 ERA (178 er in 424.2 ip) on the road, which is second lowest in the AL (Astros, 3.74)...have 62 home runs in 54 games at home, 66 in 49 on the road.

THE INJURED LIST: The A's have used the injured list 18 times this year...used it just eight times last year, which was second fewest in the majors to Cleveland (4), and 18 times in 2019, which tied for second fewest...currently have three players on the IL (Fiers, Pinder, Rosenthal), which matches the A's fewest players on the IL since the third game of the season.

THIS AND THAT: The A's are 25-15 (.625) in games in which the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher compared to 32-31 (.508) when they start a right-hander...the mark against lefties is second best in the American League (White Sox, 19-10/.655) and the 40 games are third most...are 35-8 (.814) when out-homering the opposition, 8-26 (.235) when they are out-homered...have used a different lineup in each of the last 40 games and have 100 different lineups over the first 103 contests.

A's vs. ANGELS: The A's lead the season series 9-3 and need one more win to clinch the season series for the third consecutive season...are 28-13 (.683) against the Angels over the last three years...are 2-1 in Anaheim this year and went 7-2 in Oakland...the seven home wins matched the A's most home wins against the Angels...have a 2.61 ERA (31 er in 107.0 ip) and have outscored the Angels 61-35...since moving to Oakland in 1968, the A's are 465-389 against the Angels...that includes 247-184 in Oakland and 218-205 in Anaheim...all-time, the A's are 514-465 against the Angels.

TODAY'S TIDBITS

Matt Olson ranks third in the American League in OPS (.956), tied for third in home runs (27), fourth in slugging percentage (.584), tie for fourth in extra base hits (51), tied for seventh in RBI (67), tied for eighth in runs (67) and doubles (24) and ninth in on-base percentage (.372)...Starling Marte ranks third in the majors in stolen bases (22)...based on a minimum of 250 plate appearances, he ranks fifth in on-base percentage (.407) and 12th in batting average (.306)...Sergio Romo has not allowed a run in his last 11 games (11.2 ip, 2 h, 2 bb, 13 so) and opponents are 2-for-35 (.057) over that span...Lou Trivino has converted each of his last nine save opportunities dating back to June 5 and has a 1.23 ERA (3 er in 22.0 ip) and .197 (15-for-76) opponents batting average in 21 games over that span.

THIS DATE IN ATHLETICS HISTORY

In **1969** Reggie Jackson becomes the first Oakland Athletic to hit 40 home runs when he hits a solo shot in the first inning of the A's 6-5 win against the New York Yankees...a young rookie named Vida Blue recorded his first major league win in that game...in **1989** Rickey Henderson steals five bases but the A's lose **14**-6 to Seattle...in **1992** Dennis Eckersley saves his 33rd consecutive game to set what was then a Major League record with 36 consecutive saves dating back to **1991**...he would save 36 straight to start the season for a total of 40 consecutive saves...in **2017** Rajai Davis' walkoff home run give the A's a 5-4 win over Minnesota as Bob Melvin wins his 1000th game as a manager.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Frankie Montas (8-8, 4.34 ERA)

FOR STARTERS: Is 3-4 with a 3.81 ERA (25 er in 59.0 ip), .236 (53-for-225) opponents average and five home runs allowed over his last 10 starts dating back to May 29 after going 5-4 with a 4.92 ERA, .274 opponents average and 11 home runs over his first 10 starts...is tied for 10th in the American League in wins but is tied for seventh in losses...the wins are one short of his career high of nine in 2019...has career highs in nearly every other category including games started (20), innings pitched (112.0), strikeouts (122), losses (8), hits (113), runs (59), earned runs (54), walks (30) and home runs (16).

STRIKEOUTS: Struck out 10 batters in his last start and now has 27 strikeouts and just three walks in his last three starts (18.2 ip)...it was his third game of 10 or more strikeouts this year, which matches Rich Hill (2016) and Sean Manaea (2021) for the most by an A's pitcher in a single season over the last 19 years...it was his sixth career 10-strikeout game, which is tied for sixth most in Oakland history and matches Manaea for the most over the last 20 years.

BY MONTH: Has had a roller coaster season with his ERA as he posted a mark of 6.20 in April, 3.18 in May and 5.28 in June...currently has a 2.96 ERA (8 er in 24.1 ip) in four starts in July...posted a 2-2 record in April, 3-3 in May and 2-2 in June...is 1-1 in July.

OPPONENTS BATTING: Has a .206 (33-for-160) opponents batting average the first time through the order, .282 (80-for-284) with 11 of his 16 home runs after that...has a .304 (35-for-115) opponents batting average against the opponents one and two hitters but has held the three and four hitters to a .202 (21-for-104) average.

THIS AND THAT: Has four no decisions this year, three of which have come in extra inning games...the A's won one of those games and are 9-11 (.450) in his starting assignments...has tossed seven innings or fewer in all 20 of his starts, including six innings or fewer 17 times...has received two runs of support or fewer in 11 of his 20 starts, including nine of his last 12.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS: Took the loss in his first start on April 5 against Los Angeles (NL)...allowed seven runs in a season-low 2.2 innings and walked a season-high three batters...tossed 90 pitches, which were the most by an A's pitcher in an outing of fewer than three innings since pitch counts were tracked beginning in 1988...the loss extended his losing streak to a careerhigh three games dating back to Sept. 13, 2020...then picked up the win in each of his next two starts and allowed just one run on eight hits in 12.0 innings...won 7-3 at Houston on April 10 and then combined with Romo, Diekman and Wendelken on a four-hit shutout in the A's 3-0 victory over Detroit on April 16...allowed six runs on a season-high nine hits in 4.0 innings against Minnesota on April 21 but had a no decision in the A's 13-12, 10-inning win...allowed three home runs in a start for the second time in his career (Sept. 22, 2020 vs. Los Angeles-NL)...had a season-high 105 pitches in a 4-3 loss at Tampa Bay on April 27...finished April 2-2 with a 6.20 ERA in five starts...then went 3-3 with a 3.18 ERA in six starts in May...the three wins matched his most ever in a month and he had 38 strikeouts, which tied for eighth in the American League...won each of his first three starts in May and posted a 3.12 ERA over that stretch from May 3-14...then went 0-3 with a 3.24 ERA over his next three starts from May 19-29...the losing streak matched his career high...struck out 11 batters in 6.0 innings in a 4-2 loss to Seattle on May 24...it was one of three games with 10 or more strikeouts (10, July 8 at Houston; 10, July 23 at Seattle) and the second highest single-game total of his career to his 13 against the Mariners in the final game of the 2020 season...now has six career 10-strikeout games...walked a season-high tying three...tossed a season-high 7.0 innings June 15 against Los Angles (AL) and allowed just two runs for the win...then surrendered a season-high eight runs on a season-high tying nine hits in 5.2 innings at Texas on June 21 for the loss...is 1-1 with a 3.07 ERA (10 er in 29.1 ip) in five starts since then... started consecutive games that went extra innings on June 26 at San Francisco and July 2 against Boston...issued a season-high tying three walks in each contests.

LAST START: He had a no decision in the A's 4-3 loss at Seattle last Friday... struck out 10 batters and walked just one in 6.0 innings...yielded back-to-back home runs to Raleigh (two-run) and Torrens (solo) in the second innings, but those were the only runs he would allow...retired 15 of the final 17 batters he faced...the A's scored single runs in the third, fourth and fifth innings and he was relieved by Diekman to start the seventh with the score tied 3-3.

Oakland...blanked the Angels on two hits over the first four innings but then allowed four runs in the fourth inning, all unearned...the last A's pitcher with at least four unearned runs in a game was Montas on April 29, 2019 against Boston (6)...the A's were shutout on three hits by Cobb, Watson and Iglesias... then picked up the win in a 6-4 victory in Oakland on June 15... allowed a RBI single to Upton in the third inning but the A's came back with two in the bottom of the third...yielded a RBI single to Fletcher in the fifth to tie the game at 2-2 but the A's scored three times in the sixth to take the lead for good... was relieved by Luzardo to start the eighth with the A's leading 5-2...was 0-0 with a 5.19 ERA (8.2 ip, 10 h, 5 r, 5 er, 6 bb, 10 so, 1 hr) in two starts last year, both extra inning A's wins.

2020 RECAP: Was off to a strong start as he was 2-1 with a 1.57 ERA, .175 opponents batting average and no home runs over his first four starts...was scratched from his scheduled start on Aug. 14 at San Francisco with upper back tightness and went 1-4 with an 8.70 ERA, .321 opponents average and 10 home runs over his final seven starts...went 3-5 with a 5.60 ERA in 11 starts overall...his ERA was eighth highest in the majors among pitchers with at least 50 innings pitched...had career highs in losses (5) and earned runs (33) and matched his high in home runs (10), runs (35) and walks (23)...led the A's in strikeouts (60), losses, runs, home runs and walks...his opponents batting average broke down to .198 (22-for-111) against right-handed hitters compared to .350 (35-for-100) against left-handers...surrendered six of his 10 home runs and issued 15 of his 23 walks to lefties for a 1.061 OPS (.572 against right-handers).
