OAKLAND ATHLETICS (68-49) VS. TEXAS RANGERS (41-76)

SUNDAY, AUGUST 15, 2021 — GLOBE LIFE FIELD — 1:35 CDT LHP SEAN MANAEA (8-7, 3.43) VS. LHP KOLBY ALLARD (2-10, 4.93) NBCSCA — A'S CAST ON IHEART RADIO — A'S RADIO NETWORK (960 AM, 103.7 FM HD2, 1140 AM)

ABOUT THE A'S: The A's hit a season-high five home runs to beat the Rangers 8-3 last night and have won 12 of the last 15 games...are 19 games over .500 which matches their season high from two days ago...are tied for the third best record in the American League and tied for sixth best in the majors...are 9-2 (.800) in August, which is the best record in the majors...are in second place in the AL West for the 51st consecutive day (dating back to June 21) and trail first place Houston by 2½ games...were ½-game back on June 30... are in first place in the AL Wild Card, one game ahead of the second Wild Card (Red Sox) and 3½ games ahead of the third place team (Yankees)...have spent 58 days alone in first place in the West, three days tied for first, 51 days in second, one day tied for second, three days in third, two days in fourth, three days tied for fourth and 10 days in fifth.

THIS AND THAT: The A's are 27-16 (.628) in games in which the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher compared to 41-33 (.554) when they start a right-hander...are 3-1 in this stretch of 15 games in 15 days from Aug. 10-24...are scheduled to play 22 of their next 30 games against non-division foes before concluding the season with 16 straight games against the West... have used a different lineup in each of the last 54 games and have 114 different lineups over the first 117 contests.

AGAINST THE WEST: This three-game series with Texas concludes a stretch that began on July 19 where the A's were scheduled to play 13 of 17 games against American League West teams...are 9-5 against the West during the stretch...are now 28-25 (.528) against AL West competition overall compared to 36-24 (.600) against all other teams...beginning Tuesday, the A's are scheduled to play 26 of their next 34 games against non-division foes before concluding the season with 16 straight games against the American League West.

OFFENSE: The A's are batting .283 (110-for-389) in August, which is tied for second best in the majors...have the highest on-base percentage (.376) and OPS (.870), and fewest strikeouts (80) in the majors this month...are second in stolen bases (15)...they are now batting .237 overall, which is sixth lowest in the American League but one point shy of the season high of .238 (last on June 25)...hit .225 last year but the lowest batting average in a full season in Oakland history is .236 in 1982...have been hit by a pitch 23 times in the last 24 games and 73 times overall for the season, which is the most in the AL, third most in the majors and fourth most in Oakland history (88 in 2001, 87 in 2019, 76 in 2018)...rank third in the AL in stolen base percentage (82.2%), tied for fourth in fewest grounded into double plays (72), and fifth in sacrifice flies (35), walks (401), and sacrifice hits (15)...Oakland pinch hitters lead the American League in hits (24), sacrifice flies (3) and plate appearances (108), are tied for the lead in home runs (3), rank second in RBI (17) and extra base hits (6) and are tied for second in doubles (3).

PITCHING: The A's have allowed four or fewer runs in eight of their last nine games...had their third shutoout in the previous 12 games on Thursday and their 11th of the season, which is tied with the Blue Jays for the most in the American League...have a 2.53 ERA (36 er in 128.0 ip) over the last 14 games and now have a 3.61 ERA for the season, which is the lowest in the AL and fourth lowest in the majors...also have the lowest opponents slugging percentage in the American League (.376), the third lowest OPS (.675) and fourth lowest on-base percentage (.299)...have issued the fewest walks (313), allowed the fewest home runs (119) and averaged the fewest pitches per inning (15.8).

STARTING PITCHING: A's starting pitchers are 7-3 with a 2.87 ERA (27 er in 85.2 ip) and .226 (72-for-318) opponents batting average over the last 15 contests...are 45-38 with a 3.63 ERA (271 er in 671.0 ip) overall...are tied for second in the American League in wins, rank third in ERA and opponents OPS (.682)...lead the majors in innings pitched (671.0) and are tied for third in complete games (3)...have used just eight starting pitchers, which is tied with Cincinnati and Houston for second fewest starters used in the majors (Red Sox, 6).

BULLPEN: The A's bullpen has a 1.89 ERA (20 er in 95.0 ip) and .180 (60-for-333) opponents batting average over the last 30 games dating back to July 7...has a 3.55 ERA overall, which is second lowest in the American League... also has the second lowest opponents OPS (.662)...has converted six of its eigjt save opportunities dating back to July 19 and is 29-for-46 (63.0%) for the season...is tied for sixth in saves...has 11 losses, which is the fewest in the majors.

DEFENSIVE DOINGS: The A's went errorless last night, snapping a streak of five straight games with an error...have just 52 for the season, which is tied

for second fewest in the majors to the Astros (48)...are on pace for 72 errors, which would break the Athletics record for fewest errors in a season (80 in 2019)...are tied for the second fewest outfield assists in the American League (10) and have the sixth fewest double plays (88).

CLOSE CALLS AND NOT SO CLOSE: The A's won my five runs last night...six of the A's last eight wins have been by three or more runs...are 43-21 (.672) in games decided by three runs or more compared to 25-28 (.472) in games decided by two runs or fewer... are 17-19 (.472) in one-run games, which includes 11-7 at home and 6-12 on the road...lead the American League in one-run losses (19)...have played three extra inning games in the last seven games and have a five-game winning streak in extra inning contests...are 7-3 (.700) overall, which is tied with the Red Sox for the second best record in the American League (Mariners, 10-4/.714)...are 13-4 (.765) in extra innings over the last two years...are 15-7 in games decided in the last at bat...are tied with the Rockiesfor the most walk-off wins in the majors (10) and have 93 walk-off wins in the Bob Melvin era, which are the most in the majors over that span.

HOME AND AWAY: The A's are 4-1 on this 10-game road trip to Cleveland (3-0), Texas (1-1) and Chicago-AL (four games)...are 5-1 over their last five road games and are now 34-24 (.5886) in away games...this is the A's second consecutive 10-game road trip as they went 5-5 on the last trip to Seattle (1-3), San Diego (1-1) and Los Angeles-AL (3-1)...this trip concludes a stretch that began on July 6 where the A's are scheduled to play 26 of 36 games away from home...after this trip, the A's have 22 home games and 18 road games remaining...went 4-1 on the last homestand against San Diego (1-1) and Texas (3-0) and have won six of their last seven home games...are 34-25 (.576) at home.

HOME AND AWAY SPLITS: The A's have a 3.50 ERA (196 er in 504.2 ip) on the road, which is the lowest in the American League and fourth lowest in the majors...are batting .248 (501-for-2018) with a .747 OPS on the road compared to .226 with a .707 OPS at home...have the third best road batting average and second best road OPS in the AL but the second lowest home batting average and third lowest home OPS.

A's vs. RANGERS: The A's lead the season series, 9-6...are 4-2 in Oakland and 5-4 in Texas...are 6-1 over the last seven games...won the season series last year, 7-3...it was their fourth consecutive season series victory over the Rangers, which is just the second time the A's have won four consecutive season series against Texas (2002-05)...are 53-29 (.646) against the Rangers over the last five years...are 23-10 (.697) dating back to July 27, 2019, including 11-3 (.786) in Oakland...are 394-382 all-time against the Texas Rangers...that breaks down to 207-178 in Oakland and 187-204 in Texas...are 9-7 at Globe Life Field...have an all-time record of 491-466 against the Rangers/Senators franchise

TODAY'S TIDBITS

Matt Chapman is batting a .318 (7-for-22) with a 1.152 OPS, two home runs, eight runs, six RBI, along with nine walks and just seven strikeouts over his last seven games...Mitch Moreland has started each of the A's last four games and is hitting .353 with three home runs, five RBI, and a 1.507 OPS...prior to this stretch, had appeared in just one game in August...Starling Marte is batting a ML leading .423 (44-for-104) since the All-Star Break...also leads the majors in steals since the break (15) and ranks third in on-base percentage (.469)...Matt Olson ranks third in the American League in OPS (.957), slugging percentage (.578) and home runs (29), fourth in extra base hits (58), sixth in on-base percentage (.379), tied for seventh in doubles (28), sixth in RBI (79), tied for eighth in walks (58) and tied for seventh in runs (75)...Lou Trivino has converted each of his last 12 save opportunities dating back to June 5 and has a 0.93 ERA (3 er in 29.0 ip) and .188 (19-for-101) opponents batting average in 28 games over that span.

THIS DATE IN ATHLETICS HISTORY

In **1907** Chief Bender wins his 11th consecutive decision in the A's 4-2 win over Cleveland...in **1976** Joe Rudi collects his 1000th hit as an Oakland Athletic in the A's 8-7 win against Boston...in **1980** Rick Langford pitches a sixhitter as the A's defeat Seattle 11-3...it is his club record ninth consecutive complete game victory...the win comes in the midst of a club record 22 consecutive complete games...in **2009** Adam Kennedy is a perfect 5 for 5 in the A's 8-1 loss to Chicago...it is Kennedy's second of two five-hit games in 2009.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Sean Manaea (8-7, 3.43 ERA)

FOR STARTERS: Is 2-5 with a 4.18 ERA (22 er in 47.1 ip) over his last nine starts dating back to June 20 after going 6-2 with a 2.99 ERA over his first 14 starts... has received a total of four runs of support in his five losses over his last nine starts...the A's are 7-1 in his no decisions and are 15-8 (.652) in his starting assignments...are 26-13 (.667) when he starts over the last three years.

AMONG THE LEADERS: Ranks sixth in the American League in ERA (3.43), 11th in opponents on-base percentage (.297), tied for seventh in games started (23) and ninth in opponents OPS (.678) and slugging percentage (.381)...is one of three pitchers in the majors with two shutouts (DeSclafani, SF and Wheeler, PHI) and one of six with two or more complete games.

STRIKEOUTS AND WALKS: Has 47 strikeouts and just eight walks over his last seven starts and 36.0 innings...now has a career-high 143 strikeouts for the season, which ranks eighth in the American League...has walked just 32 for an average of 2.24 per nine innings, which is 10th lowest in the AL... his strikeout-to-walk ratio of 4.47 is sixth best...has three games of 10 or more strikeout this year and six in his career...the six 10-strikeout games are tied for seventh most in Oakland history...has more strikeouts than innings pitched in 12 of his 23 starts...has walked two batters or fewer 18 times, including seven starts with one walk and six with no walks.

IN AUGUST: Has allowed eight runs on 13 hits in 6.0 innings in two starts in August and is 0-1 with a 12.00 ERA...is now 8-10 with a 5.61 ERA (65 er in 104.1 ip) in 23 career starts in August...the losses are his most in any month and the ERA is his highest (5.51 in May).

LEFT AND RIGHT: Has allowed a .180 (23-for-128) batting average against left-handed hitters compared to .272 (101-for-371) against right-handers... the mark against lefties is third lowest in the American League (Kikuchi, SEA .123; Ray, TOR .179)...has surrendered six home runs in 128 at bats against lefties and nine in 371 at bats against righties...has issued 25 of his 32 walks to righties.

HOME AND AWAY: Is 4-4 with a 3.02 ERA (20 er in 59.2 ip) and .213 (47-for-221) opponents batting average in 11 starts on the road compared to 4-3 with a 3.78 ERA (29 er in 69.0 ip) and .277 (77-for-278) opponents average in 12 starts at home...has the fourth lowest road OPS in the American League (.600) and the fifth lowest road ERA...has surrendered 10 of his 15 home runs at home

DAYS REST: Is scheduled to start on four days rest...is 3-1 with a 1.38 ERA (9 er in 58.2 ip) in nine starts on four days rest compared to 5-5 with a 4.82 ERA (35 er in 65.1 ip) in 13 starts on five days rest or more...over the last three years, he is 9-2 with a 2.28 ERA (28 er in 110.2 ip) in 19 starts on four days rest, 10-6 with a 3.89 ERA (48 er in 111.0 ip) in 21 starts on five days rest or more.

THIS AND THAT: Has allowed one run or fewer in 12 of his 23 starts...10 of the 15 home runs he has surrendered have been solo shots...has a 4.34 ERA (22 er in 45.2 ip) over the first two innings of his two starts, a 2.75 ERA (23 er in 75.1 ip) in innings three through six and a 4.15 ERA (4 er in 8.2 ip) from the seventh inning on.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS: Took the loss in his first start but then went 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA over his next four starts...picked up his first win of the season in the 100th game of his career, an 8-4 victory over Detroit on April 15...tossed a six-hit, seven-inning shutout in the A's 7-0 win over Minnesota in the first game of the doubleheader April 20...it was the 11th complete game shutout of fewer than eight innings in Oakland history and his second career complete game and shutout...the start was the 100th of his career and he became the 25th pitcher in Oakland history to make 100 starts...had 10 strikeouts on May 7 against Tampa Bay, but had a no decision in the A's 2-1 win...retired each of the first 18 batters he faced before walking Arozarena to start the seventh...allowed one run or fewer in five consecutive starts from May 23 to June 14 and went 3-0 with a 0.84 ERA over that span...became the first A's pitcher with five consecutive games of one run or fewer and five innings pitched or more since Trevor Cahill (April 17-May 9, 2011)...had a no decision in the A's 6-5 loss at Los Angeles (AL) on May 23...left with a 4-1 lead but the bullpen blew the save...it was the first of two times the pen blew the save in one of his starts (July 16 vs. Cleveland)...struck out Justin Upton to lead off the game for the 50,000 strikeout in Oakland history...fanned Taylor Ward to end the fourth inning for his 500th career strikeout...tossed a four-hit shutout in the A's 6-0 win at Seattle on June 2...it was his third career complete game and shutout, his second this year...then combined with Petit, Trivino and Diekman on a two-hit shutout in the A's 4-0 win on June 9 against Arizona...it was the second time in his career he did not allow a run in back-to-back starts (Sept. 14-20, 2016)...had a career-high 16.0-inning scoreless streak from June 2 to 14...struck out 11 batters in 5.1 innings June 20 at New York (AL) but was the losing pitcher in the A's 2-1 loss...the 11 strikeouts match the most in Athletics history by a pitcher with fewer than six innings pitched...went 2-for-2 with a double June 25 at San Francisco...it was the first . extra base hit by an A's pitcher since Joe Kennedy doubled on June 12, 2007

at Houston...was named American League Pitcher of the Month for June after going 3-2 with a 1.13 ERA and .181 opponents batting average in five starts...struck out 34 batters in 32.0 innings and allowed just one home run... it was the second time he was named Pitcher of the Month (April, 2018)... struck out a career-high 13 batters in 7.0 innings in a 4-1 win at Seattle on July 22...matched the most strikeouts in Athletics history by a pitcher with seven innings or fewer and equaled the seventh highest single-game total in Oakland history...went 2-2 with a 3.30 ERA and .211 opponents batting average in five starts in July...struck out 41 and walked just five in 30.0 innings... the strikeouts tied for third in the American League in July and tied Mike Moore (1989) for the third highest total in July in Oakland history behind Vida Blue (55 in 1971, 42 in 1976).

LAST START: He had a no decision in the A's 4-3, 10-inning win at Cleveland on Tuesday...allowed three runs on five hits in 1.2 innings...it was the second shortest start of his career (0.1, Aug. 17, 2017 vs. Baltimore)...walked a season-high tying three batters for the fifth time...allowed a RBI single to Ramirez in the first but the A's came back with a run in the second...then allowed two runs in the second, including a Rosario RBI single, and was relieved by Burch Smith after tossing 69 pitches and recording just five outs.
