OAKLAND ATHLETICS (68-51) VS. CHICAGO WHITE SOX (69-50)

TUESDAY, AUGUST 17, 2021 — GUARANTEED RATE FIELD — 7:10 CDT RHP CHRIS BASSITT (12-3, 3.06) VS. RHP REYNALDO LÓPEZ (1-0, 1.35) NBCSCA — A'S CAST ON IHEART RADIO — A'S RADIO NETWORK (960 AM, 103.7 FM HD2, 1140 AM)

ABOUT THE A'S: Have lost three of the last four games after winning seven in a row...are 9-4 (.692) in August, which is the second best record in the American League, and have won 12 of the last 17 games...are 68-51 (.571) overall, which is the fifth best record in the AL...are in second place in the AL West for the 53rd consecutive day (dating back to June 21) and trail first place Houston by 2½ games for the fourth consecutive day...with the loss last night, dropped back into second place in the AL Wild Card for the first time since Aug. 7...trail Boston by ½ game and have a 1½ game lead over the third place team, New York...have spent 58 days alone in first place in the West, three days tied for first, 53 days in second, one day tied for second, three days in third, two days in fourth, three days tied for fourth and 10 days in fifth.

AGAINST THE BEST: The A's will play seven games this week, all against teams currently leading their division...after this four-game series with the White Sox, the A's return home to host a three-game series with the Giants...have a 15-22 (.405) record against teams currently leading their divisions or holding a wild card spot compared to 53-29 (.646) against all other teams.

AGAINST THE CENTRAL: The A's are 16-5 (.762) against American League Central teams, which is the best record in the majors...are batting .253 (174-for-687) and are averaging 5.7 runs per game (119 runs in 21 games) against teams from the Central compared to .234 with an average of 4.3 runs per game against all other teams...have a 2.92 ERA (60 er in 185.0 ip) against the Central, 3.81 against everyone else...went 25-8 against the AL Central in 2019 after going 26-8 in 2018...are now 81-25 (.764) against AL Central foes dating back to June 23, 2017.

PITCHING: The A's have allowed 23 runs and 39 hits over the last four games after yielding just 17 runs and 41 hits during their seven-game winning streak...have a 3.65 ERA overall, which is third lowest in the American League...have the second lowest opponents slugging percentage (.379), the third lowest OPS (.678) and fourth lowest on-base percentage (.299)...have issued the fewest walks (317), allowed the fewest home runs (123), averaged the fewest pitches per inning (15.8) and are tied for the most shutouts (11).

STARTING PITCHING: A's starting pitchers have tossed fewer than six innings in four consecutive games, which is their second longest such streak this year...began the season by doing it in five straight games...are 0-3 with a 7.08 ERA (16 er in 20.1 ip) over the last four games and 4-4 with a 4.67 ERA (36 er in 69.1 ip) in the month of August...are 45-40 with a 3.71 ERA (281 er in 681.0 ip) overall...rank third in the American League in ERA and wins and fourth in opponents OPS (.688)...lead the majors in innings pitched (681.0) and are tied for third in complete games (3)...have used just eight starting pitchers, which is tied with the Reds and Astros for second fewest in the majors (Red Sox, 7).

BULLPEN: The A's bullpen has a 1.96 ERA (22 er in 101.0 ip) and .178 (63-for-354) opponents batting average over the last 32 games dating back to July 7...has a 3.55 ERA overall, which is second lowest in the American League... also has the second lowest opponents OPS (.659)...had two blown saves in the three games at Texas and is now 29-for-46 (63.0%) in save opportunities for the season...has just 11 losses, which is the fewest in the majors...has the second highest slugging percentage against first batters faced in the AL (.430) and the fourth highest batting average (.243) but has the fourth lowest on-base percentage (.306).

OFFENSE: The A's are batting .276 (126-for-457) in August, which is second best in the American League to the Red Sox (.288)...lead the AL in on-base percentage (.366), OPS (.846) and fewest strikeouts (95), rank second in runs (83) and third in slugging (.479), home runs (22) and stolen bases (16)...have homered in all 13 games this month, which is their second longest streak of consecutive games with a home run this year (14, June 10-24)...overall, the A's have been hit by a pitch an American League leading 75 times, which is 23 more than the next closest team, the White Sox (52)...the hit by pitches are fourth most in Oakland history (88 in 2001, 87 in 2019, 76 in 2018)... rank second in the AL in stolen base percentage (82.4%) and fifth in walks (406), sacrifice hits (15), sacrifice flies (35), fewest strikeouts (1014) and fewest grounded into double plays (74)...A's pinch hitters lead the AL in hits (24), sacrifice flies (3) and plate appearances (113), are tied for the lead in home runs (3) and rank second in RBI (17) and extra base hits (6).

DEFENSIVE DOINGS: The A's have made eight errors in the last eight games but have just 53 for the season, which is tied for second fewest in the majors to the Astros (48)...are on pace for 72 errors, which would break the Athletics record for fewest errors in a season (80 in 2019)...are tied for the third fewest outfield assists in the American League (11) and have the fifth fewest double plays (89).

CLOSE CALLS AND NOT SO CLOSE: The A's have 16 wins since the All-Star Break, 12 of which have been by three runs or more...are 43-23 (.652) in games decided by three runs or more compared to 25-28 (.472) in games decided by two runs or fewer...are 17-19 (.472) in one-run games, which includes 11-7 at home and 6-12 on the road...lead the American League in one-run losses (19) and rank third in games (36)...have a five-game winning streak in extra inning games and are 7-3 (.700) overall, which is tied with the Red Sox for the second best record in the AL (Mariners, 10-4/.714)...are 13-4 (.765) in extra innings over the last two years...are 15-7 in games decided in the last at bat...are tied with the Mariners for the second most walk-off wins in the majors (10) to the Rockies (11)...have 93 walk-off wins in the Bob Melvin era, which are the most in the majors over that span.

HOME AND AWAY: The A's are 4-3 on this 10-game road trip to Cleveland (3-0), Texas (1-2) and Chicago-AL (0-1)...this is the A's second consecutive 10-game road trip as they went 5-5 on the last trip to Seattle (1-3), San Diego (1-1) and Los Angeles-AL (3-1)...this trip concludes a stretch that began on July 6 where the A's are scheduled to play 26 of 36 games on the road...after this trip, the A's have 22 home games and 18 road games remaining...are 34-26 (.567) on the road and 34-25 (.576) at home...the road record is third best in the American League...return home following the game Thursday for a ninegame homestand against San Francisco (three games), Seattle (two games) and New York-AL (four games)...went 4-1 on the last homestand against San Diego (1-1) and Texas (3-0) and have won six of their last seven home games.

HOME AND AWAY SPLITS: The A's have a 3.60 ERA (208 er in 520.2 ip) on the road, which is the lowest in the American League and fourth lowest in the majors...are batting .248 (517-for-2086) with a .746 OPS on the road compared to .226 with a .707 OPS at home...have the third best road batting average and fourth best road OPS in the AL but the second lowest home batting average and third lowest home OPS.

THIS AND THAT: The A's are 27-18 (.600) when the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher compared to 41-33 (.554) against righties...the mark against lefties is second best in the AL to the White Sox (21-12/.636)...are 4-3 in this stretch of 15 games in 15 days from Aug. 10-24...have used a different lineup in each of the last 56 games and have 116 different lineups over the first 119 contests.

A's vs. WHITE SOX: The A's lost the first meeting of 2021 last night...the two clubs squared off in the American League Wild Card Series last year, with the A's winning two of three in Oakland...the A's won the season series in 2019, 5-1...went 3-0 in Oakland and 2-1 in Chicago...it was their third consecutive season series win over the White Sox and Oakland is 15-5 against Chicago dating back to 2017...have won seven of the last 11 games in Chicago... have an eight-game winning streak in Oakland, which is the second longest Coliseum winning streak against Chicago in Oakland history (10, May 18, 2001-May 6, 2003)...since moving to Oakland in 1968, the A's are 317-291 against the White Sox...that breaks down to 167-138 in Oakland and 150-153 in Chicago...including 68-65 at Guaranteed Rate Field...all-time, the A's are 994-1046 against Chicago.

TODAY'S TIDBITS

Andrew Chafin ranks third among Major League relievers in opponents OPS (.441) and slugging percentage (.216) and seventh in on-base percentage (.225), batting average (.154) and ERA (1.70)...Starling Marte is batting a ML leading .398 (45-for-113) since the All-Star Break...also leads the majors in steals since the break (16) and ranks fourth in on-base percentage (.443)...Matt Olson ranks third in the American League in OPS (.946) and slugging percentage (.570), tied for third in home runs (30), tied for fourth in extra base hits (58), sixth in on-base percentage (.377), tied for sixth in RBI (79), tied for seventh in doubles (28) and runs (76) and eighth in walks (59)...Lou Trivino has converted each of his last 12 save opportunities dating back to June 5 and has a 0.93 ERA (3 er in 29.0 ip) and .188 (19-for-101) opponents batting average in 28 games over that span.

THIS DATE IN ATHLETICS HISTORY

In 1934 Ed Coleman hits three consecutive home runs in the first game of a doubleheader against Chicago, a 9-8, 10 inning A's win...in 1980 Brian Kingman tosses the A's Oakland record ninth consecutive complete game in the A's 4-3 loss at Seattle...in 1987 Reggie Jackson hits the 563rd and final home run of his career against his teammates from the previous season, the California Angels...he homers off Mike Witt, but the A's would go on to lose, 6-4...in 1990 Bob Welch wins his 20th game of the season en route to a club record 27 wins and the AL Cy Young...the 27 wins are the most by an American League pitcher since Denny McClain's 31 in 1968.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Chris Bassitt (12-3, 3.06 ERA)

FOR STARTERS: Is 3-1 with a 2.08 ERA (9 er in 39.0 ip) and .204 (29-for-142) opponents batting average over his last six starts...has 38 strikeouts and just seven walks over that span...has career highs in wins (12), strikeouts (153) and innings pitched (150.0) and his 24 starts are one short of his high of 25 in 2019...currently has the lowest opponents batting average (.216) and onbase percentage (.274) of his career and has matched his best OPS (.624)... has 498 career strikeouts and needs two more for 500 career.

AMONG THE LEADERS: Picked up his 12th win of the season in his last start to become the first and only 12-game winner in the American League...the A's have not had a pitcher lead the league in wins since Barry Zito in 2002 (23)...also leads the AL in innings pitched (150.0) and Oakland has not had a pitcher lead the league in innings since Dave Stewart in 1990 (267.0)...leads the AL in winning percentage (.800), is tied for the lead in games started (24), ranks third in opponents OPS (.624) and slugging percentage (.350), fourth in ERA (3.06), on-base percentage (.274) and batting average (.216) and sixth in strikeouts (153)...has allowed 15 home runs and his average of 0.90 home runs per nine innings is third lowest...is sixth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.37) and eighth in fewest walks per nine innings (2.10)...has hit 11 batters, which is tied for the most in the AL and two short of the Oakland record of 13... he also hit 13 batters in 2019, which tied the record set by Barry Zito (2001, 2005 and 2006)...ranks second in the AL in fewest pitches per inning (15.0) to teammate Cole Irvin (14.6).

HOME AND AWAY: Is 8-0 with a 3.47 ERA (32 er in 83.0 ip) in 14 starts on the road compared to 4-3 with a 2.55 ERA (19 er in 67.0 ip) in 10 starts at home...now has an Oakland record-tying nine-game road winning streak dating back to Sept. 12, 2020 and has a 3.34 ERA (33 er in 89.0 ip) over that stretch, which spans 15 starts...shares the mark with Bob Welch

(Sept 21, 1989-June 30, 1990)...has not lost on the road since Aug. 29, 2020 at Houston...is leads the American League in road wins but has the fourth lowest home ERA.

OPPONENTS BATTING: Has allowed a .182 (22-for-121) batting average with runners in scoring position, which ranks fourth in the American League...has held left-handed hitters to a .191 (50-for-262) average, which is fifth lowest...has allowed just four home runs in 293 at bats against right-handed hitters...has surrendered 11 of his 15 home runs this year and 29 of 42 over the last three years to lefties...10 of his 15 home runs have come with the bases empty...has a .140 opponents average with two strikes, which is fifth lowest in the AL...has allowed a .176 (12-for-68) average to the opponents three hitter.

AMERICAN LEAGUE ALL-STAR: Was named to the American League All-Star Team for the first time on July 10 as a replacement...pitched the sixth inning in a 5-2 AL win (1.0 ip, 1 h, 1 r, 0 er, 2 bb, 1 so)...became the first A's starting pitcher to be named to the AL All-Star Team since Sonny Gray in 2015 and the first starter to pitch in the game since Scott Kazmir in 2014.

THIS AND THAT: Has a 3.42 ERA (197 er in 518.2 ip) in 97 career appearances with the A's, which is the ninth lowest ERA in Oakland history (min. 500 ip)... the A's are 17-7 (.708) in his starting assignments this year...has left with the lead in three of his nine no decisions only to have the bullpen blow the save (May 5 vs. Toronto, May 16 at Minnesota, June 19 at New York-AL)...has tossed at least seven innings in 11 of his 24 starts...has allowed two runs or fewer 17 times and six hits or fewer 21 times.

THE LAST THREE YEARS: Is 27-10 (.730) with a 3.23 ERA (127 er in 357.0 ip) in 63 games (60 starts) over the last three years...based on a minium of 275 innings pitched, he ranks second in the American League in winning percentage over that span, fourth in ERA and fifth in opponents OPS (.667)...is tied for fifth in wins...the A's are 40-20 (.667) in his starting assignments over the last three years...was 4-14 (.222) with a 3.86 ERA in 40 games (30 starts) over his first four seasons.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS: Was the A's Opening Day starting pitcher and took the loss in an 8-1 decision to Houston on April 1 in Oakland...became the A's 14th different Opening Day starting pitcher over the last 16 years...went 10-0 with a 3.04 ERA and .209 opponents average over a 17-start stretch from April 12 to July 11...the 10-game winning streak is a career-high, tied for fourth longest in Oakland history and is second longest in the majors in 2021 (Hendricks, CHI 11)...struck out a season-high 10 batters in a 3-2 win at Boston on May 11...it was his third career game of 10 or more strikeouts... did not walk a batter, the second time he has fanned 10 or more without issuing a free pass...is one of nine pitchers in Oakland history with two such games...tossed his first career complete game and shutout May 27 against Los Angeles (AL), a two-hitter in the A's 5-0 win...it came in his 77th career

start, his 72nd with the A's...the 71 consecutive starts without a complete games is the second longest streak in Athletics history (113, Barry Zito, Aug. 22, 2003-Sept. 28, 2006)...finished May with a 3-0 record, a 2.52 ERA and .175 opponents batting average in five starts...then went 4-0 with a 2.70 ERA in six starts in June...it was the first time in his career he won four games in a month...was one of four American League pitchers to win four games in June and his ERA tied for fifth...allowed two runs or fewer in five consecutive starts from June 8 to 30 and was 4-0 with a 1.93 ERA and .197 opponents batting average over that span.

LAST START: He combined with Puk, Guerra and Diekman on a three-hit shutout in the A's 17-0 win at Cleveland last Thursday...tossed six innings and allowed all three of the hits...also walked two but allowed just two base runners to advance into scoring position.

Oakland and 1-1 with a 2.92 ERA (4 er in 12.1 ip) in two starts at Guaranteed Rate Field as a visitor...was 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (13.0 ip, 8 h, 4 bb, 13 so) in two regular season starts last year...the first win came in a 13-2 A's victory in Oakland on July 13...tossed six scoreless innings and allowed four hits while walking two...allowed just one base runner into scoring position... was relieved by Treinen to start the seventh with the A's leading 12-0...then combined with Diekman, Soria and Hendriks on a five-hit shutout in the A's 2-0 win at Chicago (AL) on Aug. 11...tossed seven of the innings and allowed four of the hits while walking two...retired each of the final eight batters that he faced...also earned the win in a 5-3 A's victory in Game 2 of the ALWCS in Oakland on Sept. 30...blanked the White Sox on five hits and a walk over the first seven innings and allowed just three base runners as far as second base...had a 5-0 lead when he allowed a lead off single to Anderson in the eighth...was relieved by Hendriks, who allowed Anderson to score on a Grandal home run.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER

LHP Cole Irvin (8-11, 3.52 ERA): Has compiled a 2.98 ERA, .229 opponents batting average and allowed just two home runs over his last nine starts dating back to June 22...however, is just 4-4 over that span...ranks fifth in the American League in opponents OPS (.665) and slugging percentage (.364) and seventh in ERA (3.52) but is tied for fourth in most losses (11)...has walked two batters or fewer in each of his 23 starts, which is the second longest such streak by a starting pitcher in Oakland history...has issued just 25 free passes in 135.1 innings, an average of 1.66 walks per nine innings...that is the second lowest mark in the AL...is averaging 14.6 pitches per inning, which are the fewest in the majors...has allowed 11 home runs in 135.1 innings and his average of 0.73 home runs per nine innings is third lowest in the AL...was the losing pitcher in his last start, an 8-6 A's loss at Texas last Friday (5.0 ip, 8 h, 5 r, 3 er, 1 bb, 2 so)...has never faced the White Sox in his career.
