Athletics' Anderson Receives Treatment for Injured Left Elbow

OAKLAND, Calif.—The Oakland Athletics announced today that left-handed starting pitcher Brett Anderson has received a Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) injection into his left elbow and will now undergo six weeks of rehabilitation. Dr. James Andrews examined the A's pitcher this morning at the Andrews Institute in Pensacola, Fla. and recommended the procedure. The team said Anderson will be reevaluated in three weeks. .

Anderson, who was placed on the 15-day disabled list June 7 due to a left sore elbow, is 3-6 with a 4.00 ERA in 13 starts this season. He went 7-6 with a 2.80 ERA in 19 starts last season and is 21-23 with a 3.66 ERA in 62 career starts. This is his third career stint on the DL.
