News and Happenings for the A's Home Opener and Upcoming Season A's to Celebrate 40th Anniversary of 1972 World Series Championship

OAKLAND, Calif. - In one of the most unique early schedules in franchise history, the Oakland A's will square off against the Seattle Mariners for three different Opening Nights in the first two weeks of the 2012 campaign. The Athletics and Mariners christened the Major League season by playing two games in Japan last week, and now showcase the same matchup in Oakland this weekend, including the traditional Opening Night at the Oakland Coliseum this Friday at 7:05 p.m. The two teams will then stage a third Opening Night in Seattle April 13 when the Mariners open their home season.

The A's split their two-game Gloops Japan Opening Series 2012 last week in the Tokyo Dome, dropping Game One, 3-1 in 11 innings March 28 and prevailing, 4-1, March 29. Due to the Japan series, the A's will only play two games against Seattle this weekend, with the second scheduled for Saturday at 6:05 p.m. and featuring a matchup of two former Cy Young Award winners in the Athletics' Bartolo Colón and Mariners' Felix Hernandez.

Oakland then concludes its first homestand of the season by hosting the Kansas City Royals Monday, April 9 and Tuesday, April 10 at 7:05 p.m., and a Wednesday matinee at 12:35 p.m.

A's HOME OPENER: The A's Home Opener, Friday, April 6, launches the Oakland A's celebration of the 40-year anniversary of the 1972 World Series with A's '72 World Series MVP Gene Tenace tossing out the ceremonial first pitch (set for 7 p.m.). In addition, fans attending this 7:05 p.m. game against the Mariners will receive an A's Magnetic Schedule, courtesy of Farmers Insurance.

- The A's will celebrate the 40th anniversary of the 1972 World Series 1972 WORLD SERIES CELEBRATION: Championship Friday, April 20 and Saturday, April 21 vs. Cleveland. The two-night celebration will feature appearances by players from the '72 team, including Vida Blue, Bert Campaneris, Tim Cullen, Dave Duncan, Rollie Fingers, Dick Green, Dave Hamilton, Mike Hegan, Ken Holtzman, Joe Horlen, Darold Knowles, Ted Kubiak, Bob Locker, Joe Rudi and Tenace among others. Starting at 5:35 p.m. Friday, there will be an autograph session in the Eastside Club with various members of the team, with proceeds benefitting the Jim "Catfish" Hunter ALS Foundation. On Saturday, 10,000 fans will receive a Rollie Fingers bobblehead, sponsored by Comcast SportsNet California, and pre-game ceremonies will feature a reunion celebration with Fingers throwing out the ceremonial first pitch.
- TURNING BACK THE CLOCK: The A's will celebrate the 1950s Oakland Oaks with a "Turn Back the Clock" game July 8 vs. Seattle. Both teams will don throwback '55 jerseys during that afternoon's 1:05 p.m. game, with the A's wearing white Oakland Oaks jerseys and the Mariners wearing grey Seattle Rainiers jerseys. In addition, 10,000 fans through the turnstiles will receive a 1955 Oakland Oaks Hat, courtesy of Cache Creek Casino Resort.
- 20-GAME WIN STREAK ANNIVERSARY: The A's home slate also features the 10-year anniversary of the A's 20-game winning streak which will be commemorated in August against Cleveland. On Aug. 18, 15,000 fans receive a bobblehead of 20-game winning streak hero Scott Hatteberg, sponsored by Pepsi, and Aug. 19, 10,000 fans will receive a 20-game winning streak t-shirt, courtesy of Cache Creek Casino Resort, before the game.
- POST-GAME ENTERTAINMENT: Five post-game fireworks shows are scheduled for the 2012 season and all fans in attendance will have the opportunity to enjoy the show from the field. They are: May 25 vs. New York, June 15 vs. San Diego, July 3 vs. Boston, Aug. 3 vs. Toronto and Sept.14 vs. Baltimore.

- CHEVY FREE PARKING TUESDAYS: As a part of the Chevy Free Parking Tuesdays promotion, fans can park for free (\$17 savings) at the Oakland Coliseum for most Tuesday home games.

- THROWBACK THURSDAYS: Fans attending Throwback Thursday at the A's will enjoy in-game music from various classic eras and 10,000 fans will receive a commemorative scorecard and bag of peanuts upon entry. In addition, fans can purchase Plaza Level tickets at a 50% off discount, and specialty food items from the era will be available at the concession stands.

XFINITY FRIDAY FAMILY PACK: Every Friday during the regular season, fans can purchase four Plaza Level tickets and four meals (Coliseum hot dog, medium drink, bag of peanuts) for only \$50 (\$150 value).

- **CSNCA AUTHENTIC FAN FRIDAY:** Every Friday home game during the regular season, Comcast SportsNet California will host Authentic Fan Friday in the Value Deck of the Coliseum. Located in Sections 316-318, Comcast SportsNet California Value Deck tickets start at just \$12 for most Friday games, and each ticket includes a Jumbo Ticket added-value of \$6 within the ticket barcode redeemable throughout the ballpark for merchandise or concessions. NEW FOOD IN THE COLISEUM: ARAMARK concessions, premium catering and dining services will feature a few new food items this season throughout Oakland Coliseum.
