- "Miles For Smiles" Treadmill Run: Angie Balfour and other players' wives and girlfriends are teaming up with Smile Train, an international nonprofit organization that provides free cleft surgeries to poor children in developing countries. The wives and girlfriends will attempt to fund one surgery per mile that they run on a treadmill set up adjacent to the left field BBQ terrace. In addition, A's closer Grant Balfour will sign 2013 All-Star Game photos behind Section 120 from 6-6:30 p.m. for the first 100 fans who donate \$40 to Smile Train.
- **Heart and Hustle Award Presentation:** Prior to the game on Friday, July 26, World Series champion and A's broadcaster Ray Fosse will present third baseman Josh Donaldson with the ninth annual Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association's Heart and Hustle Award. The award is given to one player from each MLB team who demonstrates a passion for the game and best embodies the values, spirit and traditions of the game of baseball.
