Filipino Heritage Night: On Friday, Aug. 16, the A's are hosting their fifth annual Filipino Heritage Night, presented by Cache Creek Casino Resort. Fans that purchased a special ticket to the game will receive an exclusive A's Filipino Heritage Scarf and a traditional food item served in the Bar & Grille.

Yoenis Céspedes Bobblehead Giveaway: On Saturday, Aug. 17, 15,000 fans will receive a Yoenis Céspedes bobblehead, presented by State Farm. Gates will open at 2:30 p.m. for the 6:05 p.m. game against the Cleveland Indians, so fans are encouraged to arrive early to have a chance to take home the first ever bobblehead of the 2013 Home Run Derby champion.

- **Take the Field with the A's:** The Take the Field with the A's program gives youth baseball and softball teams the chance to live out their Major League dreams. On Sunday, Aug. 18, youth players will join Oakland A's players on the field during the National Anthem. Each participant receives an autographed baseball and t-shirt, courtesy of the A's Community Fund.
- **Little A's:** On Thursday, Aug. 15 and Wednesday, Aug. 21, as part of the Little A's program, deserving youth and their chaperones of non-profit organizations will have the opportunity to attend an A's game free of charge. In addition to a game ticket, each child receives a Bank of America souvenir and child-admission pass to the Oakland Zoo. The Little A's program is presented by Bank of America and supported by the Oakland Zoo and Clorox.
- A's Relief: As part of the A's Relief program, the A's bullpen is honoring unsung Bay Area heroes who choose to do the right thing in the community. Once per month, the A's Community Fund and A's relief pitchers will make a donation to the charity of the recipient's choice. An A's player will visit and sign autographs for the students as a way to congratulate them for their hard work. After the students have finished their homework, they are able to sit in the stands and watch the game.
- **A's Amigos:** On Tuesday, Aug. 20, an A's player will visit with Spanish-speaking children from Mujeres Unidas y Activas as part of the A's Amigos program. In addition to the pre-game chat, each child will receive a game ticket and an A's hat. A's Amigos is supported by Kelly Moore Paints and XFINITY.
- **Senior Days:** On Wednesday, Aug. 21, a group of senior citizens will receive free tickets to the game as part of the Senior Days program.
- **A's Community Fund Silent Auctions:** Every Saturday and Sunday home game, the A's Community Fund hosts a silent auction featuring signed and unsigned A's memorabilia as well as game-used items. The silent auctions are located in the A's fan center behind section 120 and end with the last out in the bottom of the 5th inning.
