A's Reinstate RHP Ryan Cook; Place OF Josh Reddick on 15-Day DL

OAKLAND, Calif. – The Oakland Athletics announced today that they have reinstated right-handed pitcher Ryan Cook from the 15-day Disabled List and placed outfielder Josh Reddick on the 15-day DL (retroactive to June 1) with a hyperextended right knee injury.

Cook, who was placed on the disabled list for a second time this season May 9 with a strained right forearm, pitched a scoreless inning with Single-A Stockton against Modesto Saturday night. He originally was placed on the DL March 29 with right shoulder tendinitis before being activated April 7. The 26-year-old reliever registered a 0-1 record and 2.92 ERA over 12.1 innings and 12 games for Oakland before returning to the disabled list May 9. Last season, Cook posted a 6-4 mark with two saves and a 2.54 ERA in a team-leading 71 relief appearances.

Reddick, who sustained his knee injury in Saturday's 11-3 victory over the Los Angeles Angels, was batting .214 (36-for-168) with three doubles, three triples, four home runs and 22 RBI in 50 games played. Last season, he hit .226 with 12 homers and 56 RBI in 114 games in a season interrupted by two stints on the disabled list with a sprained right wrist.
