An A's player will visit and sign autographs for the students as a way to congratulate them for their hard work. After the students have finished their homework, they are able to sit in the stands and watch the game.
- "A It Forward" presented by PG&E: The "A It Forward" program, sponsored by PG&E, incorporates a surprise element at the game to make the experience more special for the children and their families. "A It Forward" will host a group of children from the Type 1 diabetes group carbDM on Wednesday, June 10, for an on-field meet-and-greet with Sam Fuld, who also has T1D.
